Carpenter opened the week by scoring a career-high 41 points versus Alabama A&M, finishing just three points shy of EKU's single-game record. She tied a school single-game record with nine three-pointers. Against UNC Asheville, Carpenter scored a team-best 14 points, connecting on 3-of-7 from three-point range. She knocked down four more three-pointers while scoring a team-high 20 points in the win over Davis & Elkins. She shot over 50 percent from the field, nearly 60 percent from three-point range and over 90 percent from the line. She leads the conference with 25.6 points per game.

Jasmine Newsome, G • Sr., 5'6 • Millington, Tenn. • UT Martin

Entering the game with Quinnipiac, **Newsome** needed just 11 points to become the second player in school history to eclipse the 2,000 point mark for her career. She scored a school-single game record 44 points in the win, including 15 of the team's 19 points in overtime. Newsome also dished out eight assists and brought down six rebounds in the victory.

Lee scored nine points and pulled down a pair of rebounds in the loss at Western Kentucky. She shot nearly 50 percent from the floor in the contest and went 3-for-4 from the charity stripe. She also added two assists, a block, a steal and committed just two turnovers in 24 minutes of action.

Banks began her week with eight points and two rebounds at Southern Illinois. She then became the first APSU freshman to record a double-double since 2007 with a 14-point, 11-rebound performance against Arkansas State. Banks concluded the week by setting her season-high in scoring for the third straight game, finishing with a team-leading 17 points to go with five rebounds against Trevecca.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Let the Season Begin: The 2013-14 campaign kicks off with a pair of exhibition games on Nov. 1 as Morehead State hosts Kentucky Christian and Tennessee State welcomes Tennessee Temple. The regular-season begins on Nov. 8 with Conference play starting on Dec. 28.

New Faces: Three Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball teams will be under new direction this year as Belmont, Eastern Illinois and Jacksonville State will all welcome new coaches this season. Cameron Newbauer comes to Belmont after spending last season as an assistant at Louisville. While at Louisville, Newbauer helped lead the Cardinals to the National Championship game. Debbie Black takes over the reigns at Eastern Illinois after eight seasons as an assistant at Ohio State. She was part of a Buckeye program that won six Big Ten championships and made seven trips to the NCAA Tournament. Black is also a former WNBA All-Star. Rick Pietri comes to Jacksonville State after a 13-year stint at South Alabama. He led the Lady Jaguars to back-to-back Sun Belt championships in 2003 and 2004.

2012-13 in Review: Last season saw 12 teams competing in women's basketball for the first time resulting in divisional play. The 12 teams were broken into two divisions (West: Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri, SIUE and UT Martin. East: Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech). Tennessee Tech was picked to win the East while UT Martin was selected to win the West. The coaches' and sport information directors' prediction held true for Tech but it was Eastern Illinois who won the West. The Panthers and Golden Eagles shared the regular-season title. It marked the second title for EIU while it was the 18th for Tech. Eastern Illinois claimed the No. 1 seed in the OVC Tourney while Tennessee Tech earned the No. 2 seed. The Panthers and Golden Eagles both earned double-byes to the semifinals. Also earning tournament berths were Belmont, UT Martin, Eastern Kentucky, SIUE, Tennessee State and Murray State. Belmont and UT Martin each made it to the semifinals where the Bruins fell to Tennessee Tech and the Skyhawks defeated top-seeded Eastern Illinois. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin met for the third straight year in the championship game with Skyhawks defeating the Golden Eagles to win its third consecutive tournament title. UT Martin also earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. Along with UTM, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Belmont also earned postseason spots. EIU was the leagues automatic bid to the WNIT while Eastern Kentucky and Belmont played in the WBI. UT Martin fell to Notre Dame in the first round of the NCAA tourney while Eastern Illinois defeated Missouri to advance to the second round of the WNIT. The Panthers would fall to Illinois to end its postseason run. Eastern Kentucky and Belmont both lost in the first round of the WBI. It marked the second year the OVC had four women's basketball teams in the postseason.

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four which will take place on April 6 and 8. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

UT Martin to Play in the Preseason WNIT: UT Martin will participate in the Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Skyhawks will host Georgia State on Nov. 8 for first round action. The Preseason WNIT features a three-game guarantee format. The event opens Nov. 8 with first-round games. Second-round games will be played Nov. 10 and 11 and sites will be announced following the first-round results; semifinals will be Nov. 14; and the championship is set for Sunday, Nov. 17. Teams that lose in the first two rounds will play consolation games on the second weekend, Nov. 15-16. All games are hosted by participating schools. Ten of the 16 teams in the preseason WNIT are coming off of NCAA Tournament appearances. The field features Georgia State, Gonzaga, Idaho, IPFW, Louisville, Loyola Chicago, LSU, Mount St. Mary's, North Carolina A&T, Oklahoma, Quinnipiac, Saint Joseph's, Stephen F. Austin, Stetson, UT Martin and Wichita State.

OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 6-9 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7. The championship game on Saturday, March 8. The women's semifinals are set for March 7 and the women's championship game is on March 8.

This marks the 19th time in 20 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fourth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 3 at 1 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).

Austin Peay picked up wins over Southern Illinois (71-69) and Trevecca (98-77) while also falling to Arkansas State (79-69) last week. Junior **Kristen Stainback** has opened the season with four straight double-digit scoring outings, marking the first time in her career she has scored 10 or more points in four consecutive contests. Sophomore **Tiasha Gray** began the week hitting the game-winning shot versus Southern Illinois and posted APSU's first known triple-double to conclude the week versus Trevecca. She recorded 13 points, 12 assists and 11 rebounds in the win over Trevecca. Gray finished the week with 15.3 points, 6.7 rebounds, 7.3 assists and 3.0 steals per game. **Tearra Banks** become the first APSU freshman to record a double-double since 2007 as she posted 14 points and 11 boards versus Arkansas State. Belmont led UTC at halftime, 36-27, a feat that hadn't happened since the 1978 meeting between the two programs. Junior **Jordyn Luffman** averaged a double-double for the week with 16.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game. She tallied her second double-double of the season with a career-high 18 points and a game-high 11 boards versus Chattanooga. Freshman **Frankie Joubran** netted eight points in each contest last week.
