Hayes set a school single-game record, men's or women's, with 46 points in the win at Tennessee State. She added 10 rebounds against the Lady Tigers to record her eight double-double of the season. The 46 points are the most scored by a Division I women's basketball player this year. She followed that up with 36 points versus Austin Peay. For the week, Hayes recorded 41.0 points per game while shooting 65.1 percent from the floor, including hitting 58.8 percent of her three-point attempts. She was also a perfect 16-for-16 from the line.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former EKU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winningest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

EIU's Galligan Finalist for Lowe's CLASS Awards: Eastern Illinois' Rachel Galligan is one of ten finalists nationally for the Lowe's CLASS Award. Go to www.seniorclassaward.com to vote. The winners will be announced during the 2009 NCAA Women's Final Four.

WBCA Pink Zone Week: The Women's Basketball Coaches Association Pink Zone Week will take place Feb. 13-22. Each school is encouraged to select a game during this week to help raise awareness for breast cancer. Several OVC teams are participating. Visit OVCsports.com for more information.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

Team Notes

Austin Peay ran its home win streak to eight games with a victory over UT Martin (77-54) before seeing it stopped by Murray State (94-76). The Lady Govs seven-win improvement this season ranks fifth-best in Division I. Austin Peay shot a season-high 58.8 percent from the field against UT Martin including a season-best 61.5 percent from three-point range. In addition, the Lady Govs nabbed a season-high 16 steals with senior **April Thomas** and freshman **Whitney Hanley** each recording four. Sophomore **Ashley Herring** (21 points) and Thomas (20) both reached 20 points against Murray State, becoming the first duo to do so since Feb. 28, 2006. Hanley recorded 17 points, four rebounds and four assists in 32 minutes against UT Martin. The Lady Govs will host Tennessee State on Saturday. The game can be seen on OVCSports.TV.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated Illinois-Chicago (58-48) and Southeast Missouri (73-53) to extend its home winning streak to 19 games, which ranks fifth in the nation. The Panthers outscored UIC and SEMO by a 70-48 margin in the second half. EIU hit 10 three-pointers and had 22 assists on its 24 field goals, shooting 51 percent from the field in the win against the Redhawks. EIU also tied a team record with 11 blocked shots. Seven different players tallied a block while matching a record that dates back to 1990. Senior **Megan Edwards** was perfect from the field for the week, connecting on seven three-pointers. Edwards scored 17 points against Southeast Missouri and tied the EIU single-game three-point percentage record by making 5-of-5. She has now made eight straight field goals and 34 straight free throws. Freshman **Chantelle Pressely**, **Madeline Kish** and **Pilar Walker** accounted for all 12 of EIU's bench points against UIC, scoring 11 in the second half. Eastern Illinois will travel to Morehead State on Thursday and Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.
