Borders hit a two-run home run that tied the game with Ball State and led JSU to a win over the Cardinals. She also hit a three-run walk off home run that secured the series sweep of Tennessee Tech. Borders hit safely in every game during the week and drove in multiple runs in three of the four games. She went 2-for-4 against Ball State before going 6-for-9 with a double, seven RBI and four runs scored in the series with Tech. She went 3-for-3 in the second game against the Golden Eagles. She recorded a 1.154 slugging percentage and a .667 on-base percentage during the week. She ran her OVC leads in home runs to 8, RBI to 28, doubles to 8 and batting average to .535.

## 2014 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (9-14 overall, 0-2 OVC):** Austin Peay dropped a pair of games at SIUE to open up conference play. The third game of the series was cancelled due to inclement weather. The Lady Govs suffered 17 strikeouts in the two losses, while not drawing a walk. The only APSU player to have at least one at bat and not go down on strikes in the two games was senior **Lauren de Castro.** The Lady Govs will begin a six-game homestand this week, marking it second largest stretch at home this year. Austin Peay will host doubleheaders with Northern Kentucky on Thursday, Belmont on Saturday and Tennessee State on Sunday.

**BELMONT (7-13 overall, 1-1 OVC):** Belmont split a doubleheader with visiting Morehead State to kick off OVC play. The third game of the series was cancelled due to rain. **Kat Hollingsworth** led the team with four hits while also going 4-for-4 in stolen base attempts. **M.J. Lawson** provided the other two hits for the Bruins in the doubleheader. Belmont will host Louisiana Tech on Thursday before traveling to Austin Peay for two on Saturday and Murray State for a doubleheader on Sunday.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (18-7 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Eastern Illinois split a doubleheader with Coastal Carolina before taking two from East Carolina last week. The Panthers scheduled three-game series with Southeast Missouri over the weekend was postponed due to poor field conditions. Sophomore **Jennette Isaac** led the team with 11 total bases over the four games. She hit .571 with two runs scored and three runs batted in. Senior pitcher **Stephanie Maday** picked up a pair of wins in the circle to improve to 7-3 on the year. She gave up just three runs while striking out six in 13.2 innings of work. EIU will open up league action on the road this week as it travels to Jacksonville State for a pair on Saturday and Tennessee Tech for two on Sunday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (11-11 overall, 1-1 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky fell to South Carolina and defeated UNCG before splitting a pair with Tennessee State. The third game of the TSU series was cancelled due to rain. **Christina Ciolek** led the team with six hits, three RBI and eight total bases over the four games. She also recorded a pair of doubles. **Leanna Pittesnbarger** fanned 12 batters in her 18 innings of work. She picked up her eighth win of the year against Tennessee State. Eastern Kentucky will host Southeast Missouri for a twinbill on Saturday and UT Martin for a pair on Sunday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (17-5 overall, 3-0 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated Ball State before opening OVC play with a sweep of Tennessee Tech. Junior Sara Borders hit a two-run home run to tie the game with Ball Sate and hit a three-run walk off homer in the series finale with Tennessee Tech. She finished the week with a .615 batting average, nine RBI, five runs scored, two home runs and one double. Senior Tiffany Harbin picked up three wins in the circle to give her 65 for her career to break the school record for the most all-time victories. She walked just two while striking out 18 in 19.0 innings of work. Head coach Jana McGinnis earned her 700th career win in JSU's doubleheader sweep of Tech on Saturday. Jacksonville State will host UAB on Tuesday, Eastern Illinois for a doubleheader on Saturday and SIUE for two on Sunday.

MOREHEAD STATE (4-13 overall, 1-1 OVC): Morehead State split a doubleheader with Belmont to open up conference play. The third game of the doubleheader was cancelled due to rain. Junior Katie Raile was the only Eagle to record a hit in each contest. Senior Samantha Howard drove in the winning runs in the opening game with a two-RBI double. Freshman pitcher Megan Tymorek gave up just three hits to pick up the victory. It was her third complete game of the season. Morehead State will host UT Martin for a doubleheader on Saturday and Southeast Missouri for a pair on Sunday.

