THIS WEEK'S adidas® OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



PLAYER

Patrick Miller, G • Sr., 6-1, 195 • Chicago, Ill. • Tennessee State

Miller averaged 29.5 points, 4.5 assists, 2.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals/game while hitting 46.2 percent (18-of-39) from the field and 94.7 percent (18-of-19) at the free throw line in a pair of games. He started the week by scoring 22 points and dishing out two assists in a non-conference game with Middle Tennessee. In that contest the senior had a highlight-reel dunk over a MTSU player which ended up featured on several national highlight shows. He capped the week by scoring a career-high 37 points, the second-most points by an OVC player in a game this season, at Southeast Missouri. Miller hit 12-of-21 field goals and 11-of-12 free throws, dished out seven assists, pulled down four rebounds and had three steals in 37 minutes of action. Miller leads the OVC in scoring (21.8 points/game) and is sixth in each assists (4.3/game) and steals (1.8/game).

NEWCOMER

Jarvis Williams, F • Jr., 6-8, 210 • Macon, Ga. • Murray State

Williams earned OVC Newcomer of the Week honors for the second-straight week after averaging 16.5 points, 8.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks/game and hitting 75 percent (15-of-20) from the field in two Murray State victories. The transfer from Gordon State College started the week with his seventh double-double of the season at Eastern Kentucky, hitting 9-of-9 field goal attempts on his way to 19 points and also pulling down 11 rebounds. He capped the week with 14 points, five rebounds and two blocks in a victory over Austin Peay. Williams currently ranks second in the OVC in rebounding (10.5/game), third in blocks (1.6/game), fifth in field goal percentage (61.4%) and 11th in scoring (14.1 points/game).

FRESHMAN

Cameron Payne, G • Fr., 6-2, 175 • Bartlett, Tenn. • Murray State

Payne averaged 17.0 points, 6.5 assists, 6.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.5 blocks/game last week as Murray State won at Eastern Kentucky and at home against Austin Peay. Payne opened the week with 19 points, seven rebounds, five assists, three steals and three blocks as the Racers topped the Colonels 77-64; it marked the first road win of the year for Murray State and just the second home loss for EKU over the past two seasons. He closed the week with 15 points, a season-high eight assists, five rebounds and two steals in the 89-67 win over APSU. Payne currently ranks fourth in the OVC in assists (5.6/game), fifth in 3-pointers made (2.1/game), ninth in scoring (15.0 points/game) and ninth in steals (1.6/game). In Conference-only games Payne is third in the league in scoring (21.0 points/game). It marks the fourth time this season Payne has been named Freshman of the Week.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Following two full weeks of OVC play, Belmont and Murray State are both 4-0 in OVC play and currently on top of their respective divisions; those two teams claimed the East and West Division last year in the OVC's first season of divisional play...UT Martin (0-4) is currently the only OVC team without a Conference victory...The OVC has four players ranked in the Top 18 nationally in rebounds/game; no other conference nationally has more than two in the Top 18...Southeast Missouri senior point guard Lucas Nutt entered the OVC's career Top 10 assists list last week...Tennessee State senior guard Patrick Miller, who is approaching the career Top 10 assists list, scored a career-high 37 points in a game last week; the 37 points was the second-most by an OVC player this season...This week's games includes the first ESPN game of the league's television package, as Belmont plays at Eastern Kentucky on Thursday.

Nutt Enters OVC Career Assists Top 10: Southeast Missouri senior guard **Lucas Nutt** now ranks 10th in OVC career assists with 515 helpers in his career. Nutt needs 16 assists to move into ninth place and at his current pace he figures to finish his career sixth in OVC history. Tennessee State senior **Patrick Miller** is also nearing in on the Top 10 list, and is 41 assists behind Nutt.

Cosey Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record: Eastern Kentucky senior **Glenn Cosey** tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made against Eastern Illinois on January 2. Cosey made 10-of-12 3-point attempts on his way to 34 points. The 10 made 3-pointers tied the record also held by EIU's Marc Polite (set in the 1999-00 season against Arkansas State). The 10 made 3-pointers are the second most by a Division I player this season (Georgia State's R.J. Hunter had 12 on Dec. 22).

Rebounding: The OVC currently features four of the top 18 rebounders in Division I basketball as Morehead State's **Chad Posthumus** ranks second (12.2/game), Murray State's **Jarvis Williams** is 11th (10.5/game), Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is 14th (10.0/game) and Tennessee State's **M.J. Rhett** is 18th (9.8/game). The OVC is the only Conference with four players in the Top 18 nationally (no other conference has three players; three other leagues have two players in the Top 18).

