THIS WEEK'S adidas® OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



PLAYER

Sherman Blanford, F • Sr., 6-6, 215 • Philadelphia, Pa. • Eastern Illinois

Blanford was named OVC Player of the Week after averaging 29.0 points, 13.0 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 assists/game and hitting 59.5 percent (22-of-37) from the field and going a perfect 14-of-14 at the free throw line in two road games. He started the week with a career-high 32 points at Austin Peay. The senior hit 13-of-20 (65%) field goals and 6-of-6 free throws while also pulling down a career-high 18 rebounds; it marked his sixth double-double of the season. Blanford capped the week by scoring 26 points on 9-of-17 shooting (8-of-8 free throws) at Murray State. He added eight rebounds, two steals and an assist in the game. Blanford has now scored 20 or more points in five consecutive games and this season in conference games ranks seventh in the league in scoring (18.1 points/game) and third in rebounding (9.1/game). He is the first EIU player to earn OVC Player of the Week honors since Dec. 5, 2011 (Jeremy Granger).

NEWCOMER

Jarvis Williams, F • Jr., 6-8, 210 • Macon, Ga. • Murray State

Williams was named the OVC Newcomer of the Week for the sixth-straight week after averaging 15.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.5 blocks/game and hitting 78.6 percent (11-of-14) from the field in two Murray State wins. Williams hit 7-of-9 field goal attempts on his way to 19 points while also adding 12 rebounds against SIUE; that marked his 12th double-double of the season which ranks second in the OVC. The transfer from Gordon State College also had three steals and two blocks in that win. He capped the week by scoring 12 points and grabbing eight rebounds in 23 minutes against Eastern Illinois; in that contest Williams also had two steals and a block. Nationally Williams ranks third in field goal percentage (63.1%), 10th in rebounding (10.5/game) and 14th in double-doubles (12).

FRESHMAN

Cameron Payne, G • Fr., 6-2, 175 • Bartlett, Tenn. • Murray State

Payne earned his eighth OVC Freshman of the Week honor of the season (and fourth in a row) after averaging 13.0 points, 4.5 assists, 2.5 steals and 1.5 rebounds/game while hitting 40 percent (8-of-20) from the field and 90 percent (9-of-10) from the line in two Murray State wins last week. Payne started the week with 17 points, five assists, two steals and a rebound in a victory over SIUE and capped the week with nine points, four assists, three steals and two rebounds against Eastern Illinois. Payne ranks third in the OVC in assists (5.6/game), sixth in steals (1.7/game) and ninth in scoring (15.2 points/game).

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Two weeks of play remain in the OVC regular season...Three teams have clinched a spot in the eight-team OVC Tournament field: Belmont, Morehead State and Murray State...Murray State has also clinched the West Division for the second-straight season; the Racers are guaranteed to be either the No. 1 or 2 seed (the East winner will be the other) and get a double bye to the semifinals...Eastern Kentucky is likely the next team to clinch a spot in the field (they need just one victory)...Austin Peay sophomore Chris Horton entered the OVC career Top 10 blocks list with his 181st block last week (ninth all-time)...Tennessee State senior Patrick Miller continues to lead the OVC and rank sixth nationally in scoring (23.2 points/game)...Murray State junior Jarvis Williams, who was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the sixth-straight week on Monday, ranks third nationally in field goal percentage (63.1%), 10th in rebounding (10.5/game) and 14th in double-doubles (12)...Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos coached in his 400th career OVC game on Saturday (the most of any OVC coach all-time)...Murray State has clinched its 27-straight winning season, which is the fourth-longest active streak nationally behind only Syracuse (44), Kansas (31) and Arizona (30).

TSU's Miller Among National Scoring Leaders: Tennessee State senior guard **Patrick Miller** continues to put up big scoring games and now ranks sixth nationally in scoring (23.2 points/game). Miller has had five 30-plus games this season and 14 additional 20-plus point contests. Miller is also logging a lot of minutes, ranking seventh nationally in minutes played/game (37:35).

Nutt Now Ninth in OVC Career Assists: Southeast Missouri senior guard **Lucas Nutt** now ranks ninth in OVC career assists with 570 helpers in his career. Nutt needs 20 assists to move into eighth place and at his current pace he figures to finish his career sixth in OVC history. Tennessee State senior **Patrick Miller** is also nearing in on the Top 10 list, and is 26 assists out of 10th.

