Toney reached base every plate appearance for a 1.000 on-base percentage. Four of her six hits went for extra bases, including a pair of home runs. 2013 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (10-16 overall, 1-7 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a pair of games at Middle Tennessee and was swept in a three-game series with UT Martin. Junior **Lauren de Castro** led the team with a .625 batting average over the five games. She scored five runs and drove in three. She hit three doubles and also stole a base. With her home run in the first game against UT Martin, senior **Shelby Norton** became 10th Lady Gov to record 10 or more home runs in her career. Austin Peay finished its non-conference schedule with a 9-9 record, marking the first time since 2007 they have posted a .500 or better mark against non-conference opponents. Austin Peay will host a pair of OVC doubleheaders this weekend as it welcomes Morehead State on Saturday and Eastern Kentucky on Sunday.

BELMONT (11-16 overall, 2-7 OVC): Belmont split a pair of games with Jacksonville State last night. Sophomore **Kirbie Ferrell** led the Bruins at the plate with a .571 batting average and a team-best three RBI. She hit a double and a triple while also scoring a run in the two games. In the second game against the Gamecocks, Ferrell went 4-for-4. Belmont will host Memphis for a pair of games before hitting the road for two OVC doubleheaders this weekend. The Bruins will travel to Eastern Illinois on Saturday and SIUE on Sunday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (19-9 overall, 9-1 OVC): Eastern Illinois swept a three-game series with Murray State last week. Sophomore **Hannah Cole** hit .566 over the three games, including .714 in the doubleheader on Saturday. She scored two runs and drove in one over the three games. Junior **Hanna Menenga** picked up all three wins in the circle. She allowed just one earned run and struck out 21 in 17.0 innings of action. She recorded her eighth double-digit strikeout game as she fanned 11 in the second game of the series. Eastern Illinois will travel to Saint Louis for a pair before returning home to host a single-game with Southern Illinois on Thursday, a pair of games with Belmont on Saturday and two with Tennessee State on Sunday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (19-14 overall, 6-4 OVC): Eastern Kentucky fell to No. 6 Tennessee Tech and went 1-2 against Tennessee Tech last week. **Kayla Joyce** drove in three of the team's five runs last week. She hit .333 with two runs scored last week. **Leanna Pittsenbarger** struck out 23 batters in 13.2 innings of work. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Murray State for a doubleheader on Saturday and to Austin Peay for a pair of games on Sunday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (19-15 overall, 5-4 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated Samford and split a doubleheader with Belmont last week. **Kalee Tabor** led the team with five hits, including a pair of doubles, while also driving in a two runs. **Savanna Hennings** earned the win against Samford and pitched 3.1 scoreless innings in the second game with Belmont. Jacksonville State will travel to Alabama on Tuesday before returning home to host a pair of OVC doubleheaders this weekend. The Gamecocks will host Southeast Missouri on Saturday and UT Martin on Sunday.

MOREHEAD STATE (11-11 overall, 1-5 OVC): Morehead State split a doubleheader with Tennessee State last week. Senior **Elizabeth Wagner** hit .714 over the two games to continue to lead the team this season with a .492 batting average. She hit a pair of doubles and drove in three runs. Morehead State will host Northern Kentucky for a pair on Tuesday before hitting the road for two OVC doubleheaders this weekend. The Eagles will travel to Austin Peay on Saturday and Murray State on Sunday.

MURRAY STATE (12-18 overall, 5-4 OVC): Murray State split a doubleheader with Evansville and was swept in a three-game series with Eastern Illinois. **Alex Becker** led the team with six hits, including a pair of doubles. She also drove in three runs. **Leslie Bridges** recorded a team-leading .385 batting average and 4 RBI over the two games. Murray State will host Eastern Kentucky for a doubleheader on Saturday and Morehead State for two on Sunday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (10-18 overall, 3-5 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped a trio of games to SIUE last week. Freshman catcher **Chelsea Smith** led the team with a .500 batting average. She recorded the team's only RBI versus the Cougars. Smith also caught two runners stealing. She is currently second on the team in batting average this season. Southeast Missouri will host Evansville for a pair of games before hitting the road for two OVC doubleheaders with Jacksonville State on Saturday and Tennessee Tech on Sunday.

SIUE (22-8 overall, 7-2 OVC): SIUE swept a three-game series with Southeast Missouri last week. Sophomore **Brittany Toney** went a perfect 6-for-6 at the plate with a walk and a hit by a pitch last week. She recorded a 2.333 slugging percentage as four of her six hits were for extra bases including a pair of home runs. Freshman pitcher **Haley Chambers** picked up a pair of wins to extend her winning streak to nine. She did not give up an earned run, striking out 10 and walking just one in 11.0 innings of work. **Alex McDavid** hit .545 for the week and now has a team-leading five home runs and 26 RBI. SIUE will travel to Southern Illinois on Tuesday before returning home to host two conference doubleheaders with Tennessee State on Saturday and Belmont on Sunday.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-22 overall, 2-6 OVC): Tennessee State split a doubleheader with Morehead State last week. Senior Jennifer Givens went 5-for-7 over the two games. She scored three times and drove in one run. Givens also stole three bases to give her 16 on the season and 50 for her career. Freshman Kiarra Freeman registered five hits and is now sporting a .356 batting average. Tennessee State will hit the road this week as it travels to No. 6 Tennessee for a single game on Tuesday, to SIUE for a pair on Saturday and to Eastern Illinois for a doubleheader on Sunday.

TENNESSEE TECH (13-14 overall, 2-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech went 2-1 against Eastern Kentucky last week. Freshman **Cortney Fry** extended her hitting streak to four games. She recorded a pair of hits in the second game as well as the series finale to finish with a .500 batting average. Sophomore pitcher **Taylor Ketchum** earned both wins, giving up just two runs. She pitched a pair of complete games and struck out five. Tennessee Tech will travel to East Tennessee for a pair of games before returning home to host two conference doubleheaders this weekend. The Golden Eagles will welcome UT Martin on Saturday and Southeast Missouri on Sunday.

UT MARTIN (23-9 overall, 7-2 OVC): UT Martin swept a three-game series with Austin Peay last week. The Skyhawks have now won eight of their last nine games and 16 of the last 19. Junior **Kayla Wade** hit a pair of triples to move into a for third on the school's all-time list with 10 career triples. She hit .571 with a 1.143 slugging percentage. Wade also stole four bases and scored three times in the series. Sophomore **Kenzi Tate** picked up a pair of wins to become the first OVC player to reach 13 wins in only 15 appearances. She gave up just three runs and struck out eight in 14.0 innings of action. **Lauren Smith** hit .500 with one home run and four RBI. The Skyhawks will host a doubleheader with Evansville before hitting the road for a pair of OVC doubleheaders at Tennessee Tech on Saturday and Jacksonville State on Sunday.
