Cole led Eastern Illinois with 13 hits, three home runs, 12 RBI and a .912 slugging percentage as the Panthers went 7-2 last week. She also scored nine times and had three doubles. Cole drove in a season-best five RBI versus Lehigh off a pair of two-run homers and a RBI base hit. She is currently riding a team-best nine-game hitting streak. Cole also notched a total of 71 putouts as she saw action as both the starting catcher and right fielder last week.

Mennenga went 3-0 with a 0.30 earned run average last week. She recorded 28 strikeouts in 23 innings of work. She fanned a career-high 16 batters in the OVC-opening win at Austin Peay. Mennenga came one pitch shy of a perfect game versus North Dakota as she struck out the first seven batters she faced. She tallied a double-digit strikeout number in four of the six games played last week. Mennenga held opponents to a .159 batting average.

2013 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (9-10 overall, 0-3 OVC): Austin Peay swept a doubleheader with Southern Illinois before dropping two to Lipscomb and three to Eastern Illinois last week. Junior **Kayla Davidson** recorded hits in all seven games last week to lead the team with a .611 batting average. She recorded two doubles, three home runs, six RBI and eight runs scored. Senior **Morgan Brewer** tallied her 300th career strikeout versus Eastern Illinois to become just the fourth Lady Gov to reach that milestone. Freshman **Courtney Brower** was hit by a pitch twice last week, marking the fourth time in her nine plate appearances that she has been hit. Austin Peay hit three triples over the seven games to give them eight through 19 games this season. The Lady Govs recorded just five triples in 50 games last season. APSU will travel to Jacksonville State for a twinbill on Saturday and Tennessee Tech for a pair on Sunday.

BELMONT (7-12 overall, 0-3 OVC): Belmont fell to Ole Miss before dropping a trio of games to Eastern Kentucky to open up OVC play. Freshman **Jessica Wilson** hit .375 for the week, including hitting her first collegiate home run in the rubber game of the ECU series. In the third game versus the Colonels, she went 3-for-4 with an RBI. Freshman **Taylor Moon** saw action throughout the Eastern Kentucky series, throwing 13 innings and recording three strikeouts. The Bruins will travel to Alabama A&M on Wednesday for a pair before hosting Southeast Missouri for two on Saturday and UT Martin for a doubleheader on Sunday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (13-8 overall, 3-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois finished the Rebel Springs Games by going 4-2 with wins over Lehigh, Saint Peter's, Army and North Dakota. The two losses came against Robert Morris and Fairleigh Dickinson. The Panthers also opened up OVC play with a three-game sweep at Austin Peay. EIU is currently riding a six-game win streak. Sophomore **Hannah Cole** led the team with 13 hits, three home runs, 12 RBI and a .962 slugging percentage. She drove in a season-high five runs versus Lehigh off a pair of two-run homers. Junior **Hanna Mennenga** went 3-0 with a 0.30 earned run average last week. She fanned 28 batters and walked just 7 in 23.2 innings of work. Mennenga held opponents to a .159 batting average. Eastern Illinois will host Indiana State on Wednesday before traveling to Eastern Kentucky for two on Saturday and Morehead State for a doubleheader on Sunday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (14-9 overall, 3-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell to Western Kentucky, split a doubleheader with Middle Tennessee and swept a three-game series at Belmont. The Colonels recorded season-highs in runs (12) and hits (14) in the series finale with Belmont. Sophomore **Leanna Pittensbarger** tossed her first career no-hitter in the second game with Bruins. It marked the first seven-inning no-hitter by an EKV pitcher since March 22, 2006. Freshman **Sarah Fobbs** led the team in hits (9), runs (4) and RBI (3). She also posted a .667 slugging percentage. She hit .500 during the three games with Belmont, including going 3-for-4 with a home run and three RBI in the series finale. Eastern Kentucky will host Ohio for two on Tuesday, Eastern Illinois for a twinbill on Saturday and SIUE for a pair on Sunday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (13-9 overall, 3-0 OVC): Jacksonville State fell to Mississippi State before sweeping its OVC-opening three-game series with Tennessee State. Sophomore **Sara Border** doubled in every game during the week to take over the top spot in the league and raise her average 30 points in just four games. She had two hits in each of the first three games and scored five times during the week. Junior **Tiffany Harbin** recorded her fourth career no-hitter in the series opening win over TSU. She held the Tigers scoreless over 13.0 innings and grabbed a pair of wins. In the finale with Tennessee State, she struck out 11 batters to finish the week with 21. The Gamecocks will travel to Georgia State on Tuesday before returning home to host Austin Peay for two on Saturday and Murray State for a pair on Sunday.

