Hayes tallied a career-high 32 points against Jacksonville State while shooting 66.7 percent from the field. She added 10 rebounds versus the Gamecocks. In the Tennessee Tech win, Hayes recorded 18 points and eight rebounds to end a streak of five straight games with a double-double which ranks fourth most in school history. For the week she averaged 25.0 points and 9.0 rebounds.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former ECU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winngest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same the school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

Tickets on Sale: All-Session tickets for the 2009 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale through the Sommet Center ticket office and Ticketmaster. Fans can purchase tickets by calling the Sommet Center ticket office (615-770-2040) or Ticketmaster (615-225-9600). Tickets can also be purchased online through Ticketmaster.com.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay dropped its second straight contest in a 56-52 loss at Tennessee State. The Lady Govs lost their third rebounding battle in the last four games, after a stretch in which they won five of six. Austin Peay has averaged just 35.0 rebounds per game during the four-game stretch, bringing its season average down to 38.5 per game. Senior **April Thomas** recorded her fifth double-double in her last six games with a 16-point, 12-rebound performance at TSU. Both totals were game-highs as she made 7-of-12 from the field in 37 minutes. Thomas now leads the team with 11.3 points and 8.4 rebounds per game this season. Team Notes

Eastern Illinois improved to 8-0 at the home this season with wins over Eastern Kentucky (78-44) and Morehead State (70-52) and now has a program-record 15 consecutive victories at Lantz Arena. EIU's league-leading three-point defense mark (.254) improved when the Panthers held Morehead State to a 4-of-26 shooting from behind the arc. Junior **Maggie Kloak** put together her best two games of the season last week averaging 19.0 points and 8.5 rebounds. She posted a 20-point, 11-rebound effort against Morehead State. Senior **Rachel Galligan** scored 10 of her 14 points against Morehead State in the second half. Junior **Dominique Sims** also scored in double-figures in both games, making a career-high four three-pointers and scoring 18 points versus Eastern Kentucky. Senior **Megan Edwards** made her 100th career three-pointer in the win over Morehead State.
