#### PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Meagan Lyons, So., G, 5'6 - Greenville, Tennessee - Tennessee Tech Lyons averaged 21.0 points as Tennessee Tech went 1-1 last week. Lyons record career-highs of 27 points, eight assists, seven steals and seven rebounds against Lambuth. She shot 12-for-22 against the Eagles, including 1-of-2 from behind the arc and 2-for-3 from the charity stripe. Against Alabama, Lyons scored a team-high 15 points and also recorded five steals and three rebounds.

#### **NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK:**

Crystal Jones, Jr, G, 5'9, Indianapolis, Indiana - Eastern Kentucky
Jones led Eastern Kentucky with 20.5 points per game last week. She
netted a game-high 25 points against No. 3 Oklahoma. Jones added seven
rebounds and six assists against the Sooners. She reached double-digits against
Georgetown with 16 points. Jones was a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line
over the two games.

#### **FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK:**

Jessica Huffman, Fr., G, 5'7, Whiteland, Indiana - Eastern Illinois
Huffman averaged 20.0 points as Eastern Illinois went 2-1 last week.

She scored 23 points in her collegiate debut against Bradley and followed that up with a 22-point performance versus Illinois-Springfield. In the overtime loss to Illinois-Chicago, Huffman connected on a runner in the lane with about 15 seconds remaining in OT, putting EIU up 80-79 until a UIC basket with four second remaining propelled the Flames to victory.

#### 2006-07 OVC Women's Basketball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (0-0 OVC, 1-1 Overall): Austin Peay split a pair of home contests last week, defeating Evansville (74-72), before falling to Arkansas (58-45). Senior Brenna Link led the Lady Govs with 12.5 points and five rebounds per game. She scored a career-high 19 against Evansville, making 7-of-9 field goal attempts. Senior Alicia Watson led the squad with 10 points, four rebounds and four assists versus Arkansas. Freshman Nicole Jamen and Jackie Goetzke combined for 12.0 points and 6.0 rebounds per game last week. Austin Peay will travel to the Lady Tiger Classic this week and will face Lipscomb in the first game of the tourney on Friday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (0-0 OVC, 2-1 Overall): Eastern Illinois defeated Bradley (92-75) and Illinois-Springfield (118-76) before falling to Illinois-Chicago (81-80) in overtime last week. Sophomore Rachel Galligan scored a career-high 25 points in the season-opening win over Bradley. Galligan posted her fourth career double-double against UIC, while pulling down a personal-best 17 boards. She averaged 16.3 points and 9.0 rebounds for the week. Freshman Jessica Huffman netted 20.0 points per game last week, including 23 in her collegiate debut. Senior Meggie Eck was 13-of-26 from 3-point land for the week, averaging 16.3 points per outing. EIU had six players score in double-figures against Illinois-Springfield. The Panthers will travel to Indiana State on Tuesday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (0-0 OVC, 1-2 Overall):** Eastern Kentucky went 0-2 at the Waikiki Beach Marriott Classic, falling to No. 3 Oklahoma (92-79) and Georgetown (79-77). Junior **Crystal Jones** averaged 20.5 points per game last week, including a game-high 25 versus Oklahoma. Jones added seven rebounds and six assists against the Sooners. She was a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line over the two contests. The Lady Colonels will travel to the Southern Mississippi Lady Eagle Classic this week where they will face Louisiana Tech on Friday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (0-0 OVC, 3-1 Overall): Jacksonville State posted a 2-1 record last week, defeating Birmingham-Southern (74-68) and Georgia Southern (84-77) and falling to Southern Miss (81-61). The Gamecocks are now off to their best start since the 1989-90 season. Sophomore Ashley Boykin averaged 17.3 points per outing, including 27 points on 9-of-14 shooting against Georgia Southern. Boykin, sophomore LaTonya McKinney and senior Courtney Slaughter are averaging 13.0 points through the first four games. McKinney has reached double-figures in all four contests and scored a career-high 25 versus Georgia Southern. Slaughter has also hit double-digits in the first four games and is also averaging 5.8 rebounds per outing. The Gamecocks will travel to Furman on Tuesday before returning home to host Georgia State on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (0-0 OVC, 1-2 Overall): Morehead State went 1-1 at the Eastern Michigan Eagles Classic, defeating Grambling (75-52) before falling to Eastern Michigan (90-66) in the championship game. The Eagles trailed just 67-64 with 8:40 left against EMU, but were held without a field goal and were outscored 23-2 in the final six minutes. Senior LaKrisha Brown and freshman Amanda Green were named to the all-tournament team. Brown averaged a team-high 14.0 points and 6.5 rebounds, while Green averaged 11.5 points, including a career-high 14 against EMU. Morehead State hit 36-of-46 free throws over the week for a solid 78.3 percent. Morehead State travels to Marshall on Tuesday and hosts IUPUI on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (0-0 OVC, 2-1 Overall): Murray State dropped a 77-68 decision to Southern Illinois last week to begin a three-game road swing. Freshman Jenny Petrie had both of the Murray State's three-point baskets, keeping alive a string of games with a trey dating back to Nov. 26, 1999 (196 games). The Lady Racers hit 20 of its 24 free-throw attempts, with sophomore Amber Guffey going 6-for-6 and junior Alaina Lee going 4-for-4. Senior Joi Scott had game-highs of 28 points and 12 rebounds while Petrie chipped in eight points. Guffey scored 10 points while sophomore Ashley Nicole Hayes also had 10 to go with a teambest three assists. Junior Shaleea Petty recorded five steals. Murray State will travel to Western Kentucky on Monday.