OVC in the NCAA Statistical Rankings: In the latest NCAA statistical rankings (Feb. 17), Eastern Kentucky ranks third nationally in turnover margin (+6.7/game), eighth in steals (9.0/game), 10th in 3-pointers made/game (9.0), 19th in field goal percentage (48.2%) and 17th in free throw percentage (75.3%). Belmont ranks sixth in field goal percentage (49.7%), 13th in 3-pointers made/game (8.8), 24th in 3-point percentage (39.3%) and 25th in scoring offense (79.8 points/game). Morehead State ranks seventh nationally in rebound margin (+8.9/game) while Southeast Missouri is 11th in field goal percentage (49.2%) and 13th in scoring offense (82.1 points/game). Individually Murray State's **Jarvis Williams** is third in field goal percentage (63.1%), 10th in rebounding (10.5/game) and 14th in double-doubles (12). Morehead State's **Chad Posthumus** is third in rebounding (11.5/game) while Tennessee State's **M.J. Rhett** is eighth in double-doubles (13) and 30th in rebounding (9.3/game). Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller** is sixth in scoring (23.2 points/game) and seventh in minutes played/game (37:35). Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is 13th in field goal percentage (59.2%), 13th in blocked shots (3.12/game), 14th in double-doubles (12) and 24th in rebounding (9.5/game).

Kelly Nets 40 Points, 1 of 5 40-Plus Point Efforts by an OVC Player in Last Decade: When Morehead State senior **Drew Kelly** scored 40 points on Dec. 19 against South Dakota, it was one of just five 40-plus point efforts by an OVC player over the last decade (back through the 2004-05 season). It was the most points by a Morehead State player since Ricky Minard scored 43 in the 2002-03 season. Below is a listing of 40-plus point games over the last 10 years.

Wins Over Top 25 Teams By OVC Teams: Belmont's win over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17 was the first for an OVC team in non-conference play since Murray State (ranked No. 14 at the time) beat No. 16 Saint Mary's at home on Feb. 18, 2012. It was the first road victory over a Top 25 team since the Racers topped No. 20 Memphis 76-72 on Dec. 11, 2011. The last time an OVC team beat an opponent ranked 11th or higher was in 1987 when Austin Peay bested No. 11 Illinois in the NCAA Tournament. Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll: In the February 10 Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll (the Feb. 17 poll was not yet available), Belmont was ranked 17th while Eastern Kentucky, Murray State and Morehead State are among the other schools receiving votes. Wichita State picked up 31 first-place votes to be ranked No. 1. Now in its 15th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer is the OVC representative).

Cosey Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record: Eastern Kentucky senior **Glenn Cosey** tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made against Eastern Illinois on January 2. Cosey made 10-of-12 3-point attempts on his way to 34 points. The 10 made 3-pointers tied the record also held by EIU's Marc Polite (set in the 1999-00 season against Arkansas State). The 10 made 3-pointers are the second most by a Division I player this season (Georgia State's R.J. Hunter had 12 on Dec. 22).

Eastern Kentucky Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record: Eastern Kentucky tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made in a game with 20 against Warren Wilson College on Nov. 13. The Colonels were 20-of-39 (51.3%) from 3-point range in the 114-45 victory and tied the record set by Southeast

2014 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 5-8 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6:30 and 9 p.m. and televised on ESPNU. The championship game on Saturday, March 8 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 8 at 1:00 p.m. CT (ESPN3).

This marks the 20th time in 21 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fifth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 3 at 3 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



Mann Named National Player of the Week by CBSSports.com NBCSports.com (Nov. 18): Belmont senior **J.J. Mann** was named National Player of the Week by both CBSSports.com and NBCSports.com after leading the Bruins to a 83-80 victory over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17. Mann scored a career-high 28 points, including three 3-pointers in the final 1:02 as Belmont topped its first Top 25 team since December 2003. Mann scored 11 of Belmont's final 13 points as the team overcame an eight-point deficit with 2:37 to play. He also scored 23 points in a come-from-behind victory over Indiana State earlier in the week. For the week Mann averaged 18.3 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.7 steals/game.

Three OVC Players Named Academic All-District: Three Ohio Valley Conference student-athletes have been named to the Capital One Academic All-District® men's basketball teams as selected by CoSIDA. The selections were Belmont senior guard **J.J. Mann**, Tennessee Tech senior forward **Dennis Ogbe** and UT Martin senior forward **Terence Smith**. All three were first-team selections and for making the first-team will have their names appear on the national ballot for consideration for Academic All-American. The Capital One Academic All-America men's basketball team will be announced on Thursday, February 20. To be eligible for Academic All-America® consideration, a student-athlete must be a varsity starter or key reserve, maintain a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.30 on a scale of 4.00, have reached sophomore athletic and academic standings at his/her current institution and be nominated by his sports information director.

