PLAYER

Myles Taylor, F • So., 6-7, 250 • Little Rock, Ark. • UT Martin

Taylor helped UT Martin to an 81-72 upset of Eastern Kentucky last week in the team's lone game of the week. Taylor hit 5-of-11 (45.5%) field goals and 11-of-13 (84.6%) free throws on his way to 21 points. The sophomore also had a career-high 14 rebounds in netting his sixth double-double of the season (tied for fourth in the OVC). Taylor played the full 40 minutes and also had an assist and steal for the Skyhawks who won its second-straight OVC game, the first time that has happened for the program since winning three-straight games in January 2011. Taylor currently ranks fifth in the OVC in scoring (16.8 points/game) and fourth in rebounding (8.1/game); only two Skyhawks players have ever finished the season ranked in the top five in both of those categories (Lester Hudson and Jared Newson, both of who went on to play in the NBA).

NEWCOMER

Glenn Cosey, G • Jr., 6-0, 182 • Flint, Mich. • Eastern Kentucky

Cosey earned his fifth OVC Newcomer of the Week honor of the season after returning from injury to average 20.5 points, 4.0 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals/game while hitting 39.3 percent (11-of-28) from the field, 47.6 percent (10-of-21) from 3-point range and 90 percent (9-of-10) from the free throw line in a pair of road games. Cosey returned to the Colonels lineup after missing six games with an injury but did not miss a beat. The junior transfer from Columbus State Community College came off the bench at UT Martin to hit 6-of-14 3-pointers and score 20 points. Cosey also had four assists, three rebounds and two steals in the game. On Saturday night he earned the start at Southeast Missouri, hitting 4-of-7 3-pointers on his way to 21 points, four assists, three rebounds and two steals.

FRESHMAN

Chris Horton, C • Fr., 6-8, 205 • Decatur, Ga. • Austin Peay

Horton earned his second-straight and seventh overall OVC Freshman of the Week award of the season after netting a double-double in Austin Peay's road overtime loss to rival Murray State on Saturday. The freshman was limited to 29 minutes due to foul problems but still netted his fifth double-double of the year by scoring 11 points and grabbing 10 rebounds. Horton also blocked six shots, the 12th time this season he has had three or more blocks in a game. Horton fouled out in the closing seconds of regulation and his absence proved critical in the extra period. Overall Horton leads the OVC in blocked shots (3.1/game) and is eighth in the OVC in rebounding (6.6/game) and field goal percentage (53.1%).

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: The matchups for the 11th annual ESPN Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters were announced on Monday...Three OVC teams (Belmont, Eastern Kentucky and Murray State) received TV games in the series marking the first time the league had more than one team in the same year...On Feb. 23 Murray State will host South Dakota State (ESPN2, 7 p.m. CT) followed by Belmont hosting Ohio (ESPN2, 9 p.m. CT); the day kicks off with Eastern Kentucky at Valparaiso (ESPNU, 12 p.m. CT)...Belmont remains perfect (10-0) atop the OVC standings with six Conference games left to be played while Murray State is in first place in the West Division (7-2); those two teams will play on Thursday night in Murray on ESPNU (7:00 p.m.)...Two key players who had been sitting out with injuries returned for their respective teams last week as Tennessee State's Robert Covington (out 10 games) and Eastern Kentucky's Glenn Cosey (out 6 games) were back in the lineup and gave each of their teams a lift; ECU and TSU are currently tied for second place (7-3) in the East Division behind Belmont...As of Monday Belmont ranks No. 18 nationally in the RPI (the Bruins are 6-2 against Top 100 RPI teams this season); overall three OVC teams ((Belmont, Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee State) are in the Top 100 of the RPI...After snapping a 12-game OVC road losing streak last week, UT Martin won its second-straight OVC game this past week in besting Eastern Kentucky at home; it marked the first time since Jan. 2011 that the Skyhawks had won back-to-back OVC contests...Belmont's Ian Clark currently leads the nation in 3-point percentage (51.4%), is 10th in 3-pointers made/game (3.3), 18th in field goal percentage (57.5%) and 30th in scoring (18.9 points/game)...Murray State's Isaiah Canaan ranks eighth nationally in scoring (21.0 points/game) and also moved into a tie for fifth place on the OVC career 3-pointers made list (271)...Canaan is also now just 185 points away from becoming the 17th member of the OVC 2,000-Point Club (and third in as many years); assuming MSU plays in 3 postseason games, he would need to average 16.8 points/game to achieve that feat)...All-session tickets (14 games) for the OVC Basketball Men's & Women's Championship are now on sale for \$80 through schools ticket offices; single-session tickets (\$30 for men's sessions, \$15 for women's sessions) will be on sale through Ticketmaster beginning on Feb. 7.

