Appling scored a career-high 50 points to lead Tennessee State past Jacksonville State. Her 50-point performance was just one shy of the Ohio Valley Conference and TSU single-game record. Appling went 19-for-31 from the floor, including hitting 60 percent from beyond the arc. She also recorded her 1,000th career point, moving into 12th on TSU's all-time list.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Freshman Frenzy: Jacksonville State's Cierra Duhart is one of three OVC freshmen that are ranked among league leaders in field goal percentage. Duhart's 57.9-percent is tops in the OVC while Samford's Emily London (51.8%) and Savannah Hill (47.2%) are fourth and eighth, respectively. In addition, London (12.5 ppg) along with Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman (12.8 ppg) are among the Conference's top 15 in scoring. Bozeman is second in free throw percentage (88.1%) while London ranks seventh (82.1%). London is also second in three-point field-goal percentage (49.1%).

Two on ESPNU: Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be broadcast on ESPNU. The first contest will be on Jan. 26 and will feature Tennessee State at Tennessee Tech. Tip off for that game is 11:00 a.m. Central. The second contest will take place on Feb. 2 as Southeast Missouri entertains UT Martin at 3:00 p.m. CT.

Back to Municipal: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 14th time in 15 years, will return to Municipal Auditorium this season for the first time since 2004. The two-day event has previously been held at the Sommet Center (formerly the Gaylord Entertainment Center). The tourney was also held at Municipal in 1989, 1994 and 1995.

OVCsports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head women's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Southeast Missouri** was picked to repeat as OVC Champions in 2007-08. The Redhawks compiled a 24-8 overall record and a 16-4 Conference mark to win their second straight OVC regular-season and tournament titles. Southeast Missouri senior **Missy Whitney** was tabbed the 2007-08 OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Southeast Missouri garnered 19 of the 22 possible first-place votes with **Samford** (2) and **Eastern Illinois** (1) claiming the other first-place nods. Samford finished second in the polling, followed by **Murray State** in third and Eastern Illinois in fourth. Last season, Samford was fourth while Murray State was second and Eastern Illinois was ninth. **Tennessee Tech** was picked fifth, followed by **UT Martin** in sixth and **Eastern Kentucky** in seventh. Those three teams all finished in the top eight of the league standings and made the OVC Tournament. **Morehead State** tabbed eighth followed by **Austin Peay**, **Tennessee State** and **Jacksonville State**.

From Player to Coach: Nine former OVC Women's basketball players are now serving as head or assistant coaches in the league with seven serving on the staff of their Alma Mater. Austin Peay's skipper Carrie Daniels played for the Lady Govs where she was a member of the 1996 team that made the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament. Jacksonville State assistant coach Gerlonda Hardin was named the 2003-04 OVC Player of the Year while a member of the Austin Peay squad. She led the Lady Govs to four OVC Tournament titles. Samford assistant Clarissa Thompson, who played for the Bulldogs from 1998-2000, dished out 336 assists which ranks second all-time at the school. Tennessee State head coach Tracee Wells and assistant Tamara Washington were both members of the Lady Tigers. Wells was apart of the TSU squad that won the 1995 OVC Tournament title. UT Martin skipper Tara Tansil was a standout on the Skyhawk squad and still holds the school records for free-throw attempts (751), free throws made (564) and 3-point attempts (415). Skyhawk assistant Jessica Grayson was a member of the Austin Peay team that won two league tournament titles. Eastern Kentucky assistant Lisa Pace was a four-year letter winner for the Lady Colonels. Tennessee Tech assistant Misty Garrett was apart of four Golden Eagle teams that won or shared an OVC regular-season title.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Tuesday, Dec. 4. OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2007 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 3 p.m. and televised live on ESPN. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

This marks the 14th time in 15 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and the fifth time it will take place in Municipal. The event was also held there in 1989, 1994, 1995 and 2004.

Austin Peay saw its losing streak reach nine games after a loss to Southeast Missouri (67-47) before snapping the streak with a 55-48 win over UT Martin. Senior **Ashley McGee** maintained her position atop the league's assists leaders after posting 16 in two games last week. She is attempting to become the first APSU player to lead the league in assists in a season. In addition, McGee averaged 11.5 points last week. Freshman **Ashley Herring** led the Lady Govs in scoring in both games, posting 11 versus Southeast Missouri and 15 in the UT Martin contest. Sophomore **Nicole Jamen** grabbed an APSU season-best 15 rebounds at UT Martin. Austin Peay will close out the 2007-08 season with a pair of road contests this week as it travels to Eastern Kentucky on Thursday and Morehead State on Saturday. Eastern Illinois picked up a non-conference win as the Panthers defeated Illinois Tech, 74-30, in its only game of the week. Every Panther that played connected on a field goal in the victory. Sophomore **Marie Baker**, scored a career-high 13 points, recording her point total in just 14 minutes. She was EIU's lone double-figure scorer. It marked the first time EIU has won a game with one double-figures score since a December 2004 win at Butler. Junior **Rachel Galligan** scored eight points in 16 minutes, ending her double-figure scoring streak at 15 games. EIU made six of its seven three-pointers in the first half and six different Panthers made at least one trey. Eastern Kentucky split a pair of OVC road games last week, defeating UT Martin (68-53) and falling to Southeast Missouri (68-52). Senior **Ashley Cazee** scored 20 points and grabbed eight boards in the win over UT Martin. The Lady Colonels shot 50 percent in the second half and 47.4 percent for the game versus the Skyhawks. The EKU defense held UT Martin to 26.2 percent shooting. Against Southeast Missouri, senior **Crystal Jones** posted 18 points and a career-high 15 rebounds.
