Katie Tackett, C, So., 5'6, Murrieta, Calif. - Eastern Kentucky

Tackett posted a .563 batting average last week, including hitting .636 in a three-game sweep of Tennessee State. She hit a home run in each game versus TSU. She hit a three-run shot in the first inning of the series finale against the Tigers. She drove in eight and scored three times last week. Tackett also recorded a 1.188 slugging percentage.

Kayla Ashbrook, SS, Sr., 5'4, Canton, Ohio - Morehead State

Ashbrook led the team to a 4-3 week. She hit three home runs to bring her season total to six. Ashbrook went a perfect 4-for-4 on the base paths to improve her season total to 12-for-12. Ashbrook posted a .852 slugging percentage and a .444 on-base percentage. She homered in the game two win at Miami, had a three-run shot in the first inning of the second game at Butler and had the first Eagle RBI off a solo shot in the first win over JSU.

2013 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (12-21 overall, 3-12 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a trio of games to SIUE last week. Junior **Lauren de Castro** led the team with a .500 batting average over the three games. She also posted a 1.500 slugging percentage last week. Four of her five hits went for extra bases, including three home runs. She drove in seven runs and scored three times. de Castro hit a pair of home runs in the series finale, becoming the third lady Govs to hit two homers in a game. **Courtney Brewer** tied the school's freshman single-season mark for hit by a pitch with seven in 30 plate appearances. With their six home runs over the weekend, the Lady Govs have matched last year's total of 23 in 17 fewer games. Austin Peay will travel to Tennessee Tech for a pair on Tuesday, Belmont for a doubleheader on Saturday and Tennessee State for two on Sunday.

BELMONT (13-25 overall, 3-13 OVC): Belmont dropped a doubleheader to Lipscomb before going 1-2 versus Tennessee Tech. Sophomore **Heather Turner** led the Bruins at the plate with a .500 batting average. In the doubleheader with Lipscomb, she had a double, a home run and an RBI. In the Tech series, Turner went 6-for-11. Junior **Mia Verra** led the Bruin pitching staff, tossing 16.0 innings over the five games. She picked up the win in the first game of the TTU series. Belmont will travel to Western Kentucky for a single game on Tuesday before returning home to host a pair of OVC doubleheaders with Austin Peay on Saturday and Murray State on Sunday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (28-11 overall, 15-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois defeated Illinois and went 2-1 versus Southeast Missouri last week. In the series finale with the Redhawks, the Panthers recorded a season-high 16 hits. Junior **Reyna Hutchinson** recorded five hits last week with three of them going for extra bases. She recorded two doubles and a home run. Junior **Hanna Mennenga** went 3-0 last week in her four appearances. She allowed just one run in each of her appearances. Mennenga struck out 31 over her 21.0 innings of work. Eastern Illinois will host Jacksonville State for two on Saturday and Tennessee Tech for a doubleheader on Sunday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (26-16 overall, 13-4 OVC): Eastern Kentucky dropped a pair of games to No. 18 Kentucky before sweeping Tennessee State in a three-game series. Sophomore **Katie Tackett** in a home run in ever game of the TSU series. She hit a three-run shot in the 5-3 win over TSU in the series finale. She tallied at least two RBI in each game against the Tigers. Sophomore **Leanna Pittsenbarger** went 2-1 with a save last week. She struck out 29 and walked just four in 19.0 innings in the circle. Eastern Kentucky will hit the road for a pair of OVC doubleheaders, traveling to Southeast Missouri on Saturday and UT Martin on Sunday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (24-19 overall, 9-6 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated Alabama State and went 1-2 versus Morehead State last week. **Kelci Johnston** led the team in the three-game series with Morehead State with a .556 batting average. Jacksonville State will travel to Eastern Illinois for a pair on Saturday and SIUE for a twinbill on Sunday.