ESPN Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters Series Games Announced; Three OVC Teams Selected For TV Games (Most in One Year for the League): The pairings for the 11th annual ESPN Ramada Worldwide BracketBusters series were announced on Monday, Feb. 4. Three OVC teams (Belmont, Eastern Kentucky and Murray State) were selected to play in the 13 total TV matchups, marking the first time the OVC had more than one team in a TV game in the series in the same year. Only the Missouri Valley Conference (with four total TV games) had more TV game selections this season. The TV matchups include Belmont (19-4, 10-0 OVC) hosting 2012 NCAA Sweet 16 participant Ohio (15-6, 6-1 Mid-American Conference), Murray State (16-5, 7-2 OVC) hosting South Dakota State (18-6, 9-2 Summit) and Eastern Kentucky (17-6, 7-3 OVC) traveling to Valparaiso (17-6, 7-2 Horizon). Valparaiso and South Dakota State are currently in first place in their respective conferences while Ohio is in second place. The ECU game will kick off the day (Feb. 23) on ESPNU at 12:00 p.m. CT. The primetime slate will see an OVC doubleheader on ESPN2 as the Murray State/South Dakota State will tip-off at 7:00 p.m. CT on ESPN2 and will be followed by Belmont/Ohio at 9:00 p.m. CT on ESPN2. This marks the eighth-straight season the every OVC teams has competed in the event. Now in its 11th year, BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that has been tremendously successful with its nine events. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. This year there were 122 teams from 15 conferences in the pool of teams that will be selected for one of 13 nationally-televised games (5 on ESPN2, 4 on ESPNU and 4 on ESPN3). RPI: Entering this week the OVC is rated as the 16th-best conference in Division I. Belmont enters the week as No. 18 among all teams in the RPI. Since OVC play began at the beginning of January, Belmont's RPI has improved from No. 20 to 18th (with a high of 14 entering last week). Overall two other OVC teams are currently in the Top 100 of the RPI, with Eastern Kentucky ranking 83rd and Tennessee State ranking 97th.

Belmont Receiving Votes in Top 25: For the second time this season Belmont is once again receiving votes in the national Top 25 polls. The Bruins received votes in the USA Today Coaches Poll on Nov. 19 after its victory at Stanford, but have not been in the poll since. This week the team received 7 points in the USA Today poll and 1 vote in the AP Top 25 poll.

Murray State, Belmont, Eastern Kentucky Ranked in CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll: In this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major poll Belmont was No. 2 while Murray State was No. 15. Eastern Kentucky fell out of the poll and is now in the others receiving votes along with Jacksonville State. Gonzaga was ranked first and received 3 first-place votes while Creighton (who was 3rd) picked up the remaining first-place votes. Murray State finished the 2011-12 season ranked No. 1 in the poll, holding that spot for the final 12 weeks of the season; MSU was the first OVC team to ever be ranked No. 1 in the poll. Now in its 14th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Great West, Horizon,

2013 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2013 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 6-9 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 8 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU and ESPN3. The championship game on Saturday, March 9 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 8 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 9 at 1:30 p.m. (ESPN3).

This marks the 19th time in 20 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fourth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 4 at 1 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer is the OVC representative).