MURRAY STATE (11-10 overall, 0-2 OVC): Murray State defeated South Dakota State and fell to IPFW before opening league play with a pair of losses to UT Martin. The third game of the UTM series was cancelled due to inclement weather. Junior Mo Ramsey went 6-for-13 on the week, hitting safely in three of the four games. She went 3-for-3 in the opening game against the Skyhawks. For the week she recorded one run scored, one double, one RBI and two stolen bases. Murray State will travel to Auburn for a doubleheader on Wednesday, UAB for a single game on Thursday and Tennessee State for a pair on Saturday before returning home to host Belmont for a twinbill on Sunday.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (5-8 overall, 0-0 OVC):** Southeast Missouri split a pair with UMSL last week. Its original three-game series with Eastern Illinois over the weekend was postponed due to poor field conditions. Sophomore **Savannah Carpenter** extended her hitting streak to four games as she hit .429 in the doubleheader. She had three hits, including two in the nightcap. She also scored once, had a walk and hit her team-high four double of the season. Carpenter had multiple hits in five of her last seven starts and leads the team with a .487 batting average so far this year. Southeast Missouri will host North Dakota State for a single game on Tuesday before hitting the road for doubleheaders at Indiana State on Wednesday, Evansville on Thursday, Eastern Kentucky on Saturday and Morehead State on Sunday.

SIUE (8-14 overall, 2-0 OVC): SIUE fell at Missouri State before taking two from Austin Peay. The third game of the Austin Peay series was cancelled due to inclement weather. Senior **Kayla Riggs** went 4-for-4 with two RBI and a run scored in the opening game with Austin Peay. She finished the week with six hits, two runs scored, two RBI and one stolen bases. Sophomore **Haley Chambers** went 1-1 in the circle last week. She gave up just three earned runs while striking out 14 in 12.2 innings of work. The Cougars will host Northern Iowa on Tuesday before traveling to Tennessee Tech for a pair on Saturday and Jacksonville State for a doubleheader on Sunday.

**TENNESSEE STATE (13-17 overall, 1-1 OVC):** Tennessee State fell to No. 15 Georgia before splitting a doubleheader with Eastern Kentucky. The third game of the EKU series was cancelled due to rain. Freshman pitcher **Hannah St. Clair** gave up just two runs in 9.0 innings of work. Sophomore **Lindsey Burgess** collected two hits on the week including a three-run shot in the game against UGA. Senior **Ashley Haynes** hit a two-run home run in the second game against the Colonels. It marked her first long ball since her freshman year. Tennessee State will host Murray State for a pair on Saturday before traveling to Austin Peay for a doubleheader on Sunday.

**TENNESSEE TECH (8-21 overall, 0-3 OVC):** Tennessee Tech dropped a pair to Lipscomb, fell to Western Kentucky and went 0-3 against Jacksonville State last week. **Chelsea Burgess** led the team with five hits and three RBI. Two of her five hits came from a double and a home run. Tennessee Tech will host SIUE for a pair on Saturday and Eastern Illinois for a doubleheader on Sunday.

**UT MARTIN (11-13-1 overall, 2-0 OVC):** UT Martin split a doubleheader with Saint Louis before taking two from Murray State. The third game of the Murray State series was cancelled due to rain. Sophomore **Deven Wilson** led the team with a .667 batting average while posting a 1.000 slugging percentage. She scored three times and drove in four RBI. She recorded two doubles and one home run on the week. Freshman pitcher **Elizabeth Wiegand** picked up a pair of complete-game victories last week. She has now won six of her last eight. UT Martin will travel to Morehead State for a doubleheader on Saturday and Eastern Kentucky for a pair on Sunday.
