Galligan shot 82 percent from the field last week. She broke the school's all-time scoring record in the win over Tennessee State. She led all scorers in EIU's both wins, going for 27 points on 13-of-15 shooting at TSU and 22 points on 10-of-13 shooting from the field at Austin Peay. Her 13 field goals at TSU represent a career high. Galligan scored 11 of EIU's first 12 points of the second half at Tennessee State as the Panthers rallied back from a four-point halftime deficit.

Smith averaged 11.0 pointers in games against Southeast Missouri and Eastern Illinois. She recorded her eighth double-double of the year versus the Redhawks with 11 points and 11 rebounds to go along with three assists, two blocks and one steal.

Drake averaged 20.0 points for Eastern Kentucky last week. In the win over UT Martin, she scored 13 points including hitting a three-pointer with 1:34 left to give the Lady Colonels the lead. She also recorded four rebounds, four steals and three assists versus the Skyhawks. Against Murray State, she hit six three-pointers to finish with a game-high 27 points. Drake also brought down a team-high five rebounds against the Racers.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Back to the Sommet: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 15th time in 16 years, will return to the Sommet Center this season after a one-year absence. The two-day event was held at the Municipal Auditorium last year.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: SIU Edwardsville officially became a member of the OVC on July 1, 2008 while its athletic programs will begin competing in the Conference over the following years as the institution completes its reclassification to Division I. All SIUE team sports will begin regular-season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception will be the SIUE softball program which will be eligible for both regular-season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at the Division I level prior to other SIUE sports.

New Faces: In addition to welcoming SIU Edwardsville to the league, the OVC will have two new head coaches this season. Eastern Kentucky will have a new skipper for the first time in 20 years while Murray State welcomes a new coach for the second straight year. Former EKU standout Chrissy Roberts takes over the program after Larry Joe Inman, the league's winningest coach, retired. Roberts was named the 1997-98 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year. She led the Lady Colonels to their first ever OVC Championship and NCAA Appearance in 1997. She returns to her alma mater after spending the last six seasons as an assistant at East Carolina. Longtime Murray State assistant Rob Cross will take over the helm of the Racers. Cross, who spent 13 years as the assistant, is believed to be the only assistant in NCAA Division I Basketball to remain at the same school through three different coaching regimes. He becomes the 12th head coach in program history.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the end of the 2007-08 season. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

New Award: The Ohio Valley Conference will present a Defensive Player of the Year award this season for the first time ever. The honor will be voted on by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.

OVCsports.TV: For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonally, monthly or per-event basis.

EIU's Galligan Finalist for Lowe's CLASS Awards: Eastern Illinois' Rachel Galligan is one of ten finalists nationally for the Lowe's CLASS Award. Go to www.seniorclassaward.com to vote. The winners will be announced during the 2009 NCAA Women's Final Four.

WBCA Pink Zone Week: The Women's Basketball Coaches Association Pink Zone Week will take place Feb. 13-22. Each school is encouraged to select a game during this week to help raise awareness for breast cancer. Several OVC teams are participating. Visit OVCsports.com for more information.

2014 Final Four Coming to Nashville: The City of Nashville and the Ohio Valley Conference will host the 2014 Division I Women's Basketball Final Four on April 6-8 at the Sommet Center. Nashville was one of five cities awarded the Final Four between the years of 2012 and 2016. Other host cities include Denver (2012), New Orleans (2013), Tampa Bay (2015) and Indianapolis (2016).

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

The initial teleconference will take place on Monday, Dec. 1. Following a break for the holidays, the schedule resumes and goes weekly beginning Tuesday, Jan. 20 and continues through the OVC Tournament. Team Notes

Austin Peay fell to Eastern Illinois, 69-59, before defeating Southeast Missouri, 80-74, in overtime. Senior **April Thomas** posted a career-best 22 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in her final game at the Dunn Center, Saturday against Southeast Missouri. She currently has 13 double-doubles this season, tied for fourth most in program history. Her 17 career double-doubles are sixth-most in school history. Junior **Nicole Jamen** scored 19 points in the regular-season finale, her biggest point output since scoring a career-high 23 points at Morehead State on Jan. 3. Austin Peay makes its second OVC Tournament appearance under current head coach **Carrie Daniels**. The Lady Govs return after failing to qualify for the 2008 tourney. In their previous appearance under Daniels, the Lady Govs lost at Southeast Missouri in the opening round of the 2007 Tournament. Daniels will seek her first tournament win as a head coach. She was a member of the 1996 Lady Govs squad which won the program's first OVC Tournament championship. APSU will travel to No. 4 Morehead State for first-round action on Tuesday.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois defeated Austin Peay (69-59) and Tennessee State (89-79) to finish the regular-season with 22 victories, tying the program's win mark in the Division I era. The Panthers have now won five straight road games and 10 of their last 11. Senior **Rachel Galligan** shot 82.1 percent from the field while also breaking the program's all-time scoring record. She led all scorers in both games, going for 27 points versus Tennessee State and 22 at Austin Peay. She made a career-best 13 field goals at Tennessee State. EIU shot a season-high 60 percent in the TSU win, including 74 percent in the second half. The Panthers scored 55 second half points, the most since Dec. 2006. Freshman **Chantelle Pressley** and **Pilar Walker** both scored a season-high nine points in the TSU win. Senior **Megan Edwards** finished the road trip with 21 points and 11 assist. Senior **Lindsey Klumpers** was 7-for-10 from the field and scored 17 points while senior **Ellen Canale** was 11-of-14 at the free throw line and put up 20 points. Eastern Illinois earned the second seed in the OVC Tournament and will host No. 7 Tennessee Tech in first-round action on Tuesday.
