In the game against Rice, she set a career-high with six seals while pulling down 18 boards and scoring 11 points. NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former EKU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winngest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same the school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

Two on "The U": Two Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball games will be televised nationally on ESPNU. The first contest will take place on Jan. 3 when Jacksonville State hosts Eastern Illinois while the second game will be on Jan. 17 as Tennessee Tech welcomes Murray State. Game times for both matchups are set for 5:00 p.m. CT.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCSports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016)

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

Austin Peay split a pair of contests last week, losing at No. 2 North Carolina, 93-61, before returning home to defeat Morehead State, 73-52. The win over Morehead State was Austin Peay's third straight home victory, the Lady Govs are now 4-1 at the Dunn Center this season. Senior April Thomas had a double-double in each game last week, averaging 14.0 points and 10.0 rebounds. Freshman Jasmine Rayner nearly posted her season's first double-double at North Carolina, scoring a team-best 17 points and grabbing nine rebounds. The Lady Govs have brought down 40 or more rebounds in five of their last six games. They are averaging 46.5 boards per game, including 19.5 offensive rebounds per game in those six contests. Eastern Kentucky split a pair of games last week, defeating Bluefield State, 70-37, and falling at Tennessee State, 61-52.
