Hayes averaged 22.7 points and 11.7 rebounds last week to help propel the Racers into a tie for first in the OVC standings. She tallied a double-double in all three games last week to give her four straight and six for the season. Against Austin Peay she brought down a season-high 14 rebounds to go with 29 points. She also tied a season-high with four assists against Tennessee State.

She scored 12 points, including four three-pointers against Tennessee State and added nine points in the Tennessee Tech contest.

Drake scored 20-plus points in all three of Eastern Kentucky's games, including a pair of wins. Drake put up 20 points and handed out four assists against Austin Peay. In the Jacksonville State contest, Drake had 21 points, a career-high nine rebounds, three assists and three steals. She totaled 22 points, six rebounds, five steals and four assists against Tennessee Tech. In three games, Drake shot 40.9 percent from the field and 81 percent from the free throw line.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former ECU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winngest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same the school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

Tickets on Sale: All-Session tickets for the 2009 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale through the Sommet Center ticket office and Ticketmaster. Fans can purchase tickets by calling the Sommet Center ticket office (615-770-2040) or Ticketmaster (615-225-9600). Tickets can also be purchased online through Ticketmaster.com.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay went 2-1 last week, picking up wins over Eastern Kentucky (70-66) and UT Martin (71-55) and falling to Murray State, 87-77. The win against ECU was the Lady Govs fourth straight home victory improving them to 5-1 at the Dunn Center this season. The victory over the Lady Colonels also gave head coach **Carrie Daniels** a victory against every current OVC member. Austin Peay put together a streak of 64 minutes where they did not trail. The stretch started late against Morehead State and lasted until early in the second half at UT Martin. Senior **April Thomas** had two double-doubles in three games last week. She finished the week with 15.7 points and 11.3 rebounds per game. Thomas also shot 62.1 percent from the floor over the three contests. Austin Peay's current streak of four games with more than 70 points is their longest such streak since the 2003-04 campaign. The Lady Govs will travel to Tennessee State on Saturday. Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated Tennessee Tech, 50-46, before dropping its first OVC contest at Southeast Missouri (58-51). The Panthers have not won in Cape Girardeau since 2001. With 16 points, senior **Rachel Galligan** was EIU's lone double-figure scorer in the win at Tech. Senior **Ellen Canale** grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds in the loss at Southeast Missouri, but saw her streak of 10 consecutive games with a three-pointers come to an end. Junior **Maggie Kloak** tied her season-high with 14 points off the bench against the Redhawks. EIU committed 14 of its 21 turnovers in the second half at Southeast Missouri. With their season-long, five-game road stretch complete, the Panthers return home and put their OVC-best 13-game home win streak on the line this week. EIU needs just one more home win to set a new program record. The Panthers will host Eastern Kentucky on Thursday and Morehead State on Saturday. Both games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.
