THIS WEEK'S adidas® OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



CO-PLAYER

Corey Walden, G • Sr., 6-2, 189 • Daytona Beach, Fla. • Eastern Kentucky

Walden averaged 22.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.5 steals/game while shooting 61.9 percent (13-of-21) from the field, 93.8 percent (15-of-16) from the free throw line and 42.9 percent (3-of-7) from 3-point range in a pair of Eastern Kentucky road victories. During the week the point guard scored 33 percent of his team's points and turned the ball over only three times in 78 minutes of action. He opened the week with 21 points, five rebounds, five assists and two steals in a win over UT Martin; in that game the senior hit 8-of-11 (72.7%) field goals and was 5-of-6 (83.3%) at the free throw line. Two days later he scored 23 points, hitting 3-of-5 (60%) 3-pointers and 10-of-10 free throws in a win at Southeast Missouri; he also added five rebounds, a steal and assist in the win. Walden currently ranks first in the OVC in steals (2.8/game), second in scoring (18.4 points/game), third in minutes played (33.9/game), fifth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.9), seventh in field goal percentage (56.2%), eighth in free throw percentage (78.2%) and ninth in assists (3.5/game). It marks the third time this season he has been named OVC Player of the Week.

CO-PLAYER

Jarvis Williams, F • Sr., 6-8, 215 • Macon, Ga. • Murray State

Williams averaged 20.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.0 blocks/game while hitting 60 percent (12-of-20) from the field and 70.8 percent (17-of-24) from the free throw line in a pair of Murray State road victories. He recorded his fifth double-double of the season at Jacksonville State on Sunday, scoring 25 points and pulling down 11 rebounds in front of a national television audience; Williams hit 8-of-11 (72.7%) field goals and 9-of-10 (90%) free throws in the victory. He opened the week with 16 points and nine rebounds in a victory over Tennessee Tech. Williams currently ranks third in the OVC in rebounding (7.9/game), fourth in scoring (16.0 points/game), fifth in field goal percentage (59.5%) and 10th in blocked shots (1.0/game).

CO-NEWCOMER

LeTrell Viser, G • Jr., 6-2, 185 • Aurora, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Viser averaged 10.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.0 blocks/game in helping Eastern Illinois to victories over Tennessee State and Belmont as the Panthers improved to 4-0 in OVC play for the first-time ever. The transfer from Des Moines Area Community College started the week with eight points, three steals, two rebounds and a block at Tennessee State. He capped the week with 13 points, five rebounds, two steals and a block in an 84-73 home court win over Belmont; in that game Viser hit 4-of-6 (66.7%) 3-pointers. He now has at least two steals in nine-straight games.

CO-NEWCOMER

Dewille Smith, G • Sr., 6-0, 175 • Jackson, Miss. • UT Martin

In UT Martin's first two OVC games of the season Smith averaged 15.0 points, 4.5 rebounds, 4.5 assists and 1.0 steals/game as the team lost to Eastern Kentucky and rebounded to top Morehead State in overtime. Smith had 18 points, including the go-ahead basket in overtime, against Morehead State; in that contest the transfer from UNLV added four rebounds, four assists and two steals in 43 minutes of action. He opened the week with 12 points, five rebounds and five assists against Eastern Kentucky. Smith ranks first in the OVC in minutes played (35.3/game), third in steals (2.1/game), fifth in assists (4.5/game), sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7), seventh in free throw percentage (78.3%) and eighth in scoring (14.2 points/game).

FRESHMAN

Darreon Reddick, G • Fr., 6-4, 195 • Belleville, Ill. • Tennessee State

Reddick averaged 12.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 1.5 steals and 1.0 assists/game last week in contests against Eastern Illinois and SIUE. He scored a team-high 13 points to open the week as the Tigers lost by seven points to first-place Eastern Illinois. He also added seven rebounds, an assist and steal in the game. He closed the week with 11 points, eight rebounds, two steals and an assist in a seven-point loss at SIUE (in a game that was tied with just over a minute to go).

