Hayes scored 30 points against Southeast Missouri, including 21 in the second half to spark the Racers to victory after the team trailed by seven at the half. It was the third time this season she tallied at 30 points in a single game. Against Eastern Illinois, she tied a career-high with five steals to go along with 16 points. For the week, Hayes averaged 23.0 points while shooting 51.4 percent from the floor.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former ECU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winngest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same the school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

Tickets on Sale: All-Session tickets for the 2009 Ohio Valley Conference Men's and Women's Basketball Tournament are now on sale through the Sommet Center ticket office and Ticketmaster. Fans can purchase tickets by calling the Sommet Center ticket office (615-770-2040) or Ticketmaster (615-255-9600). Tickets can also be purchased online through Ticketmaster.com.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season a weekly teleconference featuring the league's 11 head coaches will be held on every other Tuesday morning at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. A schedule of what times coaches will appear weekly is below. The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at to be determined time.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay ran its home win streak to six games with victories over Tennessee Tech (83-81, 2OT) and Jacksonville State (82-57). The Lady Govs are 6-1 at the Dunn Center this season, including a 4-0 mark in league play. Austin Peay has reached the OVC's halfway mark with a 6-3 Conference mark, already doubling last season's league wins total. After winning six games last year, the Lady Govs have the seventh best turnaround so far this season in the nation with 10 victories. Freshman **Whitney Hanley** led the team in both wins scoring 19 points against both Tech and JSU. Sophomore **Brooke Faulkner** had a team-best 10 rebounds versus Tennessee Tech to go along with nine points. She finished the week averaging 11.5 points and 6.5 rebounds. Senior **April Thomas** has scored 10 or more points in her last eight contests and in 11 of her last 12 outings. She leads the team with 14.8 points per game during the last eight contests, making 53.6 percent of her field goals. Eastern Illinois split a pair of OVC games last week, falling at Murray State (60-51) before picking up a 55-49 win at UT Martin. The Panthers have not won in Murray since 2002. Senior **Rachel Galligan** scored a game-high 21 points in the loss at Murray State and followed that up with 10 points versus UT Martin. Galligan broke the EIU all-time record for free throw attempts versus UT Martin. Senior **Ellen Canale** scored 12 of her 14 points in the second half at UT Martin. Galligan (10) and junior **Dominique Sims** (9) scored all of their points in the second stanza against the Skyhawks. EIU won the rebounding battle in both games last week and have now more rebounds than an opponent in eight straight games and 17 of the first 20 games total. The Panthers now open a four-game home stand this week riding the league-best 15-game home win streak which also ranks sixth in the nation. EIU hosts Tennessee Tech on Thursday and Jacksonville State on Saturday. Both games can be seen on OVCSports.TV. The JSU contest will also be broadcast locally on WEIU-TV.