NCAA Statistical Leaders: In the latest set of NCAA statistical leaders released on Feb. 4, Belmont ranks sixth nationally in steals (10.1/game), seventh in 3-point percentage (40.6%), eighth in field goal percentage (49.3%), ninth in 3-pointers made/game (8.8), 17th in scoring margin (+14.2/game), 18th in turnover margin (+3.8/game), 19th in assists (16.1/game) and 19th in scoring offense (77.6 points/game). Eastern Kentucky ranks sixth nationally in turnover margin (+5.0/game), 13th in 3-pointers made/game (8.7) and 14th in free throw percentage (75.6%). Austin Peay is 11th nationally in 3-point percentage (40.0%) and 21st in blocks (5.3/game). Morehead State is 12th in steals (9.6/game) and Jacksonville State is sixth in 3-point percentage defense (27.5%). Individually Belmont's **Ian Clark** is first nationally in 3-point percentage (51.4%), 10th in 3-pointers made/game (3.30), 18th in field goal percentage (57.5%) and 30th in scoring (18.9 points/game). Murray State's **Isaiah Canaan** ranks eighth nationally in scoring (21.0 points/game) and 22nd in 3-pointers made/game (2.9). Murray State's **Ed Daniel** is seventh in rebounding (10.9/game) and seventh in double-doubles (12). Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is ninth in blocks (3.13/game) while Eastern Kentucky's **Corey Walden** is ninth in free throw percentage (90.7%).

Two OVC Players Named to CoSIDA Capital One Academic All-District Team: Two Ohio Valley Conference student-athletes have been named to the Capital One Academic All-District® men's basketball teams as selected by CoSIDA. The selections were Tennessee Tech's **Dennis Ogbe** (3.86 GPA in electrical engineering) and Southeast Missouri's **Nick Niemczyk** (3.80 GPA in higher education). Both were first-team selections and for making the first-team will have his name appear on the national ballot for consideration for Academic All-American. The Capital One Academic All-America men's basketball team will be announced on Thursday, February 21. To be eligible for nomination, a student-athlete must have reached sophomore academic standing and have at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average. District III selections include schools from the states of North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia while District VI selections are from the states of Arkansas, Iowa, Louisiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Mississippi, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wisconsin.

OVC One of Just 9 Conferences (3 Non-BCS) to Win NCAA Tournament Games in Each of Past Four Seasons: The OVC is one of just nine (9) Division I conferences to win a NCAA Tournament game in each of the past four years and one of just three non-BCS conferences to achieve the feat. The other non-BCS leagues to win a game in each of the last three years are the Atlantic 10 and West Coast Conferences. The ACC, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-10/12 and SEC are the BCS-level conferences that have won at least one game in each of the past three years.

More on NCAA Success: The four-year winning streak in NCAA Tournament play is unprecedented in OVC history. After winning NCAA Tournament games in each 1987, 1988 and 1989, the OVC went 20 years without a NCAA victory. That changed in 2009 when Morehead State topped Alabama State 58-43 in front of a record crowd at the Opening Round game in Dayton, Ohio. A year later it was No. 13 seed Murray State who won, topping No. 4 seed Vanderbilt 66-65 when Danero Thomas nailed a buzzer-beater in San Jose. In 2011 it was Morehead State's turn again, as the Eagles were seeded 13th and sent to Denver to battle No. 4-seed Louisville. MSU got off to a 15-2 lead nearly eight minutes into the game but trailed 61-59 with 31 seconds to play. On its final possession senior Demonte Harper nailed a 3-pointer from the top of the key with 4.3 seconds remaining to give Morehead State the lead and Kenneth Faried blocked Louisville's last shot attempt to seal the victory. Last season it was Murray State who once again won, knocking off Colorado State 58-41 in the second round in a game played in Louisville. The Racers earned a No. 6 seed in that event, the highest seed ever for an OVC team since the tournament seeding began in 1979.

Murray State First OVC Team to Reach 600 Conference Victories: Murray State, who was a charter member of the OVC when the Conference was formed in 1948, became the first Conference member to reach 600 OVC wins with a victory over UT Martin on Jan. 3. No other league member currently has more than 500 Conference wins.

Two Teammates With 30 Points in Same Game: In Belmont's 107-72 victory over Southeast Missouri on Jan. 10, teammates **Ian Clark** and **Trevor Noack** each scored 30 points in the game. It marked the first time anywhere at the Division I level in 2012-13 that two teammates had scored 30 or more points in the same game. It was the first time that had happened in Division I since two other OVC players, Eastern Kentucky's Mike DiNunno (33) and Jaron Jones (30), did so in an overtime loss to Tennessee State on Jan. 28, 2012.

