Harris posted a pair of double-doubles and set career highs for points, assists and steals as the Eagles win the Comfort Inn and Suites Classic with three straight wins. In the game against Norfolk State, Harris recorded career-bests of 30 points, five assists and seven steals to go with a game-high 13 rebounds. Against Central Arkansas, she registered a double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds while also adding three assists.

Hillman averaged 12.0 points, 6.6 rebounds, 3.6 six assists and 3.6 steals over Morehead State's three wins in the Comfort Inn and Suites Classic. She had a career-high 16 points while grabbing eight rebounds, dishing out three assists and swiping six steams in the win over Houston Baptist. Against Norfolk State, she shot 7-for-9 from the field for 15 points while also collecting six rebounds. In the game with Central Arkansas, Hillman had seven rebounds, three assists and four steals.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Let the Season Begin: The 2010-11 campaign kicks off with Morehead State hosting Kentucky Wesleyan in an exhibition game on Nov. 1. The regular-season begins on Nov. 13 with Conference play starting on Dec. 3. Nine different teams have won a regular-season title with Tennessee Tech leading the way with 15.

New Tournament Format: Starting with the 2011 Championships, all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville. The bracket will also shift from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). The winners of those quarterfinal matchups will advance to the semifinals to face the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds (who received a pair of byes).

Back at Municipal: Along with the change in format, comes a relocation of the tournament to historic Nashville Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. The venue will host the championship, which will now be a four-day event. Municipal Auditorium has been the site of the OVC Basketball Championship in 1989 (men only), 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and most recently in 2008. The move to Municipal Auditorium will keep the championships in Nashville, a place where they have been held 16 times in the last 17 years. The only year the tournaments have not been held in Nashville during that stretch was 2002.

New Faces: For the third straight year the Ohio Valley Conference will have two new coaches. Morehead State and Jacksonville State will each have new head coaches. The Eagles will be under the direction of first-year head coach Tom Hodges, who comes to Morehead State after spending the last five years at Middle Tennessee State, including the last two seasons as the on-court assistant to Rick Insell. Hodges also spent time at Chattanooga as an assistant and was an undergraduate assistant at Tennessee Tech. Annette Watts takes over the reigns of Jacksonville State after spending the last nine seasons as the head coach at Davidson, where she was the winningest coach in program history. Prior to Davidson, Watts spent two years as the coach of Jackson County Comprehensive High School.

2009-10 in Review: Morehead State was selected to win the 2009-10 title but it was Eastern Illinois who won its first regular-season crown after being predicted to finish the season fourth. The Panthers compiled a 23-11 overall mark and went 16-2 in the OVC to capture the title and the top seed in the league tournament. Eastern Illinois defeated No. 8 Tennessee State, 73-56, in the first round and topped fourth-seeded UT Martin, 65-51, in the semifinals. Third-seeded Austin Peay upset the top-seeded Panthers, 69-60, in the championship game to win its second straight OVC Tournament title. UT Martin's Kevin McMillan was named the OVC Coach of the Year after leading his team to a fourth place finish after being predicted to place 10th. Morehead State's Chynna Bozeman was named the OVC Player of the Year after leading the league with 19.6 points per game. She also broke an OVC single-season record with 121 three-pointers made which is the fourth best single-season total in NCAA Division I history. Eastern Illinois' Ta'Kenya Nixon was named the OVC Freshman and Defensive Player of the Year becoming the first player in league history to earn both honors in the same season. Nixon led the league with 2.1 steals per game while also putting up 14.0 points each time out. The 2009-10 season was the first time the OVC had three teams in the postseason. Austin Peay earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament while Eastern Illinois earned the conference's WNIT bid. Morehead State was selected to play in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitational.

Starting with the 2011 tourney, all Eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament. Previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville.

The bracket also shifts from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals. Starting in 2011, the first round of each the men's and women's tournament will feature the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. The winners of those games will advance to the quarterfinals to face the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds (who received a bye). Austin Peay fell to Middle Tennessee, 74-60, and Valparaiso, 72-52, before snapping a 13-game non-conference losing streak with a 73-69 victory over Utah Valley in the Women's Preseason NIT. Junior **Jasmine Rayner** scored 21 points, grabbed six rebounds and nabbed four steals in the win. She also had a pair of 12-point efforts against MTSU and Valpo. Freshman **Nicole Olszewski** scored nine points and grabbed five rebounds versus Valpo. Senior **Dalilia Thomas** recorded 12.3 points and 6.0 rebounds per game last week. Junior **Whitney Hanley** also averaged 12.3 points and dished out 3.3 assists while pulling down 3.7 rebounds over the three games. Austin Peay will travel to Chattanooga on Tuesday, SIU Edwardsville on Friday and Southern Illinois on Sunday.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois fell at Illinois State, 84-53, last week. Freshman **Jackie Herman** came off the bench in the second half to pace the Panthers with 16 points. She was 5-of-12 from the floor and 4-of-10 from beyond the arc. She also went 2-for-2 from the free throw line and pulled down a pair of rebounds in her first collegiate action.
