Johnston averaged 16.0 points, 3.5 assists and 1.5 rebounds/game while hitting 71.4 percent (10-of-14) from the field, 85.7 percent (6-of-7) from the free throw line and a perfect 6-of-6 from 3-point range as Eastern Illinois won at Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State to improve to 6-0 in Conference play. Overall the Panthers ran its winning streak to nine games (seventh-longest nationally), which is the longest for the program since joining the Division I ranks in 1981. Johnston had a season-high 22 points in the win at MSU as he hit 4-of-4 3-pointers and 7-of-8 shots in 38 minutes of action; he also added three assists in the win. He opened the week by scoring 10 points and dishing out four assists against the Colonels. Johnston currently ranks fifth in the OVC in 3-point percentage (44.9%), fifth in minutes played (33.4/game) and sixth in assists (4.2/game).

NEWCOMER

Deville Smith, G • Sr., 6-0, 175 • Jackson, Miss. • UT Martin

Smith, the transfer from UNLV, averaged 13.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.0 blocks/game while hitting 52.9 percent (9-of-17) from the floor and 54.5 percent (6-of-11) from 3-point range as UT Martin won a pair of games to improve to 3-1 in OVC play for the first time since 2002-03. At Tennessee Tech he helped the Skyhawks snap an eight-game losing streak to the Golden Eagles by scoring five of his team's seven points down the stretch in the three-point victory. Smith finished that game with 16 points, five assists, four rebounds and a block. Two days later he scored the final three points of the game against Jacksonville State after that contest was tied with 2:49 to play. Smith had 11 points, six rebounds, five assists, a block and steal against the Gamecocks. Smith currently ranks first in the OVC in minutes played (35.5/game), fourth in assists (4.6/game), sixth in steals (1.9/game), seventh in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.7) and ninth in scoring (14.1 points/game) and free throw percentage (75.0%).

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Eastern Illinois ran its winning streak to nine games (seventh-longest nationally entering the week) with road wins over Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State last week; the winning streak is the longest for the program since joining the Division I ranks in 1981...Eastern Illinois is now 6-0 in OVC play for the first time ever...Murray State also won a pair of games last week to increase its winning streak to 13 games, the third-longest streak nationally; the Racers rank 10th nationally in field goal percentage (49.4%) and 13th in 3-point percentage (40.4%), both of which lead the OVC...Eastern Illinois and Murray State will battle for first place on Thursday night in Charleston in a game that can be seen on CBS Sports Network...Belmont head coach Rick Byrd won his 700th career game on Saturday at Austin Peay; Byrd is now one of just seven active Division I coaches to have 700 career wins...Belmont sophomore Evan Bradds enters this week leading all Division I players in field goal percentage (67.8%) while Tennessee Tech junior Charles Jackson is second nationally in double-doubles (13)...UT Martin is off to a 3-1 start in OVC play, its first 3-1 start since the 2002-03 season...So far this season teams from the West Division are 21-10 against teams from the East Division; in the first two years of division play, East teams were a combined 50-22 against teams from the West...This season the OVC schedule was front-loaded with cross divisional matchups, as only five of those matchups remain the remainder of the season...Entering this week three OVC teams were ranked in the Top 110 of the NCAA RPI: Murray State (104), Eastern Illinois (106) and Belmont (108).

Overall Winning Streaks: Entering this week OVC teams have two of the seven longest overall winning streaks nationally. Murray State has won 13-straight games which is the third-best active streak nationally while Eastern Illinois has won nine-straight games which is tied for the seventh-longest winning streak.

700 Club: Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** became just the seventh active Division I head coach to reach the 700 win plateau on January 17 when his team won at Austin Peay. With the 700 victories Byrd joins an elite group that also includes Mike Krzyzewski, Jim Boeheim, Bob Huggins, Roy Williams, Bo Ryan and Rick Pitino (Youngstown State's Jerry Slomcum needs just three more wins entering this week to become the eighth active member). All-time the 700 career wins rank Byrd 25th in NCAA Division I history.

