Rebecca Gray, LF, So., 5'6, Crete, Ill. - SIUE

Gray hit .700 as the Cougars went 3-1 last week. She recorded seven hits, four of which went for extra bases. Gray posted a 1.300 slugging percentage and a .727 on-base percentage. She hit her first home run of the season in the first win over Tennessee Tech. She had three-hits and two RBI in the 10-0 win over Jacksonville State. She has moved to second on the team with a .370 batting average and is hitting .451 in OVC games.

Haley Chambers, P, Fr., 5'7, Coatesville, Ind. - SIUE

Chambers tossed a perfect game in the opener versus Jacksonville State, needing just 58 pitches for the victory. It was the fifth perfect game in school history. She recorded a pair of shutouts for the weekend against JSU and Tennessee Tech. She struck out 22 batters and gave up just one earned run in 15.0 innings of work. Opponents hit .132 against her last week.

Shea Morris, P, So., Lawrenceburg, Tenn. - Tennessee State

Morris earned all three of Tennessee State wins last week. She just missed her first career no-hitter in the opening game against Austin Peay, striking out 11 and walking none. In the second game with APSU, Morris fanned seven batters to earn the shutout victory. She recorded 27 strikeouts in 21.0 innings in the circle. Morris held opponents to a .176 batting average.

2013 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (15-24 overall, 6-15 OVC): Austin Peay split a pair of games with Tennessee Tech, swept a doubleheader with Belmont and dropped two to Tennessee State last week. Junior **Lauren de Castro** led the team in batting average (.429) and slugging percentage (.857). She recorded nine hits over the six games, five of which went for extra bases. de Castro hit two home runs and three doubles while also driving in seven runs. She became just the fourth player in school history to record at least 20 home runs in a career. The Lady Govs turned the second triple play in school history in the first game against Belmont. With its extra-inning win over the Bruins, Austin Peay is now 4-1 this season in extra inning games. The Lady Govs will host Southeast Missouri for a three-game series this weekend.

BELMONT (14-29 overall, 4-16 OVC): Belmont fell to Western Kentucky, dropped a pair to Austin Peay and split a doubleheader with Murray State last week. Sophomore **Kat Hollingsworth** led the Bruins at the plate, batting .500 and recording eight hits. She hit a two-run walk-off home run in the night cap against Murray State. Hollingsworth now has 10 home runs on the season. Junior **Mia Vierra** went 1-1 in the circle last week for the Bruins, pitching 15.0 innings and walking just one. The Bruins played in their fourth extra inning game of the season against Austin Peay. Belmont will travel to Morehead State for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (32-11 overall, 19-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois swept doubleheaders with Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech last week to remain a perfect 12-0 at home this season. The Panthers have now won 25 of their last 28 games. Junior **Carly Willert** hit .385 with five hits last week, four of which were for extra bases. She recorded a pair of doubles and two triples while driving in five. Junior pitcher **Hanna Mennenga** gave up just two earned runs and struck out 28 in 14.0 innings of work. She fanned 16 batters to tie a career-high and break the school's single-season strikeout record in the first win over Jacksonville State. Eastern Illinois will travel to IUPUI for a pair of games on Wednesday before heading to UT Martin for a three-game series this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (29-17 overall, 16-5 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a twinbill with Southeast Missouri and took two at UT Martin. The Colonels are now 10-1 in OVC road games this year. Senior **Raquel Howes** recorded two doubles, two home runs and drove in seven runs over the four games. She also scored three times. Sophomore pitcher **Leanna Pittsenbarger** tossed her 12th complete game of the season in the 4-1 win over the Skyhawks. EKU has scored at least four runs in eight straight OVC games. Eastern Kentucky will host Northern Kentucky for a doubleheader on Tuesday before traveling to Jacksonville State for a three-game series this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (25-22 overall, 10-9 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a pair at Eastern Illinois and split a doubleheader with SIUE last week. **Tiffany Harbin** became the school's all-time strikeout leader in the opening game with EIU. Jacksonville State will travel to Middle Tennessee on Thursday before returning home to host Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (20-19 overall, 6-11 OVC): Morehead State split doubleheaders with UT Martin and Southeast Missouri last week. Senior **Katie Pfost** and Junior **Kelcey McMurray** each picked up wins in the circle. Both Eagle catchers, juniors **Jamie Massaro** and **McKenna Bartko**, hit their first home runs of the year. Bartko's home run started a four-run rally in the seventh of the Eagles' come-from-behind win at Southeast Missouri. The Eagles will host Tennessee Tech for a pair of games on Wednesday and welcome Belmont for a three-game series this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (19-24 overall, 10-10 OVC): Murray State split a pair of doubleheaders with Tennessee State and Belmont last week. The Racers outscored their opponents 16-11 over the four games. **Christian Cox** and **Alex Becker** each drove in a team-leading three runs last week. Murray State will host St. Catharine for a doubleheader on Wednesday before traveling to SIUE for a three-game series this weekend.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (14-27 overall, 6-13 OVC): Southeast Missouri split doubleheaders with Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State last week. Junior **Alexis Anderson** led the Redhawks with a .563 batting average. She recorded one double, four RBI and six runs scored while also stealing a base. She had at least two hits and one run in each contest. Southeast Missouri will host Southern Illinois on Thursday before traveling to Austin Peay for a three-game series this weekend.

