THIS WEEK'S adidas® OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



PLAYER

Tyler Stone, F • Sr., 6-8, 230 • Memphis, Tenn. • Southeast Missouri

Stone averaged a double-double in helping lead Southeast Missouri to two key victories last week. The senior averaged 20.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks/game while hitting 57.1 percent (16-of-28) from the field as the Redhawks beat Jacksonville State and UT Martin to close in on an OVC Tournament spot. Stone had 28 points, nine rebounds and two blocks in the home win over JSU and followed that with 12 points, 11 rebounds and a block on the road against UTM. That marked his 11th double-double of the season which is fourth in the OVC. Stone ranks third in the OVC in scoring (19.1 points/game) and fourth in rebounding (9.3/game).

NEWCOMER

Jarekious Bradley, F • Jr., 6-5, 220 • Memphis, Tenn. • Southeast Missouri

Bradley returned from an injury to lead his team to two crucial victories last week as he came off the bench to average 18.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals/game while hitting 51.7 percent (15-of-29) from the field. He started the week with 15 points, three rebounds, two steals and an assist in a 17-point victory over Jacksonville State and capped the week with 22 points, eight rebounds, two steals, an assist and a block in a three-point win at UT Martin. Against the Skyhawks Bradley hit a 3-pointer with 48 seconds remaining to tie the game at 72 and then hit two free throws with 15 seconds on the clock to give the Redhawks a 74-72 advantage. It marks the seventh time this season Bradley, a transfer from East Mississippi Community College, has been named OVC Newcomer of the Week. Bradley ranks second in the OVC in scoring (19.3 points/game).

CO-FRESHMAN

Cameron Payne, G • Fr., 6-2, 175 • Bartlett, Tenn. • Murray State

Payne earned his ninth OVC Freshman of the Week award of the season after scoring 23 points and dishing out three assists in Murray State's win over Morehead State last week. The freshman hit 9-of-15 (60%) shots and 4-of-7 3-pointers in helping Murray State finish the home season with a 13-1 record. Payne ranks third in the OVC in assists (5.5/game), sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7), seventh in steals (1.6/game) and 3-pointers made/game (2.0) and eighth in scoring (15.5 points/game).

CO-FRESHMAN

Antonius Cleveland, G • Fr., 6-5, 175 • Memphis, Tenn. • Southeast Missouri

Cleveland earned his fourth OVC Freshman of the Week honor after helping Southeast Missouri to a pair of victories including banking in a half court 3-pointer at the buzzer to beat UT Martin 77-74 on Saturday. That play was included among ESPN's fantastic finishes of the day and was No. 4 on FOX Sports Live's top plays of the day. Cleveland finished that game with 14 points on 5-of-8 shooting (2-of-3 3-pointers) while also adding two rebounds, a block and a steal in 20 minutes off the bench. He started the week with six points, a rebound and an assist off the bench against Jacksonville State.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Just one week is left in the regular season as six teams have clinched a spot in the OVC Tournament field and three teams are battling for the final two spots...Belmont and Murray State are tied for first place and would be OVC Co-Champions if they finish in a tie; in that scenario Belmont would earn the No. 1 seed for the OVC Tournament due to a head-to-head win over the Racers earlier this season...Morehead State has locked up a bye to the quarterfinals and will be joined by either Eastern Kentucky or Tennessee Tech...SIUE is locked into a first round game at this moment while Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri are trying to lock up one of the final two spots...Last week Belmont senior J.J. Mann (first-team) and Tennessee Tech senior Dennis Ogbe (second-team) were named CoSIDA Academic All-Americans and are two of just 15 players honored at the Division I level (three, 5-player teams); the duo are two of just nine OVC men's basketball players to earn that honor all-time...Tennessee State senior Patrick Miller continues to rank sixth nationally in scoring (23.2 points/game)...Murray State guard Cameron Payne was named OVC Freshman of the Week for the ninth time this season, which is tied for second-most in OVC history (the all-time record is 11)...The OVC will announce its 2013-14 All-OVC teams and award winners next Tuesday (March 4).

OVC Tournament Field Takes Shape: Entering this week six teams have clinched a spot in the eight-team OVC Tournament field while three other teams are competing for the final two spots. Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Morehead State, Murray State, SIUE and Tennessee Tech are locked into the field. Belmont and Murray State are guaranteed to be the No. 1 and 2 seeds (and get double byes to the semifinals), although the exact order has not yet been determined (if Belmont wins out they will get the No. 1 spot). Morehead State is guaranteed to be either the No. 3 or 4 seed (and get a bye to the quarterfinals) and will be joined by either Eastern Kentucky or Tennessee Tech in the quarterfinals.

