PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Lauren deCastro, 1B/P, So., 5'7, Torrance, Calif. - Austin Peay
deCastro led the Lady Govs with a .611 batting average, a .1.000 slugging percentage and a .650 on-base percentage last week. She also became the first APSU player in over 12 years to record a five-hit game, going 5-for-5 in the second contest with Tennessee State. She recorded a walk-off hit in the first win over Morehead State and hit a two-run triple to force the second game versus the Eagles into extra innings. For the week, she recorded four runs scored, four RBI, three doubles, one triple and one home run.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK:

Shea Morris, P, Fr., Lawrenceburg, Tenn. - Tennessee State

Morris held opponents to a .174 batting average last week. She earned her first career shutout, striking out eight in the first game against Austin Peay. She earned the win in the second game with the Lady Govs, working the final 2.1 innings and striking out four. Morris allowed just one earned run while fanning a career-high 10 batters in the loss to Tennessee Tech. She eclipsed the 100 strikeout mark for the season during the TTU game, becoming just the third TSU pitcher to accomplish that feat. For the week, Morris went 3-1 with 28 strikeouts in 23.1 innings of work.

2012 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (9-16 overall, 3-8 OVC): Austin Peay went 2-3 last week in OVC play. The Lady Govs dropped a pair to Tennessee State (0-5, 5-6) before taking two of three from Morehead State (2-1, 3-4, 7-3). Sophomore **Lauren deCastro** became the first APSU play since 1999 to record five hits in a game when she went 5-for-5 in the second game versus TSU. She finished the week with a .611 batting average with four runs scored, four RBI, two doubles, one triple and one home run. Austin Peay has hit 31 doubles in 25 games this season which is just one shy of its total all of last season. Junior **Morgan Brewer** recorded two complete-game victories against Morehead State. She posted a 1.50 ERA with 18 strikeouts in 23.1 innings of action. Sophomore **Caitlyn Anderson** got her first starts of the season last week. She hit .385 (5-for-13) after entering the week with just two hits in four at-bats. Austin Peay will host Tennessee State on Thursday before traveling to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (12-12 overall, 3-4 OVC): Eastern Illinois split twinbills with SIUE (0-4, 4-1) and Missouri State (3-8, 5-4) last week. The loss to the Cougars marked head coach **Kim Schuette**'s first home-opening lost during her Panther tenure. Freshman **Bailey O'Dell** led the team with a four-RBI performance. O'Dell posted a .429 batting average with three doubles. Sophomore **Stephanie Maday** went 1-1 in the circle last week. She pitched two complete games, striking out 12 and walking just five. Eastern Illinois will host Butler for a pair on Tuesday, travel to SIUE on Wednesday and welcome Murray State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (12-15 overall, 5-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky went 4-2 last week. The Colonels took two from Morehead State (2-1, 8-6), defeated Western Kentucky (5-3) and went 1-2 versus Jacksonville State (4-5, 8-4, 1-3). Junior **Raquel Howes** hit .409 over the six games, including going 5-for-9 in the doubleheader sweep of Morehead State. For the week, she recorded two home runs, three doubles, three runs scored and seven RBI. **Larkyn Wood** hit a two-run shot to break a tie in the win over Western Kentucky. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Ohio for a doubleheader on Tuesday before returning home to host Morehead State for a single game on Thursday and Austin Peay for a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (9-2 overall, 14-16 OVC): Jacksonville State took two from Tennessee State (6-0, 5-1) and went 2-1 against Eastern Kentucky (5-4, 4-8, 3-1) last week. Senior **Kaycee Crow** hit .353 last week with three doubles and two home runs. She posted a .882 slugging percentage while scoring four runs and driving in nine. Sophomore **Tiffany Harbin** went 2-0 in the circle last week. She recorded a 1.62 ERA with 25 strikeouts and walked just seven batters in 21.2 innings of work. Jacksonville State will host Middle Tennessee for a doubleheader on Tuesday and Tennessee Tech for a single game on Thursday before traveling to Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend.

