2014 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (14-15 overall, 3-3 OVC): Austin Peay went 5-1 last week, including doubleheader sweeps of Northern Kentucky and Belmont. The Lady Govs also split a pair with Tennessee State. Senior **Lauren de Castro** earned a pair of shutouts to give her four on the season which is the most by a Lady Govs pitcher since 2007. In the circle, de Castro struck out 18 batters while walking just three in 21.2 innings of work. At the plate, de Castro recorded 12 RBI, 10 hits, 9 runs scored, three home runs and two doubles. She now has 100 RBI for her career to become just the fourth Lady Gov to accomplish that feat. The 20 hits given up to Tennessee State in the second game of the doubleheader are the most hits given up in a single game since the 2008 season. Austin Peay will hit the road this week as it travels to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

BELMONT (7-18 overall, 1-5 OVC): Belmont fell to Louisiana Tech before dropping doubleheaders to Austin Peay and Murray State last week. **Jessica Wilson** paced the team with five hits and two RBI over the five games. **Kate Hollingsworth** recorded four hits, two RBI and a team-best two stolen bases. The Bruins will host Evansville for a single game on Wednesday and entertains Tennessee Tech for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (20-9 overall, 2-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois split doubleheaders with Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech to open up OVC play last week. Senior **Carly Willert** led the team with a .636 batting average. She recorded seven hits, two runs scored, two RBI and two doubles over the four games. The Panthers will host Valparaiso on Thursday before traveling to Murray State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (14-12 overall, 4-2 OVC): Eastern Kentucky split a doubleheader with Southeast Missouri and took two from UT Martin last week. The Colonels recorded a season-high 12 runs in the second win over the Skyhawks. Senior **Christina Ciolek** is riding a nine-game hitting streak. In the four games over the weekend, she hit .643 with five RBI. Sophomore **Sarah Fobbs** hit a pair of solo shots in the win over Southeast Missouri. She homered in consecutive at-bats in EKU's eight-run fourth inning in game two against UTM. She finished the week with a 1.583 slugging percentage. In two starts, junior **Leanna Pittsenbarger** struck out 27 hitters, including tying a career-high with 14 strikeouts in the 5-0 win over UT Martin. She gave up just one earned run and walked two in 14.2 innings pitched. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (19-8 overall, 5-2 OVC): Jacksonville State fell to UAB before splitting doubleheaders with Eastern Illinois and SIUE last week. Ella Denes led the team with a .588 batting average. She recorded 10 hits, five RBI, two home runs and two doubles. Logan Green went 1-1 in the circle, striking out 10 in 16.1 innings pitched. The Gamecocks will host Middle Tennessee on Wednesday before traveling to Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (6-15 overall, 3-3 OVC): Morehead State dropped a pair to UT Martin before taking two from Southeast Missouri last week. The wins over Southeast Missouri marked the first doubleheader sweep of the season for Morehead State. Over the four games, the Eagles recorded 37 hits, which is nearly half of its season total of 80. Five Morehead State players had at least five hits during the week. Freshman pitcher Megan Tymorek recorded career-best seven strikeouts in the second win over Southeast Missouri. The Eagles will travel to Western Illinois for a pair on Wednesday before returning home to host Eastern Kentucky for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (15-13 overall, 4-2 OVC): Murray State went 4-3 last week with doubleheader sweeps over Tennessee State and Belmont. The Racers also dropped a pair at No. 21 Auburn and lost to UAB. Sophomore **Shelby Miller** went 11-for-24 with six runs and six RBI last week. She hit her first career home run at Auburn. Junior **CheyAnne Gaskey** went 2-1 in the circle last week, picking up both of her wins in OVC play. She tossed 22.1 innings and struck out 17. She recorded the shutout against Tennessee State and pitched six scoreless innings against Belmont. Murray State will host Western Kentucky for a single game on Wednesday before welcoming Eastern Illinois for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-16 overall, 1-3 OVC): Southeast Missouri played a stretch of nine games in six days last week. The Redhawks fell to North Dakota State, dropped doubleheaders to Indiana State, Evansville and Morehead State while also splitting a twinbill with Eastern Kentucky. The win over the Colonels snapped a season-long seven game losing streak. Sophomore **Savannah Carpenter** is on a three-game hitting streak and has reached back in each of her last six contests. Last week, Carpenter recorded nine hits, four RBI, three runs scored, one double and one home run. **Haylee Krack** hit three home runs and had a team-high five RBI in the nine games. She fell a triple shy of the cycle went she went 3-for-4 with a run scored, a double, a home run and one RBI at Morehead State. Southeast Missouri will host Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

SIUE (11-16 overall, 5-1 OVC): SIUE fell to Northern Iowa before taking two from Tennessee Tech and splitting a pair with Jacksonville State. The Cougars outscored their opponents 14-3 in the team's three wins and now has a +26 run differential in OVC competition. Senior **Kayla Riggs** hit .400 over the five games, scoring four times and stealing one base. She has collected one hit in seven of SIUE's last nine games. Sophomore **Haley Chambers** tossed her second career no hitter in the 1-0 win over Tennessee Tech. She has not allowed a run in three conference starts this year. Chambers gave up just one run in 16.1 innings of work last week while striking out 19. SIUE will host Bradley for a single game before traveling to UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (14-20 overall, 2-4 OVC): Tennessee State dropped a pair to Murray State before splitting a doubleheader with Austin Peay last week. The Tigers recorded 12 runs in the nightcap versus APSU, marking the first time since 2011. TSU also collected 20 hits in the win the most in a single-game since the 2001 season. Sophomore **Kiarra Freeman** set a school record by reaching base five times (four hits and a walk) in game two versus Austin Peay. **Jayna Hanawahine** also had four hits in a game to tie a school mark. **Lindsey Burgess** continues to lead the Tigers with a .330 batting average, seven doubles and four home runs. Kate Morris tops the team with 21 RBI while hitting .300. Tennessee State will host Jacksonville State for a three-game series beginning on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (9-24 overall, 1-6 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a pair to SIUE before splitting a doubleheader with Eastern Illinois. Sophomore **Madison Taylor** scored two runs and drove in one in the win over EIU. She finished the week with five hits, five runs scored, three RBI and two doubles. Tennessee Tech will travel to Belmont for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (13-15-1 overall, 4-2 OVC): UT Martin swept a doubleheader with Morehead State before dropping a pair to Eastern Kentucky last week. Freshman **Gabby Glenn** hit a home run on back-to-back days. She hit .556 and posted a slugging percentage of 1.333 for the week. She scored three times and drove in three over the two games. **Kenzi Tate** posted a .364 batting average while tallying two home runs and five RBI. **Kelsey Dixon** tallied one home run and drove in five on the week. UT Martin will host Ole Miss for a single game on Tuesday before welcoming SIUE for a three-game series starting on Saturday.