OVC Tournament Seeding FAQ: With the OVC playing in divisions once this season, the seeding for the OVC Tournament will see the winner of the East and West Divisions garnering the No. 1 and No. 2 overall seeds with the division winner with the best OVC winning percentage taking the No. 1 seed. As has been the case in the last three OVC Tournaments, the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds receive double byes to the semifinals under the merit-based format. Seeding for the remainder of the tournament field (No. 3-8) will be based on conference winning percentage of the remaining teams regardless of divisions. Seeds No. 3 and No. 4 will receive a single bye to the quarterfinals while seeds No. 5/8 and No. 6/7 will square off in the first round. Overall the OVC will crown an OVC regular season champion, but not award trophies for finishing first place in each division.

Two OVC Players Named CoSIDA Academic All-Americans: A pair of OVC men's basketball players - Belmont senior **J.J. Mann** and Tennessee Tech senior **Dennis Ogbe** - have been named Capital One Division I Academic All-Americans, as selected by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Mann was a first-team selection (of our five nationally) while Ogbe was a second-team pick. Overall the OVC has had 223 student-athletes earn Academic All-America honors since 1970; the duo are the fifth and sixth to earn the honor this academic year (2013-14). There have been nine OVC men's basketball players named Academic All-America all-time; the pair are the first OVC men's basketball players selected since 2006. Mann is only the second OVC men's basketball student-athlete to earn first-team honors (joining Southeast Missouri's Derek Winans in 2005). To be eligible for Academic All-America® consideration, a student-athlete must be a varsity starter or key reserve, maintain a cumulative G.P.A. of 3.30 on a scale of 4.00, have reached sophomore athletic and academic standings at his/her current institution and be nominated by his/her sports information director. Since the program's inception in 1952, CoSIDA has bestowed Academic All-America honors on more than 20,000 student-athletes in Divisions I, II, III and NAIA, covering all NCAA championship sports. Earlier in the year UT Martin senior forward **Terence Smith** was named an Academic All-District selection along with Mann and Ogbe.

TSU's Miller Among National Scoring Leaders: Tennessee State senior guard **Patrick Miller** continues to put up big scoring games and now ranks sixth nationally in scoring (23.2 points/game). Miller has had five 30-plus games this season and 15 additional 20-plus point contests. Miller is also logging a lot of minutes, ranking seventh nationally in minutes played/game (37:38).

Nutt Now Ninth in OVC Career Assists: Southeast Missouri senior guard **Lucas Nutt** now ranks ninth in OVC career assists with 583 helpers in his career. Nutt needs seven assists to move into eighth place and at his current pace he figures to finish his career sixth in OVC history. Tennessee State senior **Patrick Miller** is also nearing in on the Top 10 list, and is 22 assists out of 10th.

OVC in the NCAA Statistical Rankings: In the latest NCAA statistical rankings (Feb. 24), Eastern Kentucky ranks first nationally in turnover margin (+6.8/game), sixth in 3-pointers made/game (9.3), seventh in steals (9.0/game), 16th in field goal percentage (48.6%) and 17th in free throw percentage (75.0%). Belmont ranks fourth in field goal percentage (50.0%), 10th in 3-pointers made/game (8.9), 11th in 3-point percentage (39.8%) and 22nd in scoring offense (79.9 points/game). Morehead State ranks seventh nationally in rebound margin (+8.6/game) while Southeast Missouri is ninth in field goal percentage (49.4%), 13th in scoring offense (82.1 points/game) and 17th in assists (16.1/game). Individually Murray State's **Jarvis Williams** is third in field goal percentage (63.4%), 12th in rebounding (10.3/game) and 19th in double-doubles (12). Morehead State's **Chad Posthumus** is second in rebounding (11.6/game) while Tennessee State's **M.J. Rhett** is sixth in double-doubles (14) and 27th in rebounding (9.3/game). Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller** is sixth in scoring (23.2 points/game) and seventh in minutes played/game (37:38). Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is 13th in field goal percentage (59.4%), 14th in blocked shots (3.07/game), 19th in double-doubles (12) and 32nd in rebounding (9.1/game). Eastern Kentucky's **Glenn Coasey** is ninth in 3-pointers made/game (3.39) and 23rd in 3-point percentage (42.4%).