Eastern Kentucky Posts 28-Point Road Win Over Nationally-Ranked Miami; Second-Largest Ever By OVC Team: Eastern Kentucky made history when it went on the road and beat No. 18 Miami (Fla.) 72-44 on December 19. It was the first victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference opponent for the team since topping No. 6 Dayton on Dec. 9, 1967. It is the second-largest victory over a Top 25 team by an OVC team, trailing only a 31-point win by Western Kentucky over No. 15 St. Bonaventure on January 3, 1953 (94-63 at a neutral site in Oklahoma City). NCAA Stats Leaders: In the latest NCAA statistical leaders (Jan. 19), Eastern Kentucky ranks second nationally in turnover margin (+9.4/game), fourth in steals (10.4/game), sixth in free throw percentage (76.9%) and 18th in 3-pointers made/game (8.8). Murray State ranks 10th in field goal percentage (49.5%), 13th in 3-point percentage (40.4%), 15th in assists (16.8/game), 16th in scoring offense (79.7 points/game) and 17th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.42). Belmont ranks sixth in 3-pointers made/game (9.8). Individually Tennessee Tech's **Charles Jackson** is second in double-doubles (13) and 27th in rebounding (9.4/game). Belmont's **Craig Bradshaw** is 25th in scoring (19.5 points/game) and 32nd in 3-point percentage (42.9%) while teammate **Evan Bradds** is first nationally in field goal percentage (67.8%) and **Reece Chamberlain** is 14th in assists (6.1/game). Eastern Kentucky's **Corey Walden** is sixth in steals (2.71/game) and 30th in scoring (19.1 points/game) while teammate **Eric Stutz** is seventh in field goal percentage (60.7%). Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is 14th in rebounding (10.2/game), 15th in double-doubles (9) and 37th in blocked shots (2.28/game). Murray State's **Cameron Payne** is 16th in assists (5.9/game), 22nd in steals (2.21/game) and 39th in scoring (18.4 points/game). Southeast Missouri's **Jarekious Bradley** is third nationally in free throw percentage (92.9%).

Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll: In the latest Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll (Jan. 12 - the newest poll was not yet available), Murray State is ranked 15th while Belmont is 16th while Eastern Kentucky and Eastern Illinois were among the others receiving votes. Gonzaga picked up all 31 first-place votes to be ranked No. 1. Now in its 16th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer is the OVC representative).

UTM's Smith Among Rare Company With Stat-Filled Game: UT Martin senior guard **Deville Smith** put himself in rare company with his performance at Illinois-Chicago on December 15. Smith had 26 points, 7 assists, 6 rebounds, 5 blocks and 3 steals in the overtime victory over the Flames. He is the first Division I player to have a 25-point, 5-assist, 5-rebound, 5-block and 3-steal performance against a fellow Division I team since Minnesota's Joel Przybilla against Iowa in 1999-00 (Przybilla had 28 points, 18 rebounds, 7 blocks, 5 assists and 3 steals).

Horton Records 10th Triple-Double in OVC History: Austin Peay junior **Chris Horton** recorded just the 10th triple-double in OVC history on Nov. 16 when he had 15 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against

2015 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2015 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4-7 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tennessee. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams with the men's teams playing a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals and the women's team playing a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. bracket.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6:30 and 8:30 p.m. and televised on ESPNU. The championship game on Saturday, March 7 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 7 at 1:00 p.m. CT (ESPN3).

This marks the 21st time in 22 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the sixth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. The deadline to request credentials is **MONDAY, MARCH 2 at 3 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).

Bradshaw Nets 42 Points, One of Six 40-Plus Point Efforts By an OVC Player in Last 11 Years: When Belmont junior **Craig Bradshaw** scored 42 points at Ohio on Nov. 29, it was one of just six 40-plus point efforts by an OVC player over the last 11 years (back through the 2004-05 season). It was the most points by a Belmont player in the program's Division I era and the second-most points by a Division I player this season. Payne Named Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Week by CollegeInsider.com (Dec. 15): Murray State sophomore **Cameron Payne** was named the Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Week by CollegeInsider.com on Dec. 15 following his play at Evansville. Payne scored a career-high 32 points as Murray State won 81-79; the sophomore hit 10-of-19 field goals attempts, 4-of-7 3-pointers and 8-of-12 free throws while also adding eight assists, five rebounds and two steals in 35 minutes of action. Payne scored 20 of his 32 points in the first half as MSU built a 42-38 halftime advantage.

Bradshaw Named National Player of the Week by NBCSports.com (Dec. 1): Belmont's **Craig Bradshaw** was named the National Player of the Week by NBCSports.com/CollegeBasketballTalk following his play in three games that saw him average 33.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 steals/game while hitting 58.2 percent (32-of-55) from the field, 58.6 percent (17-of-29) from 3-point range and 75 percent (18-of-24) from the free throw line in three Belmont victories. After scoring 29 and 28 points in games to open the week he hit 8-of-12 3-pointers on his way to a Belmont Division I scoring record of 42 points at Ohio; in that game he also raced the length of the court and hit the game-winning basket to lift his team to a 83-81 victory.

