### J.J. Mann, G/F • Sr., 6-6, 215 • Smyrna, Ga. • Belmont

Mann averaged 18.3 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.7 steals/game in three contests last week and most importantly hit the game-winning 3-pointer as Belmont topped No. 11 North Carolina 83-80 in Chapel Hill on Sunday. With his team trailing by two points, Mann knocked down the game-winning trifecta with 13.1 seconds left to give the Bruins its first win over a ranked opponent since beating No. 23 Missouri in December 2003. Overall Mann hit three 3-pointers over the final 1:02 of the game to help his team overcome an eight-point deficit with 2:37 to play. Mann finished the game with five 3-pointers and was 7-of-7 at the free throw line as he scored a career-high 28 points (including 11 of his team's final 13 points), added nine rebounds, three assists and a steal in 39 minutes of action. Earlier in the week Mann scored 23 points (on 6-of-9 shooting and 10-of-12 free throws), pulled down six rebounds and had three steals as Belmont overcame a 16-point halftime deficit to beat Indiana State 96-95. Mann started the week with four points, six rebounds and three assists in a loss at Richmond. The senior currently ranks tied for second in the OVC in scoring (19.0 points/game). Mann was named National Player of the Week by both CBSSports. com and NBCSports.com.

### Drew Windler, F • Sr., 6-9, 215 • South Milwaukee, Wis. • Belmont

Windler, the transfer from Samford, averaged 15.3 points, 5.7 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.0 steals/ game and hit 55.6 percent (15-of-27) from the field, 57.1 percent (8-of-14) from 3-point range and 80 percent (8-of-10) in three contests last week for Belmont. In the Bruins win over No. 11 North Carolina on Saturday he hit 4-of-6 3-pointers on his way to 16 points as Belmont beat a Top 25 opponent for the first time since December 2003. In the team's come-from-behind victory over a good Indiana State team, the senior had 17 points (on 2-of-4 3-point shooting), seven rebounds and an assist in just 18 minutes of action. He started the week with 13 points, nine rebounds, two blocks and an assist in a road loss to Richmond. Windler currently leads the OVC in 3-point percentage (66.7%) and is second in 3-pointers made/game (3.0).

Antonius Cleveland, G • Fr., 6'5, 175 • Memphis, Tenn. • Southeast Missouri
Cleveland averaged 14.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals/game and hit 57.9 percent (11-of-19) from the field in two Southeast Missouri State victories last week. Cleveland started the week with 13 points, eight rebounds, four steals, two assists and two blocks in 21 minutes against Central Baptist College. He followed that with 15 points (13 of which came in the first half), three rebounds, four assists and two steals in 34 minutes of play in a 76-68 road victory over IUPUI. Cleveland had three dunks in the first half of the win over IUPUI. He is currently averaging 14.0 points/game, second among OVC freshmen.

### NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Mann Named National Player of the Week by CBSSports.com NBCSports.com (Nov. 18): Belmont senior J.J. Mann was named National Player of the Week by both CBSSports.com and NBCSports. com after leading the Bruins to a 83-80 victory over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17. Mann scored a career-high 28 points, including three 3-pointers in the final 1:02 as Belmont topped its first Top 25 team since December 2003. Mann scored 11 of Belmont's final 13 points as the team overcame an eight-point deficit with 2:37 to play. He also scored 23 points in a come-from-behind victory over Indiana State earlier in the week. For the week Mann averaged 18.3 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.7 steals/game.

Wins Over Top 25 Teams By OVC Teams: Belmont's win over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17 was the first for an OVC team in non-conference play since Murray State (ranked No. 14 at the time) beat No. 16 Saint Mary's at home on Feb. 18, 2012. It was the first road victory over a Top 25 team since the Racers topped No. 20 Memphis 76-72 on Dec. 11, 2011. The last time an OVC team beat an opponent ranked 11th or higher was in 1987 when Austin Peay bested No. 11 Illinois in the NCAA Tournament. Belmont Receiving Votes in Both AP and USA Today Polls: Following its win over No. 11/12 North Carolina on Nov. 17, Belmont is now receiving votes in both major Top 25 polls. The Bruins picked up 18 points and are unofficially 31st in the Associated Press (AP) poll while they picked up five points (and are tied for 39th) in the USA Today Coaches poll. Belmont received votes in eight different weeks during the 2012-13 season.

**Belmont Home Winning Streak:** Belmont enters this week with a 21-game home court winning streak which is the longest in Division I. The Bruins host in-city rival Lipscomb on Wednesday.

