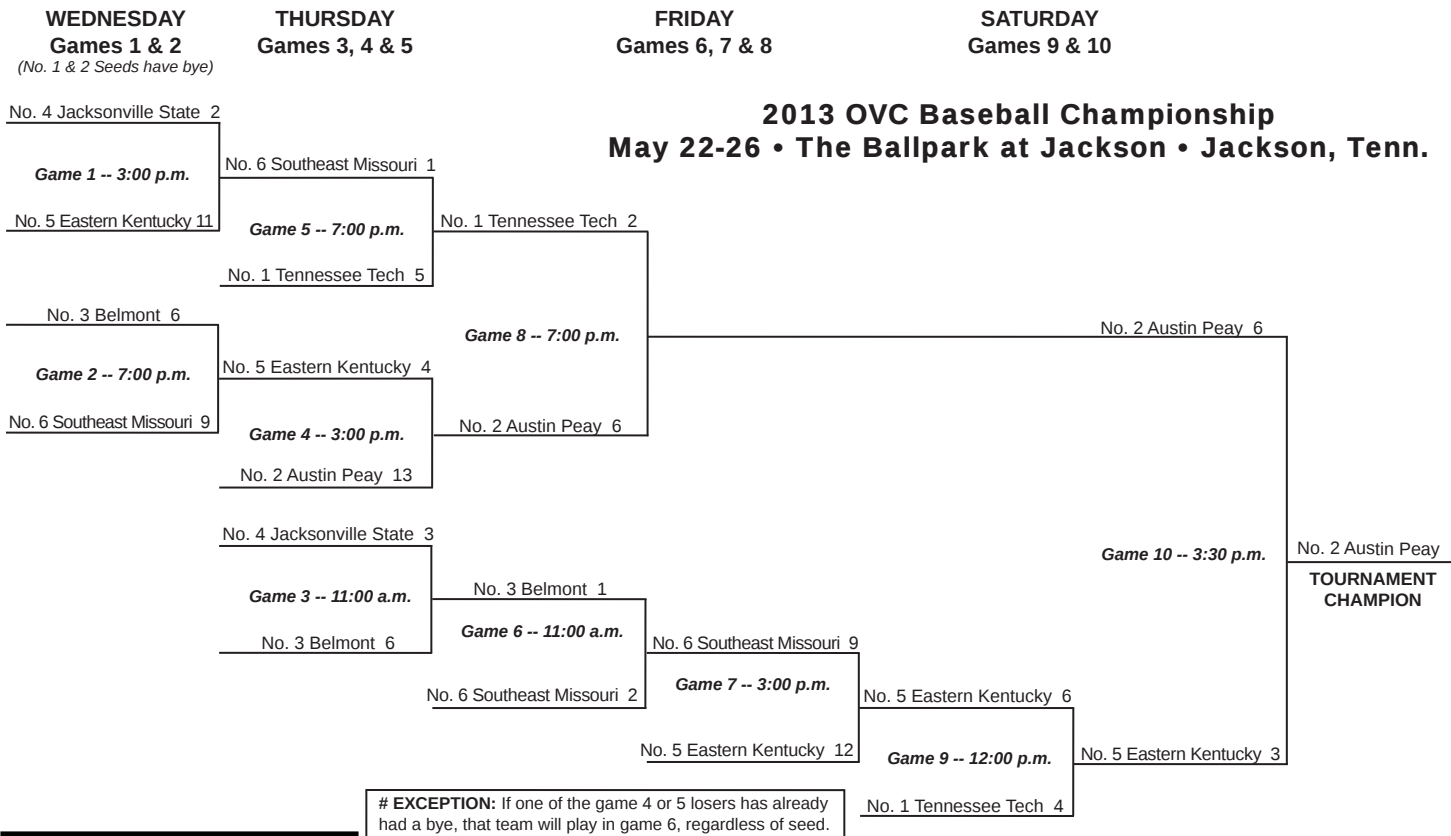

All-Time OVC Record: 24-70

AUSTIN PEAY NOTES

"Three-Peay": Austin Peay captured its third-straight OVC Baseball Tournament Championship last week, marking the first time since 1990-92 that an OVC team had won three-straight titles (Middle Tennessee). The Govs have also won OVC Tournament Championships in 1996, 2005, 2007, 2011 and 2012.

Austin Peay Back in the NCAA Tournament: Austin Peay is back in the NCAA Tournament for the third-straight year. The No. 2 seed in the OVC Tournament, the Governors swept through the competition to win the event (APSU also swept through the tournament in 2011). Overall Austin Peay has won 10 of its last 11 OVC Tournament games (losing only its first OVC Tournament game to Southeast Missouri in 2012). The NCAA Tournament appearance is the sixth all-time for Austin Peay who also appeared in the NCAAs in 1996, 2005, 2007, 2011 and 2012. Last year was narrowly edged by Oregon (6-5) before bouncing back to eliminate both Indiana State and Cal State Fullerton. The Govs then lost to host Oregon 8-1 in the Regional Championship Round. In 2011 the team topped host Georgia Tech in the first game of the Atlanta Regional before falling to Mississippi State and losing the rematch to Georgia Tech to be eliminated. In 2007 the Governors nearly upset No. 1 overall national seed Vanderbilt and David Price, taking the Commodores to extra innings before losing 2-1 on an unearned run in the bottom of the 11th. APSU is 4-10 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

Recent OVC Success in NCAA Play: Despite not winning a NCAA Regional, OVC teams have been competitive in NCAA Regional play, winning at least one game in four of the last six years.

