THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Ashley Herring, G/F • So., 5'9 • Memphis, Tenn. • Austin Peay

Herring led Austin Peay each of its two OVC contests, finishing the week with 54 points. She tied her career-best with 21 points at Southeast Missouri, including hitting the team's first 14 points of the second half as the Lady Govs pulled away to secure the victory. Herring followed that up with a career-high 33 points at Eastern Illinois and became the first player to reach 30 points since the 2005-06 campaign. Her seven rebounds at EIU also led the team. Herring shot 53.1 percent from the floor, including hitting 50 percent of her three-point attempts last week.

Tiffany Hamilton, G • Jr., 5'7 • Winter Haven, Fla. • Morehead State

Hamilton ran her streak of double-figure scoring games to seven, averaging 15.0 points against UT Martin and Murray State last week. She totaled 14 points, four rebounds and six assists in an 84-76 overtime win against Murray State. Seven of her 14 points came in overtime and she was 4-for-4 at the free throw line in the final minute to help seal the victory. She hit four three-points and scored 16 points in 28 minutes in an 82-54 win against UT Martin.

Drake was Eastern Kentucky's second leading scorer with 11 points against Murray State while also dishing out three assists. In EKU's win over UT Martin, Drake scored nine points and added a career-high six assists and a team-best six rebounds. In 33 minutes on the court, Drake committed just two turnovers and forced three steals.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former ECU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winngest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same the school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016)

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay opened Conference play with a victory for the third consecutive year, posting a 61-50 win at Southeast Missouri. The Lady Govs saw their record leveled with an 81-70 loss at Eastern Illinois. The 70 points APSU scored at EIU were a season high and the most since a 72-points outburst at Tennessee State last season - a span of 14 games between 70-point outings. Sophomore **Ashley Herring** averaged 27 points to lead the Lady Govs in both games. She shot 53.1 percent from the floor including 50 percent from behind the arc. Freshman point guard **Emily Pollock** dished out 14 assists last week and finished with four steals. Sophomore transfer **Brooke Faulkner** will join the Lady Govs' bench against SIU Edwardsville on Saturday, after sitting out one year due to transfer rules. The game with the Cougars on Saturday is the only contest for Austin Peay this week. The game can be seen on OVCSports.TV.

Eastern Illinois swept its Conference-opening weekend, improving its home winning streak to 11. The Panthers defeated Tennessee State, 83-45, and Austin Peay, 81-70. EIU grabbed a season-high 53 rebounds in the win against Tennessee State, reaching the 50-board mark in a game for the first time since December 2007. Against Austin Peay, EIU shot 54 percent from the field after making its first seven field goal attempts of the game. The Panthers made six three pointers in both games. Team Notes

Morehead State started 2-0 in OVC play for the first time since 2003-04 by defeating UT Martin (82-54) and Murray State (84-76, OT). The Eagles' 6-2 start is the best eight-game start since 2001-02.
