Pittman recorded 16.0 points and 12.5 rebounds per game over Morehead State's two contests last week. She also shot 47 percent from the field and averaged 5.0 blocked shots. Pittman scored a game-high 18 points to go along with 11 rebounds and three blocks in the win over Tennessee State. She followed that up with 14 points, 14 rebounds and seven blocks versus Austin Peay.

Smith averaged a double-double last week with 14.5 points and 13.0 rebounds to help Tennessee State split a pair of road contests. She matched a career-high with 16 points to go with 12 rebounds against Morehead State. Smith picked up her fourth double-double of the season in the win at Eastern Kentucky with 13 points and 14 boards. She shot nearly 67 percent from beyond the arch last week.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former ECU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winngest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same the school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

Tickets on Sale: All-Session tickets for the 2009 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale through the Sommet Center ticket office and Ticketmaster. Fans can purchase tickets by calling the Sommet Center ticket office (615-770-2040) or Ticketmaster (615-255-9600). Tickets can also be purchased online through Ticketmaster.com.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay picked up victories over Eastern Kentucky (67-51) and Morehead State (61-59) to run its winning streak to four games. With seven games remaining in the regular-season, the Lady Govs have improved last season's overall total by six games, which is one of the nation's top improvements. APSU also has a five game improvement in OVC play. The win in Morehead was the first since Jan. 17, 2004 and also snapped the Eagles 14-game home win streak. Junior **Nicole Jamen** put up 15.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game over the two contests. She led the Lady Govs with 18 points in the win over Eastern Kentucky. Senior **April Thomas** recorded her eighth double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 rebounds at EKU. She is averaging 14.3 points and 9.8 rebounds in her last 10 outings. Freshman **Whitney Hanley** had an off-night offensively at EKU, scoring just eight points, but followed that up with a 12-point performance versus Morehead State. Austin Peay will return home to host UT Martin on Tuesday and Murray State on Saturday. Both games can be seen on OVCSports.TV.

Eastern Illinois extended its home-win streak to 17 games with victories over Tennessee Tech (76-56) and Jacksonville State (71-58). Senior **Rachel Galligan** shot 72.2% from the floor en route to leading the Panthers in scoring in both games. She had 22 points against Tech and 14 in the win over JSU. She was also 10-for-10 from the line, tying the EIU single-game percentage record. Senior **Lindsay Kluempers** scored a season-high 14 points in the win versus JSU and chipped in nine points against Tech. She made a pair of three-pointers in both games. Junior **Maggie Kloak** had 15 points in the game against Tennessee Tech thanks to a career-high 9-of-10 showing from the line.