Payne Named to Cousy Award Watch List: Murray State's **Cameron Payne** has been named to the watch list of candidates for the 2015 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. The Watch List included 35 players right now and will be narrowed to 20 in early February, then the final five by early March. The winner will be honored on Monday of Final Four weekend in Indianapolis.

Four OVC Players Named to Lou Henson Award Watch List: Four OVC men's basketball players have been named to the Lou Henson Award Watch list by CollegeInsider.com. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The OVC selections included Southeast Missouri senior guard **Jarekious Bradley**, Belmont junior guard **Craig Bradshaw**, Murray State sophomore guard **Cameron Payne** and Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Corey Walden**. The group are among 40 players nationally nominated for the award. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. The 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 men's NCAA Basketball Championship.

OVC to Produce 14-Game National Television Package: The OVC will produce the largest national television package in its history in 2014-15 as 14 Conference games will air on either the ESPN Family of Networks or the CBS Sports Network. The Conference will once again have seven games on the ESPN Family of Networks, including four regular season games as well as the OVC Tournament semifinals and championship game. The OVC will also have a seven-game package on CBS Sports Network, up from just four games on the network a season ago. The 14-game package ensures that every member institution is on national television at least once this year. In addition the OVC will produce five games that will air in select markets on the new American Sports Network.

Recent Postseason Success: Last year the OVC had four men's basketball teams selected for postseason play (1 NCAA, 1 NIT, 1 CIT, 1 CBI) which matched an all-time high for a single season, tying the mark set in 2011. Overall OVC teams were 7-3 in postseason play in 2014; the seven total wins were the most for the OVC in one postseason (topping four wins in the 1971 season). With wins by Belmont (who advanced to the NIT Quarterfinals) and Murray State (who won the CIT Championship), OVC teams have now at least won at least one game in postseason play for six-straight years (the longest stretch in league history). Also included in that mark are wins in four of the past six NCAA Tournaments.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 7th Among Active NCAA Coaches: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 25th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 389 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 471 for his career. Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** (who is in his third year in the OVC) has 700 career victories, which ranks seventh among active Division I head coaches. Loos and Byrd are two of just six active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boeheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe and Davidson's Bob McKillop).

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2015 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 4-7). It marks the fifth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the 10th time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967 and 1989. The OVC recently signed an extension with Municipal Auditorium to hold the tournament there through 2017. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. That format remains the same for the men's team, although the women's teams have switched back to a traditional bracket (1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc.) bracket this season. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium.

OVC Men's Hoops in Third Year of Divisional Play: For the third year the OVC will use divisional play for men's basketball (the OVC women's teams are not using divisional play this year). The addition of Belmont University on July 1, 2012 gave the OVC 12 member institutions, the largest the Conference has been since it was formed in 1948 (the OVC is currently the nation's eighth-oldest Division I conference). The East Division includes Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. The West Division includes Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin.

Former OVC Players in the NBA: There are currently four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his fourth season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and helped lead Team USA to a Gold Medal in the World Cup of Basketball this past summer. Former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan** is in his second year with the Houston Rockets after being drafted in the second round by the club. Former Belmont All-American **Ian Clark** signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz after doing undrafted and has a guaranteed deal with the Jazz this season. Former Tennessee State star **Robert Covington** was cut by Houston after spending last year with the team, but signed a free agent contract with the Philadelphia 76ers right after the season began. Two other former OVC players are currently playing in the NBDL: Travis Betran (Austin Peay) with the Erie BayHawks and Kevin Murphy (Tennessee Tech) with the Idaho Stampede.

The 2014-15 Season: The 2014-15 season marks the 67th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 66 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Murray State's Payne Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2014-15 OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Murray State sophomore guard **Cameron Payne** who was named the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Payne is the first sophomore to be named Preseason Player of the Year since the award was first handed out in 1993-94. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Murray State having the most selections (3) and Belmont (2) also having multiple picks. Payne was named both a first-team All-OVC selection and OVC Freshman of the Year after averaging 16.8 points, 5.4 assists, 3.6 rebounds and 1.7 steals/game and leading Murray State to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) Championship (where he was named MVP). In addition to Payne the other players named to the All-OVC Team last year and appearing on the preseason team this season are Southeast Missouri State senior guard **Jarekious Bradley**, Belmont junior guard **Craig Bradshaw**, Morehead State senior guard **Angelo Warner** and Murray State senior forward **Jarvis Williams**. The Preseason All-OVC Team was rounded out by Belmont senior guard **Reece Chamberlain**, Austin Peay junior center **Chris Horton**, Murray State senior guard **T.J. Sapp**, UT Martin senior forward **Myles Taylor** and Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Corey Walden**, who was the 2013-14 OVC Defensive Player of the Year.