**Eastern Kentucky Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record:** Eastern Kentucky tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made in a game with 20 against Warren Wilson College on Nov. 13. The Colonels were 20-of-39 (51.3%) from 3-point range in the 114-45 victory and tied the record set by Southeast Missouri State a season ago.

Two OVC Players Named Candidates for Senior CLASS Award: Two OVC men's basketball student-athletes have been named candidates for the 2013-14 Senior CLASS Award. The two players are among 30 male candidates nationally considered for the award (UT Martin's Heather Butler is one of 30 female candidates for the award as well). The OVC selections were Belmont guard J.J. Mann and Tennessee Tech forward Dennis Ogbe. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School ®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The Senior CLASS Award winners will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Men's Final Four® and NCAA Women's Final Four®. Each of the 30 candidate classes will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one male candidate and one female candidate who best exemplify excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

**OVC Enters Season Having Won a Game in Four of Past Five NCAA Tournaments:** Despite not winning a game in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, the OVC has won a NCAA Tournament game in four of the past five years. The four-year winning streak came to an end last season, as the OVC had been one of just nine conferences (3 non-BCS) to win a game from 2009-12.

**OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium:** The 2014 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 5-8). It marks the fourth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the ninth time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 8th Among Active NCAA Coaches: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 24th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 372 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 454 for his career (which ranks him 28th among Division I head coaches). Belmont head coach Rick Byrd (who is in his second year in the OVC) has 666 career victories, which ranks eighth among active Division I head coaches (who recently passed John Wooden's 665 wins on the all-time list). Loos and Byrd are two of just seven active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boeheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe, Coppin State's Fang Mitchell and Davidson's Bob McKillop.

### COACHES TELECONFERENCE

The initial teleconference will take place Jan. 14 with the next call following on Feb. 11 (women's coaches calls will be held on Wednesday's - Jan. 8 and Feb. 5). On Monday, March 3 a call featuring the men's & women's coaches who make the 8-team OVC Tournament field will be held at 9 a.m. (schedule to be announced). ### **2014 OVC TOURNAMENT**

The 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 5-8 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6:30 and 9 p.m. and televised on ESPNU. The championship game on Saturday, March 8 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 8 at a time TBA (ESPN3).

This marks the 20th time in 21 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fifth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 3 at 1 p.m. No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



Former OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the 2013-14 season there are four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American Kenneth Faried was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his third season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and was the MVP of the Rising Stars Game in 2013. The other three players are all rookies this season, including former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan**, former Belmont All-American **Isaiah Canaan**, Tennessee State standout Robert Covington. Canaan and Covington are teammates with the Houston Rockets (Canaan was drafted in the second round while Covington signed a free agent deal) while Clark signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz.

The 2013-14 Season: The 2013-14 season marks the 66th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 65 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Southeast Missouri's Stone Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2013-14 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Southeast Missouri State senior Tyler Stone, who was named the Preseason Player of the Year. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Southeast Missouri having two selections apiece while Belmont, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and UT Martin had one selection each to round out the team. The squad features two players who were All-OVC first or second-team selections last season and three players who were selected to the All-Newcomer squad. The team is comprised of seven seniors and three juniors. Last season Stone ranked eighth in the OVC in scoring (15.5 points/ game), fifth in rebounding (7.8/game) and blocked shots (1.3/game) and 12th in field goal percentage (49.2%) while leading Southeast Missouri to a winning overall record and berth in the OVC Tournament quarterfinals. Other selections to the Preseason All-OVC team were Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller**, Austin Peay's Travis Betran and Will Triggs, Eastern Kentucky's Glenn Cosey and Corey Walden, Belmont's J.J. Mann, Southeast Missouri's Nino Johnson, UT Martin's Myles Taylor and Jacksonville State's Brian Williams.

Murray State, Belmont Picked as OVC Preseason Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Eastern Kentucky has been picked the favorites in the East Division while Murray State and Southeast Missouri State were tabbed cofavorites in the West Division in the OVC for 2013-14. Eastern Kentucky picked up 18 of a possible 24 first-place votes (schools were not allowed to vote for themselves) and a total of 128 points to lead all vote getting. The Colonels were followed in the East by defending OVC champion Belmont, who picked up the remaining six first-place votes and 116 total points. The East Division voting was rounded out by Morehead State (74 points), Jacksonville State (72), Tennessee State (60) and Tennessee Tech (42). The top of the West Division was shared by Southeast Missouri and defending West Champions Murray State. The Redhawks received 13 first-place votes while the Racers picked up the remaining 11 to both finish with 117 total points. The West was rounded out by Austin Peay (90 points), UT Martin (66), Eastern Illinois (58) and SIUE (44).