Belmont's Johnson, Murray State's Canaan Named to Cousy Award Watch List: Belmont senior **Kerron Johnson** and Murray State senior **Isaiah Canaan** have been named to the watch list for the 2013 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award, which is presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. This watch list of candidates will be narrowed down to a final 20 around January 1st, final 10 near February 1st, and final five by approximately March 1st. A premier Selection Committee has been appointed by the Hall of Fame to review the final five candidates in contention for the nation's top collegiate point guard award. These Hall of Fame committees are made up of top college basketball personnel including media members, head coaches, Sports Information Directors and Hall of Famers. The winner of the 2013 Bob Cousy Award will be presented at the Hall of Fame's Class Announcement on Championship Monday in Atlanta as part of NCAA Final Four weekend.

Canaan Named to Wooden Award Midseason Top 25 Watch List: Murray State senior guard **Isaiah Canaan**, who was one of 50 players named to the John Wooden Award Preseason Watch List,

remained one of 25 players on the Midseason Watch List which was released in January. The players on the list are considered strong candidates for the midseason list and the official voting ballot, both of which are open to freshman and transfer students. The National Ballot consists of approximately 20 top players who have proven to their universities that they are also making progress toward graduation and maintaining at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA. The Wooden Award All American Team, consisting of the nation's top 10 players, will be announced the week of the "Elite Eight" round of the NCAA Tournament. The 37th annual Wooden Award ceremony will honor the Men's and Women's Wooden Award winners, and will include the presentation of the Wooden Award All American Teams and the Legends of Coaching Award. The event will take place the weekend of April 12-13, 2013.

Canaan Named Preseason All-American by Associated Press: Murray State senior guard **Isaiah Canaan** was one of six players named to the Associated Press Preseason All-American team this season. Canaan was joined on the team by Indiana sophomore Cody Zeller, Creighton junior Doug McDermott, Lehigh senior C.J. McCollum, Ohio State junior Deshaun Thomas and Michigan sophomore Trey Burke. Canaan was named on 43 of the 65 media ballots, second only to McDermott (who was named on 62 ballots).

Canaan Named to Naismith Award Early Season Watch List: Murray State senior guard **Isaiah Canaan** is one of 50 players nationally named to the Naismith Award early season watch list and announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club. The 50-player watch list was compiled by the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors, which based its criteria on player performances from the previous year and expectations for the 2012-13 college basketball season. The Naismith Men's College Player of the Year presented by AT&T will be awarded on April 7, 2013 in Atlanta. In late February, the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors will compile a mid-season team of the top 30 players in the nation. Then in March, the Naismith Trophy voting academy will narrow the list to the four finalists.

Canaan is Candidate for Senior CLASS Award: Murray State senior guard **Isaiah Canaan** is one of 30 men's basketball student-athletes who are candidates for the Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. The complete list of candidates follows this release. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The candidate classes will be narrowed to 10 men's and 10 women's finalists midway through the regular season, and those names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one men's finalist and one women's finalist who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

No Freshmen: The SIUE men's basketball team is one of six Division I teams this season to not feature a freshman (either true or redshirt) on its roster. The other teams without a freshman include Ohio, Portland State, Savannah State, UAB and Valparaiso.

Canaan Named to All-Tournament Team at Charleston Classic: Murray State senior **Isaiah Canaan** was named to the Charleston Classic All-Tournament team after leading his team to a runner-up finish at the event. Canaan averaged 20.7 points, 3.7 assists and 3.0 rebounds/game as the Racers topped Auburn and St. John's before falling to Colorado.

Belmont's Clark and Noack Named to All-Tournament Team at Great Alaska Shootout: Belmont senior guard **Ian Clark** and senior forward **Trevor Noack** were named to the Great Alaska Shootout All-Tournament Team after leading his team to a third-place finish in the event. In the three games Clark averaged 16.3 points, 3.7 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.3 steals/game while hitting 51.6 percent (16-of-31) from the field and 59.1 percent (13-of-22) from 3-point range. In the Bruins win over host Alaska Anchorage he scored 14 points, dished out five assists and held UAA's leading scorer to just two field goals in 40 minutes. In the semifinal loss to Northeastern, Clark set a record in the 35-year old history of the Great Alaska Shootout by connecting on 9-of-11 (81.8) 3-pointers on his way to a game-high 29 points. In a third-place victory over Oral Roberts, Clark struggled offensively but limited ORU's top player (who entered the game averaged 24.0 points/game) to a season-low three points in 30 minutes of play. Noack averaged 13.7 points and 5.3 rebounds/game in scoring double figures in each game. He had 15 against each Alaska Anchorage and Oral Roberts and 11 against Northeastern. It marks the second-straight year an OVC player has been named to the event's All-Tournament Team (Murray State's Isaiah Canaan earned the honors last year).

