Okafor averaged a double-double with 20.0 points and 10.0 rebounds as Tennessee State split its last two regular-season games. She had 21 points and 10 boards for her 10th double-double of the season against Morehead State. In addition, Okafor had three steals and one block versus the Eagles. She tallied a team-high 19 points and 10 rebounds to help the Lady Tigers win at Eastern Kentucky for the first time since 1990. She was nearly perfect from the free-throw line (8-for-9)

Sims scored in double-figures in both Eastern Illinois wins last week. She had 14 points, five rebounds and five assists in the victory over Jacksonville State. Sims followed that up with 12 points, eight rebounds against Samford. For the week, nine of her 13 rebounds were offensive, helping EIU extend possession late in the game. She also hit a three-pointer in both games.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Freshman Frenzy: Jacksonville State's Cierra Duhart is one of three OVC freshmen that are ranked among league leaders in field goal percentage. Duhart's 57.8-percent is tops in the OVC while Samford's Emily London (51.7%) and Savannah Hill (47.0%) are fourth and ninth, respectively. In addition, London (12.6 ppg) along with Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman (12.6 ppg) are among the Conference's top 15 in scoring. Bozeman is third in free throw percentage (86.7%) while London ranks sixth (83.3%). London is also second in three-point field-goal percentage (50.0%) while Austin Peay's Ashley Herring is ninth (40.0%)

OVC Tourney on OVCSports.TV: The entire OVC Women's Basketball Tournament will be available live on OVCSports.TV. First round games will be on Tuesday followed by the semifinals on Friday and championship on Saturday. Log on to OVCSports.com for more information and to sign up.

Back to Municipal: The Ohio Valley Conference Basketball Tournament, which will be held in Nashville for the 14th time in 15 years, will return to Municipal Auditorium this season for the first time since 2004. The two-day event has previously been held at the Sommet Center (formerly the Gaylord Entertainment Center). The tourney was also held at Municipal in 1989, 1994 and 1995.

OVCSports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head women's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Southeast Missouri** was picked to repeat as OVC Champions in 2007-08. The Redhawks compiled a 24-8 overall record and a 16-4 Conference mark to win their second straight OVC regular-season and tournament titles. Southeast Missouri senior **Missy Whitney** was tabbed the 2007-08 OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Southeast Missouri garnered 19 of the 22 possible first-place votes with **Samford** (2) and **Eastern Illinois** (1) claiming the other first-place nods. Samford finished second in the polling, followed by **Murray State** in third and Eastern Illinois in fourth. Last season, Samford was fourth while Murray State was second and Eastern Illinois was ninth. **Tennessee Tech** was picked fifth, followed by **UT Martin** in sixth and **Eastern Kentucky** in seventh. Those three teams all finished in the top eight of the league standings and made the OVC Tournament. **Morehead State** tabbed eighth followed by **Austin Peay**, **Tennessee State** and **Jacksonville State**.

From Player to Coach: Nine former OVC Women's basketball players are now serving as head or assistant coaches in the league with seven serving on the staff of their Alma Mater. Austin Peay's skipper Carrie Daniels played for the Lady Govs where she was a member of the 1996 team that made the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament. Jacksonville State assistant coach Gerlonda Hardin was named the 2003-04 OVC Player of the Year while a member of the Austin Peay squad. She led the Lady Govs to four OVC Tournament titles. Samford assistant Clarissa Thompson, who played for the Bulldogs from 1998-2000, dished out 336 assists which ranks second all-time at the school. Tennessee State head coach Tracee Wells and assistant Tamara Washington were both members of the Lady Tigers. Wells was apart of the TSU squad that won the 1995 OVC Tournament title. UT Martin skipper Tara Tansil was a standout on the Skyhawk squad and still holds the school records for free-throw attempts (751), free throws made (564) and 3-point attempts (415). Skyhawk assistant Jessica Grayson was a member of the Austin Peay team that won two league tournament titles. Eastern Kentucky assistant Lisa Pace was a four-year letter winner for the Lady Colonels. Tennessee Tech assistant Misty Garrett was apart of four Golden Eagle teams that won or shared an OVC regular-season title.

The 2007 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 3 p.m. and televised live on ESPN. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

This marks the 14th time in 15 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and the fifth time it will take place in Municipal. The event was also held there in 1989, 1994, 1995 and 2004.

Team Notes

Austin Peay closed out the 2007-08 season with a pair of losses last week. The Lady Goves fell to Eastern Kentucky (62-55) and Morehead State (43-40). Senior **Ashley McGee** maintained her position atop the league's assists leaders after posting 13 assists in two games last week. She ended the regular-season with an 11-assist lead in her attempt to become the first APSU player to lead the league in assists in a season. Her 151 assists this season are the fifth most in a season at APSU. Freshman **Ashley Herring** led the Lady Goves in 2007-08 with 302 points (10.8 ppg), the first freshman to lead the team in scoring since Brooke Armistead (1999-00) and 10th most by a freshman all-time. Her 160 rebounds this season are tied for 10th most by a freshman.

Eastern Illinois defeated Jacksonville State (71-68) and Samford (68-60) last week to close out the regular-season with 17 overall victories, the most since the 1987-88 season. It was the first time EIU defeated JSU and Samford in four tries at home. Junior **Rachel Galligan** led Panthers in double-figures with 22 points in the win over Samford. Galligan enters the OVC Tournament just two blocks shy of tying the EIU all-time record. Sophomore **Maggie Kloak** also scored in double-figures in both wins, registering 15 of her 26 points in the second half. She scored a game-high 16 points in the JSU win on 7-of-8 shooting. Team Notes

Eastern Kentucky went 1-2 to close out the regular-season. The Lady Colonels defeated Austin Peay, 62-55, while also dropping contests to Morehead State (68-65) and Tennessee State (68-66).
