In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, **Tennessee Tech** has been picked to win the East Division while UT Martin was selected to take the West Division in the 2013-14 Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball race. The Golden Eagles earned 119 points and 12 first place votes while the Skyhawks picked up 22 first-place votes and 132 points. Belmont is selected to finish second in the East Division after earning 115 points and nine first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky picked up the remaining three first-place nods and 95 points for a predicted third-place finish. Morehead State is picked to finish fourth with 66 points followed by Tennessee State with 65 and Jacksonville State with 32. In the West Division, SIUE picked up the remaining two first-place votes and 103 points to be picked to finish second. Eastern Illinois earned 85 points for a thirdplace predicted finish. Rounding out the West Division are Murray State (68), Southeast Missouri (61) and Austin Peay (42).

The 2013-14 Preseason All-OVC is headlined by UT Martin senior guard **Jasmine Newsome** who was selected as the Preseason Player of the Year. In addition to Newsome, UT Martin's **Heather Butler** (22.5 ppg; 3.1 3-PT field goals per game), Tennessee Tech's **Diamond Henderson** (15.8 ppg, 47.8 FG%) and Morehead State's **Terrice Robinson** (17.5 ppg, 82.1 FT%) and were All-OVC picks last year and earned spots on the Preseason All-Conference team this year. Rounding out the preseason squad are Morehead State's **Almesha Jones** (11.1 ppg, 35.9 FG%); Eastern Kentucky's **Marie Carpenter** (14.1 ppg, 90.0 FT%); SIUE's **Tierny Austin** (11.4 ppg, 6.6 rpg); Belmont's **Jordyn Luffman** (8.9 ppg, 7.2 rpg); Southeast Missouri's **Kara Wright** (8.5 ppg, 45.5 FG%); and Tennessee Tech's **Molly Heady** (6.7 ppg; 40.9 3-PT FG%).

Newsome was named the OVC Player and Defensive Player of the Year last season, marking the first time in league history a player has won both awards in the same year. It was her second straight Player of the Year honor and second overall Defensive Player of the Year award. She led the league with 22.6 points and 3.0 steals per game in 2012-13. The Millington, Tenn., native was also named the OVC Tournament MVP as she set a new tournament record with 98 points over three games.

2011-12 OVC WOMEN'S NOTES/PREVIEW

Let the Season Begin: The 2013-14 campaign kicks off with a pair of exhibition games on Nov. 1 as Morehead State hosts Kentucky Christian and Tennessee State welcomes Tennessee Temple. The regular-season begins on Nov. 8 with Conference play starting on Dec. 28.

New Faces: Three Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball teams will be under new direction this year as Belmont, Eastern Illinois and Jacksonville State will all welcome new coaches this season. Cameron Newbauer comes to Belmont after spending last season as an assistant at Louisville. While at Louisville, Newbauer helped lead the Cardinals to the National Championship game. Debbie Black takes over the reigns at Eastern Illinois after eight seasons as an assistant at Ohio State. She was part of a Buckeye program that won six Big Ten championships and made seven trips to the NCAA Tournament. Black is also a former WNBA All-Star. Rick Pietri comes to Jacksonville State after a 13-year stint at South Alabama. He led the Lady Jaguars to back-to-back Sun Belt championships in 2003 and 2004.

2012-13 in Review: Last season saw 12 teams competing in women's basketball for the first time resulting in divisional play. The 12 teams were broken into two divisions (West: Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri, SIUE and UT Martin. East: Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech). Tennessee Tech was picked to win the East while UT Martin was selected to win the West. The coaches' and sport information directors' prediction held true for Tech but it was Eastern Illinois who won the West. The Panthers and Golden Eagles shared the regular-season title. It marked the second title for EIU while it was the 18th for Tech. Eastern Illinois claimed the No. 1 seed in the OVC Tourney while Tennessee Tech earned the No. 2 seed. The Panthers and Golden Eagles both earned double-byes to the semifinals. Also earning tournament berths were Belmont, UT Martin, Eastern Kentucky, SIUE, Tennessee State and Murray State. Belmont and UT Martin each made it to the semifinals where the Bruins fell to Tennessee Tech and the Skyhawks defeated top-seeded Eastern Illinois. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin met for the third straight year in the championship game with Skyhawks defeating the Golden Eagles to win its third consecutive tournament title. UT Martin also earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. Along with UTM, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Belmont also earned postseason spots. EIU was the leagues automatic bid to the WNIT while Eastern Kentucky and Belmont played in the WBI. UT Martin fell to Notre Dame in the first round of the NCAA tourney while Eastern Illinois defeated Missouri to advance to the second round of the WNIT. The Panthers would fall to Illinois to end its postseason run. Eastern Kentucky and Belmont both lost in the first round of the WBI. It marked the second year the OVC had four women's basketball teams in the postseason.

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four which will take place on April 6 and 8. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

UT Martin to Play in the Preseason WNIT: UT Martin will participate in the Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Skyhawks will host Georgia State on Nov. 8 for first round action. The Preseason WNIT

features a three-game guarantee format. The event opens Nov. 8 with first-round games. Second-round games will be played Nov. 10 and 11 and sites will be announced following the first-round results; semifinals will be Nov. 14; and the championship is set for Sunday, Nov. 17. Teams that lose in the first two rounds will play consolation games on the second weekend, Nov. 15-16. All games are hosted by participating schools. Ten of the 16 teams in the preseason WNIT are coming off of NCAA Tournament appearances. The field features Georgia State, Gonzaga, Idaho, IPFW, Louisville, Loyola Chicago, LSU, Mount St. Mary's, North Carolina A&T, Oklahoma, Quinnipiac, Saint Joseph's, Stephen F. Austin, Stetson, UT Martin and Wichita State.

OVC Digital Newtork: This marks the second season of the OVC Digital Network. It launched last year and is a new and improved home for lives streaming of athletic contests involving OVC member institutions. One of the top features of the Network is that all events will be offered free for fans. The events will also feature improved quality with most events streaming in high definition (HD). Fans will also have easier access to the streams, easily accessing them through links at OVCDigitalNetwork.com without any registration being required. The streams will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without any app or software download thanks to the use of HTML5 technology. The portal also includes live stats and social media integration to give fans even more interaction. The streaming efforts will concentrate on football and men's and women's basketball in the first year, with all home nonconference and conference contests featuring OVC schools in those sports airing on the platform.
