Mills hit 67 percent of her shots versus Jacksonville State and was perfect from the stripe en route to matching her career best of 11 points for a second straight game.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Let the Season Begin: The 2013-14 campaign kicks off with a pair of exhibition games on Nov. 1 as Morehead State hosts Kentucky Christian and Tennessee State welcomes Tennessee Temple. The regular-season begins on Nov. 8 with Conference play starting on Dec. 28.

New Faces: Three Ohio Valley Conference women's basketball teams will be under new direction this year as Belmont, Eastern Illinois and Jacksonville State will all welcome new coaches this season. Cameron Newbauer comes to Belmont after spending last season as an assistant at Louisville. While at Louisville, Newbauer helped lead the Cardinals to the National Championship game. Debbie Black takes over the reigns at Eastern Illinois after eight seasons as an assistant at Ohio State. She was part of a Buckeye program that won six Big Ten championships and made seven trips to the NCAA Tournament. Black is also a former WNBA All-Star. Rick Pietri comes to Jacksonville State after a 13-year stint at South Alabama. He led the Lady Jaguars to back-to-back Sun Belt championships in 2003 and 2004.

2012-13 in Review: Last season saw 12 teams competing in women's basketball for the first time resulting in divisional play. The 12 teams were broken into two divisions (West: Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri, SIUE and UT Martin. East: Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech). Tennessee Tech was picked to win the East while UT Martin was selected to win the West. The coaches' and sport information directors' prediction held true for Tech but it was Eastern Illinois who won the West. The Panthers and Golden Eagles shared the regular-season title. It marked the second title for EIU while it was the 18th for Tech. Eastern Illinois claimed the No. 1 seed in the OVC Tourney while Tennessee Tech earned the No. 2 seed. The Panthers and Golden Eagles both earned double-byes to the semifinals. Also earning tournament berths were Belmont, UT Martin, Eastern Kentucky, SIUE, Tennessee State and Murray State. Belmont and UT Martin each made it to the semifinals where the Bruins fell to Tennessee Tech and the Skyhawks defeated top-seeded Eastern Illinois. Tennessee Tech and UT Martin met for the third straight year in the championship game with Skyhawks defeating the Golden Eagles to win its third consecutive tournament title. UT Martin also earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament. Along with UTM, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Belmont also earned postseason spots. EIU was the league's automatic bid to the WNIT while Eastern Kentucky and Belmont played in the WBI. UT Martin fell to Notre Dame in the first round of the NCAA tourney while Eastern Illinois defeated Missouri to advance to the second round of the WNIT. The Panthers would fall to Illinois to end its postseason run. Eastern Kentucky and Belmont both lost in the first round of the WBI. It marked the second year the OVC had four women's basketball teams in the postseason.

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four which will take place on April 6 and 8. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

UT Martin to Play in the Preseason WNIT: UT Martin will participate in the Preseason Women's National Invitational Tournament. The Skyhawks will host Georgia State on Nov. 8 for first round action. The Preseason WNIT features a three-game guarantee format. The event opens Nov. 8 with first-round games. Second-round games will be played Nov. 10 and 11 and sites will be announced following the first-round results; semifinals will be Nov. 14; and the championship is set for Sunday, Nov. 17. Teams that lose in the first two rounds will play consolation games on the second weekend, Nov. 15-16. All games are hosted by participating schools. Ten of the 16 teams in the preseason WNIT are coming off of NCAA Tournament appearances. The field features Georgia State, Gonzaga, Idaho, IPFW, Louisville, Loyola Chicago, LSU, Mount St. Mary's, North Carolina A&T, Oklahoma, Quinnipiac, Saint Joseph's, Stephen F. Austin, Stetson, UT Martin and Wichita State.

OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 6-9 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7. The championship game on Saturday, March 8. The women's semifinals are set for March 7 and the women's championship game is on March 8.

This marks the 19th time in 20 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fourth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 3 at 1 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).

Austin Peay dropped a trio of games last week to see its losing streak reach nine games. The Lady Govs fell at Ole Miss (99-69) before dropping home games to Southeast Missouri (75-64) and UT Martin (91-81). Sophomore **Jennifer Nwokocha** recorded her first two career double-doubles last week. Against Ole Miss, she had 14 points and 10 rebounds. She finished the week with a 22-point, 10-rebound performance versus UT Martin. Junior **Kristen Stainback** doubled her previous career best with 34 points against the Skyhawks. It was the first 30-point performance for a Lady Govs player since Whitney Hanley tallied 38 against Morehead State in the 2012 OVC Tournament. Freshman **Beth Rates** scored a career-best 14 points against Southeast Missouri. Austin Peay begins a four-game road trip this week as it travels to Murray State on Saturday and Morehead State on Monday.

Belmont went 3-0 last week with wins over Southeast Missouri (81-74), Tennessee Tech (62-53) and Jacksonville State (92-50). The win over JSU marked the first time the Bruins had scored more than 90 points since the 2001-02 season. Junior **Adrienne Tarrence** averaged 11.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 6.7 assists while shooting 61.9 percent from the floor last week. She nearly recorded a triple double versus JSU with nine points, eight rebounds and a career-high nine assists. Junior **Taylor Mills** recorded 10.3 points per outing, including tying a career-high with 11 points versus both Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State. Freshman **Frankie Joubran** scored 26 points and pulled down 27 boards over the three games last week. Belmont will travel to UT Martin on Saturday and host Murray State on Monday.