SIUE (34-9 overall, 17-3 OVC): SIUE swept a doubleheader with Tennessee Tech and split a twinbill with Jacksonville State last week. Freshman **Haley Chambers** became the fifth player in school history to toss a perfect game as she picked up the victory against Jacksonville State. For the week, she gave up just one earned run and struck out 22 in 15.0 innings of work. Sophomore **Rebecca Gray** hit .700 for the weekend. Four of her seven hits were for extra bases, including one home run and three doubles. **Alex McDavid** became the first Cougar in the Division I era to record double-digits in home runs. She hit her 10th versus JSU. **Taylor Tooley** hit a walk-off home run against Jacksonville State to become just the fourth player in school history to hit 20 homers in her career. SIUE will travel to Saint Louis on Wednesday before returning home to host Murray State for a three-game series this weekend.

TENNESSEE STATE (14-31 overall, 5-14 OVC): Tennessee State split a doubleheader with Murray State and took two from Austin Peay last week. The doubleheader sweep of Austin Peay recorded just the second series sweep for the Tigers at home in program history. Freshman **Kiarra Freeman** recorded a hit in every game over the weekend to hit .643. She scored twice and drove in a run while going 3-for-4 on the base paths. Sophomore **Shea Morris** went 3-0 in the circle, picking up a pair of shutouts. She struck out 27 in 21.0 innings of work while walking just one. Tennessee State will host Tennessee Tech for a three-game series this weekend.

TENNESSEE TECH (19-25 overall, 8-10 OVC): Tennessee Tech split a doubleheader with Austin Peay, fell to Chattanooga, dropped a pair to SIUE and got swept in a doubleheader with Eastern Illinois last week. **Melody Christian** led the team with a .350 batting average and seven hits over the seven games. **Erica Tuck** did not allow an earned run in three appearances in the circle. The Golden Eagles will travel to Morehead State for a twinbill on Wednesday before heading to Tennessee State for a three-game series this weekend.

UT MARTIN (30-16 overall, 11-9 OVC): UT Martin split a doubleheader with Murray State and dropped a pair two Eastern Kentucky. With the win over the Eagles, head coach **Donley Canary** recorded his 400th career victory to rank fourth on the OVC active coaching list. Senior **Becca Williams** led the team with a .417 batting average. She drove in three runs with a bases clearing double against Morehead State to tied the game at 3-3. **Autumn Glenn** and **Casey Vincent** each hit .400 on the week, picking up two hits each in five at-bats. **Kenzi Tate** tied the team-high with her 10th home run of the season against Eastern Kentucky. Freshman **Deven Wilson** hit her first career home run to beat Morehead State. The Skyhawks will host Memphis on Wednesday and Eastern Illinois for a three-game series this weekend.
