NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Freshman Frenzy: Jacksonville State's Cierra Duhart is one of three OVC freshmen that are ranked among league leaders in field goal percentage. Duhart's 59.8-percent is tops in the OVC while Samford's Emily London (51.1%) and Savannah Hill (48.4%%) are sixth and ninth, respectively. In addition, London (12.2 ppg) along with Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman (12.5 ppg) are among the Conference's top 15 in scoring. Bozeman is third in free throw percentage (88.7%) while London ranks sixth (83.8%). London is also third in three-point field-goal percentage (44.2%) and Hill ranks 10th, making 40.3 percent of her three-point field goal attempts.

Two on ESPNU: Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be broadcast on ESPNU. The first contest will be on Jan. 26 and will feature Tennessee State at Tennessee Tech. Tip off for that game is 11:00 a.m. Central. The second contest will take place on Feb. 2 as Southeast Missouri entertains UT Martin at 3:00 p.m. CT.

Back to Municipal: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 14th time in 15 years, will return to Municipal Auditorium this season for the first time since 2004. The two-day event has previously been held at the Sommet Center (formerly the Gaylord Entertainment Center). The tourney was also held at Municipal in 1989, 1994 and 1995.

OVCSports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head women's basketball coaches and sports information directors, Southeast Missouri was picked to repeat as OVC Champions in 2007-08. The Redhawks compiled a 24-8 overall record and a 16-4 Conference mark to win their second straight OVC regular-season and tournament titles. Southeast Missouri senior Missy Whitney was tabbed the 2007-08 OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Southeast Missouri garnered 19 of the 22 possible first-place votes with Samford (2) and Eastern Illinois (1) claiming the other first-place nods. Samford finished second in the polling, followed by Murray State in third and Eastern Illinois in fourth. Last season, Samford was fourth while Murray State was second and Eastern Illinois was ninth. Tennessee Tech was picked fifth, followed by UT Martin in sixth and Eastern Kentucky in seventh. Those three teams all finished in the top eight of the league standings and made the OVC Tournament. Morehead State tabbed eighth followed by Austin Peay, Tennessee State and Jacksonville State.

From Player to Coach: Nine former OVC Women's basketball players are now serving as head or assistant coaches in the league with seven serving on the staff of their Alma Mater. Austin Peay's skipper Carrie Daniels played for the Lady Govs where she was a member of the 1996 team that made the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament. Jacksonville State assistant coach Gerlonda Hardin was named the 2003-04 OVC Player of the Year while a member of the Austin Peay squad. She led the Lady Govs to four OVC Tournament titles. Samford assistant Clarissa Thompson, who played for the Bulldogs from 1998-2000, dished out 336 assists which ranks second all-time at the school. Tennessee State head coach Tracee Wells and assistant Tamara Washington were both members of the Lady Tigers. Wells was apart of the TSU squad that won the 1995 OVC Tournament title. UT Martin skipper Tara Tansil was a standout on the Skyhawk squad and still holds the school records for free-throw attempts (751), free throws made (564) and 3-point attempts (415). Skyhawk assistant Jessica Grayson was a member of the Austin Peay team that won two league tournament titles. Eastern Kentucky assistant Lisa Pace was a four-year letter winner for the Lady Colonels. Tennessee Tech assistant Misty Garrett was apart of four Golden Eagle teams that won or shared an OVC regular-season title.
