Rachel Galligan, F • Jr., 6'2 • Bloomington, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Galligan averaged 27.3 points to help lead Eastern Illinois to a 2-1 record last week. She scored a career-high 31 points in the overtime win against Eastern Kentucky. She tied the EIU single-game record for free throws made and attempted (15-of-18) versus EKV. Galligan also joined EIU's 1,000-point club. She also had at least one blocked shot in all three games, including three in the Eastern Kentucky contest.

Armstrong led the Lady Gobs in scoring (12.7 ppg) and rebounding (6.0 rpg) during the week despite all of her output coming in two contests. She posted career-highs in points (18), rebounds (7) and minutes played (22) against Murray State. Armstrong followed that up by resetting all three marks against Southeast Missouri, scoring 20 points and grabbing nine boards in 24 minutes. The transfer from West Virginia saw just five minutes of action against Eastern Illinois after picking up three fouls, but had two rebounds

Duhart went 24-for-32 from the floor to improve her league-leading field goal percentage to .580. She scored in double-figures in all three games, averaging 17.6 points and 8.6 rebounds. Duhart had 14 points and nine rebounds versus Samford and followed that up with 20 points and nine boards against Tennessee Tech. In the Tennessee State contests, she recorded 19 points and eight rebounds

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Two on ESPNU: Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be broadcast on ESPNU. The first contest will be on Jan. 26 and will feature Tennessee State at Tennessee Tech. Tip off for that game is 11:00 a.m. Central. The second contest will take place on Feb. 2 as Southeast Missouri entertains UT Martin at 3:00 p.m. CT.

Back to Municipal: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 14th time in 15 years, will return to Municipal Auditorium this season for the first time since 2004. The two-day event has previously been held at the Sommet Center (formerly the Gaylord Entertainment Center). The tourney was also held at Municipal in 1989, 1994 and 1995.

OVCSports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head women's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Southeast Missouri** was picked to repeat as OVC Champions in 2007-08. The Redhawks compiled a 24-8 overall record and a 16-4 Conference mark to win their second straight OVC regular-season and tournament titles. Southeast Missouri senior **Missy Whitney** was tabbed the 2007-08 OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Southeast Missouri garnered 19 of the 22 possible first-place votes with **Samford** (2) and **Eastern Illinois** (1) claiming the other first-place nods. Samford finished second in the polling, followed by **Murray State** in third and Eastern Illinois in fourth. Last season, Samford was fourth while Murray State was second and Eastern Illinois was ninth. **Tennessee Tech** was picked fifth, followed by **UT Martin** in sixth and **Eastern Kentucky** in seventh. Those three teams all finished in the top eight of the league standings and made the OVC Tournament. **Morehead State** tabbed eighth followed by **Austin Peay**, **Tennessee State** and **Jacksonville State**.

OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2007 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 3 p.m. and televised live on ESPN. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

Team Notes

Austin Peay saw its losing streak hit nine-games as it dropped a trio OVC games last week. The Lady Govs fell to Eastern Illinois (75-52), Murray State (81-59) and Southeast Missouri (70-54). APSU's nine-game slide is its longest in more than 10 seasons. The Lady Govs offense showed improvement during the week after opening the three-game stretch making just 23.7 percent of its field goals against Eastern Illinois, the Lady Govs made 40.4 percent of its shots against Southeast Missouri, marking its first 40 percent shooting performance since facing Ball State in Las Vegas. Sophomore **Janay Armstrong** led the team in scoring (12.7 ppg) and rebounds (6.0) despite all of her output coming in two contests. She posted career highs in points (20), rebounds (9) and minutes played (24) against Southeast Missouri. Team Notes

Eastern Illinois went 2-1 last week, defeating Austin Peay (76-52) and Eastern Kentucky (86-81, OT) and falling to UT Martin (66-64). Junior **Rachel Galligan** scored a career-high 31 points against EKU, tying the program's single-game records for free throws made and attempted (15-of-18). The Panthers made 40-of-46 free throws in the overtime win to break the team record for attempts in a game. Also against the Lady Colonels, Galligan became the 19th member of EIU's 1,000 point club. She is just the seventh player in school history to reach 1,000 career points by her junior season. Sophomore **Dominique Sims** put together a solid all-around effort against EKU (14, pts, 9 reb., 8 assists) and scored all eight of her points at APSU in a row in the second half after the Lady Govs pulled within 12. Sophomore **Megan Edwards** scored a season-high 17 points thanks to an EIU season-best four 3-pointers in the loss to UT Martin. For the week, she registered eight steals while committing just two turnovers in 110 minutes of action. Sophomore **Ashley Thomas** stepped up big with 11 points of the bench in the overtime victory against Eastern Kentucky. The Panthers will travel to Tennessee Tech on Thursday and Tennessee State on Saturday. Both games can be seen on OVCsports.TV.