Kelly Nets 40 Points, 1 of 5 40-Plus Point Efforts by an OVC Player in Last Decade: When Morehead State senior **Drew Kelly** scored 40 points on Dec. 19 against South Dakota, it was one of just five 40-plus point efforts by an OVC player over the last decade (back through the 2004-05 season). It was the most points by a Morehead State player since Ricky Minard scored 43 in the 2002-03 season. Below is a listing of 40-plus point games over the last 10 years.

2014 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2014 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 5-8 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams in a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6:30 and 9 p.m. and televised on ESPNU. The championship game on Saturday, March 8 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 8 at 1:00 p.m. CT (ESPN3).

This marks the 20th time in 21 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the fifth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. **The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, MARCH 3 at 3 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



Wins Over Top 25 Teams By OVC Teams: Belmont's win over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17 was the first for an OVC team in non-conference play since Murray State (ranked No. 14 at the time) beat No. 16 Saint Mary's at home on Feb. 18, 2012. It was the first road victory over a Top 25 team since the Racers topped No. 20 Memphis 76-72 on Dec. 11, 2011. The last time an OVC team beat an opponent ranked 11th or higher was in 1987 when Austin Peay bested No. 11 Illinois in the NCAA Tournament. Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll: In the February 17 Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll (the Feb. 24 poll was not yet available), Belmont was ranked 16th while Eastern Kentucky, Murray State and Morehead State are among the other schools receiving votes. Wichita State picked up 31 first-place votes to be ranked No. 1. Now in its 15th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer is the OVC representative).

Cosey Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record: Eastern Kentucky senior **Glenn Cosey** tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made against Eastern Illinois on January 2. Cosey made 10-of-12 3-point attempts on his way to 34 points. The 10 made 3-pointers tied the record also held by EIU's Marc Polite (set in the 1999-00 season against Arkansas State). The 10 made 3-pointers are the second most by a Division I player this season (Georgia State's R.J. Hunter had 12 on Dec. 22).

Eastern Kentucky Ties OVC Single-Game 3-Pointers Made Record: Eastern Kentucky tied the OVC single-game record for 3-pointers made in a game with 20 against Warren Wilson College on Nov. 13. The Colonels were 20-of-39 (51.3%) from 3-point range in the 114-45 victory and tied the record set by Southeast Missouri State a season ago.

Mann Named National Player of the Week by CBSSports.com NBCSports.com (Nov. 18): Belmont senior **J.J. Mann** was named National Player of the Week by both CBSSports.com and NBCSports.com after leading the Bruins to a 83-80 victory over No. 11 North Carolina on Nov. 17. Mann scored a career-high 28 points, including three 3-pointers in the final 1:02 as Belmont topped its first Top 25 team since December 2003. Mann scored 11 of Belmont's final 13 points as the team overcame an eight-point deficit with 2:37 to play. He also scored 23 points in a come-from-behind victory over Indiana State earlier in the week. For the week Mann averaged 18.3 points, 7.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.7 steals/game.

Two OVC Players Named Candidates for Senior CLASS Award: Two OVC men's basketball student-athletes have been named candidates for the 2013-14 Senior CLASS Award. The two players are among 30 male candidates nationally considered for the award (UT Martin's Heather Butler is one of 30 female candidates for the award as well). The OVC selections were Belmont guard **J.J. Mann** and Tennessee Tech forward **Dennis Ogbe**. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The Senior CLASS Award winners will be announced during the 2014 NCAA Men's Final Four® and NCAA Women's Final Four®. Each of the 30 candidate classes will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one male candidate and one female candidate who best exemplify excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

Two OVC Players Announced as Nominees for Allstate NABC Good Works Team: Eastern Kentucky's **Deverin Muff** and Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller** have been announced as nominees for the Allstate NABC Good Works Team. The award recognizes a select group of college basketball student-athletes who have made significant contributions to the greater good of their communities through volunteerism and civic service. The pair are two of 117 men's nominees from which two 10-member teams will be selected later this year.

OVC Enters Season Having Won a Game in Four of Past Five NCAA Tournaments: Despite not winning a game in the 2013 NCAA Tournament, the OVC has won a NCAA Tournament game in four of the past five years. The four-year winning streak came to an end last season, as the OVC had been one of just nine conferences (3 non-BCS) to win a game from 2009-12.

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2014 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 5-8). It marks the fourth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the ninth time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 8th Among Active NCAA Coaches:

With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 24th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 382 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 464 for his career (which ranks him 28th among Division I head coaches). Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** (who is in his second year in the OVC) has 684 career victories, which ranks eighth among active Division I head coaches (who passed John Wooden's 669 wins on the all-time list this season). Loos and Byrd are two of just seven active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boenheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe, Coppin State's Fang Mitchell and Davidson's Bob McKillop).