OVC in the NCAA Statistical Rankings: In the latest NCAA statistical rankings (Jan. 13), Eastern Kentucky ranked second nationally in turnover margin (+7.1/game), seventh in steals (9.8/game), eighth in 3-pointers made/game (9.4), 18th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.49) and 19th in fewest turnovers/game (10.1). Morehead State ranks 14th in rebounding margin (+8.6/game) and 18th in steals (9.8/game). Belmont is fifth in field goal percentage (50.6%), 10th in 3-pointers made/game (9.0), 26th in 3-point percentage (40.3%) and 27th in assists (15.9/game). Southeast Missouri is 13th in field goal percentage (49.2%), 15th in scoring offense (83.9 points/game) and 24th in assists (16.1/game). Individually Morehead State's **Chad Posthumus** is second in rebounding (12.2/game) and fifth in double-doubles (9) while Murray State's **Jarvis Williams** is 11th in rebounding (10.5/game). Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is 11th in double-doubles (8), 14th in rebounding (10.2/game), 17th in blocked shots (3.18/game) and 21st in field goal percentage (59.1%). Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller** is ninth in minutes played/game (37:16/game) and 11th in scoring (21.8/game) while Southeast Missouri's **Jarekious Bradley** is 13th in scoring (21.7/game). Eastern Kentucky's **Glenn Cosey** is 15th in 3-pointers made/game (3.29) while TSU's **M.J. Rhett** is fifth in double-doubles (9) and 18th in rebounding (9.8/game).

Kelly Nets 40 Points, 1 of 5 40-Plus Point Efforts by an OVC Player In Last Decade: When Morehead State senior **Drew Kelly** scored 40 points on Dec. 19 against South Dakota, it was one of just five 40-plus point efforts by an OVC player over the last decade (back through the 2004-05 season). It was the most points by a Morehead State player since Ricky Minard scored 43 in the 2002-03 season. Below is a listing of 40-plus point games over the last 10 years.

Wins Over Top 25 Teams By OVC Teams: Belmont's win over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17 was the first for an OVC team in non-conference play since Murray State (ranked No. 14 at the time) beat No. 16 Saint Mary's at home on Feb. 18, 2012. It was the first road victory over a Top 25 team since the Racers topped No. 20 Memphis 76-72 on Dec. 11, 2011. The last time an OVC team beat an opponent ranked 11th or higher was in 1987 when Austin Peay bested No. 11 Illinois in the NCAA Tournament. CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll: In the January 6 CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll (the Jan. 13 poll was not yet available), Eastern Kentucky is now 20th while Belmont was ranked 25th. Morehead State is among the other schools receiving votes. Wichita State picked up 31 first-place votes to be ranked No. 1. Now in its 15th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer is the OVC representative).

Eastern Kentucky Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record: Eastern Kentucky tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made in a game with 20 against Warren Wilson College on Nov. 13. The Colonels were 20-of-39 (51.3%) from 3-point range in the 114-45 victory and tied the record set by Southeast Missouri State a season ago.

2014 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 5-8 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6:30 and 9 p.m. and televised on ESPN2. The championship game on Saturday, March 8 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 8 at 1:00 p.m. CT (ESPN3).

This marks the 20th time in 21 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fifth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 3 at 1 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



Mann Named National Player of the Week by CBSSports.com NBCSports.com (Nov. 18): Belmont senior **J.J. Mann** was named National Player of the Week by both CBSSports.com and NBCSports.com after leading the Bruins to a 83-80 victory over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17. Mann scored a career-high 28 points, including three 3-pointers in the final 1:02 as Belmont topped its first Top 25 team since December 2003. Mann scored 11 of Belmont's final 13 points as the team overcame an eight-point deficit with 2:37 to play. He also scored 23 points in a come-from-behind victory over Indiana State earlier in the week. For the week Mann averaged 18.3 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.7 steals/game.

Two OVC Players Named Candidates for Senior CLASS Award: Two OVC men's basketball student-athletes have been named candidates for the 2013-14 Senior CLASS Award. The two players are among 30 male candidates nationally considered for the award (UT Martin's Heather Butler is one of 30 female candidates for the award as well). The OVC selections were Belmont guard **J.J. Mann** and Tennessee Tech forward **Dennis Ogbe**. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The Senior CLASS Award winners will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Men's Final Four® and NCAA Women's Final Four®. Each of the 30 candidate classes will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one male candidate and one female candidate who best exemplify excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

Two OVC Players Announced as Nominees for Allstate NABC Good Works Team: Eastern Kentucky's **Deverin Muff** and Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller** have been announced as nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The award recognizes a select group of college basketball student-athletes who have made significant contributions to the greater good of their communities through volunteerism and civic service. The pair are two of 117 men's nominees from which two 10-member teams will be selected later this year.

