She hit a double and a three-run home run in an 8-run sixth inning that erased a 10-7 deficit in the victory. She also homered to lead off the second inning. 2012 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (1-3 overall, 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay's three-game series at Jackson State which was originally scheduled for Saturday and Sunday was forced to a Monday doubleheader after rain on Saturday and a water main break on campus on Sunday. The Lady Govs will also host Trevecca for a pair on Wednesday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (2-1 overall, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois went 2-1 at the Georgia State Tournament to open up the 2012 season. The Panthers defeated IUPUI (3-0) and Chattanooga (5-4) and fell to Georgia State (7-0). Sophomore **Megan Biel** led the Panthers, hitting .500 over the three games. She scored a pair of runs while also driving in one. She scored the winning run in the victory over Chattanooga. Sophomore pitcher **Stephanie Maday** went 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA, fanning 13 batters in 14.0 innings of work. She tossed two complete games including one shutout. Eastern Illinois will play in the Samford Tournament this weekend. EIU will play Samford and Mercer each twice over the two-day event.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (3-1 overall, 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky opened up its 2012 season going 3-1 en route to capturing the Quality Inn Classic championship at Troy. The Colonels defeated Nicholls State (7-4, 10 inn.), East Tennessee State (3-2, 8 inn.) and No. 5 Missouri (6-5, 10 inn.). EKU's only loss of the weekend came to host Troy, 5-4. Missouri is the highest ranked team Eastern Kentucky has ever beaten. The previous best was a victory over No. 7 South Carolina in 1995. Freshman **Katie Tackett** led the Colonels with a .429 batting average and five RBI over the four games. Freshman pitcher **Shaylon Robb** went 2-0 with a 1.67 ERA in four appearances. Eastern Kentucky will participate in the Phyllis Rafter Memorial Tournament hosted by Kennesaw State this weekend. EKU will play Indiana, Georgia State, Campbell, Southeastern Louisiana and Alabama State.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (1-5 overall, 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State sent 1-1 in its own rain-shorten Jacksonville State Invitational. The Gamecocks fell to Southern Illinois (10-9) and Southeastern Louisiana (15-10). Senior **Kaycee Crow** had a career game in the come-from-behind win over Southeastern Louisiana, racking up 11 total bases. She went 4-for-4 with two home runs, one double and four RBI. She had a double and a three-run home run in JSU's eight-run sixth inning that erased a 10-7 deficit. She went 1-for-3 with an RBI single in the loss to SIU. Jacksonville State will travel to the Georgia Southern Eagle Classic this weekend. The Gamecocks will face Kentucky, Georgia Southern, Albany, Radford and North Florida over the three-day event.

MOREHEAD STATE (1-3 overall, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State went 1-3 at the College of Charleston Classic to open up the 2012 season. The Eagles defeated College of Charleston (7-2) and fell to Akron (6-4), Kennesaw State (2-1) and Marshall (9-4). Morehead State committed just one error over the four games. Junior **Amber Riddle** led the team with a .455 average. She hit one double and a home run in the tourney while scoring four times and driving in three runs. Senior pitcher **Jamie Whitcomb** went 1-1 in the circle to open up the season. She struck out six in 10.1 innings of work. Morehead State will play in the Hilltopper Spring Classic this weekend where it will face Murray State, Western Kentucky, Bowling Green and Indiana State.

MURRAY STATE (2-0 overall, 0-0 OVC): Murray State went 2-0 on its first weekend of action 2012. The Racers defeated future OVC foe Belmont, 10-0, in five innings and beat Ole Miss, 11-6. Senior pitcher **Chelsey Sullivan** picked up the complete-game shutout victory over Belmont. She struck out six and allowed just two hits in the five innings of work. Senior **Megan Glosser** hit .625 with four runs scored, three RBI and a pair of doubles to go with two stolen bases over the two games. Against Ole Miss, the Racers recorded 14 hits and nine walks, scoring seven straight runs after falling behind 5-4. Murray State will play in the Holiday Inn University Plaza Hilltopper Spring Classic this weekend. The Racers will face host Western Kentucky, Indiana State, Morehead State and Bowling Green over the three days.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-2 overall, 0-0 OVC): Southeast Missouri had last week off after opening the season 4-2. The Redhawks turn to action this weekend at the Blue City Classic hosted by Memphis. Southeast Missouri will play Miami (Ohio), Western Illinois, Northern Iowa, Missouri State and Memphis in the tourney.

SIUE (5-3 overall, 0-0 OVC): SIUE went 3-1 last week. The Cougars defeated Mississippi Valley State twice (4-0, 7-1) and split a pair with Mississippi State (5-4, 0-5). Senior **Lindsey Barron** hit .400 for the week with two runs scored and one RBI. Barron also stole a pair of bases and now needs two more to break into SIUE's top 10 list. She is a perfect 4-for-4 so far this season. She also became a member of the 100-hit club joining senior **Whitney Davis** on that list as members of the 2012 team that have 100 or more hits. Davis leads the team in runs batted in with seven after hitting a bases-loaded double in the win over MVSU. Junior pitcher **Lindsey Coleman** went 2-0 with a 2.40 ERA last week. She struck out six in 15.0 innings of work. Coleman is now 3-0 in the circle this season. The Cougars will travel to the Alabama Tournament this weekend where they will face North Dakota State, East Carolina, and Alabama.

TENNESSEE STATE (2-2 overall, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee State had all four of its game rained out over the weekend. The Tigers kicked off the season with a 2-2 record at the Palmetto Classic in Charleston, S.C. on Feb. 10-12. TSU will be back in action at the Arkansas Tournament this weekend where it will play Jackson State, Arkansas and Northwestern State.

TENNESSEE TECH (4-5 overall, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech went 3-1 at the Georgia Softball Classic last week, picking wins over Buffalo (3-0), Winthrop (5-4, 9 inn.) and Connecticut (9-7). The Golden Eagles only loss was to No. 14 Georgia (6-1). Sophomore **Cassie Garrett** hit .545 over the four games, including going 4-for-4 in the win over UConn. For the tourney, recorded two runs scored, two doubles and three RBI. Senior pitcher **Holly Thomas** tallied a pair of complete game victories, including one shutout last week. She struck out nine batters in 16.0 innings of work. Tennessee Tech will participate in Chattanooga's Frost Classic this weekend where it will face Cleveland State, Dayton, Belmont, Troy and Ball State.

UT MARTIN (6-4 overall, 0-0 OVC): UT Martin went 3-2 at the Florida Gulf Coast Tournament, including wins over Saint Louis (3-0), Binghamton (7-4) and Delaware (9-1). The Skyhawks fell to Florida Gulf Coast (6-0) and Boston College (7-1). Junior **Leah Taylor** hit .375 with one triple, four runs scored and five RBI. She also went 5-for-7 on the base paths. She leads the team with two triples and nine stolen bases for the year. Sophomore **Morgan Lewis** batted .333 in the tourney with five hits, including a double and two home runs. Freshman pitcher **Casey Vincent** claimed her first win of the season, pitching a complete game. She scattered five hits and allowing just one earned run. Senior pitcher **Chelsea Jones** struck out 11 batters against Binghamton to earn her fifth straight victory of the year. UT Martin will travel to Chattanooga for the Frost Classic this weekend. The Skyhawks will play Niagara, Purdue, East Tennessee State, Valparaiso and Cleveland State in the tourney.