Former OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the 2013-14 season there are four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his third season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and was the MVP of the Rising Stars Game in 2013. The other three players are all rookies this season, including former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan**, former Belmont All-American **Ian Clark** and former Tennessee State standout **Robert Covington**. Canaan and Covington are teammates with the Houston Rockets (Canaan was drafted in the second round while Covington signed a free agent deal) while Clark signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz. Covington is currently playing with the Rio Grande Valley Vipers of the NBDL (and was named MVP of the NBDL All-Star Game), making him one of four total OVC players in that league. The others are Jacksonville State's **Nick Murphy** (Tulsa 66ers), TSU's **Kellen Thornton** (Idaho Stampede) and TTU's **Kevin Murphy** (Idaho Stampede).

The 2013-14 Season: The 2013-14 season marks the 66th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 65 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Southeast Missouri's Stone Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2013-14 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Southeast Missouri State senior **Tyler Stone**, who was named the Preseason Player of the Year. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Southeast Missouri having two selections apiece while Belmont, Jacksonville State, Tennessee State and UT Martin had one selection each to round out the team. The squad features two players who were All-OVC first or second-team selections last season and three players who were selected to the All-Newcomer squad. The team is comprised of seven seniors and three juniors. Last season Stone ranked eighth in the OVC in scoring (15.5 points/game), fifth in rebounding (7.8/game) and blocked shots (1.3/game) and 12th in field goal percentage (49.2%) while leading Southeast Missouri to a winning overall record and berth in the OVC Tournament quarterfinals. Other selections to the Preseason All-OVC team were Tennessee State's **Patrick Miller**, Austin Peay's **Travis Betran** and **Will Triggs**, Eastern Kentucky's **Glenn Cosey** and **Corey Walden**, Belmont's **J.J. Mann**, Southeast Missouri's **Nino Johnson**, UT Martin's **Myles Taylor** and Jacksonville State's **Brian Williams**.

Eastern Kentucky, Southeast Missouri, Murray State Picked as OVC Preseason Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Eastern Kentucky has been picked the favorites in the East Division while Murray State and Southeast Missouri State were tabbed co-favorites in the West Division in the OVC for 2013-14. Eastern Kentucky picked up 18 of a possible 24 first-place votes (schools were not allowed to vote for themselves) and a total of 128 points to lead all vote getting. The Colonels were followed in the East by defending OVC champion Belmont, who picked up the remaining six first-place votes and 116 total points. The East Division voting was rounded out by Morehead State (74 points), Jacksonville State (72), Tennessee State (60) and Tennessee Tech (42). The top of the West Division was shared by Southeast Missouri and defending West Champions Murray State. The Redhawks received 13 first-place votes while the Racers picked up the remaining 11 to both finish with 117 total points. The West was rounded out by Austin Peay (90 points), UT Martin (66), Eastern Illinois (58) and SIUE (44).

This marks the eighth year the OVC has streamed live events, but the second year the events will be offered free of charge and in an HD format and will feature improved quality thanks to an investment in new equipment conference-wide. Fans will also find it easier to log onto OVCDigitalNetwork.com and access the streams and can do so without any registration. The events will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without needing any special downloads or apps thanks new streaming technology.

Team Notes

Austin Peay lost a pair of games last week, falling 90-88 in double overtime at Morehead State and 96-75 at home to Eastern Kentucky...The team has now lost three games in a row; after finishing .500 or better in OVC play for 19-straight seasons, the team is assured to finish below .500 for the second-straight year... The Governors enter this week needing to win at least one game (and likely two) to get into the eight-team OVC Tournament field...Travis Betran averaged 23.0 points/game and hit 52 percent from the field in the two games; against MSU nine of his 24 points came in overtime after Chris Horton and Ed Dyson had fouled out for the Govs...In its home loss to EKU, the Govs shot 58 percent from the floor but lost by 21 points; it was the highest field goal percentage in a loss since the 1999-00 season (58.8 percent against TSU)...APSU has allowed 80 or more points in five-straight games; the team is 2-12 this season when allowing 80-plus points in a game...Horton led or co-led Austin Peay in rebounding in each of the first 20 games this season, but has not been the team's top rebounder in three of its last four games...The Govs rank first in the OVC in blocks (5.3/game)...Austin Peay closes out the regular season with road contests at Southeast Missouri on Thursday and UT Martin on Saturday...A loss to Southeast on Thursday would mean the Govs would need to beat UTM on Saturday, hope Eastern Illinois loses at SIUE and that Tennessee Tech is a higher seed than SIUE in the final standings (APSU topped TTU in the regular season, but was swept by SIUE).