OVC Enters Season Having Won a Game in Four of Past Five NCAA Tournaments: Despite not winning a game in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, the OVC has won a NCAA Tournament game in four of the past five years. The four-year winning streak came to an end last season, as the OVC had been one of just nine conferences (3 non-BCS) to win a game from 2009-12.

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2014 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 5-8). It marks the fourth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the ninth time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 8th Among Active NCAA Coaches: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 24th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 379 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 461 for his career (which ranks him 28th among Division I head coaches). Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** (who is in his second year in the OVC) has 675 career victories, which ranks eighth among active Division I head coaches (who recently passed John Wooden's 669 wins on the all-time list). Loos and Byrd are two of just seven active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boeheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe, Coppin State's Fang Mitchell and Davidson's Bob McKillop).

Former OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the 2013-14 season there are four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his third season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and was the MVP of the Rising Stars Game in 2013. The other three players are all rookies this season, including former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan**, former Belmont All-American **Ian Clark** and former Tennessee State standout **Robert Covington**. Canaan and Covington are teammates with the Houston Rockets (Canaan was drafted in the second round while Covington signed a free agent deal) while Clark signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz. Covington is currently playing with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers of the NBDL, making him one of three total OVC players in that league. The others are Jacksonville State's **Nick Murphy** (Tulsa 66ers) and TSU's **Kellen Thornton** (Idaho Stampede).

The 2013-14 Season: The 2013-14 season marks the 66th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 65 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Southeast Missouri's Stone Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2013-14 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Southeast Missouri State senior **Tyler Stone**, who was named the Preseason Player of the Year. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Southeast Missouri having two selections apiece while Belmont, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and UT Martin had one selection each to round out the team. The squad features two players who were All-OVC first or second-team selections last season and three players who were selected to the All-Newcomer squad. The team is comprised of seven seniors and three juniors. Last season Stone ranked eighth in the OVC in scoring (15.5 points/game), fifth in rebounding (7.8/game) and blocked shots (1.3/game) and 12th in field goal percentage (49.2%) while leading Southeast Missouri to a winning overall

Other selections to the Preseason All-OVC team were Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller**, Austin Peay's **Travis Betran** and **Will Triggs**, Eastern Kentucky's **Glenn Cosey** and **Corey Walden**, Belmont's **J.J. Mann**, Southeast Missouri's **Nino Johnson**, UT Martin's **Myles Taylor** and Jacksonville State's **Brian Williams**.

Eastern Kentucky, Southeast Missouri, Murray State Picked as OVC Preseason Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Eastern Kentucky has been picked the favorites in the East Division while Murray State and Southeast Missouri State were tabbed co-favorites in the West Division in the OVC for 2013-14. Eastern Kentucky picked up 18 of a possible 24 first-place votes (schools were not allowed to vote for themselves) and a total of 128 points to lead all vote getting. The Colonels were followed in the East by defending OVC champion Belmont, who picked up the remaining six first-place votes and 116 total points. The East Division voting was rounded out by Morehead State (74 points), Jacksonville State (72), Tennessee State (60) and Tennessee Tech (42). The top of the West Division was shared by Southeast Missouri and defending West Champions Murray State. The Redhawks received 13 first-place votes while the Racers picked up the remaining 11 to both finish with 117 total points. The West was rounded out by Austin Peay (90 points), UT Martin (66), Eastern Illinois (58) and SIUE (44).

Team Notes

Austin Peay saw its three-game winning streak come to an end with an 89-67 loss at Murray State in its lone game of last week...It marked APSU's sixth-straight loss to its biggest rival...Off the bench sophomore transfer Zavion Williams had 16 points, seven assists and four rebounds in the MSU contest...Despite being limited to just 15 minutes due to foul trouble, sophomore Chris Horton had seven rebounds and blocked three shots; Horton has been the team's top rebounder to co-leading rebounder in all 17 games this season...Horton ranks 14th nationally in rebounding (10.0/game), 17th in blocked shots (3.18/game) and 21st in field goal percentage (59.1%)...Seniors Travis Betran and Will Triggs each had 17 points to share the team lead...Triggs now has 973 career points and is likely the next OVC player to reach the 1,000-Point Club (which currently contains six OVC players)...Betran has now scored in double figures in his last four games, hitting 16 3-pointers over that stretch...APSU out-rebounded MSU 39-38 but was outshot 47.6 to 44.3 percent from the field and is now 0-6 on the season when its opponent shoots a higher percentage...The Gobs lead the OVC in field goal defense (44.2%) and blocks (5.7/game)...Austin Peay will play a pair of road games this week, playing at SIUE on Thursday and at Eastern Illinois on Saturday...The Governors are just 1-6 on the road this season, with that lone victory coming at Youngstown State on Nov. 30.

