Against Eastern Kentucky, she recorded her seventh career double-double with 29 points and a career-best 19 rebounds. Hayes followed that up with 18 points, six rebounds and seven assists. She shot 45.5 percent from the field during the week and added four steals.

Darling totaled 27 points and 21 rebounds in Tennessee Tech's two wins last week. She recorded seven points and six rebounds against Eastern Kentucky. In the victory over Morehead State, she posted her fourth career double-double with career-highs of 20 points and 15 rebounds while shooting 71.4 percent from the floor. Darling also had four blocks against the Eagles.

She fell one board shy of a double-double at Austin Peay with 16 points and nine rebounds. She shot 48.0 percent from the floor and went 9-of-11 at the free throw line for the week.

Foster extended her double-digit scoring streak to seven straight games last week. She finished with 12 points against Murray State, including hitting a crucial shot with 21 seconds left to help the Lady Tigers get the win. NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

New Tournament Format: Starting with the 2011 Championships, all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville. The bracket will also shift from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

Back at Municipal: Along with the change in format, comes a relocation of the tournament to historic Nashville Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. The venue will host the championship, which will now be a four-day event. Municipal Auditorium has been the site of the OVC Basketball Championship in 1989 (men only), 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and most recently in 2008. The move to Municipal Auditorium will keep the championships in Nashville, a place where they have been held 16 times in the last 17 years. The only year the tournaments have not been held in Nashville during that stretch was 2002.

New Faces: For the third straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Morehead State and Jacksonville State will each have new head coaches. The Eagles will be under the direction of first-year head coach Tom Hodges, who comes to Morehead State after spending the last five years at Middle Tennessee State, including the last two seasons as the on-court assistant to Rick Insell. Hodges also spent time at Chattanooga as an assistant and was an undergraduate assistant at Tennessee Tech. Annette Watts takes over the reigns of Jacksonville State after spending the last nine seasons as the head coach at Davidson, where she was the winningest coach in program history. Prior to Davidson, Watts spent two years as the coach of Jackson County Comprehensive High School.

2009-10 in Review: Morehead State was selected to win the 2009-10 title but it was Eastern Illinois who won its first regular-season crown after being predicted to finish the season fourth. The Panthers compiled a 23-11 overall mark and went 16-2 in the OVC to capture the title and the top seed in the league tournament. Eastern Illinois defeated No. 8 Tennessee State, 73-56, in the first round and topped fourth-seeded UT Martin, 65-51, in the semifinals. Third-seeded Austin Peay upset the top-seeded Panthers, 69-60, in the championship game to win its second straight OVC Tournament title. UT Martin's Kevin McMillan was named the OVC Coach of the Year after leading his team to a fourth place finish after being predicted to place 10th. Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman was named the OVC Player of the Year after leading the league with 19.6 points per game. She also broke an OVC single-season record with 121 three-pointers made which is the fourth best single-season total in NCAA Division I history. Eastern Illinois' Ta'Kenya Nixon was named the OVC Freshman and Defensive Player of the Year becoming the first player in league history to earn both honors in the same season. Nixon led the league with 2.1 steals per game while also putting up 14.0 points each time out. The 2009-10 season was the first time the OVC had three teams in the postseason. Austin Peay earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament while Eastern Illinois earned the conference's WNIT bid. Morehead State was selected to play in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitational.

OVCSports.TV: For the fifth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed thousands of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events.

Starting with the 2011 tourney, all Eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville.

The bracket also shifts from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). Austin Peay returned home and picked up a pair of wins last week, defeating UT Martin (69-61) and Murray State (69-59). After not leading in the first half, the Lady Govs scored 47 points in the second stanza of its win over UT Martin. **Brooke Faulkner** scored all of her 16 points against the Skyhawks in the second half to help lead the team past UTM. Austin Peay trailed for just 55 seconds in the victory over Murray State. Five different players scored 10 or more points for the first time this season, including four starters and senior **Dalila Thomas** off the bench. Junior **Whitney Hanley** posted her third double-double of the season with 18 points and 10 points to go along with five assists versus the Skyhawks. In the win over Murray State, she had 19 points, seven rebounds, three assists and two blocks in 38 minutes of action. Austin Peay hosts Tennessee State in its Pink Zone contest on Saturday. Eastern Illinois earned wins over SIU Edwardsville (73-54) and Southeast Missouri (74-49) at home last week.