MOREHEAD STATE (8-6 overall, 0-0 OVC): Morehead State split a doubleheader with Detroit last week. The Eagles' OVC opening series with Tennessee Tech was postponed due poor field conditions. Senior **Amber Riddle** hit .571 over the two games. In the win over Titans, Riddle hit her 30th career home run, which ties the school career mark. She had a 1.000 slugging percentage and a perfect fielding percentage. The Eagles will travel to Dayton for a pair on Tuesday before returning home to host Shawnee State for two on Wednesday, SIUE for a doubleheader on Saturday and Eastern Illinois for a twinbill on Sunday.

MURRAY STATE (7-12 overall, 1-1 OVC): Murray State split a pair of games with Southeast Missouri to open up OVC play. Sophomore **Alexa Becker** went 3-for-7 at the plate with a home run, a RBI and two runs scored. She posted a .429 batting average, a .857 slugging percentage and a .500 on-base percentage. Sophomore **CheyAnne Gaskey** picked up the win in the circle. She pitched a complete game, giving up just one earned run and striking out nine. The Racers will travel to Tennessee on Tuesday, Chattanooga on Wednesday and East Tennessee State on Thursday. Murray State will conclude the week with a pair of OVC doubleheaders at Tennessee Tech on Saturday and Jacksonville State on Sunday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (8-12 overall, 1-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri took two from Indiana State before splitting an OVC-opening doubleheader with Murray State. Junior **Alexis Anderson** went 5-for-7 versus the Racers with two home runs and a double. She drove in four RBI versus Murray State and scored three runs while also stealing a pair of bases. For the week, she recorded a .636 batting average with 14 total bases and a 1.273 slugging percentage. Senior **Taylor Cowan** went 2-0 in the circle for the Redhawks. She struck out eight batters in 14.0 innings of work. Southeast Missouri will host Georgia Tech on Wednesday before traveling to Bowling Green for a pair on Thursday, Belmont for two on Saturday and Tennessee State for a doubleheader on Sunday.

SIUE (14-7 overall, 1-1 OVC): SIUE defeated Missouri State before splitting a pair of games with UT Martin to open up league play. Sophomore **Brittany Toney** hit a home run in her first at-bat against the Skyhawks. She finished the week with a .444 batting average with one double, one home run, four runs scored and six RBI while also stealing two bases. **Alex McDavid** currently has a 13-game hit streak which is the longest by a Cougar since the 2006 season. It is also the longest by an OVC player this year. Freshman **Haley Chambers** picked up her third and fourth straight wins in the circle last week. She tossed a three-hitter in the five-inning victory over Missouri State and struck out seven in the win over UT Martin. The Cougars will host Georgia Tech for a two on Tuesday and Wichita State on Thursday before hitting the road for a pair of OVC doubleheaders at Morehead State on Saturday and Eastern Kentucky on Sunday.

TENNESSEE STATE (9-19 overall, 0-3 OVC): Tennessee State fell to Auburn and Florida State before defeating Florida A&M to conclude its spring break schedule. The Tigers also dropped a trio of games to Jacksonville State to open up OVC play. **Olivia Gamache** registered her 99th career strikeout against JSU. She also cracked the school's career top ten strikeout list. **Jennifer Givens** continues to lead the Tigers with a .388 batting average while **Shea Morris** is pacing the pitching staff with a 2.89 ERA. TSU will host a pair of OVC doubleheaders this weekend with UT Martin on Saturday and Southeast Missouri on Sunday.

TENNESSEE TECH (11-9 overall, 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech defeated Thomas University in its only game of the week. The Golden Eagles OVC-opening series with Morehead State was postponed due to poor field conditions. Tech will travel to Lipscomb for a pair on Wednesday before hosting Murray State for two on Saturday and Austin Peay for a doubleheader on Sunday.

UT MARTIN (16-8 overall, 1-1 OVC): UT Martin defeated Ole Miss before splitting a pair of games with SIUE to open up Conference play. Senior **Leah Taylor** scored the winning run against Ole Miss. She added three hits and scored another run against SIUE for the week. **Casey Vincent** and **Kenzi Tate** pitched a combined shutout versus the Rebels. Tate also hit .444 for the week with two doubles and four RBI. Seniors **Katie Reiff** and **Becca Williams** combined for two home runs and four RBI at SIUE. UT Martin will host Trevecca on Wednesday before hitting the road for two OVC doubleheaders at Tennessee State on Saturday and Belmont on Sunday.
