Galligan posted a pair of double-doubles in Eastern Illinois' two double-overtime games. She led all scorers in both contests, going for 19 points and 12 rebounds at Jacksonville State and 23 points and 11 rebounds at Samford. Galligan also delivered a game-clinching block in the second overtime against Jacksonville State.

Armstrong posted her first career double-double with 26 points and 11 rebounds against Tennessee State. She went 8-for-19 (.421) from the field and 9-of-10 from the free throw line. The 26 points were the most by a Lady Gov since Ashley Haynes scored 25 points in the 2005-06 regular-season finale. Against Murray State, she had nine points and five rebounds.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Freshman Frenzy: Jacksonville State's Cierra Duhart is one of three OVC freshmen that are ranked among league leaders in field goal percentage. Duhart's 59.2-percent is tops in the OVC while Samford's Emily London (50.8%) and Savannah Hill (50.0%) are seventh and 10th, respectively. In addition, London (12.0 ppg) along with Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman (12.6 ppg) are among the Conference's top 15 in scoring. Bozeman is third in free throw percentage (88.5%) while London ranks sixth (84.6%). London is also fifth in three-point field-goal percentage (44.9%) and Hill ranks ninth, making 42.4 percent of her three-point field goal attempts.

Two on ESPNU: Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be broadcast on ESPNU. The first contest will be on Jan. 26 and will feature Tennessee State at Tennessee Tech. Tip off for that game is 11:00 a.m. Central. The second contest will take place on Feb. 2 as Southeast Missouri entertains UT Martin at 3:00 p.m. CT.

Back to Municipal: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 14th time in 15 years, will return to Municipal Auditorium this season for the first time since 2004. The two-day event has previously been held at the Sommet Center (formerly the Gaylord Entertainment Center). The tourney was also held at Municipal in 1989, 1994 and 1995.

OVCSports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head women's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Southeast Missouri** was picked to repeat as OVC Champions in 2007-08. The Redhawks compiled a 24-8 overall record and a 16-4 Conference mark to win their second straight OVC regular-season and tournament titles. Southeast Missouri senior **Missy Whitney** was tabbed the 2007-08 OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Southeast Missouri garnered 19 of the 22 possible first-place votes with **Samford** (2) and **Eastern Illinois** (1) claiming the other first-place nods. Samford finished second in the polling, followed by **Murray State** in third and Eastern Illinois in fourth. Last season, Samford was fourth while Murray State was second and Eastern Illinois was ninth. **Tennessee Tech** was picked fifth, followed by **UT Martin** in sixth and **Eastern Kentucky** in seventh. Those three teams all finished in the top eight of the league standings and made the OVC Tournament. **Morehead State** tabbed eighth followed by **Austin Peay**, **Tennessee State** and **Jacksonville State**.

From Player to Coach: Nine former OVC Women's basketball players are now serving as head or assistant coaches in the league with seven serving on the staff of their Alma Mater. Austin Peay's skipper Carrie Daniels played for the Lady Govs where she was a member of the 1996 team that made the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament. Jacksonville State assistant coach Gerlonda Hardin was named the 2003-04 OVC Player of the Year while a member of the Austin Peay squad. She led the Lady Govs to four OVC Tournament titles. Samford assistant Clarissa Thompson, who played for the Bulldogs from 1998-2000, dished out 336 assists which ranks second all-time at the school. Tennessee State head coach Tracee Wells and assistant Tamara Washington were both members of the Lady Tigers. Wells was apart of the TSU squad that won the 1995 OVC Tournament title. UT Martin skipper Tara Tansil was a standout on the Skyhawk squad and still holds the school records for free-throw attempts (751), free throws made (564) and 3-point attempts (415). Skyhawk assistant Jessica Grayson was a member of the Austin Peay team that won two league tournament titles. Eastern Kentucky assistant Lisa Pace was a four-year letter winner for the Lady Colonels. Tennessee Tech assistant Misty Garrett was apart of four Golden Eagle teams that won or shared an OVC regular-season title.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

The initial teleconference will take place on Tuesday, Dec. 4. OVCTOURNAMENT

The 2007 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 3 p.m. and televised live on ESPN. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

This marks the 14th time in 15 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and the fifth time it will take place in Municipal. The event was also held there in 1989, 1994, 1995 and 2004.

AUSTIN PEAY LADY GOVS (5-16, 2-10)

Team Notes

Austin Peay dropped a pair of home OVC contests last week, falling to Murray State (78-57) and Tennessee State (74-72). Junior **April Thomas** returned from a one-game absence and led the Lady Govs with 13 points and seven rebounds against Murray State. She followed that up with her third double-double (16 points, 12 rebounds) of the season. Sophomore **Janay Armstrong** scored 26 points and grabbed 11 boards in the loss to Tennessee State. She is the first Lady Gov to score more than 25 points since Ashley Haynes did so during the 2005-06 season. Thomas and Armstrong became the first teammates to post double-doubles in the same game since Haynes and **Kellea Reeves** did so in the 2006 OVC Tournament first round against Morehead State. Austin Peay, which is ranked ninth in free-throw percentage, made 30-of-28 (78.9%) during the week, including an 18-of-22 (81.8%) performance against Tennessee State. Austin Peay will travel to Eastern Illinois on Thursday before returning home to host Samford on Saturday. Both games can be seen on OVCsports.TV.

Eastern Illinois split a pair of OVC double-overtime games last week, defeating Jacksonville State (83-81) before having its five-game winning streak snapped with an 86-80 loss to Samford. The Panthers have now played in five overtime games this season, all in league action, posting a 4-1 record. Junior **Rachel Galligan** posted her first two double-doubles of the season, leading all scorers in both games. She went for 19 points and 12 rebounds at Jacksonville State and followed that up with a 23-point, 11-board performance at Samford. Sophomore **April Thomas** went 7-for-13 from behind the arc over the two games, including hitting a career-high five three pointers en route to a season-best 19 points at Samford. Junior **Lindsey Kluempers** posted 11 points, including hitting the game winning shot at Jacksonville State. EIU made a season-high 10 three-pointers in both games.
