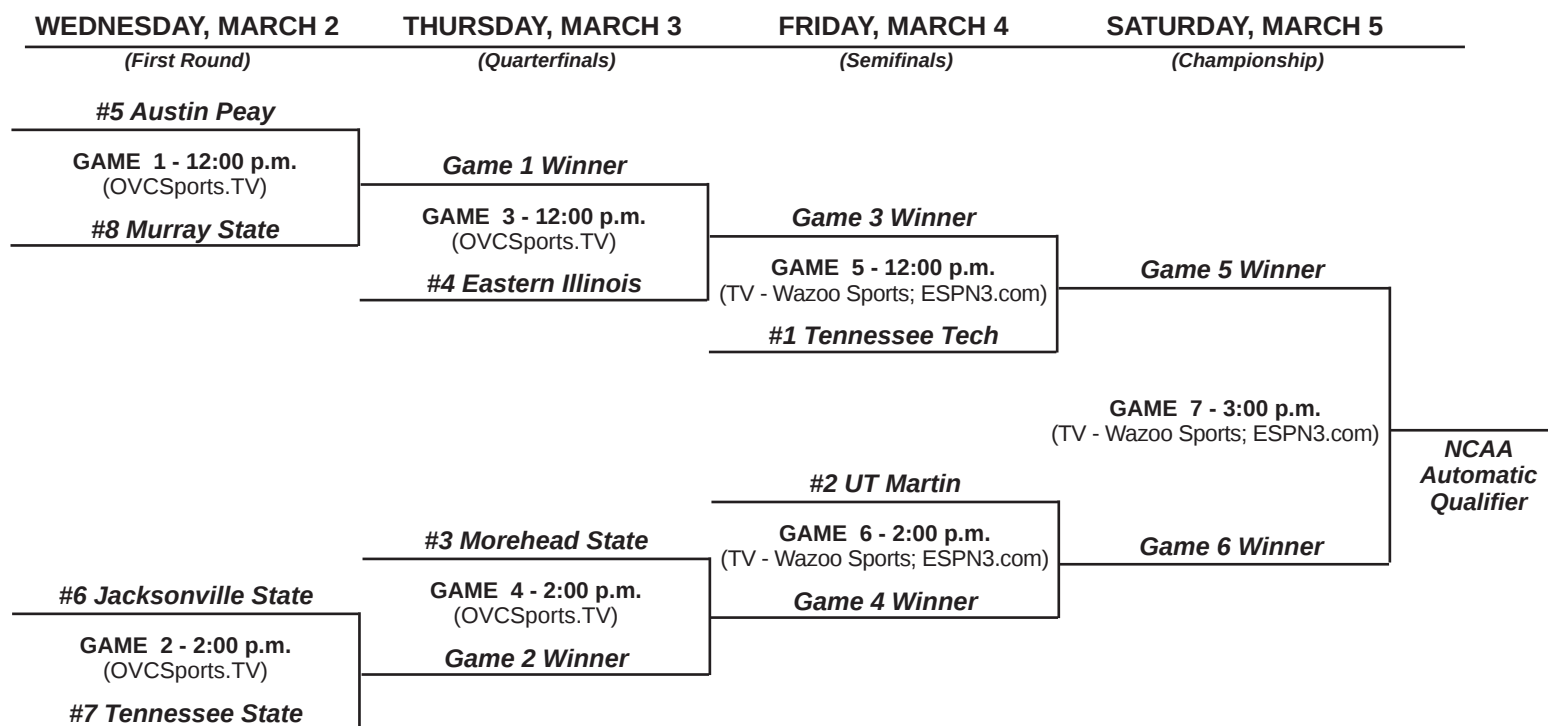

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Tennessee Tech Wins 16th OVC Regular-Season Title: Tennessee Tech, which was predicted to finish 4th in the league race, earned its 16th OVC regular-season title but its first since the 2005-06 season. The Golden Eagles 16 regular-season crowns is tops in the conference. Tennessee Tech has also won nine OVC Tournament titles most recently in 2000.

Tourney Tidbits: Austin Peay enters the tournament as the fifth seed for the second time in three years....Eastern Illinois is making its fourth straight trip to the tourney... Jacksonville State will be making its sixth appearance in the postseason since joining the OVC in 2003....Morehead State has finished in the top four in the OVC Standings the last three years....Murray State will be appearing in its 18th conference tournament ...Tennessee State earned its fourth straight trip to the OVC Tourney...Tennessee Tech has posted a 41-19 record in OVC Tournament games and has won a league-leading nine tourney titles...UT Martin will play in its third OVC Tourney in the last five years.

New Tournament Format: Starting with the 2011 Championships, all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville. The bracket will also shift from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

Back at Municipal: Along with the change in format, comes a relocation of the tournament to historic Nashville Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. The venue will host the championship, which will now be a four-day event. Municipal Auditorium has been the site of the OVC Basketball Championship in 1989 (men only), 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and most recently in 2008. The move to Municipal Auditorium will keep the championships in Nashville, a place where they have been held 16 times in the last 17 years. The only year the tournaments have not been held in Nashville during that stretch was 2002.

New Faces: For the third straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Morehead State and Jacksonville State will each have new head coaches. The Eagles will be under the direction of first-year head coach Tom Hodges, who comes to Morehead State after spending the last five years at Middle Tennessee State, including the last two seasons as the on-court assistant to Rick Insell. Hodges also spent time at Chattanooga as an assistant and was an undergraduate assistant at Tennessee Tech. Annette Watts takes over the reigns of Jacksonville State after spending the last nine seasons as the head coach at Davidson, where she was the winningest coach in program history. Prior to Davidson, Watts spent two years as the coach of Jackson County Comprehensive High School.

OVCSports.TV: For the fifth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

Team Notes

Austin Peay saw its five-game win streak snapped with a 71-66 loss to Eastern Illinois. The Lady Govs rebounded with a 71-51 victory over Southeast Missouri to close-out the regular-season. Austin Peay finished with a 12-6 OVC record, the fourth consecutive year APSU has improved its league mark under head coach **Carrie Daniels**. Austin Peay will enter the tournament as the fifth seed for the second time in three years. Senior **Brooke Faulkner** led the Lady Govs with 16 points against Eastern Illinois, making 6-of-14 from the field and 4-of-9 from three-point range. She scored 11 points against Southeast Missouri to go with four assists, three blocks and two steals. Freshman **Nicole Olszewski** was second on the team in scoring for the second straight week. She had 14 points against EIU and followed that up with nine points against Southeast Missouri. Junior **Jasmine Rayner** recorded her fifth double-double with 11 points and 13 rebounds against the Panthers. The fifth-seeded Lady Govs will face No. 8 Murray State in first round action on Wednesday.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois closed out the regular-season with a pair of wins as the Panthers defeated Austin Peay (71-66) and Tennessee State (69-53). Eastern Illinois has now won its last nine games. Sophomore **Mariah King** scored 18 points in each of the wins. For the week, she shot 64 percent from the floor. Junior **Hillary Held** came off the bench to score 10.5 points per game last week. She was 8-for-10 from the floor over the two games. Held scored 13 points versus Tennessee State and had eight points against Austin Peay. Eastern Illinois earned the third seed in the OVC Tournament and a first-round bye. The Panthers will face the winner of the Austin Peay/Murray State game in the quarterfinals on Thursday.