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2013 OVC Tournament will once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 6-9). It marks the third-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the eighth time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium. Last year's event (2012) saw the largest neutral site crowds ever in Nashville and the second-largest championship game attendance ever at a neutral site. For the semifinal games last year 5,142 fans attended the Murray State/Tennessee Tech and

Tennessee State/Morehead State games. A day later 6,454 fans attended the Murray State/Tennessee State Championship game. That crowd was the largest ever for a neutral site OVC Tournament game in Nashville and the second-largest neutral site championship crowd ever (trailing only the 8,145 fans who saw the 1993 Championship in Rupp Arena in Lexington, Ky.).

OVC at 12 Schools for First Time With Addition of Belmont; League Begins First Year of Divisional Play: The addition of Belmont University on July 1, 2012 gave the OVC 12 member institutions, the largest the Conference has been since it was formed in 1948 (the OVC is currently the nation's eighth-oldest Division I conference). The 2012-13 also marks the first year that SIUE, who finished its reclassification process to Division I in August, is eligible for the postseason. The East Division includes Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. The West Division includes Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin. The team who finishes first in each division will be guaranteed either the No. 1 or No. 2 seed for the OVC Tournament (and get a double bye into the semifinals); Seeds 3-8 in the tournament will be based on best Conference record, regardless of which division the team is from.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 23rd year at Austin Peay where he also serves as the Athletics Director, making him the only Division I head men's basketball coach to hold that distinction. Loos is one of just 11 active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years. Loos now has 368 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 450 for his career (which ranks him 27th among Division I head coaches). Although he is in his first year in the OVC, Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** has 656 career victories, which ranks seventh among active Division I head coaches.

The OVC Welcomes Four New Head Coaches: The OVC has four new head coaches this season. Tennessee State promoted head coach **Travis Williams** to its top spot after former coach John Cooper left for Miami (Ohio). Eastern Illinois is under the direction of **Jay Spoonhour** while Morehead State hired former Mississippi Valley State head coach **Sean Woods**. Although not new to his team, Belmont's **Rick Byrd** is new to the league as the Bruins are playing its first year in the league in 2012-13.

Former OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the 2012-13 season there are two former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his second season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 after averaging 10.2 points and 7.7 rebounds/game in 46 contests. Former Tennessee Tech star **Kevin Murphy**, who scored 50 points in a game last season, was picked by the Utah Jazz with the 47th overall pick in the 2012 NBA Draft and begins his rookie season with the team. Murphy is currently playing with the Jazz's NBDL affiliate, the Reno BigHorns. Several other former NBA players are in the NBDL including Morehead State's **Demonte Harper** (Erie BayHawks), Tennessee Tech's **Liam McMorow** (Iowa Energy), Jacksonville State's **Nick Murphy** (Iowa Energy) and Jacksonville State's **Walker Russell** (Fort Wayne Mad Ants).

The 2012-13 Season: The 2012-13 season marks the 65th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 64 years, 12 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Murray State's Canaan Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2012-13 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Murray State senior **Isaiah Canaan** who is the defending OVC Player of the Year and a preseason All-American selection. Overall six different schools were represented on the team with Belmont, Murray State, Southeast Missouri and Tennessee State having two selections apiece while SIUE and Tennessee Tech each had one selection to round out the team. The squad features three players who were All-OVC first-team selections last season, two players who were second-team selections and one player who was selected to the All-Newcomer squad. The team is comprised of eight seniors and two juniors. Last season Canaan was named the 2012 OVC Player of the Year and 2011-12 OVC Male Athlete of the Year after ranking 24th nationally in scoring (19.0), sixth in 3-point percentage (45.6%) and 13th in 3-pointers made/game (2.97). In addition to Canaan, Tennessee State senior forward **Robert Covington** and Tennessee Tech senior guard **Jud Dillard** were each first-team selections last year and are on the preseason team this year. The second-team selections from last year appearing on the preseason team this year are Southeast Missouri junior forward **Tyler Stone** and SIUE senior forward **Mark Yelovich**. The Preseason All-OVC team was rounded out by the Belmont senior backcourt duo of **Kerron Johnson** and **Ian Clark**, Murray State senior forward **Ed Daniel**, Tennessee State junior guard **Patrick Miller** and Southeast Missouri senior guard **Marland Smith**.