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: With a pair of Conference wins last week Eastern Illinois improved to 4-0 in OVC play for the first time since joining the league in 1996-97; the last time the program was 4-0 in any conference was in 1985-86 when the Panthers were members of the Mid-Continent Conference...EIU is one of three OVC teams still undefeated in Conference play as they are joined by Murray State (3-0) and Eastern Kentucky (2-0)...Murray State enters this week with an 11-game winning streak, tied for the third-longest streak in the country (trailing only 15-game streaks by Kentucky and Virginia); Eastern Illinois has won seven-straight which is the seventh-longest active streak nationally...UT Martin has won nine total games this season, one more than the program won all of last season...Belmont's Rick Byrd has won 699 career games and will be searching for No. 700 at Murray State on Thursday...The Belmont/Murray State game can be seen on ESPNU; the two teams have played three total times since Belmont joined the league and each game came down to the final possession of the game...Murray State and Eastern Kentucky each enter the week with six road victories, one behind Hofstra for the national lead...So far this season teams from the West Division are 12-7 against teams from the East Division; in the first two years of division play, East teams were a combined 50-22 against teams from the West...Entering this week four OVC teams were ranked in the Top 150 of the NCAA RPI: Murray State (105), Belmont (113), Eastern Illinois (125) and Eastern Kentucky (130).

Overall Winning Streaks: Entering this week two OVC teams have long overall winning streaks. Murray State has won 11-straight games which is tied for the third-best active streak nationally while Eastern Illinois has won seven-straight games which is tied for the seventh-longest winning streak.

Eastern Kentucky Posts 28-Point Road Win Over Nationally-Ranked Miami; Second-Largest Ever By OVC Team: Eastern Kentucky made history when it went on the road and beat No. 18 Miami (Fla.) 72-44 on December 19. It was the first victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference opponent for the team since topping No. 6 Dayton on Dec. 9, 1967. It is the second-largest victory over a Top 25 team by an OVC team, trailing only a 31-point win by Western Kentucky over No. 15 St. Bonaventure on January 3, 1953 (94-63 at a neutral site in Oklahoma City). UTM's Smith Among Rare Company With Stat-Filled Game: UT Martin senior guard **Deville Smith** put himself in rare company with his performance at Illinois-Chicago on December 15. Smith had 26 points, 7 assists, 6 rebounds, 5 blocks and 3 steals in the overtime victory over the Flames. He is the first Division I player to have a 25-point, 5-assist, 5-rebound, 5-block and 3-steal performance against a fellow Division I team since Minnesota's Joel Przybilla against Iowa in 1999-00 (Przybilla had 28 points, 18 rebounds, 7 blocks, 5 assists and 3 steals).

Horton Records 10th Triple-Double in OVC History: Austin Peay junior **Chris Horton** recorded just the 10th triple-double in OVC history on Nov. 16 when he had 15 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against Berea College. It was the first triple-double in the OVC since the 2008-09 season and he was only the second player to ever do it with blocked shots. Below are a list of all-time OVC triple-doubles.

Bradshaw Nets 42 Points, One of Six 40-Plus Point Efforts By an OVC Player in Last 11 Years: When Belmont junior **Craig Bradshaw** scored 42 points at Ohio on Nov. 29, it was one of just six 40-plus point efforts by an OVC player over the last 11 years (back through the 2004-05 season). It was the most points by a Belmont player in the program's Division I era and the second-most points by a Division I player this season. 2015 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2015 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4-7 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tennessee. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams with the men's teams playing a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals and the women's team playing a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. bracket.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6:30 and 8:30 p.m. and televised on ESPNU. The championship game on Saturday, March 7 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 7 at 1:00 p.m. CT (ESPN3).

This marks the 21st time in 22 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the sixth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. The deadline to request credentials is **MONDAY, MARCH 2 at 3 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer is the OVC representative).

