She tossed a pair of two -hitters over the weekend sweep of Belmont. Harbin struck out 14 batters on Saturday, striking out eight of the first nine batters she faced. She concluded the weekend with a nine-strikeout, two-hitter on Sunday. Against OVC opponents, she has thrown 40.2 straight scoreless innings and on the year has thrown 93.2 innings versus the OVC 88 of which have been shutout innings.

# 2014 OVC Softball Team Notes

**AUSTIN PEAY (19-30 overall, 7-16 OVC):** Austin Peay dropped a trio of games to Eastern Illinois last week. Sophomore **Mel Pavel** had her streak of 594 consecutive innings behind the plate come to an end as she had to leave the second game of the EIU doubleheader with a gash on her chin. Senior **Kayla Davidson** drew a pair of walks to give her 25 on the season, tying a school single-game record. Austin Peay will close out the regular-season hosting UT Martin for a three-game series starting on Saturday.

**BELMONT (19-30 overall, 7-16 OVC):** Belmont dropped a three-game series to Jacksonville State last week. The Bruins have lost their last seven contests. Belmont will return to the field this week as it hosts Middle Tennessee for a doubleheader on Thursday and Tennessee State for a three-game series starting on Saturday to conclude the regulars-season.

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (37-13 overall, 17-4 OVC):** Eastern Illinois dropped a pair to Butler before sweeping a three-game series with Austin Peay last week. EIU has now won its last 13 OVC contests. Sophomore **April Markowski** paced the offense with seven hits, nine total bases, a .600 slugging percentage, a .500 on-base percentage and two walks. Senior **Stephanie Maday** led the pitching staff as she improved to 17-6 overall and 9-2 in OVC action with a pair of victories. She fanned a career-high 17 batters in the second game with the Lady Govs, finishing one pitch shy of a no-hitter. She upped her career strike out total to 593, which is the most by a Panther during the current OVC-era and second all-time. Eastern Illinois will close out the regular season with a three-game series at SIUE starting on Saturday.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (27-19 overall, 14-8 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky split a doubleheader with Northern Kentucky before going 1-2 against Tennessee Tech last week. Head coach **Jane Worthington** earned her 600th career victory in the win over Tech. Worthington is 600-566 in her 22 years at EKU. **Leanna Pittsenbarger** tied EKU's single-season record for shutouts (11) in the 2-0 win over Tennessee Tech. Eastern Kentucky will host Jacksonville State for a three-game series starting on Saturday to close out the regular-season.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (36-12 overall, 20-4 OVC):** Jacksonville State swept a three-game series with Belmont last week. The Gamecocks did not give up a run over the three contests. Senior pitcher **Tiffany Harbin** picked up two more complete game shutout victories to give her a nation leading 12 for the season. In her last six OVC starts, Harbin has picked up the complete game shutout. She struck out 14 batters including eight of the first nine batters on Saturday. She followed that up with nine strikeouts on Sunday. She has pitched 40.2 straight scoreless innings in OVC action. Junior **Savannah Sloan** hit safely in each game and had two multi-hit games last week. She scored two runs in the second game and one in the third contest. She also recorded a pair of stolen bases. The Gamecocks will travel to Alabama State on Wednesday before closing out the regular-season with a three-game series at Eastern Kentucky.

**MOREHEAD STATE (14-30-1 overall, 9-13 OVC):** Morehead State swept Tennessee State in a three-game series last week. The Eagles have now won six of its last seven games, which marks the best streak since winning eight straight games in 2009. Junior pitcher **Tanna Seufferer** went 2-0 in the circle and did not give up an earned run over 11.1 innings of work. She went the distance in the 1-0 eight inning victory over the Tigers on Saturday. Morehead State will travel to Northern Kentucky for a pair on Wednesday before closing out the regular-season with a three-game series at Tennessee Tech starting on Saturday.

**MURRAY STATE (27-21 overall, 14-8 OVC):** Murray State picked up a pair of wins over SIUE last weekend. Junior **Alexa Becker** posted a .571 batting average, a .667 on-base percentage and a 1.429 slugging percentage. She tallied three runs score, two home runs, four RBI, two walks and three stolen bases over the two games. Freshman pitcher **Mason Robinson** gave up just one earned run and struck out nine in 10.0 innings of work. The Racers will travel to Memphis on Wednesday before heading to Southeast Missouri for a three-game series starting on Saturday to close out the regular-season.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (8-32 overall, 2-18 OVC):** Southeast Missouri split a doubleheader with Saint Louis before dropping a pair to UT Martin last week. The win over Saint Louis snapped a season-long 13 game losing streak. Junior **Haylee Krack** hit .462 with four runs scored, a double, two home runs and four RBI. In the win over Saint Louis, Krack went 3-for-4 with two home runs, three runs scored and four RBI. Savannah Carpenter is fourth in the league with a .404 batting average. The Redhawks will host Missouri Baptist for a doubleheader on Wednesday before welcoming Murray State for a three-game series starting on Saturday to close out the regular-season.

**SIUE (24-21 overall, 16-5 OVC):** SIUE dropped both ends a doubleheader to Murray State last week. With the losses, the Cougars had their seven-game OVC winning streak snapped. Senior **Chelsea Yankolovich** led the team with four hits over the two games to raise her season batting average to .320. She leads the team this season in hits, runs scored, stolen bases and at-bats. The Cougars will close out the regular season at home with a three-game series with Eastern Illinois starting on Saturday.

**TENNESSEE STATE (16-37 overall, 4-19 OVC):** Tennessee State dropped a trio of games at Morehead State last week. Sophomore **Kiarra Freeman** had three hits and drew a pair of walks to give her a .417 on-base percentage. She went a perfect 5-for-5 in stolen base attempts while scoring ones and driving in a run. Freeman was also perfect in five chances defensively, including an assist. Over the past seven games, pitcher **Shea Morris** has posted a 0.40 ERA and held opponents to a .200 batting average with 16 strikeouts in 17.1 innings of work. In the first game against Murray State, **Ashley Haynes** collected her 100th career hit. Tennessee State will close out the season with a three-game series at Belmont beginning on Saturday.

**TENNESSEE TECH (20-33 overall, 12-12 OVC):** Tennessee Tech went 2-1 against Eastern Kentucky last week. Sophomore **Cortney Fry** went 4-for-7 with three RBI, two runs scored, one double and one home run over the three games. Freshman pitcher **Danielle Liberatore** picked up a pair of wins in the circle, giving up just three earned runs and striking out nine in 12.0 innings of work. Tennessee Tech will host Morehead State for a three-game series starting on Saturday to close out the regular-season.

**UT MARTIN (25-24-1 overall, 12-9 OVC):** UT Martin fell to Middle Tennessee and Southern Illinois before taking two from Southeast Missouri last week. Freshman Carly Gonzales drove in five runs in the doubleheader against the Redhawks. She also went 3-for-3 in stolen base attempts last week. Freshman pitcher **Elizabeth Wiegand** made three appearances last week, going 1-0 and not giving up an earned run. She struck out nine batters in 12.0 innings of work last week. **Casey Vincent** set a career-high with a 2-for-4 day against Southeast Missouri, recording two doubles and four RBI in the contest. The Skyhawks will travel to Austin Peay for a three-game series starting on Saturday to close out the regular-season.