MOREHEAD STATE (8-17 overall, 2-8 OVC): Morehead State dropped a pair to Eastern Kentucky (1-2, 6-8) and went 1-2 against Austin Peay (1-2, 4-3, 3-7) last week. Junior **Amber Riddle** hit a pair of home runs last week, bringing her season total to eight. The school record for home runs in a season is 10. Junior **Katie Pfost** continues to lead the Eagles in the circle, posting a 2.41 ERA in 69.2 innings of work. Senior **Jami Whitcomb** posted the Eagles' lone win versus the Lady Govs, pitching a complete game and allowing just two earned runs while not giving up a walk. Morehead State will travel to Eastern Kentucky for a single game on Thursday before returning home to host Jacksonville State for a three-game series this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (11-7 overall, 6-3 OVC): Murray State took two of three from UT Martin (4-1, 3-2, 2-4) last week. It marked the first time the Racers have defeated the Skyhawks in regular-season action. Junior **Shelby Kosmecki** picked up the win in game one of the series, throwing seven-innings of one-run ball. She did not allow an earned run in 10 innings of action last week to move her into the top spot on the team with a 1.95 ERA. **Chelsey Sullivan** notched her fourth win of the season in the second game with the Eagles. Sophomore **Leslie Bridges** hit .500 for the week with one home run and five RBI. Murray State will hit the road this week with a pair of games at Memphis on Wednesday and a three-game series at Eastern Illinois this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (12-17 overall, 5-5 OVC): Southeast Missouri went 2-2 last week, dropping a pair to UT Martin (4-5, 1-2) and sweeping a doubleheader with SIUE (9-8, 4-1). The Redhawks have either scored in the bottom of the seventh to win or have gone into extra innings against every OVC team this season. Junior **Taylor Cowan** led the team with a .500 batting average. She went 3-for-6 versus UT Martin and went 4-for-8 in the SIUE doubleheader. She recorded one home run, two doubles, two runs scored and six RBI. Sophomore **Shea Cothren** went 1-1 with a 1.08 ERA in 13.0 innings of work last week. Southeast Missouri will host UT Martin for a single game on Thursday before traveling to Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

SIUE (11-19 overall, 3-7 OVC): SIUE split a doubleheader with Eastern Illinois (4-0, 1-4) and dropped a pair to Southeast Missouri (8-9, 1-4) last week. Sophomore **Chelsea Yankolovich** hit .417 with three runs scored, two doubles and two RBI last week. Freshman **Brittany Toney** became the first player this season to record five RBI in a game when she went 4-for-4 against Southeast Missouri. Junior **Amanda Lambrecht** went 1-1 last week with a nine-inning shutout versus Eastern Illinois. She struck out 16 batters in 17.2 innings of work last week. Freshman **Alex McDavid** leads the team in RBI with 15. Junior **Taylor Tooley** is just one hit shy of having 100 for her career. Senior **Lindsey Barron** is now tied for eight all-time in stolen bases with 56. The Cougars will host Southern Illinois on Tuesday and Eastern Illinois on Thursday.

TENNESSEE STATE (10-17 overall, 3-5 OVC): Tennessee State took two from Austin Peay (6-0, 6-5) and went 1-2 against Tennessee Tech (3-5, 0-4, 4-1) last week. Sophomore **Devin Amar** hit .364 with five walks, four runs scored, two doubles and two RBI over the five games. Freshman pitcher **Shea Morris** posted a 3-1 record with a 0.30 ERA in 23.1 innings last week. She fanned 28 batters while giving up just four walks in three complete games. Morris recorded her first career shutout against Austin Peay and tied a season-best with 10 strikeouts versus Tennessee Tech. Junior **Jennifer Givens** stole five bases on the week. Tennessee State will travel to Austin Peay on Thursday before returning home to host UT Martin for a three-game series this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (11-18 overall, 5-6 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a pair to Jacksonville State (0-6, 1-5) and went 2-1 against Tennessee State (5-3, 4-0, 1-4) last week. Junior **Brittney Spalding** hit safely in all but one of Tech's games last week and also contributed to runs in every game in the TSU series. She hit .308 over the five games with three runs scored, three RBI and a double. Senior pitcher **Holly Thomas** threw a near-perfect game in the second game of the series with Tennessee State. She struck out four and retired 19 straight batters, allowing a lone runner in the first inning. For the week, Thomas went 2-1 with 16 strikeouts in 19.2 innings of work. Tennessee Tech will travel to Jacksonville State on Thursday before returning home to host Southeast Missouri for three this weekend.

UT MARTIN (19-11 overall, 9-2 OVC): UT Martin swept a doubleheader with Southeast Missouri (5-4, 2-1) and went 1-2 versus Murray State (1-4, 2-3, 4-2) last week. Three of the five games were one-run contest and UT Martin improved to 6-2 on the year in one-run games. Junior **Leah Taylor** hit .444 (8-for-18) over the five games. She hit her eighth triple of the season in the series finale with Murray State. Senior **Chelsea Jones** pitched three complete games last week, going 2-1. She posted a 1.88 ERA with 14 strikeouts in 22.1 innings of work. UT Martin will host Belmont on Tuesday, travel to Southeast Missouri on Thursday and entertain Tennessee State for a three-game series this weekend.