NCAA Stats Leaders: In the latest NCAA statistical leaders (Jan. 12), Eastern Kentucky ranks second nationally in turnover margin (+9.6/game), fifth in steals (10.6/game), sixth in free throw percentage (76.8%) and 11th in 3-pointers made/game (9.1). Belmont ranks sixth in 3-pointers made/game (9.8) while Murray State is 13th in field goal percentage (49.5%), 14th 3-point percentage (40.3%) and 21st in scoring (78.3 points/game). Individually Tennessee Tech's **Charles Jackson** is second in double-doubles (12) and 24th in rebounding (9.6/game). Belmont's **Craig Bradshaw** is 22nd in scoring (19.7 points/game) and 24th in 3-point percentage (43.8%) while teammate **Evan Bradds** is third in field goal percentage (66.1%) and **Reece Chamberlain** is 16th in assists (6.1/game). Eastern Kentucky's **Corey Walden** is seventh in steals (2.8/game) and 40th in scoring (18.4 points/game) while Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is 15th in rebounding (10.1/game), 15th in double-doubles (8) and 34th in blocked shots (2.44/game). Murray State's **Cameron Payne** is 27th in assists (5.8/game), 29th in steals (2.24/game) and 41st in scoring (18.4 points/game). Southeast Missouri's **Jarekious Bradley** is second nationally in free throw percentage (93.9%).

Payne Named Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Week by CollegeInsider.com (Dec. 15): Murray State sophomore **Cameron Payne** was named the Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Week by CollegeInsider.com on Dec. 15 following his play at Evansville. Payne scored a career-high 32 points as Murray State won 81-79; the sophomore hit 10-of-19 field goals attempts, 4-of-7 3-pointers and 8-of-12 free throws while also adding eight assists, five rebounds and two steals in 35 minutes of action. Payne scored 20 of his 32 points in the first half as MSU built a 42-38 halftime advantage.

Bradshaw Named National Player of the Week by NBCSports.com (Dec. 1): Belmont's **Craig Bradshaw** was named the National Player of the Week by NBCSports.com/CollegeBasketballTalk following his play in three games that saw him average 33.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 steals/game while hitting 58.2 percent (32-of-55) from the field, 58.6 percent (17-of-29) from 3-point range and 75 percent (18-of-24) from the free throw line in three Belmont victories. After scoring 29 and 28 points in games to open the week he hit 8-of-12 3-pointers on his way to a Belmont Division I scoring record of 42 points at Ohio; in that game he also raced the length of the court and hit the game-winning basket to lift his team to a 83-81 victory.

Payne Named to Cousy Award Watch List: Murray State's **Cameron Payne** has been named to the watch list of candidates for the 2015 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. The Watch List included 35 players right now and will be narrowed to 20 in early February, then the final five by early March. The winner will be honored on Monday of Final Four weekend in Indianapolis.

Four OVC Players Named to Lou Henson Award Watch List: Four OVC men's basketball players have been named to the Lou Henson Award Watch list by CollegeInsider.com. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The OVC selections included Southeast Missouri senior guard **Jarekious Bradley**, Belmont junior guard **Craig Bradshaw**, Murray State sophomore guard **Cameron Payne** and Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Corey Walden**. The group are among 40 players nationally nominated for the award. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. The 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 men's NCAA Basketball Championship.

OVC to Produce 14-Game National Television Package: The OVC will produce the largest national television package in its history in 2014-15 as 14 Conference games will air on either the ESPN Family of Networks or the CBS Sports Network. The Conference will once again have seven games on the ESPN Family of Networks, including four regular season games as well as the OVC Tournament semifinals and championship game. The OVC will also have a seven-game package on CBS Sports Network, up from just four games on the network a season ago. The 14-game package ensures that every member institution is on national television at least once this year. In addition the OVC will produce five games that will air in select markets on the new American Sports Network.

Recent Postseason Success: Last year the OVC had four men's basketball teams selected for postseason play (1 NCAA, 1 NIT, 1 CIT, 1 CBI) which matched an all-time high for a single season, tying the mark set in 2011. Overall OVC teams were 7-3 in postseason play in 2014; the seven total wins were the most for the OVC in one postseason (topping four wins in the 1971 season). With wins by Belmont (who advanced to the NIT Quarterfinals) and Murray State (who won the CIT Championship), OVC teams have now at least won at least one game in postseason play for six-straight years (the longest stretch in league history). Also included in that mark are wins in four of the past six NCAA Tournaments.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 8th Among Active NCAA Coaches: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 25th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 388 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 470 for his career (which ranks him 29th among Division I head coaches). Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** (who is in his third year in the OVC) has 699 career victories, which ranks seventh among active Division I head coaches. Loos and Byrd are two of just six active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boeheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe and Davidson's Bob McKillop).