Winning Streak: Austin Peay enters the NCAA Tournament having won 15 games in a row and 19th of its last 20 overall. The 15-game winning streak is the longest in Division I.

Austin Peay Up to 25th in NCBWA Poll; 21st in USA Today Poll: Austin Peay entered the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Top 30 poll on May 13 at No. 30 and moved up to No. 26 the next week. The team enters the NCAA Tournament No. 25 in that poll (May 27). On May 27 the team also debuted in the USA Today Coaches Poll at No. 21. The Governors are the first OVC team to be ranked since the 2009 season. That year Eastern Illinois was ranked No. 27 in the Collegiate Baseball newspaper poll on April 6 and No. 29 on April 13 before falling out.

40 Victories: Austin Peay reached the 40-win plateau for the second-straight season and enters the NCAA Tournament with a school record 45 victories. Tennessee Tech also finished the year with 40 victories marking just the second time in OVC history the league had two teams win 40 or more games in the same season (Middle Tennessee and Eastern Kentucky each won 42 games in 1990). The OVC record for victories in a season is 47 by Western Kentucky in 1980.

Triple Crown Contention: For the second-straight season a player came up just short in trying to win the first Triple Crown in the OVC since 1982. Austin Peay junior first baseman **Craig Massoni** entered the final week of the regular season leading the OVC in batting average and tied for the Conference lead in home runs and RBI. Entering NCAA Tournament play Massoni is still first in the OVC in batting (.388, first in home runs (16) and currently ranks second in RBI (68 - three behind TTU's Zach Stephens). Massoni will have a chance in the postseason to win the award. No OVC player has achieved the feat since Western Kentucky's Ralph Antone achieved the honor in 1982. Antone's crown in 1982 actually marked the third time in four years that an OVC player won the award (Morehead State's Jody Hamilton achieved the feat in 1979 and WKU's Mike Williams did in 1980) but the league has now gone the past 30 years without a player leading the league in batting average, home runs and RBI in the same season.

Rogers Sets OVC Single-Season and Career Saves Record; Two Saves Away From Tying NCAA Record: Austin Peay senior closer **Tyler Rogers**, who currently leads Division I with 21 saves this season, set the new OVC single-season saves record by recording his 16th save on April 24 against Evansville. It broke the record of 15 set by Jacksonville State's Todd Hornsby in 2011. He broke the OVC career record of 32 (also held by Hornsby) with his 33rd save in May 25's OVC Tournament Championship victory over Eastern Kentucky. Rogers is now just two saves away from tying the NCAA single-season record of 23 set by USC's Jack Krawczyk in 1998. Below are the top single season saves outputs in NCAA history.

Harper Named OVC Tournament MVP; Ties OVC Career Games Started Record, One Away From Games Played Mark: Senior shortstop **Reed Harper** was named MVP of the OVC Tournament after his performance in three games in leading the Governors to the OVC Championship. Harper hit .462 (6-for-13) with two runs scored, a home run and seven RBI while not committing an error in the field in 13 chances. His three-run home run in the bottom of the first in the Championship Game against Eastern Kentucky tied the contest and led to the team's 6-3 win. In that Championship Game Harper tied the OVC record for games started (233) and is just one away from the career games played record (234); both of those records are held by Jacksonville State's Bert Smith (2006-10).

McClure Sets OVC All-Time Coaching Victories Record: Austin Peay head coach **Gary McClure**, now in his 26th year at his alma mater, set the OVC career victories record when he recorded his 777th victory with a 7-3 win over Tennessee Tech on April 5. He broke the previous record of 776 held by Murray State's Johnny Reagan (1958-93). Last season McClure began the first coach in OVC history to reach 300 Conference victories in a career. McClure now has 797 wins.

Austin Peay Among National Leaders: Among the most recent set of NCAA statistical leaders, Austin Peay ranks ninth nationally in batting average (.315), 11th in slugging (.458), 16th in on-base percentage (.402) and home runs (51), 18th in walks (261) and 20th in scoring (6.9 runs/game). Individually junior Craig Massoni is seventh in home runs (16) and RBI (68), eighth in total bases (153), ninth in slugging (.683) and 20th in batting average (.388). Junior Jordan Hankins is eighth in runs (66) while Cody Hudson is 14th in stolen bases (30). Closer Tyler Rogers leads Division I in saves (21).