Two OVC Players Named Candidates for Senior CLASS Award: Two OVC men's basketball student-athletes have been named candidates for the 2013-14 Senior CLASS Award. The two players are among 30 male candidates nationally considered for the award (UT Martin's Heather Butler is one of 30 female candidates for the award as well). The OVC selections were Belmont guard **J.J. Mann** and Tennessee Tech forward **Dennis Ogbe**. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The Senior CLASS Award winners will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Men's Final Four® and NCAA Women's Final Four®. Each of the 30 candidate classes will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one male candidate and one female candidate who best exemplify excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

Two OVC Players Announced as Nominees for Allstate NABC Good Works Team: Eastern Kentucky's **Deverin Muff** and Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller** have been announced as nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The award recognizes a select group of college basketball student-athletes who have made significant contributions to the greater good of their communities through volunteerism and civic service. The pair are two of 117 men's nominees from which two 10-member teams will be selected later this year.

OVC Enters Season Having Won a Game in Four of Past Five NCAA Tournaments: Despite not winning a game in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, the OVC has won a NCAA Tournament game in four of the past five years. The four-year winning streak came to an end last season, as the OVC had been one of just nine conferences (3 non-BCS) to win a game from 2009-12.

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2014 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 5-8). It marks the fourth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the ninth time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 8th Among Active NCAA Coaches: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 24th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 382 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 464 for his career (which ranks him 28th among Division I head coaches). Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** (who is in his second year in the OVC) has 683 career victories, which ranks eighth among active Division I head coaches (who recently passed John Wooden's 669 wins on the all-time list). Loos and Byrd are two of just seven active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boeheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe, Coppin State's Fang Mitchell and Davidson's Bob McKillop).

Former OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the 2013-14 season there are four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his third season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and was the MVP of the Rising Stars Game in 2013. The other three players are all rookies this season, including former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan**, former Belmont All-American **Ian Clark** and former Tennessee State standout **Robert Covington**. Canaan and Covington are teammates with the Houston Rockets (Canaan was drafted in the second round while Covington signed a free agent deal) while Clark signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz. Covington is currently playing with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers of the NBDL (and was named MVP of the NBDL All-Star Game), making him one of four total OVC players in that league. The others are Jacksonville State's **Nick Murphy** (Tulsa 66ers), TSU's **Kellen Thornton** (Idaho Stampede) and TTU's **Kevin Murphy** (Idaho Stampede).

The 2013-14 Season: The 2013-14 season marks the 66th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 65 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Southeast Missouri's Stone Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2013-14 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Southeast Missouri State senior **Tyler Stone**, who was named the Preseason Player of the Year. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Southeast Missouri having two selections apiece while Belmont, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and UT Martin had one selection each to round out the team. The squad features two players who were All-OVC first or second-team selections last season and three players who were selected to the All-Newcomer squad. The team is comprised of seven seniors and three juniors. Last season Stone ranked eighth in the OVC in scoring (15.5 points/game), fifth in rebounding (7.8/game) and blocked shots (1.3/game) and 12th in field goal percentage (49.2%) while leading Southeast Missouri to a winning overall record and berth in the OVC Tournament quarterfinals. Other selections to the Preseason All-OVC team were Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller**, Austin Peay's **Travis Betran** and **Will Triggs**, Eastern Kentucky's **Glenn Coasey** and **Corey Walden**, Belmont's **J.J. Mann**, Southeast Missouri's **Nino Johnson**, UT Martin's **Myles Taylor** and Jacksonville State's **Brian Williams**.

Eastern Kentucky, Southeast Missouri, Murray State Picked as OVC Preseason Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Eastern Kentucky has been picked the favorites in the East Division while Murray State and Southeast Missouri State were tabbed co-favorites in the West Division in the OVC for 2013-14. Eastern Kentucky picked up 18 of a possible 24 first-place votes (schools were not allowed to vote for themselves) and a total of 128 points to lead all vote getting. The Colonels were followed in the East by defending OVC champion Belmont, who picked up the remaining six first-place votes and 116 total points. The East Division voting was rounded out by Morehead State (74 points), Jacksonville State (72), Tennessee State (60) and Tennessee Tech (42). The top of the West Division was shared by Southeast Missouri and defending West Champions Murray State. The Redhawks received 13 first-place votes while the Racers picked up the remaining 11 to both finish with 117 total points. The West was rounded out by Austin Peay (90 points), UT Martin (66), Eastern Illinois (58) and SIUE (44).

The events will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without needing any special downloads or apps thanks new streaming technology.

