PLAYER

Jolie Efezokhae, F • So., 6'1 • Buford, Ga. • Jacksonville State

Efezokhae scored a career-high 30 points to lead the Gamecocks to a 72-67 win over Austin Peay. Twenty-one of her 30 came in the second half as JSU overcame an eight-point margin with 5:57 to play. Her 30 points were the most by any Gamecock player in 50 games, dating back to Feb. 2, 2006. She was 11-of-14 from the field and also had nine rebounds, four assists, three steals and two blocks.

Oby Okafor, F • Jr., 5'9 • Rolla, Mo. • Tennessee State

Okafor averaged a career-high 30 points to lead Tennessee State go 2-0 in Conference play. She recorded her 18th career double-double against Morehead State with 20 points and 10 rebounds in addition to two steals. In TSU's overtime win at Murray State, she notched her 19th double-double of her career with 31 points and 12 boards. Okafor also had two steals in the contest.

Kristina Tyler, C • Sr., 6'1 • Flowery Branch, Ga. • Tennessee Tech

Tyler averaged 29.5 points and 8.5 rebounds as Tennessee Tech went 1-1 last week. In the win over Austin Peay, she recorded career-highs of 29 points, six steals and four blocks. Tyler followed that up by scoring a career-best 30 points against Eastern Kentucky.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to Municipal: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 14th time in 15 years, will return to Municipal Auditorium this season for the first time since 2004. The two-day event has previously been held at the Sommet Center (formerly the Gaylord Entertainment Center). The tourney was also held at Municipal in 1989, 1994 and 1995.

OVCSports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head women's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Southeast Missouri** was picked to repeat as OVC Champions in 2007-08. The Redhawks compiled a 24-8 overall record and a 16-4 Conference mark to win their second straight OVC regular-season and tournament titles. Southeast Missouri senior **Missy Whitney** was tabbed the 2007-08 OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Southeast Missouri garnered 19 of the 22 possible first-place votes with **Samford** (2) and **Eastern Illinois** (1) claiming the other first-place nods. Samford finished second in the polling, followed by **Murray State** in third and Eastern Illinois in fourth. Last season, Samford was fourth while Murray State was second and Eastern Illinois was ninth. **Tennessee Tech** was picked fifth, followed by **UT Martin** in sixth and **Eastern Kentucky** in seventh. Those three teams all finished in the top eight of the league standings and made the OVC Tournament. **Morehead State** tabbed eighth followed by **Austin Peay**, **Tennessee State** and **Jacksonville State**.

OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2007 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 3 p.m. and televised live on ESPN. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

This marks the 14th time in 15 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and the fifth time it will take place in Municipal. The event was also held there in 1989, 1994, 1995 and 2004.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois split a pair of OVC games last week, defeating Murray State (62-59) and falling to Southeast Missouri (55-51). Junior **Rachel Galligan** carried the Panthers offensively off the bench, scoring 46 of EIU's 113 points for the week. She tallied a season-high 27 points, including 17 in the second half versus Murray State. Against Southeast Missouri, Galligan netted 19 points but fouled out for the first time since December 2006. Sophomore **Megan Edwards** dished out a season-best eight assists and had just one turnover in 38 minutes of play against Murray State. Junior **Lindsey Kluempers** scored 10 points on a perfect 4-of-4 shooting in the win over the Racers. Sophomore **Maggie Kloak** scored 10 points and grabbed nine rebounds while junior **Ellen Canale** scored 12 points versus Southeast Missouri. Sophomore **Jessica Huffman** returned to the lineup for the first time since Dec. 1 but did not score in either game.