Murray State Picked as OVC Preseason Favorite: In a vote of OVC head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Murray State has was picked the preseason favorite for the 2014-15 season. Murray State, who has won a league-best 23 OVC regular season championships, picked up 15 of 24 first-place votes in being picked the overall regular season champion. The Racers were also tabbed the West Division favorites, picking up 22 of 24 first-place votes in that category, while two-time defending regular season champion Belmont was picked the East Division favorites. In the overall champion voting, in addition to Murray State picking up 15 first-place votes other teams with first-place votes included Belmont (7), Eastern Kentucky (1) and Morehead State (1). Since Murray State was picked as the overall champion, they were also an overwhelming favorite to take first place in its own division; the Racers have finished first in the West in each of the first two years of divisional play. MSU received 132 total points to top the West and were followed by Southeast Missouri (who picked up the other 2 first-place votes and 109 points), SIUE (77), Austin Peay (70), Eastern Illinois (64) and UT Martin (40). Belmont picked up 16 of the 24 first-place votes and 125 points in being picked the East Division favorite while Morehead State (103) and Eastern Kentucky (102) each picked up four first-place votes. The East was rounded out by Tennessee Tech (71), Jacksonville State (52) and Tennessee State (40).

OVC Digital Network: The OVC launched the OVC Digital Network (OVCDN) in August 2012. The OVCDN is the exclusive home for live web streamed athletic contests involving OVC schools. This marks the eighth year the OVC has streamed live events, but the second year the events will be offered free of charge and in an HD format and will feature improved quality thanks to an investment in new equipment conference-wide. Fans will also find it easier to log onto OVCDigitalNetwork.com and access the streams and can do so without any registration. The events will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without needing any special downloads or apps thanks new streaming technology.

Team Notes

Austin Peay began last week by topping Tennessee State in the final seconds to score its first Conference victory of the season; the week ended with a home loss to Belmont...The Govs trailed the Tigers by 11 points with 6:26 to play and were down eight with 3:03 to go before making the dramatic comeback...Trailing by two points with on the final possession of the game, freshman Josh Robinson was fouled and made the first attempt before missing the second, but Zavion Williams tipped in the rebound to give APSU the lead with just six seconds left; TSU's final shot was no good as the Govs held on for the win...Robinson averaged 14.5 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals/game during the week...Williams scored 13 points in just 10 minutes against TSU...Despite falling to Belmont, the Govs scored a season-high 83 points against the Bruins while shooting 45.6 percent from the field (snapping a four-game streak of shooting less than 40 percent)...Chris Horton netted his ninth double-double of the season with 23 points and 12 rebounds against Belmont; Horton is now averaging 10.2 rebounds/game which ranks him 14th nationally...Horton is also pulling down 4.17 offensive rebounds/game, a mark that is sixth nationally...The Governors are third in the OVC in blocks (4.3/game)...Austin Peay will play a pair of road games this week, challenging SIUE on Thursday night and Eastern Illinois on Saturday...After those two games are finished the Govs will have played a stretch of five of seven games on the road.

Team Notes

Belmont lost its second-straight OVC game to start the week, falling 92-77 at Murray State; it marked the first time the Bruins had lost back-to-back Conference games since joining the OVC...But the Bruins rebounded by topping Austin Peay 89-83 on Saturday night to give head coach Rick Byrd his 700th career victory...Byrd is one of just seven active Division I head coaches with 700 victories...Sophomore Evan Bradds made 15-of-19 field goals (78.9%) last week to increase his season percentage to a Division I best 67.8 percent...Bradds had a team-high 22 points at Austin Peay after scoring 17 against the Racers; for the week Bradd averaged 19.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists/game while also hitting 9-of-10 free throw attempts...Sophomore newcomer Taylor Barnette knocked down 9-of-19 (47.4%) 3-pointers during the week and continues to lead the OVC in 3-pointers made/game (2.8); he had a team-high 19 points at Murray State and a key basket late in the win over Austin Peay...Freshman Tyler Hadden scored 10 of his career-high 13 points in the second half of Belmont's win over Austin Peay on Saturday; Hadden missed only one shot on the week...The Bruins rank first in the OVC in 3-pointers made (177) and second in scoring (73.7 points/game), free throw percentage (70.4%) and assists (15.1/game)...Belmont will host UT Martin on Thursday night and make the roughly four mile trip to Tennessee State on Sunday when they challenge the Tigers on a game that can be seen on the American Sports Network.