Murray State, Belmont Picked as OVC Preseason Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors defending champion Murray State was picked the favorite in the West Division while newcomer Belmont was picked as the East Division favorite in the OVC for 2012-13. This year marks the first for divisional play in the OVC, which now includes 12 teams for the first time in Conference history. Murray State led the West Division voting, picking up 22 of a possible 24 first-place votes (schools were not allowed to vote for themselves) and 132 total points. Southeast Missouri State was tabbed second and picked up the remaining two first-place votes and 108 points. The West was rounded out by Austin Peay (92), SIUE (73), Eastern Illinois (49) and UT Martin (38). Belmont picked up 21 of the 24 first-place votes and 131 points to be picked the East Division favorites. Tennessee State was tabbed second and received the other three first-place votes and 109 points. The East was rounded out by Tennessee Tech (87), Morehead State (77) and Eastern Kentucky (56). Due to a NCAA APR penalty, Jacksonville State is ineligible for the OVC and NCAA Tournaments this season and was not included in the preseason voting.

Dial Global to Broadcast OVC Championship Game: For the fourth consecutive season, the 2013 Men's Basketball Championship game will be broadcast by the Dial Global (formerly Westwood One) radio network, the largest provider of audio content in America. In its lone game last week, Austin Peay took West Division leader Murray State to overtime but came up short by a 75-68 margin...The loss was the sixth-straight for the Governors who have lost 14 of its last 15 games overall...Austin Peay is now 0-10 on Saturday's this season...Freshman Chris Horton, who earned his sixth OVC Freshman of the Week honor of the season, recorded his fifth double-double of the season on Saturday in scoring 11 points on 5-of-9 shooting and also grabbing 10 rebounds in 29 minutes of action; Horton also blocked six shots on the afternoon, increasing his season total to 72...Horton's 3.1 blocks/game ranks first in the OVC and ninth nationally; only four active OVC players have more blocks in their careers than Horton does this season...Horton needs just 12 blocks to set the APSU single-season blocks record of 83 held by Josh Lewis (2003-04)...Senior Anthony Campbell hit 4-of-8 3-pointers in the game on his way to 16 points; Campbell also had seven rebounds and two assists...Senior point guard Jerome Clyburn played 18 minutes off the bench against MSU; he had been out with an injury since the beginning of December...Senior Will Triggs shot 50 percent or better from the field for the 11th-straight game on Saturday...APSU limited Murray State to just 38.7 percent shooting, the second time in OVC play the Gobs have held an opponent to less than 40 percent shooting...Austin Peay did commit a season-high 26 fouls against the Racers...APSU ranks 11th nationally in 3-point percentage (40.0%) and 21st in blocks (5.3/game)...This week the Governors return home to host a pair of games; the team will host Tennessee State on Thursday night and OVC newcomer Belmont on Saturday.

Belmont ran its winning streak to 10 games (fifth-longest nationally) with wins over Morehead State and Tennessee Tech last week...With the wins the Bruins are now 10-0 and in first place in the OVC...The team enters this week with an RPI of 18 and a non-conference strength of schedule of 4...Overall BU has won 17-straight home games, the eighth-longest streak nationally; the team has won 38 of its last 39 at the Curb Event Center...For the first time since Nov. 19, Belmont is once again receiving votes in the national Top 25 polls; the Bruins picked up 7 points in the USA Today coaches poll and 1 point in the AP poll...Senior point guard Kerron Johnson averaged 19.0 points, 4.0 steals and 2.5 assists/game last week including hitting 26-of-30 (86.7%) at the free throw line...Senior Ian Clark leads the nation in 3-point percentage (51.4%) and effective field goal percentage (Ken Pomeroy); Clark also ranks 10th nationally in 3-pointers made/game (3.3), 18th in field goal percentage (57.5%) and 30th in scoring (18.9 points/game)...Belmont ranks in the Top 50 nationally in 10 statistical categories, including sixth in steals/game (10.1), seventh in 3-point percentage (40.6%) and ninth in 3-pointers made/game (8.8)...Belmont begins a four-game road swing on Thursday night with an ESPN2 contest at Murray State; the meeting is the first between the two schools as members of the OVC (they have played four times overall with the last coming in Dec. 2007) and will be a battle of the two teams currently sitting in first place in their respective OVC divisions...The game is also the 1000th of head coach Rick Byrd's coaching career; Byrd currently has a 656-343 record in his 32nd year as a collegiate head coach...The week concludes with a Saturday night game at Austin Peay.