With a pair of wins last week Murray State clinched its second-straight West Division crown and will be either the No. 1 or No. 2 seed for the OVC Tournament; that guarantees the Racers a double bye into the semifinals...The Racers topped SIUE (82-72) and Eastern Illinois (72-60) and have now won three in a row and six of its last seven...The victory over SIUE avenged one of the team's two OVC losses of the season...Jarvis Williams averaged 15.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.5 blocks/game while hitting 78.6 percent (11-of-14) from the field; Williams had 19 points, 12 rebounds, three steals and two blocks against SIUE and added 12 points, eight rebounds and two steals against the Panthers...Williams was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the sixth-straight week; Williams ranks second in the OVC in rebounding (10.5/game), fourth in field goal percentage (63.1%) and fifth in blocks (1.5/game)...Freshman Cameron Payne averaged 13.0 points, 4.5 assists, 2.5 steals and 1.5 rebounds/game while hitting 90 percent (9-of-10) of his free throw attempts in the two wins; Payne had 17 points in the win over SIUE...Payne was named OVC Freshman of the Week for the fourth-straight week and eighth time this season on Monday...The Racers rank first in the OVC in 3-point percentage defense (33.2%) and are second in field goal defense (44.6%)...Murray State plays just once this week, on Saturday night when they host Morehead State in its final home game of the season; the Racers are 12-1 at the CFSB Center this season (having won 10 in a row).

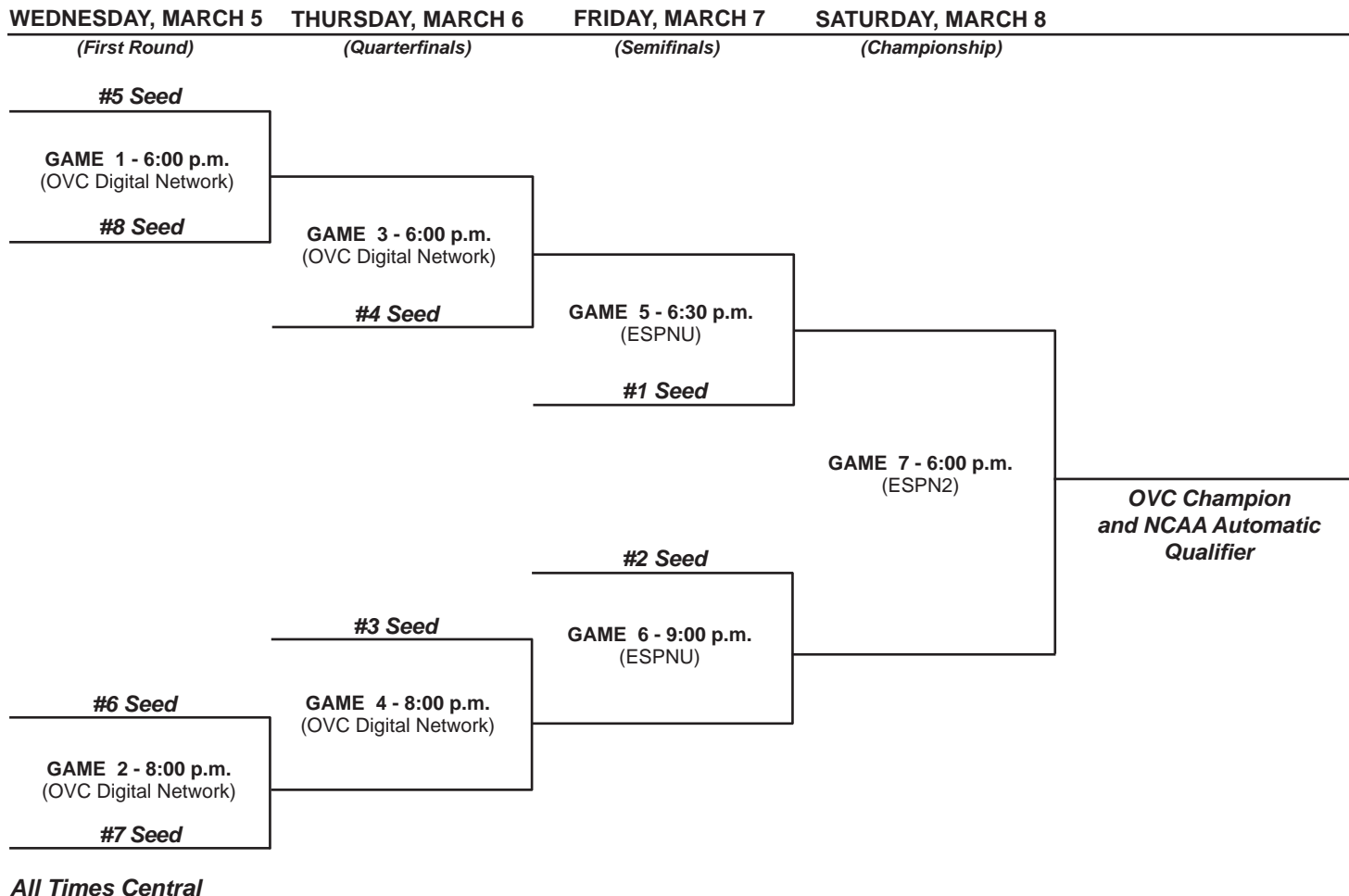
