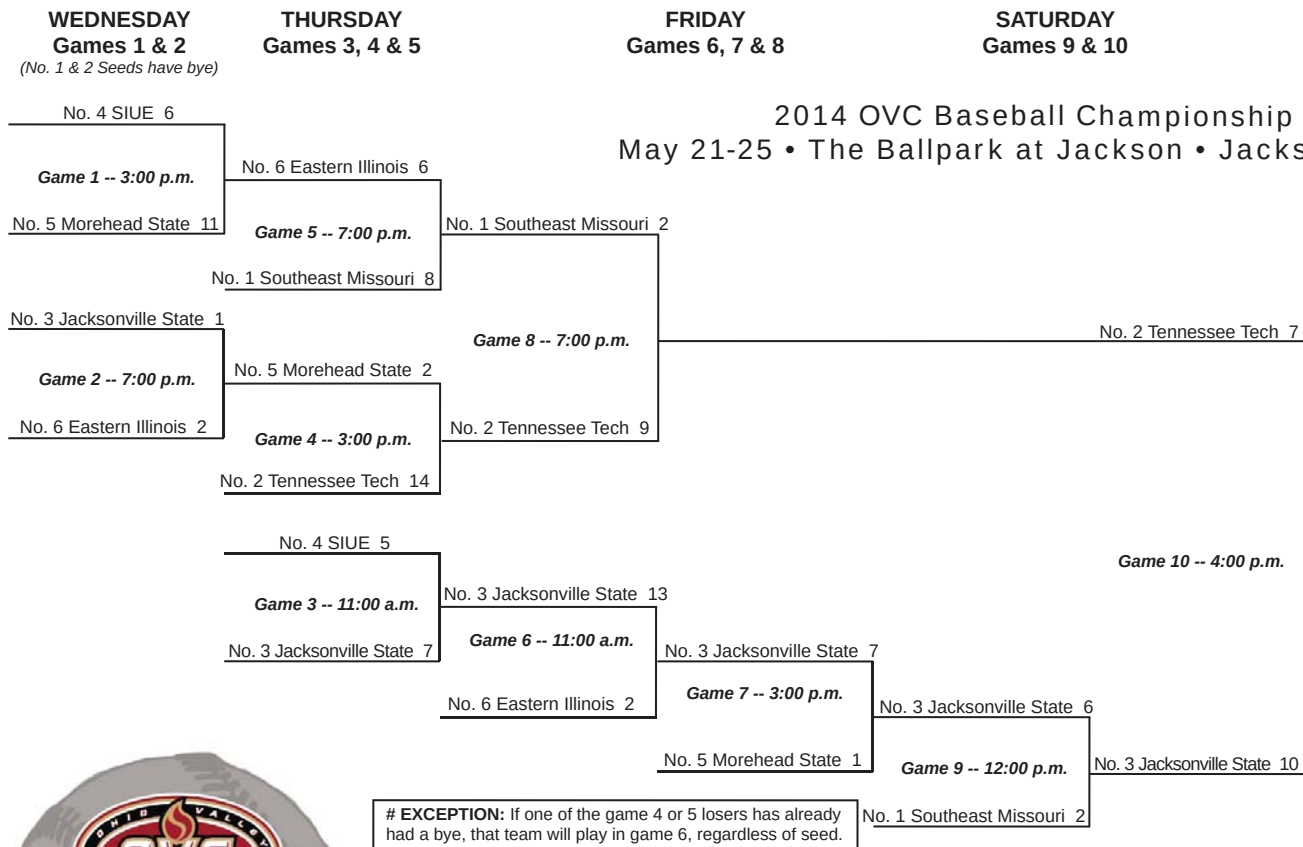

JACKSONVILLE STATE NOTES

Tournament Champions: With its improbable run through the OVC Tournament, Jacksonville State won its fourth OVC Tournament Championship, tying it for third in OVC history. The Gamecocks have also won OVC titles in 2004, 2006 and 2010.

OVC Tournament History: Jacksonville State made history in several capacities in winning the OVC Tournament. The Gamecocks lost its opening round game to Eastern Illinois and then won six-straight elimination contests to claim the crown. They became the first OVC team under the current format (since 2005) to lose in the opening round and even make it to the Championship Round, yet along with the title. The Gamecocks became the first OVC team to eliminate each of the other five teams on the way to the title while the six tournament victories also set a new OVC record. JSU also became the first No. 3 seed to win the championship under the current format.

Jacksonville State in the NCAA Tournament: Jacksonville State is 0-6 all-time in the Division I NCAA Baseball Championship. JSU played in the Atlanta Regional in 2004 (losing to No. 1 Georgia Tech and No. 3 Mississippi State), was in the Tuscaloosa Regional in 2006 (losing to No. 1 Alabama and No. 3 Southern Miss) and was assigned to the Auburn Regional in 2009 (falling to No. 1 Auburn and No. 3 Southern Miss).

Recent OVC Success in NCAA Play: Despite not winning a NCAA Regional, OVC teams have been competitive in NCAA Regional play, winning at least one game in five of the last seven years, including reaching the Regional Championship Round in each of the past two years.

Entire Jacksonville State Pitching Staff Earns OVC Tournament MVP: In making history by winning six-straight elimination games, the Jacksonville State pitching staff was impressive in leading the Gamecocks to the Championship. They were so valuable the 12 players on the travel roster shared OVC Tournament MVP honors as the award went to "The Jacksonville State Pitching Staff." The 12 pitchers at the tournament were Casey Antley, Michael Barber, Zachary Fowler, Michael Mason, Connor Metcalf, Michael McCreless, Graham Officer, Adam Polk, Bradley Raulston, Ryan Sebra, Taylor Shields and Travis Stout. In seven games the staff combined for a 2.14 E.R.A. and four saves (all by Stout) in 63 innings of work. In its final five games of the tournament JSU allowed each of its opponents to score in just one inning of each of the games. It marked the first time multiple players had shared OVC Tournament MVP honors.

Stout Nears OVC Saves Record: Jacksonville State junior **Travis Stout** recorded four saves during the OVC Tournament last week. Stout now has 15 saves on the season, tied for the third-most in OVC single-season history. For his career Stout has 32 saves, which is tied for the second-most in OVC history (with former teammate Todd Hornsby) and just three away from tying the all-time record (held by Austin Peay's Tyler Rogers).

Jacksonville State Among National Leaders: Among the most recent set of NCAA statistical leaders, Jacksonville State ranks fourth nationally in doubles (125), fifth in hits (642), fifth in sacrifice flies (37), 10th in triples (22), 17th in runs (375), 18th in slugging (.423), 22nd in base on balls (247), 23rd in home runs and 25th in double plays (56). Individually Taylor Shields is first nationally in games started (17), Griff Gordon is fourth in hits (96), Paschal Petrongolo is sixth in triples (7), Gavin Golsan is seventh in stolen bases (32), Zachary Fowler is seventh in games started (16) and Travis Stout in seventh in saves (15).