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2015 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 4-7). It marks the fifth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the 10th time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967 and 1989. The OVC recently signed an extension with Municipal Auditorium to hold the tournament there through 2017. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round

included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. That format remains the same for the men's team, although the women's teams have switched back to a traditional bracket (1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc.) bracket this season. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium.

OVC Men's Hoops in Third Year of Divisional Play: For the third year the OVC will use divisional play for men's basketball (the OVC women's teams are not using divisional play this year). The addition of Belmont University on July 1, 2012 gave the OVC 12 member institutions, the largest the Conference has been since it was formed in 1948 (the OVC is currently the nation's eighth-oldest Division I conference). The East Division includes Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. The West Division includes Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin.

Former OVC Players in the NBA: There are currently four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his fourth season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and helped lead Team USA to a Gold Medal in the World Cup of Basketball this past summer. Former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan** is in his second year with the Houston Rockets after being drafted in the second round by the club. Former Belmont All-American **Ian Clark** signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz after doing undrafted and has a guaranteed deal with the Jazz this season. Former Tennessee State star **Robert Covington** was cut by Houston after spending last year with the team, but signed a free agent contract with the Philadelphia 76ers right after the season began. Two other former OVC players are currently playing in the NBDL: Travis Betran (Austin Peay) with the Erie BayHawks and Kevin Murphy (Tennessee Tech) with the Idaho Stampede.

The 2014-15 Season: The 2014-15 season marks the 67th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 66 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Murray State's Payne Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2014-15 OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Murray State sophomore guard **Cameron Payne** who was named the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Payne is the first sophomore to be named Preseason Player of the Year since the award was first handed out in 1993-94. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Murray State having the most selections (3) and Belmont (2) also having multiple picks. Payne was named both a first-team All-OVC selection and OVC Freshman of the Year after averaging 16.8 points, 5.4 assists, 3.6 rebounds and 1.7 steals/game and leading Murray State to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) Championship (where he was named MVP). In addition to Payne the other players named to the All-OVC Team last year and appearing on the preseason team this season are Southeast Missouri State senior guard **Jarekious Bradley**, Belmont junior guard **Craig Bradshaw**, Morehead State senior guard **Angelo Warner** and Murray State senior forward **Jarvis Williams**. The Preseason All-OVC Team was rounded out by Belmont senior guard **Reece Chamberlain**, Austin Peay junior center **Chris Horton**, Murray State senior guard **T.J. Sapp**, UT Martin senior forward **Myles Taylor** and Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Corey Walden**, who was the 2013-14 OVC Defensive Player of the Year.

Murray State Picked as OVC Preseason Favorite: In a vote of OVC head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite for the 2014-15 season. Murray State, who has won a league-best 23 OVC regular season championships, picked up 15 of 24 first-place votes in being picked the overall regular season champion. The Racers were also tabbed the West Division favorites, picking up 22 of 24 first-place votes in that category, while two-time defending regular season champion Belmont was picked the East Division favorites. In the overall champion voting, in addition to Murray State picking up 15 first-place votes other teams with first-place votes included Belmont (7), Eastern Kentucky (1) and Morehead State (1). Since Murray State was picked as the overall champion, they were also an overwhelming favorite to take first place in its own division; the Racers have finished first in the West in each of the first two years of divisional play. MSU received 132 total points to top the West and were followed by Southeast Missouri (who picked up the other 2 first-place votes and 109 points), SIUE (77), Austin Peay (70), Eastern Illinois (64) and UT Martin (40). Belmont picked up 16 of the 24 first-place votes and 125 points in being picked the East Division favorite while Morehead State (103) and Eastern Kentucky (102) each picked up four first-place votes. The East was rounded out by Tennessee Tech (71), Jacksonville State (52) and Tennessee State (40).

OVC Digital Network: The OVC launched the OVC Digital Network (OVCDN) in August 2012. The OVCDN is the exclusive home for live web streamed athletic contests involving OVC schools. This marks the eighth year the OVC has streamed live events, but the second year the events will be offered free of charge and in an HD format and will feature improved quality thanks to an investment in new equipment conference-wide. Fans will also find it easier to log onto OVCDigitalNetwork.com and access the streams and can do so without any registration. The events will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without needing any special downloads or apps thanks new streaming technology.