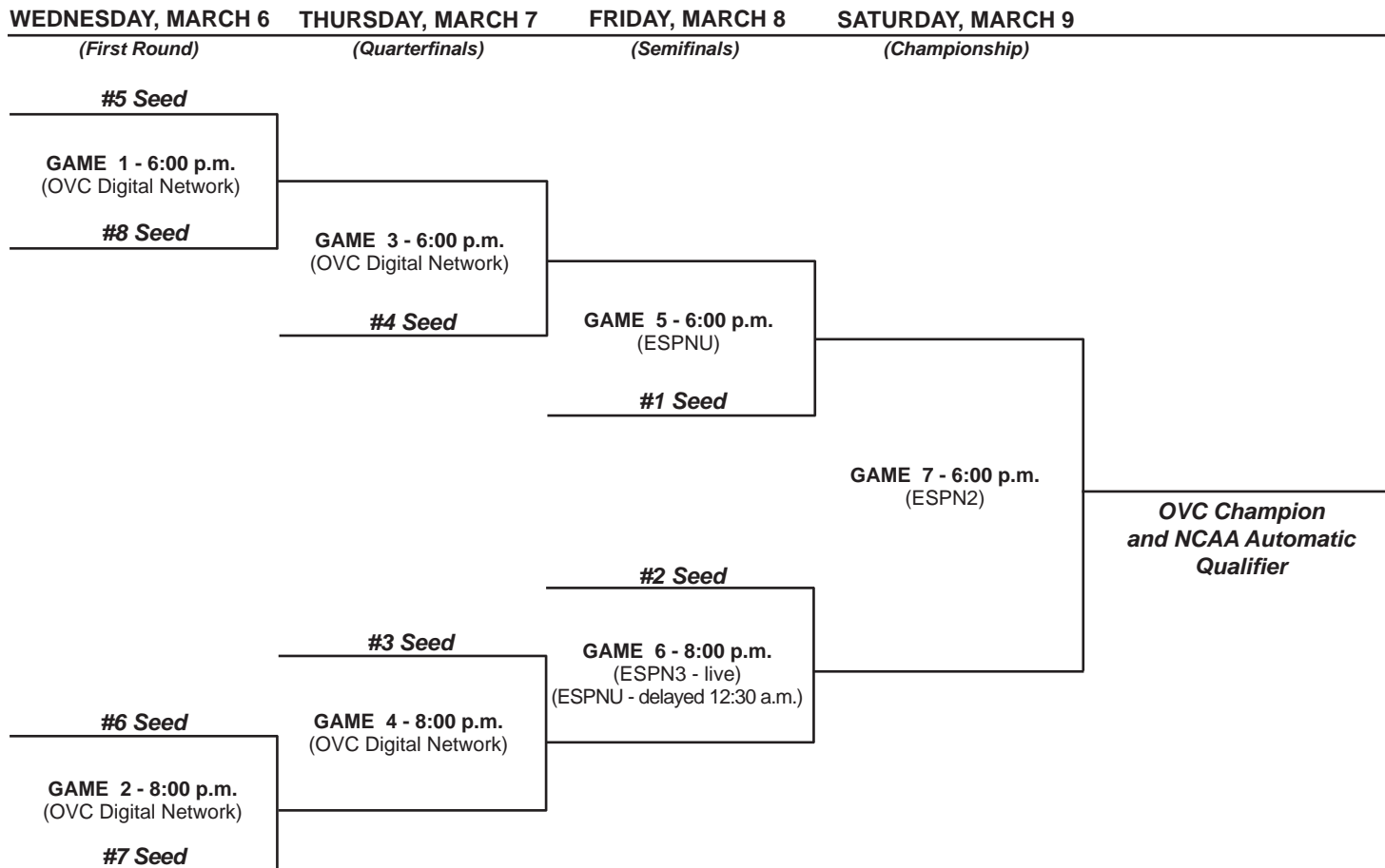
