# 2012 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (1-3 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Austin Peay went 1-3 at the Kennesaw State Classic to open up this 2012 season over the weekend. The Lady Govs defeated Mercer, 11-9, in eight innings before falling to Miami (Ohio) (7-3), Southern Illinois (9-1) and Kennesaw State (9-0). Sophomore **Lauren deCastro** earned all-tournament honors after hitting .364 over the four games. She hit a grand slam in the come-from-behind win over Mercer. Junior **Catie Cozart** became the 28th player in school history to record 100 career hits with her final hit against Miami (Ohio). Junior **Shelby North** recorded her first career triple versus the Salukis. Austin Peay will travel to Jackson State for a three-game series this weekend.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (0-0 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois kicks off its 2012 season this weekend at the Georgia State Tournament. The Panthers will face IUPUI and Georgia State on Saturday and Chattanooga on Sunday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (0-0 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky will begin its 20th season of collegiate softball on Friday at the Quality Inn Classic hosted by Troy. The Colonels will face Nicholls State and East Tennessee State on Friday; Missouri and Troy on Saturday before concluding the tourney with Ball State on Sunday.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (0-4 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Jacksonville State went 0-4 at the South Alabama Mardi Gras Invitational to open up the 2012 season. The Gamecocks fell to Lipscomb (2-0), Mississippi State (8-1), Memphis (10-5) and Alabama (3-0). Freshman **Shelby Holley** went 4-for-12 in her first collegiate games. Two of her four hits were home runs. Holley scored two runs and drove in three over the four games. Junior **Hilary Phillips** struck out 22 batters in 18.0 innings of work. The Gamecocks will host the Jacksonville State Invitational this weekend. JSU will play Southern Illinois on Friday; Southeastern Louisiana on Saturday; and South Alabama on Sunday. Jacksonville State will conclude the tournament with a second match up with Southeastern Louisiana on Sunday.

**MOREHEAD STATE (0-0 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Morehead State will be under that new direction of head coach David Williams this season. The Eagles will open up the 2012 campaign at the College of Charleston Tournament this weekend. Morehead State will play host College of Charleston and Akron on Friday; Kennesaw State and Marshall on Saturday; and Charleston Southern on Sunday.

**MURRAY STATE (0-0 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Murray State will kick off its 2012 season this weekend at the Dickey's Barbecue Pit Invitational hosted by Southern Miss. The Racers will face Southern and Southern Miss on Saturday before playing future OVC foe Belmont and a second game with Southern on Sunday.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-2 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri fell to Jackson State, 11-1, before going 4-1 at the Mardi Gras Classic. The Redhawks posted a pair of wins over Grambling State (15-8, 21-3) while also getting victories over host ULM (8-4) and Northwestern State (3-1). Southeast Missouri one loss in the tourney came to IUPUI (5-0). The 21-3 win over Grambling State was Southeast Missouri largest margin of victory since April 13, 1994. The 21 runs were the most in school history. Senior **Renee Kertz** was named the tourney MVP after hitting .471 with nine runs scored and nine RBI in over the five games. Sophomore pitcher **Alora Marble** earned all-tournament team honors, going 2-1 with one complete game and seven strikeouts in 15.1 innings of work. The Redhawks have this week off and will return to the field on Feb. 24.

**SIUE (2-2 overall, 0-0 OVC):** SIUE went 2-2 at the Mardi Gras Classic to open up the 2012 campaign. The Cougars picked up wins at Northwestern State (7-4) and Grambling State (12-2), while losing to ULM (7-6, 9 inn.) and IUPUI (7-1). It marked the second straight year SIUE opened up the season with an extra inning game. Sophomore **Chelsea Yankolovich** and freshman **Alex McDavid** both went 8-for-17 at the plate. Yankolovich drove in four runs while scoring six times and stealing two bases. Senior **Lindsey Barron** hit .467 over the four games. Junior **Samantha Stanicke** picked up the Cougars' first walk-off hit of the season, a three-run homer in the bottom of the seventh against Northwestern State. SIUE will play in the Bulldog Round Robin this weekend. The Cougars will play Mississippi State and Mississippi Valley State twice over the three days.

**TENNESSEE STATE (2-0 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee State went 2-2 to open up the season at the Palmetto Classic. The Tigers defeated South Carolina (4-2) and Cleveland State (5-3) before falling to Western Kentucky (8-0) and Winthrop (3-1). The win over South Carolina, marked TSU's first ever victory over an SEC opponent. The TSU pitching staff finished the weekend with a 3.77 and struck out 22 batters in 26 innings of work. Freshman pitcher **Shea Morris** led the team, going 1-1 with a save and a 1.24 ERA. She fanned 14 batters and walked just four in 17.0 innings of work. Juniors **Tedra Alford** and **Jennifer Givens** led the offense. Alford hit .333 with a double, a triple, two runs scored, two RBI, a walk and a stolen bas. Givens went 4-for-13, crossing the plate three teams and stole three bases in as many attempts. Tennessee State will play in the Alabama State Class on Saturday, facing Alabama State and Savannah State. The Tigers will also play a pair at Alabama A&M on Sunday.

**TENNESSEE TECH (1-4 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Tennessee Tech went 1-4 at the Florida State Tournament to open up the 2012 season. The Golden Eagles fell to Ole Miss (6-3), Stephen F. Austin (3-2) and twice to Florida State (5-2, 8-0). Tech picked up its first win of the year in the second game with Stephen F. Austin (3-2). Junior **Chanelle Spalding** hit .385 over the five games. She scored three runs while tallying a .529 on-base percentage. Sophomore **Cassie Garrett** drew walks to open each of Tech's first three games. Tennessee Tech will play in the Georgia Tournament this weekend, playing Buffalo, Winthrop, Connecticut, Western Illinois and Georgia.

**UT MARTIN (3-2 overall, 0-0 OVC):** UT Martin went 3-2 in the Lions Classic to open the 2012 season. The Skyhawks picked up wins over Kansas (6-4), Nicholls State (5-3) and Southern (9-1, 6 inn.). UT Martin also fell to Northern Colorado (8-6) and Northern Illinois (7-5). Senior **Jenny Bain** extended her games played streak to 182 consecutive games after playing in all five over the weekend. She hit .563 with nine hits, a double and a home run in the tourney. She also drove in eight runs. Senior pitcher **Chelsea Jones** went 3-0 in the tourney with wins over Kansas, Nicholls State and Southern. She struck out 18 in 20 innings of work. Junior **Leah Taylor** went 7-for-7 at the plate in the first two games of the Lions Classic. She hit .611 in the five games and had one triple. Taylor also stole four bases in six attempts. UT Martin will participate in the Florida Gulf Coast Tournament this weekend. The Skyhawks will play Saint Louis and Florida Gulf Coast on Friday; Binghamton and Delaware on Saturday; and Boston College on Sunday.
