## 2006-07 OVC Women's Basketball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (0-0 OVC, 1-4 Overall): Austin Peay lost a pair of non-conference games at the Lady Tigers Classic last week, falling to Lipscomb (56-55) and Central Arkansas (67-61, OT). The Lady Govs held second-half leads in both its contests during the week, surrendering a nine-point advantage to Lipscomb in the final 15 minutes and a 15-point margin to Central Arkansas in the final 18 minutes. Junior Amber Bacon was named to the all-tournament team, leading the team with 14 points per game and a 41.7 percent field goal percentage. Junior Kellea Reeves was the only other APSU player to average double-digit scoring at the tourney with 10 points and four rebounds per game. Austin Peay will travel to Southern Illinois on Wednesday before returning home to open up Conference play with Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

**EASTERNILLINOIS (0-0 OVC, 2-2 Overall):** Eastern Illinois dropped a 102-86 decision to Indiana State last week. Freshman **Jessica Huffman** led the team with 22 points while shooting 58.3 percent from the field. Sophomore **Rachel Galligan** added 19 points while freshman **Ashley Thomas** posted 13 points and senior **Amanda Maxedon** netted a career-high 12 points. EIU has had at least four players score in double-figures in the last three games. The Panthers will travel to Illinois State on Tuesday before playing in the Missouri Tournament this week where they will face Alabama A&M on Friday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (0-0 OVC, 2-3 Overall):** Eastern Kentucky went 1-1 at the LaQuinta Inn Lady Eagle Classic last week. The Lady Colonels defeated Louisiana Tech, 86-86, and fell to Southern Illinois, 81-76, in the championship game. Junior **Crystal Jones** led the team with 23.0 points and 7.0 rebounds per game. She netted a season-high 28 points in the win over Louisiana Tech and followed that up with 18 against Southern Miss. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Belmont on Tuesday before playing in the Chattanooga Classic this weekend where it will face Western Carolina on Saturday and Chattanooga on Sunday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (0-0 OVC, 3-3 Overall): Jacksonville State dropped contests to Furman (72-67) and Georgia State (78-67) last week. After winning their first three games of the season, the Gamecocks have lost its last three contests. Freshman Jolie Efezokhae led the team in scoring over the two contest, netting 15.0 points per outing. She posted a career-high 22 points versus Georgia State. JSU has had at least three players reach double-digits in scoring in five of its six games this season. The Gamecocks will hit the road for its next three games. JSU plays at Alcorn State on Monday, Auburn on Wednesday and Troy on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (0-0 OVC, 1-4 Overall): Morehead State fell to 1-4 with losses to Marshall (65-62) and IUPUI (68-61) last week. Senior LaKrisha Brown averaged 17.0 points and 12.5 rebounds per game in the two contests, posting her second and third double-doubles of the year. She also led the team by shooting 68 percent from the field. Junior Tarah Combs hit four three-pointers in both games and averaged 14.0 points per outing. With 82 career treys, she needs just 10 more to move into ninth place in career 3-pointers at Morehead State. Freshman Amanda Green averaged 6.0 assists in the two games, including a career-high seven handouts against IUPUI. Morehead State travels to Florida on Monday, hosts Western Kentucky on Wednesday and plays at Xavier on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (0-0 OVC, 2-2 Overall): Murray State dropped a 67-60 contest to Western Kentucky last week. The Racers went on a 13-4 run to pull within 51-49 with 7:54 left in the game, but were unable to overcome the Lady Toppers. Sophomore Amber Guffey scored five points during that run to finish with 17 on 5-for-12 shooting from the field and a 5-for-6 night from the line. Senior Joi Scott led the team with 17 points and 10 rebounds while sophomore Ashley Nicole Hayes had nine points and nine rebounds in the contest. Murray State closed out its three-game road swing on Tuesday at Cincinnati.

SAMFORD (0-0 OVC, 4-1 Overall): Samford went 3-0 last week, including going 2-0 at the Sheraton Roundball Classic to capture the tournament title. The Bulldogs recorded wins over Birmingham-Southern (73-66), Alabama A&M (67-52) and Centenary (60-36). Senior Chelsee Insell was named the MVP of the Sheraton Roundball Classic after averaging 16.0 points in the two games. She led the team with 20 points versus Alabama A&M and followed that up with 12 versus Centenary. Against Birmingham-Southern, Insell netted 18 points and pulled down seven boards. Samford will travel to Georgia State on Tuesday and Iowa on Sunday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (0-0 OVC, 2-2 Overall): Southeast Missouri picked up a 101-78 win over Harris-Stowe last week. Junior Missy Whitney recorded a career-high 24 points versus Harris-Stowe and added eight rebounds and eight assists. During the Redhawks three-game homestand, senior Lachelle Lyles averaged 13 rebounds per game, including 15 against Florida State. Senior Tarina Nixon currently leads the team with 19 assists, good for an average of 4.8 per contest. Southeast Missouri will travel to No. 16 Baylor on Saturday.

**TENNESSEE STATE (0-0 OVC, 0-2 Overall):** Tennessee State fell to Savannah State, 79-65, last week. Sophomore **Kendra Appling** scored in double-figures for the second straight game with 22 points. She also tallied five steals and shot 42.1 percent from the field. Junior **Meesha Jackson** posted a double-double in her debut on the basketball court with 22 points and 17 rebounds. Jackson added six steals and five blocks. The Lady Tigers will travel across town to face Lipscomb on Monday.

**TENNESSEE TECH (0-0 OVC, 1-3 Overall):** Tennessee Tech went 0-2 at the Malibu Thanksgiving Classic last week, falling to Pepperdine (91-62) and Virginia Tech (87-52). Senior **Kendall Cavin** was named to the all-tournament team after averaging 12.5 points and 3.5 rebounds over the two contests. Sophomore **Allison Price** chipped in a career-high 10 points in the Pepperdine contest. The Golden Eagles will look to get back on the winning track as they host Middle Tennessee on Wednesday and open up Conference play at Austin Peay on Saturday.

**UT MARTIN (0-0 OVC, 2-1 Overall):** UT Martin defeated Texas A&M-Corpus Christi, 69-68, last week. Senior **Andreika Jackson** scored 23 points, including 13 in the second half, to lead the Skyhawks. Junior **Victoria Carlile** added 10 points in 17 minutes of action. UT Martin will host Dayton on Thursday before traveling to Memphis on Sunday.