SAMFORD (0-0 OVC, 1-1 Overall): Samford picked up a 62-54 win over Memphis last week. Junior Alex Munday led the team with 15 points while shooting 7-of-10 from the field. Freshman Monica Maxwell came off the bench to net 14 points. Maxwell is now averaging 13.0 points per game over her first two collegiate contests. The Bulldogs will play its home opener on Monday against Birmingham Southern before participating in the SU/BSC Classic this weekend. Samford faces Alabama A&M on Friday and will take on Centenary on Saturday.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (0-0 OVC, 1-2 Overall):** Southeast Missouri defeated Central Arkansas, 64-60, before falling to Florida State, 64-50, last week. Junior **Ashley Lovelady** tallied 21 points on 9-of-17 shooting against Central Arkansas. She followed that up with 12 points versus Florida State. Junior **Missy Whitney** averaged 10.5 points and 12.5 rebounds over the two games, including her first career double-double of 12 points and 15 rebounds against Central Arkansas. Florida State became the first team from the ACC to face the Redhawks in the Show Me Center. Southeast Missouri out-rebounded the Seminoles, by a 42-32 margin. The Redhawks will host Harris-Stowe on Tuesday.

**TENNESSEE STATE (0-0 OVC, 0-0 Overall):** Tennessee State dropped a 96-59 decision to Saint Louis last week. Sophomore **Kendra Appling** led the Lady Tigers with 19 points and five steals. She also tallied five rebounds, two assists and only two turnovers in 33 minutes. Tennessee State will look for its first win of the season when it travels to Savannah State on Wednesday.

**TENNESSEE TECH (0-0 OVC, 1-1 Overall):** Tennessee Tech defeated Lambuth (92-75) and dropped a 71-56 contest at Alabama last week. Sophomore **Meagan Lyons** averaged 21.0 points including 27 versus Lambuth. She also finished with 12 steals, 10 rebounds and nine assists over the two games. Junior **Kristina Tyler** chalked up her first career double-double with 12 points and a team-high 11 rebounds versus Lambuth. Also against the Eagles, junior **Cara Reed** netted a career-high 26 points. The Golden Eagles will travel to the Malibu Holiday Classic where they will face Pepperdine on Friday.

**UT MARTIN (0-0 OVC, 1-1 Overall):** UT Martin fell to Saint Louis, 66-65, last week. Senior **Andreika Jackson** netted 14 points and grabbed seven rebounds in the game. Freshman **Nicole Holman** scored 13 points, including going a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line. Holman also added four assists and six steals in the game. The Skyhawks will host Texas A&M-Corpus Christi on Wednesday.