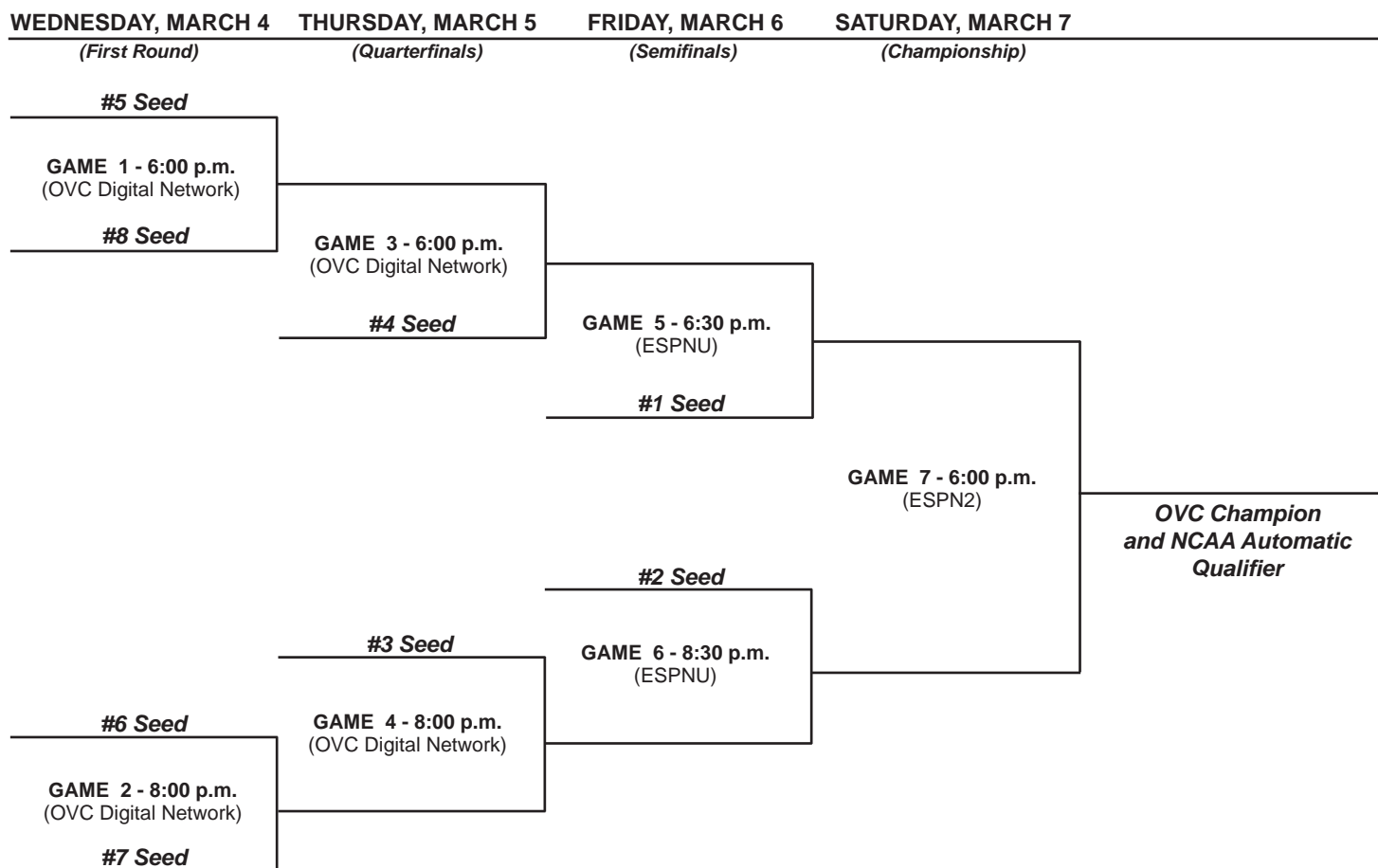
