Jones averaged 31.0 points as UT Martin went 1-1 last week. She scored 27 points versus Chattanooga before recording a career-high 35 points versus Miami (Ohio). Jones nearly recorded a triple-double with 11 steals and nine rebounds against the RedHawks. It marked her seventh career double-double.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Let the Season Begin: The 2014-15 regular-season begins on Nov. 14 with Conference play starting Jan. 1. Nine different teams have won a regular-season title with Tennessee Tech leading the way with 18.

New Tournament Format: The bracketing for the OVC Women's Basketball Tournament is changing after four years under a merit-based format that gave the top four seeds byes. Beginning with the 2011 OVC Women's Basketball Championship the bracket gave the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds double byes to the semifinals and the No. 3 and No. 4 seeds single byes to the quarterfinals. Beginning this season the bracket will return to a traditional 1/8, 2/7, 3/6, 4/5 format. The recommendation to change to this format also came from the women's basketball coaches group in part to allow for all teams to arrive at the tournament site at the same time and allow for an awards recognition event the day prior to the tournament to celebrate OVC women's basketball and interact with each other. The schedule for the 2015 Women's Basketball Championship will see the No. 1 vs. No. 8 and No. 2 vs. No. 7 seeds playing on Wednesday, with the teams winning those games having an off day on Thursday when the first round games continue with No. 3 vs. No. 6 and No. 4 vs. No. 5 matchups. The semifinals will remain on Friday with the Championship Game still being played on Saturday.

Playing On a New Day: Prior to the 2011-12 season the OVC's women's basketball slate shifted from the traditional Thursday/Saturday schedule (that saw them play back-to-back games with men's teams) to a Saturday/Monday schedule. The change was made in order to give women's basketball teams its own exclusive night of games, help with the development of women's basketball and to grow its fan base. Beginning this season the schedule is changing to a Wednesday/Saturday format. The recommendation came from the women's basketball coaches group who preferred to have Sunday as a true off day and believe that Wednesday will be more fan-friendly than Monday night games. The men's schedule format will remain Thursday/Saturday.

OVC Digital Newtork: This marks the third season of the OVC Digital Network. It launched last year and is a new and improved home for lives streaming of athletic contests involving OVC member institutions. One of the top features of the Network is that all events will be offered free for fans. The events will also feature improved quality with most events streaming in high definition (HD). Fans will also have easier access to the streams, easily accessing them through links at OVCDigitalNetwork.com without any registration being required. The streams will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without any app or software download thanks to the use of HTML5 technology. The portal also includes live stats and social media integration to give fans even more interaction. The streaming efforts will concentrate on football and men's and women's basketball in the first year, with all home non-conference and conference contests featuring OVC schools in those sports airing on the platform.

2013-14 In Review: UT Martin won its third OVC regular-season title and its fourth straight league tournament title. The Skyhawks defeated No. 2 Belmont, 78-60, in the championship game. Both UT Martin and Belmont earned post season bids as the Bruins were the league's automatic bid in the WNIT and the Skyhawks played in the NCAA Tournament. The Skyhawks nearly knocked off North Carolina as they fell 60-58 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The Bruins dropped a 48-47 game to Indiana in the first round of the WNIT. In his first year at the helm at Jacksonville State, Rick Pietri was named the OVC Coach of the Year. He led the Gamecocks to a 14-18 overall mark and an 8-8 OVC record in 2013-14 after JSU recorded just one win in 2012-13. UT Martin's Heather Butler earned the OVC Player of the Year award after becoming the league's all-time leading scoring. She finished her career with 2,865 points while teammate Jasmine Newsome is second on the OVC's career list with 2,566 points. Newsome was also tabbed the OVC Defensive Player of the Year after leading the league with 2.72 steals per outing. The Skyhawks Ashia Jones earned Freshman of the Year honors as she tallied 13.1 points per game in 2013-14.

EKU to play in Preseason WNIT: The OVC will once again have a representative in the Preseason WNIT this year as Eastern Kentucky will participate in the tourney. The Colonels will travel to West Virginia on Nov. 15. The winner of the game will advance to play the winner of Seton Hall/Rider. If a team loses in the first two rounds, they will finish the tournament in the consolation bracket. The consolation bracket will be re-drawn to form new matchups based on the geography of teams involved, who can/cannot host, and recent history of teams. The consolation bracket will be released Nov. 16 after all of the first round games are complete.

COACHES TELECONFERENCE

During the regular season there will be two teleconferences featuring the league's 12 head coaches. The teleconferences will take place on Jan. 13 and Feb. 10 at 10:00 a.m. CT. A schedule of what time the coaches will appear is below. OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2015 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4-7 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams.

The women's first round games will take place on Wednesday, March 4 and Thursday, March 5 at 12 p.m. and 2 p.m. CT each day. The semifinals will be on Friday, March 6 at 12 p.m. and 2 p.m. CT with the championship being held on March 7. The entire women's tournament can be seen on the OVC Digital Network.

This marks the 20th time in 21 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

Team Notes

Austin Peay fell at home to Southern Illinois last week. Junior **Tiasha Gray** had 23 points, six rebounds and four assists in the game. She has led the Lady Govs in scoring in four of the last five games, averaging 21.0 points, 5.4 rebounds and 6.6 assists in those five outings. She ranks in the nation's top 50 in steals (5th, 3.7 spg), assists (10th, 6.2 apg) and scoring (25th 20.0 ppg). The Lady Govs will play their final game of the 2014 calendar year when they host Western Kentucky Tuesday. Austin Peay's next home game is Jan. 15, 2014 - a span of 30 days between home games. Austin Peay will begin its longest road trip when it travels to Missoula, Montana for the Lady Grizz Holiday Classic hosted by Montana. The Lady Govs open up the tournament against Saint Louis on Friday and will face either Montana or Utah State on Saturday.

Eastern Illinois dropped a trio of contests last week, falling to Milwaukee and Western Illinois on the road before dropping a home contest to UIC. Senior **Sabaina Oroszova** led the team in scoring and rebounding over the three games, averaging 15.0 points and 11.0 rebounds. She shot 54 percent from the floor and was 2-for-5 beyond the arc. Sophomore **Phylicia Johnson** scored in double figures in two of the three games averaging 10.7 points. Johnson also went 6-for-18 from three-point range. Freshman **Bh'rea Griffin** had 11 points versus UIC. She came off the bench in all three games to average 7.3 points while shooting 43.5 percent from the field. She also went 10-for-12 from the free throw line. Eastern Illinois will travel to the Wells Fargo Holiday Tournament in Tempe, Ariz.
