NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

OVC Associate Commissioner Named to NCAA Women's Basketball Committee: Brad Walker, the Ohio Valley Conference's associate commissioner for operations/chief operating officer, has been appointed to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee. Walker and Wisconsin senior associate athletic director Terry Gawlik are the new additions to the 10-person committee. This year's chair is Carolayne Henry, associate commissioner of compliance at the Mountain West Conference. Walker's term officially begins in September and will last for five years.

OVC Tournament Newcomers: The OVC Championship field will have a pair of newcomers this season. Belmont in its first year in the league earned the No. 3 seed while SIUE, which finished its reclassification to Division I and eligible for the first time, earned the No. 6 seed.

Belmont Joins the League: Belmont officially joins the league this year bringing the Ohio Valley Conference to 12 teams for the first times. Belmont competes in 17 sports (8 men's sports and 9 women's sports), 16 of which will compete in the OVC (the exception being men's soccer which is not sponsored by the OVC). The Bruins have competed in the Atlantic Sun Conference since 2001-02 and will compete in its final year in that league in 2011-12 before joining the OVC. Since 2001-02 Belmont has won 30 Atlantic Sun Championships, the second most in the conference. Bruins athletic teams have made recent NCAA Tournament appearances in men's and women's basketball, women's soccer, men's tennis and volleyball.

SIUE full Division I Member: After the past five seasons of reclassification, SIUE is now a full Division I member and will be eligible for postseason play. In its first season with a full OVC schedule, the Cougars posted a 12-4 record and would have been the third seed on the league tournament.

OVC Women's Hoops on Monday Nights: OVC women's basketball will again be featured on Monday night's. The league approved in 2011 to move away from the men's/women's Thursday night doubleheaders and move the women's games to Monday night.

OVC Basketball to Play in Divisions: With the addition of Belmont and with SIUE gaining full Division I status and becoming eligible for postseason competition, the OVC will feature 12 schools in the sports of men's and women's basketball, softball and volleyball for the first time this coming year. The league announced in February its intention to use a divisional scheduling model for the sports that featured 12 member institutions. The East Division will include Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech while the West Division will include Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin. In the sports of men's and women's basketball, the top team in each division based on conference winning percentage automatically earns a berth into the OVC Basketball Championship. The next six teams with the highest conference winning percentage will also earn a bid, regardless of division. The No. 1 seed will go to the divisional winner with the top conference winning percentage, while the No. 2 seed will automatically go to the other divisional winner. The remaining six teams will be seeded 3-8 by conference winning percentage, regardless of division.

OVC Digital Network: The Ohio Valley Conference has launched the OVC Digital Network (www.OVCDigitalNetwork.com), the new and improved home for live streaming of athletic contests involving OVC member institutions. One of the top new features of the Digital Network is that all events will be offered free for fans. The events will also feature improved quality with most events streaming in high definition (HD). Fans will also have easier access to the streams, easily accessing them through links at OVCDigitalNetwork.com without any registration being required. The streams will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without any app or software download thanks to the use of HTML5 technology. The portal also includes live stats and social media integration to give fans even more interaction. The streaming efforts will concentrate on football and men's and women's basketball in the first year, with all home non-conference and conference contests featuring OVC schools in those sports airing on the platform.

UT MARTIN SKYHAWKS (19-14, 11-5)

Team Notes

UT Martin is coming off its third straight OVC Tournament title as the No. 4 Skyhawks upset second-seeded and co-regular season champions Tennessee Tech, 87-80, in overtime. UT Martin, which has won its last eight contests, makes its third trip to the NCAA Tournament when it faces Notre Dame on Sunday. UT Martin is the only team in the nation to boast two top-10 scorers in the nation in juniors Jasmine Newsome (22.9 points per game, fourth) and Heather Butler (22.0, seventh). Both players are three-time All-OVC first teamers while Newsome is coming off back-to-back OVC Player of the Year accolades. Newsome was also named the OVC Defensive Player of the Year as well as the Tournament MVP. Newsome set new OVC Tournament records for points in a single-game (41) and points in the tournament with a three-game total of 98.

Team Notes

Eastern Illinois is making its fourth straight postseason appearance after earning its second OVC regular-season crown. The Panthers will be making its third WNIT appearance when it faces Missouri on Wednesday. The Panthers are led in scoring by seniors Ta'Kenya Nixon (14.6 ppg) and Mariah King (14.0 ppg). EIU has three players who average more than six rebounds per game, led by Sabina Oroszova's 7.0 rebounds per game. EIU trails the all-time series between the two schools, 7-1. The Panthers are 1-1 in the last two meetings, posting an 81-73 home win on Nov. 14, 2010 and losing a 56-54 contest in Columbia, Mo., last season on Dec. 7. Eastern Illinois will be looking for its first postseason as they own a 0-4 record. The Panthers have played in two WNIT's (2010, 2012), the WBI (2011) and the NCAA Tournament (1988).

Team Notes

Eastern Kentucky will be making its first postseason appearance since winning the OVC Tournament and playing in the NCAA Tournament in 2005. The Lady Colonels are 1-3 all-time in the postseason with the lone win coming against Missouri State in the 2002 WNIT. EKU won 18 games this season, the most by a Lady Colonel team since that championships season of 2005. Junior Marie Carpenter enters the tournament leading EKU at 14.1 points-per-game while senior Alex Jones nearly averages a double-double for the Lady Colonels (9.1 points-per-game, 10.3 rebounds-per-game).