Belmont played its final home game of the season last week, topping Eastern Illinois in its lone contest of the week; the team has now won 54 of its last 56 home games...The victory pushed the Bruins to 12-1 at home this season (the lone loss coming to nationally-ranked VCU) and was the final home game for seniors J.J. 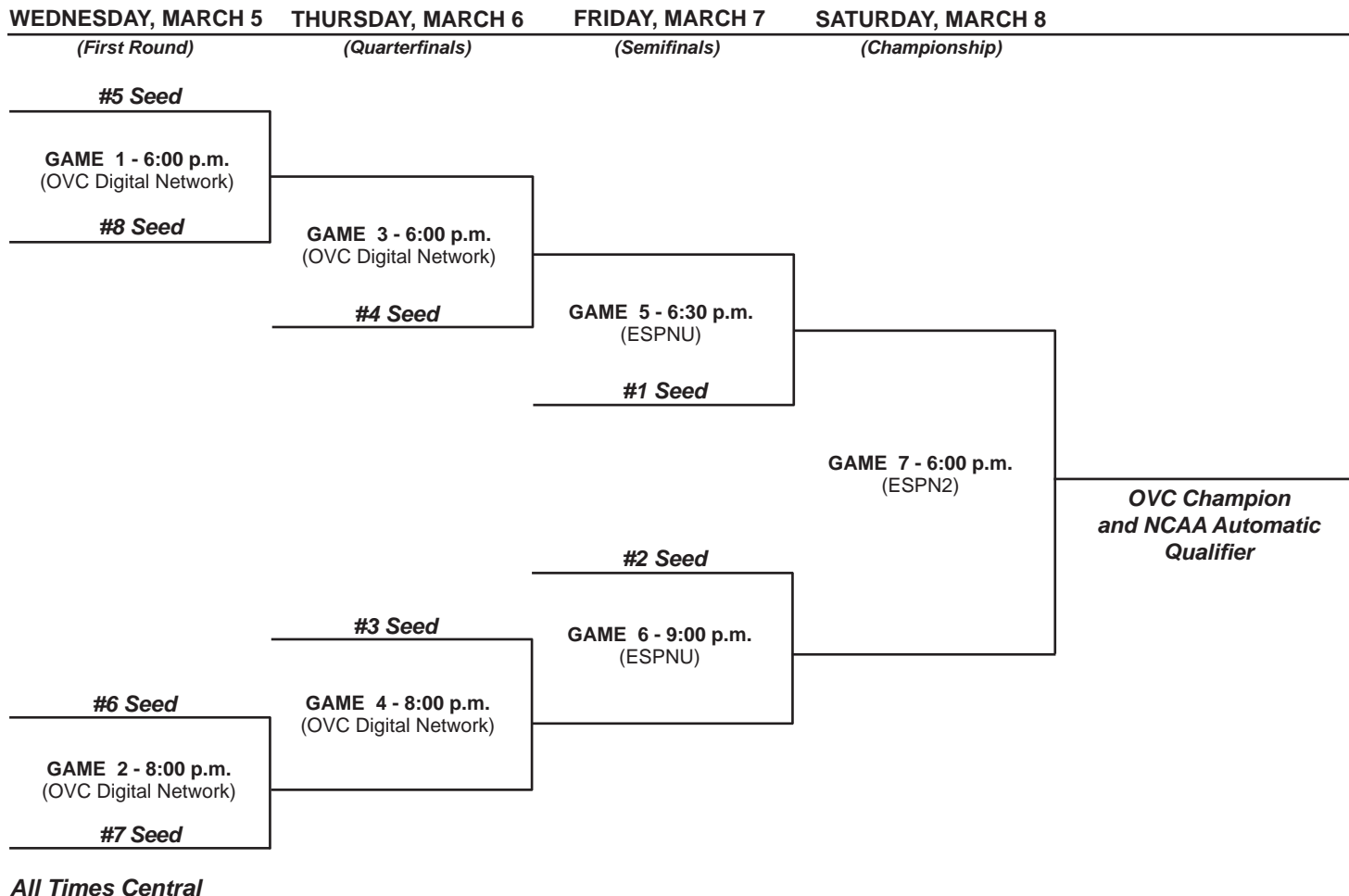