MOREHEAD STATE (18-17 overall, 4-9 OVC): Morehead State swept a doubleheader with Miami (Ohio), dropped a pair at Butler and went 2-1 versus Jacksonville State last week. **Kayla Ashbrook** led the team with three home runs while hitting .444. She went a perfect 4-for-4 on the base paths. In the doubleheader sweep of Miami (Ohio), senior **Amber Riddle** broke the school career RBI record. Eight Eagles are hitting over .300 and senior Elizabeth Wanger continues to lead the team with a .419 average. Morehead State will travel to Dayton for two on Wednesday, UT Martin for a pair on Saturday and Southeast Missouri for a doubleheader on Sunday.

MURRAY STATE (17-22 overall, 8-8 OVC): Murray State swept a doubleheader with Bethel and went 2-1 against UT Martin. Freshman **Shelbey Miller** hit. 500 over the five games, including going 4-for-5 with a double and a triple in the sweep of Bethel. She finished the week with three doubles and one triple. Sophomore **CheyAnne Gaskey** went 2-0 on the week with a save. She struck out 13 in 14.0 innings of work. She allowed just one run and held opponents to a .184 batting average. Murray State will host Tennessee State for a doubleheader on Saturday before traveling to Belmont for a pair on Sunday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (12-25 overall, 4-11 OVC): Southeast Missouri went 1-2 versus Eastern Illinois last week. Junior **Alexis Anderson** hit .556 for the series with two home runs, two RBI and two runs scored. Freshman **Hannah Clemons** pitched her first career complete game in the 4-1 over Eastern Illinois. The Redhawks will host Eastern Kentucky for two on Saturday and Morehead State for a doubleheader on Sunday.

SIUE (31-8 overall, 14-2 OVC): SIUE defeated Bradley and swept a three-game series from Austin Peay to extend its winning streak to 14. Only Michigan (17) and Tennessee (15) have more consecutive victories. Sophomore **Alex McDavid** hit her second grand slam of the season in the first game of the APSU series. She finished the week with a .467 batting average, two home runs, four runs scored and eight RBI. Freshman pitcher **Haley Chambers** extended her winning streak to 14 after going 2-0 last week. She did not give up a walk while striking out 13 in 12.0 innings of work. **Brittney Toney** went 4-for-4 in the Austin Peay series finale to become the first SIUE player this season to have four hits twice in a game. SIUE will travel to Evansville on Thursday before hosting Tennessee Tech for a doubleheader on Saturday and Jacksonville State for two on Sunday.

TENNESSEE STATE (11-30 overall, 2-13 OVC): Tennessee State dropped a trio of games to Eastern Kentucky last week. Freshman **Lindsey Burgess** hit her first collegiate home run during the opening the game of the series. Freshman **Audrey Sensing** recorded a two-run single in the finale giving her 23 RBI on the season. Sensing enters the TSU single season record book and is currently tied for sixth. Tennessee State will travel to Murray State for a pair on Saturday

TENNESSEE TECH (18-19 overall, 7-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech fell to No. 3 Tennessee and went 2-1 against Belmont. Sophomore Hannah Eldridge hit .462 over the four games, including collecting a pair of hits versus Tennessee. She had three hits in the finale of the Belmont series. She drove in six runs last week. Tennessee Tech will host Austin Peay for a doubleheader on Tuesday and Chattanooga for a single game on Wednesday before traveling to SIUE for a pair on Saturday and Eastern Illinois for two on Sunday.

UT MARTIN (29-13 overall, 10-6 OVC): UT Martin defeated Southern Illinois and went 1-2 versus Murray State last week. Junior **Kayla Wade** hit for the weekly cycle, registering a single, double, triple and home run over the four games. She recorded her league-leading seventh triple on the season to move her into second on the school's all-time list. Sophomore **Casey Vincent** registered a shutout against Murray State. She struck out 15 in a team-leading 19.0 innings of work. Head coach Donley Canary is one win away for 400 in his career. The Skyhawks will host Middle Tennessee for a single game on Tuesday, Morehead State for a pair of games on Saturday and Eastern Kentucky for a doubleheader on Sunday.