Belmont won a pair of road games last week, topping Southeast Missouri 107-94 in a high-scoring affair before winning 87-72 at UT Martin...With the two wins the Bruins improved to 4-0 in OVC play, first place in the East Division and now one of two teams perfect in league play (Murray State is the other)...In the SMO contest the Bruins hit 17-of-26 (65.4%) 3-point attempts and 63.3 percent (38-of-60) from the field...J.J. 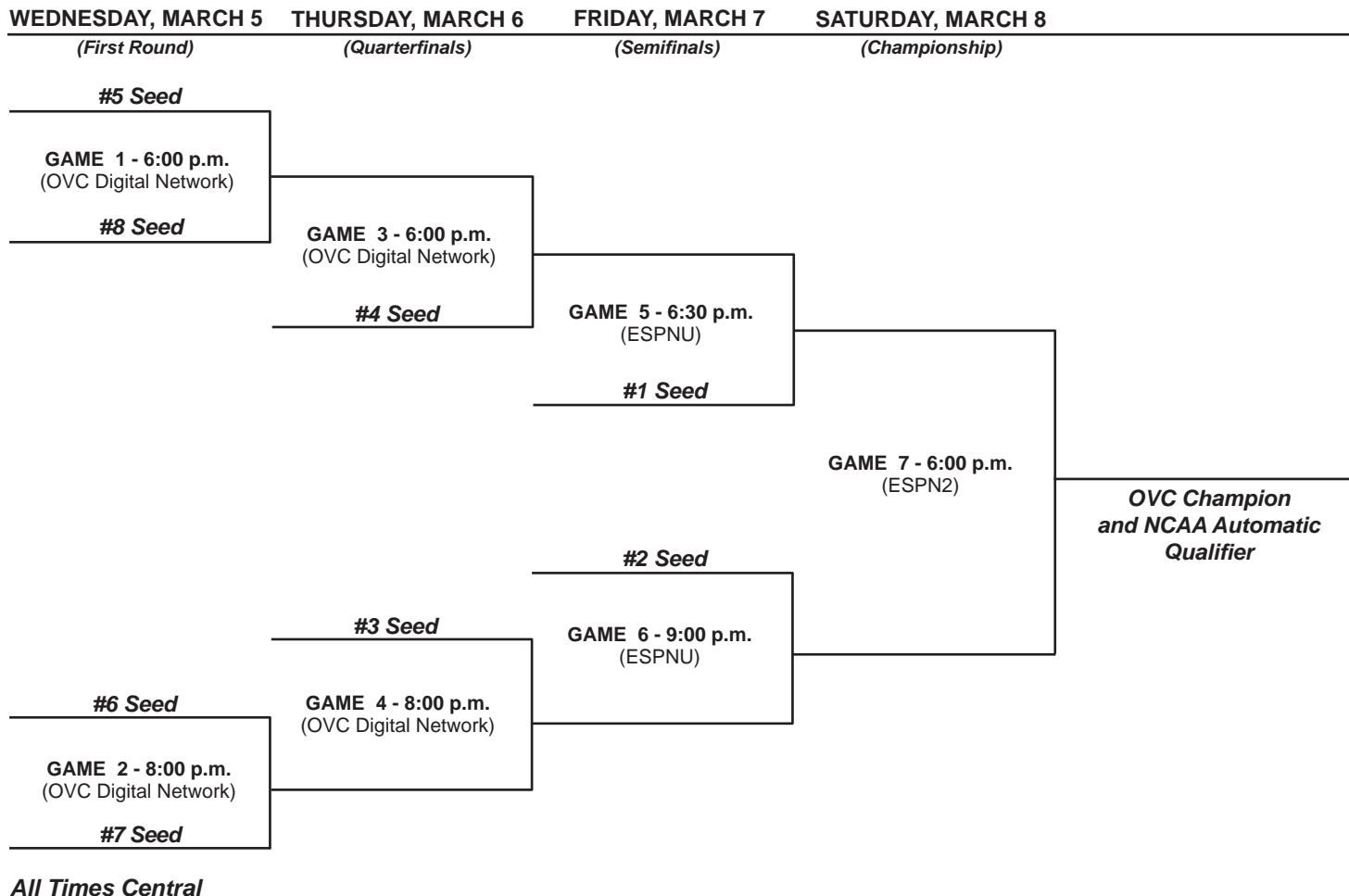
