King recorded 19 points and eight rebounds in 27 minutes of play in the win over Southeast Missouri. She posted her third double-double of the season in the win over the Skyhawks with a team-best 23 points to go with 10 rebounds. She scored 19 of her 23 points versus UT Martin in the second half, going 5-for-6 from the floor and 9-for-10 from the line. King hit three of her four free throw attempts in the final 14 seconds against the Skyhawks to seal the win.

Raven Berry, C • Sr., 6'0 • Collinsville, Ill. • SIUE

Berry recorded a career-high 28 points to go with 13 rebounds in the win over Southeast Missouri. She became the all-time leader in rebounds at SIUE in the game with the Redhawks. Berry now has 928 career boards and is on pace to become the first Cougar to have 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds in her career. In the win over UTM, she posted 19 points and 11 rebounds. She now has seven double-doubles on the season and 31 in her career.

Coleman led Belmont in blocks (4), assists (9) and steals (4) for the week and narrowly missed recording a pair of double-doubles. Against Eastern Kentucky, she was the only Bruin to reach double-digits with 10 points, including going 4-for-4 at the line. She also brought down four boards versus the Lady Colonels. In the win over Morehead State, Coleman finished with a game and a career-high seven assists, a game-best three blocks and two seals. She was a perfect 4-for-4 from the floor versus UTM.

Sisk averaged 17.0 points last week as the Racers extended its winning streak to four. She put up 22 points against Jacksonville State and followed that up with 12 at Tennessee Tech. She shot 44.8 percent from the floor for the week, including hitting a pair of three pointers. Sisk also finished the week with 3.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 2.5 steals each time out.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Belmont Joins the League: Belmont officially joins the league this year bringing the Ohio Valley Conference to 12 teams for the first times. Belmont competes in 17 sports (8 men's sports and 9 women's sports), 16 of which will compete in the OVC (the exception being men's soccer which is not sponsored by the OVC). The Bruins have competed in the Atlantic Sun Conference since 2001-02 and will compete in its final year in that league in 2011-12 before joining the OVC. Since 2001-02 Belmont has won 30 Atlantic Sun Championships, the second most in the conference. Bruins athletic teams have made recent NCAA Tournament appearances in men's and women's basketball, women's soccer, men's tennis and volleyball.

SIUE full Division I Member: After the past five seasons of reclassification, SIUE is now a full Division I member and will be eligible for postseason play. In its first season with a full OVC schedule, the Cougars posted a 12-4 record and would have been the third seed on the league tournament.

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

OVC Women's Hoops on Monday Nights: OVC women's basketball will again be featured on Monday night's. The league approved in 2011 to move away from the men's/women's Thursday night doubleheaders and move the women's games to Monday night.

OVC Basketball to Play in Divisions: With the addition of Belmont and with SIUE gaining full Division I status and becoming eligible for postseason competition, the OVC will feature 12 schools in the sports of men's and women's basketball, softball and volleyball for the first time this coming year. The league announced in February its intention to use a divisional scheduling model for the sports that featured 12 member institutions. The East Division will include Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech while the West Division will include Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin. In the sports of men's and women's basketball, the top team in each division based on conference winning percentage automatically earns a berth into the OVC Basketball Championship. The next six teams with the highest conference winning percentage will also earn a bid, regardless of division. The No. 1 seed will go to the divisional winner with the top conference winning percentage, while the No. 2 seed will automatically go to the other divisional winner. The remaining six teams will be seeded 3-8 by conference winning percentage, regardless of division.

OVC Associate Commissioner Named to NCAA Women's Basketball Committee: Brad Walker, the Ohio Valley Conference's associate commissioner for operations/chief operating officer, has been appointed to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee. Walker and Wisconsin senior associate athletic director Terry Gawlik are the new additions to the 10-person committee. This year's chair is Carolayne Henry, associate commissioner of compliance at the Mountain West Conference. Walker's term officially begins in September and will last for five years.

OVC Digital Network: The Ohio Valley Conference has launched the OVC Digital Network (www.OVCDigitalNetwork.com), the new and improved home for live streaming of athletic contests involving OVC member institutions. One of the top new features of the Digital Network is that all events will be offered free for fans. The events will also feature improved quality with most events streaming in high definition (HD). Fans will also have easier access to the streams, easily accessing them through links at OVCDigitalNetwork.com without any registration being required. The streams will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without any app or software download thanks to the use of HTML5 technology. The portal also includes live stats and social media integration to give fans even more interaction. The streaming efforts will concentrate on football and men's and women's basketball in the first year, with all home non-conference and conference contests featuring OVC schools in those sports airing on the platform.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season there will be two teleconferences featuring the league's 12 head coaches. The teleconferences will take place on Jan. 16 and Feb. 13 at 10:00 a.m. CT. OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2013 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 6-9 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 8 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU and ESPN3. The championship game on Saturday, March 9 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 8 (TV TBA) and the women's championship game is on March 9 at a TBD time.

This marks the 19th time in 20 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fourth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 6 at 1 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).

Austin Peay split a pair of road games, falling at Tennessee Tech (73-51) and defeating Jacksonville State (78-71). The win over the Gamecocks ended a seven-game OVC losing streak. Senior **Leslie Martinez** led the team with 18 points and seven assists, including 16 second-half points, in the win over Jacksonville State. She had 13 points and five assists at Tech. Freshman **Tiasha Gray** tied a career-high with 12 points and recorded seven steals, which was the third most in school history, against Jacksonville State. **Meghan Bussabarger** recorded her second double-double with 16 points and 10 rebounds versus Tennessee Tech. She also had 17 points against the Gamecocks. Austin Peay will travel to Murray State on Saturday before returning home to host Southeast Missouri on Monday.

Senior **Katie Brooks** is just 57 points away from her 500th point as a Bruin. Senior **Jordan Coleman** led the team in blocks (4), assists (9) and steals (4) for the week. Against Eastern Kentucky, Coleman recorded 10 points and nine boards. She followed that up with a career-high seven assists, a game-best three blocks and two steals. Belmont will return home this weekend as its hosts Tennessee Tech on Saturday and Morehead State on Monday.

Eastern Illinois picked up a pair of league wins last week, defeating Southeast Missouri (82-62) and UT Martin (84-79). Senior **Mariah King** recorded 19 points and eight rebounds in 27 minutes. Against UTM, King posted her third double-double of the season with 23 points and 10 rebounds. Senior **Kelsey Wyss** hit four three-pointers in the win over the Skyhawks, needing only nine more to become the school's all-time leader. Wyss averaged 13.0 points over the two games, going 6-for-11 from behind the arc. Senior **Ta'Kenya Nixon** was two points shy of her second career triple-double against UTM, scoring eight points to go with 10 rebounds and a game-high 11 assists. Senior **Sydney Mitchell** started her first game of the season against Southeast Missouri. She hit 50 percent of her field goal attempts, going 10-for-20 from the floor to average 13.0 points.