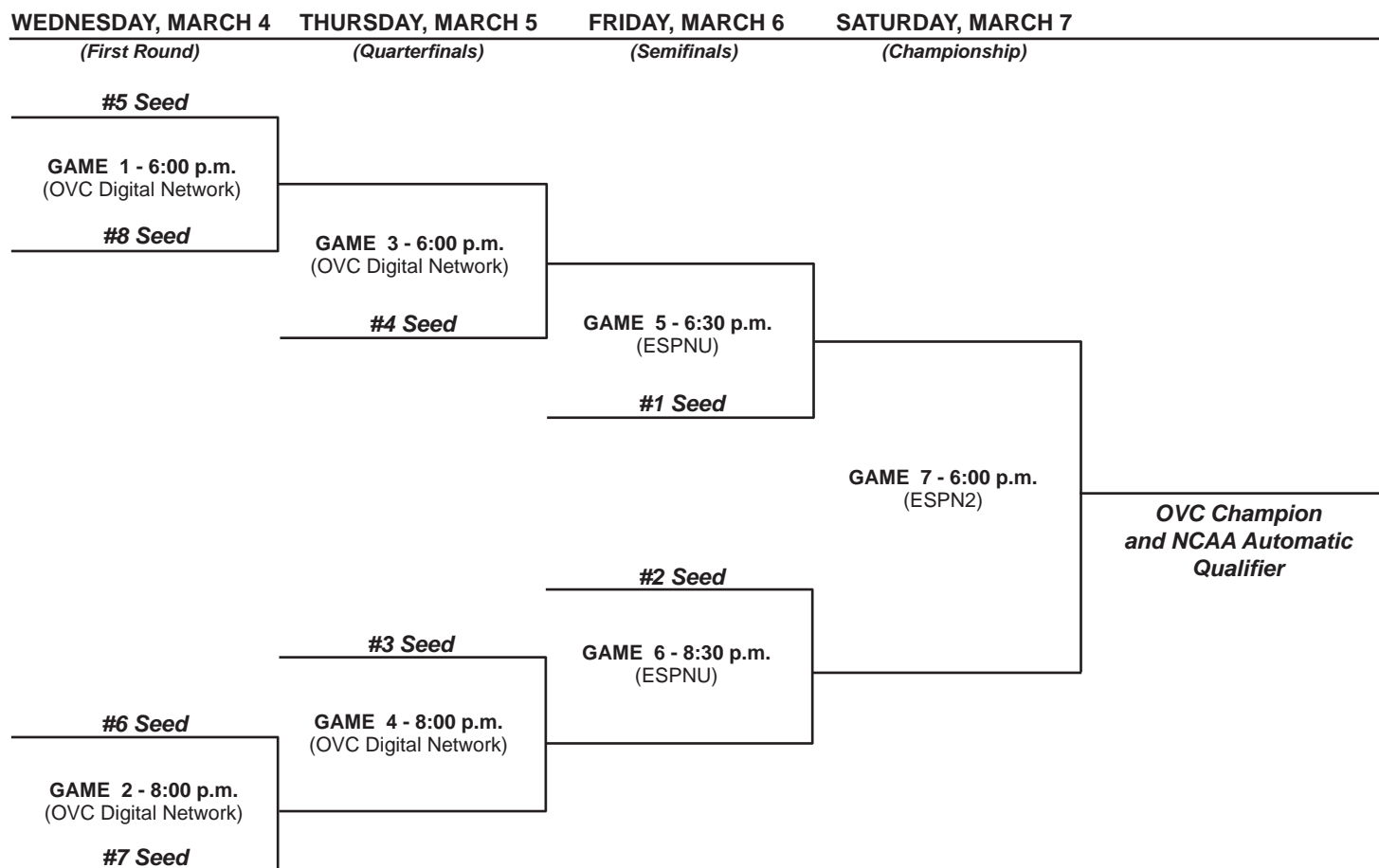
