CO-PLAYER OF THE WEEK:

Alexa Becker, SS, So., 5'9, Breese, Ill. - Murray State

Becker led the team with a .467 batting average as the Racers went 4-2 overall, including posting a 4-0 OVC mark last week. She notched home runs against both Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State for a slugging percentage of .867. She paced the team with five runs scored, six RBI and a .500 on-base percentage.

Alex McDavid, 3B, So., 5'7, Suwanee, Ga. - SIUE

McDavid homered in three straight games last week as the Cougars went 5-1. She hit a two-RBI single in the top of the seventh that helped SIUE's extra-inning comeback over Morehead State. She also recorded the hit that scored two runs in extra innings. In the 9-4 win over Eastern Kentucky, McDavid hit a three-run shot to take over the team lead with five homers this year. She recorded 17 total bases for a .944 slugging percentage. McDavid also led the team with a .476 on-base percentage.

2013 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (10-11 overall, 1-4 OVC): Austin Peay split a doubleheader at Jacksonville State last week while the two games schedule with Tennessee Tech were postponed due to inclement weather last week. The Lady Govs moved to 2-0 in extra innings games with the 4-2 8-inning win over JSU. Junior **Kayla Davidson** batted .429 over the two games and extended her hitting streak to a team-best nine games. She recorded two doubles and drove in pair of runs. Senior **Morgan Brewer** picked up the wins in the circle, giving up just two earned runs and striking out a pair in 8.0 innings of work. Austin Peay will travel to Middle Tennessee for a pair on Wednesday and UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Friday.

BELMONT (10-15 overall, 1-6 OVC): Belmont swept a doubleheader with Alabama A&M, split a twinbill with Southeast Missouri and dropped a pair to UT Martin last week. The win over the Redhawks was the Bruins first OVC win of the season. Sophomore **Kat Hollingsworth** led the team at the plate. Against AAMU, she picked up four RBI with a grand slam in game two. In the opening game with Southeast Missouri, Hollingsworth hit her second home run in as many games. In the second game with UT Martin, she hit three doubles. Belmont will host Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (16-9 overall, 6-1 OVC): Eastern Illinois swept a doubleheader at Morehead State and split a pair of games at Eastern Kentucky. Junior **Carly Willert** led all Panthers with 10 total bases, an .833 slugging percentage and three RBI. She hit the game-winning RBI base hit in the second game with EKU. She also hit a two-run home run in the opening game with the Colonels. Junior **Stephanie Maday** fanned 15 batters in 16.0 innings of work as she picked up a pair of wins. She improved to 7-3 in the circle this year. The Panthers will travel to Butler for a pair before hosting Murray State for a three-game series starting this Friday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (18-11 overall, 5-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky took two from Ohio before splitting doubleheaders with SIUE and Eastern Illinois last week. Senior **Racquel Howes** recorded six hits last week, five of which were for extra bases. She recorded two doubles and three home runs while driving in five. **Christina Ciolek** hit the team's first grand slam of the year, which ended the second game of the SIUE doubleheader. **Katie Tackett** hit a pair of home runs in the win over Eastern Illinois. Pitcher **Leanna Pittsenbarger** gave up just one hit in the 7-0 win over Ohio. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Tennessee on Wednesday before returning home to host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series starting on Friday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (17-14 overall, 4-3 OVC): Jacksonville State fell at Georgia State, split a doubleheader with Austin Peay and dropped a pair to Murray State last week. **Tiffany Harbin** struck out 31 batters in 17.0 innings of work. In the first game with Austin Peay, Harbin gave up just two hits and fanned 13 to earn the win. Jacksonville State will travel to Samford on Tuesday and Belmont for a three-game series starting on Friday.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-10 overall, 0-4 OVC): Morehead State swept a doubleheader with Shawnee State before dropping doubleheaders to Eastern Illinois and SIUE. Senior **Elizabeth Wagner** led the Eagles in a doubleheader sweep of Shawnee State as she hit .800 over the two games. In the two OVC doubleheaders, Wagner batted .400 with a double and a home run. She led the team in slugging percentage (.800) and on-base percentage (.538) in conference games. Morehead State will travel to Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Friday.

MURRAY STATE (11-14 overall, 5-1 OVC): Murray State fell to No. 8 Tennessee and Chattanooga before sweeping doubleheaders with Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State last week. Sophomore **Alexa Becker** led the team with a .467 batting average. She recorded home runs against both Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State. Becker led the team with five runs scored and six RBI. Sophomore **CheyAnne Gaskey** went 2-1 in the circle, striking out 27 batters in 21.5 innings of work. Murray State will travel to Evansville on Wednesday and Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Friday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (10-15 overall, 3-2 OVC): Southeast Missouri fell to Georgia Tech and Western Kentucky before splitting a doubleheader with Belmont and defeating Tennessee State last week. Junior **Alexis Anderson** recorded a team-high six hits on the week, including a double and a home run. She drove in four RBI and had 10 total bases. Senior **Taylor Cowan** struck out 14 batters in 21.1 innings of work in the circle. Against Tennessee State, she picked up the shutout victory. Southeast Missouri will host SIUE for a three-game series starting on Friday.

SIUE (19-8 overall, 4-2 OVC): SIUE swept a doubleheader with Georgia Tech, split a twinbill with Eastern Kentucky and took two from Morehead State last week. Sophomore **Alex McDavid** hit a home run in three straight games last week. She drove in eight and scored five times while also swiping two bases. Freshman pitcher **Haley Chambers** ran her winning streak to seven to move her to 10-2 overall this season. She went 3-0 with 20 strikeouts and giving up just one walk in 21.0 innings of work last week. **Erin Greenwalt** earned her second shutout of the season in the 1-0 win over Georgia Tech. She currently leads the team with a 1.61 earned run average. SIUE will travel to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series beginning on Friday.

TENNESSEE STATE (10-21 overall, 1-5 OVC): Tennessee State split a doubleheader with UT Martin and fell to Southeast Missouri last week. Senior **Jennifer Givens** reached base twice in each game last week. She scored a pair of runs and stole three bases. Givens is now tied for second on the school's all-time stolen base chart with 47 in just her second season as a Tiger. Sophomore **Shea Morris** tossed a pair of complete games last week, picking up the win over UT Martin. She struck out 14 over her 14.0 innings of work and did not give up an outfield hit against the Skyhawks. Tennessee State will host Morehead State for a three-game series beginning on Friday.

TENNESSEE TECH (11-13 overall, 0-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a pair to Lipscomb and Murray State last week. The Golden Eagles' doubleheader with Austin Peay was postponed. **Melody Christian** hit .357 over the four games with one double and two runs scored. Tennessee Tech will travel to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Friday.

UT MARTIN (20-9 overall, 4-2 OVC): UT Martin defeated Trevecca, split a doubleheader with Tennessee State and took two from Belmont last week. **Lauren Smith** hit .692 with a 1.000 slugging percentage over the five games. She hit one home run, drove in three runs and scored three times. Smith tallied two or more hits in three of the five games. Sophomore **Casey Vincent** pitched three complete games, going 2-1. She fanned 15 and walked just two in the 21.1 innings of work. **Kenzi Tate** went 6-for-8 with one double, a home run and seven RBI on the week. Tate also posted a 2-0 mark in the circle, striking out 11. **Leah Taylor** went 4-for-12 with one double, one home run and six RBI. Freshman **Mikala Torrence** has started three games in a row, hitting .583 with two RBI and five runs scored. UT Martin will travel to Saint Louis on Wednesday before returning home to host Austin Peay for a three-game series starting
