THIS WEEK'S adidas® OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



PLAYER

Cameron Payne, G • So., 6-3, 180 • Memphis, Tenn. • Murray State

Payne averaged 27.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists/game in helping Murray State to a pair of road games to extend the team's winning streak to 15 games, tied for the seventh-longest streak in OVC history. Payne had a career-high 33 points on 12-of-20 shooting (3-of-5 3-pointers) in handing Eastern Illinois its first Conference loss of the season on Thursday. The point guard added four assists (against only one turnover) and pulled down five rebounds in the win. At SIUE he hit 4-of-6 3-pointers on his way to 22 points in a full 40 minutes of action. Payne also had six assists, six rebounds and a steal in that win. For the week Payne hit 51.2 percent (21-of-41) from the field, 63.6 percent (7-of-11) from 3-point range and was a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. Payne ranks first in the OVC in scoring (19.2 points/game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (2.5), second in assists (5.9/game) and steals (2.0/game), third in 3-pointers made/game (2.2) and fifth in free throw percentage (77.1%). It marks the fourth time this season he has been named OVC Player of the Week.

NEWCOMER

Charles Jackson, C • Jr., 6-10, 225 • Sacramento, Calif. • Tennessee Tech

Jackson, the transfer from College of Southern Idaho, averaged 18.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 1.5 blocks and 1.5 steals/game while hitting 78.9 percent (15-of-19) from the field in a pair of games. In an overtime win over Eastern Kentucky on Saturday, he recorded his NCAA-leading 14th double-double of the season by scoring 18 points and hauling in 10 rebounds; in that game he also had two steals and a blocked shot while hitting 8-of-10 from the field. He started the week with 18 points, five rebounds, two blocks and a steal against Morehead State. Jackson ranks second in the OVC in rebounding (9.2/game), fifth in field goal percentage (59.4%) and blocks (1.3/game) and 11th in scoring (14.0 points/game).

FRESHMAN

Josh Robinson, G • Fr., 6-3, 190 • St. Louis, Mo. • Austin Peay

Robinson averaged 14.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals/game last week as Austin Peay split a pair of road Conference games. Robinson earned his third start of the season at SIUE, where he led the Govs with 17 points, including hitting a trio of 3-pointers while also pulling down five rebounds (three offensive) and netting two steals. At Eastern Illinois on Saturday he helped Austin Peay to its first road win of the season, scoring 11 points including a pair of late 3-pointers that capped a 13-point second half comeback. He was also key at the end of the game when he knocked down 3-of-4 free throws as the team pulled out a four-point victory. Robinson has now scored in double figures in five-straight games.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Murray State won a pair of road games last week to improve to 7-0 in OVC play, giving the program a two-game lead over every other team in the Conference...The Racers are now 15 games in a row, tied for the seventh-longest winning streak in OVC history; the streak is the third-longest active streak nationally (behind only Kentucky and Virginia)...Belmont sophomore Evan Bradds enters this week leading all Division I players in field goal percentage (69.8%) while Tennessee Tech junior Charles Jackson is first nationally in double-doubles (14)...So far this season teams from the West Division are 21-11 against teams from the East Division; in the first two years of division play, East teams were a combined 50-22 against teams from the West...Entering this week two OVC teams are ranked in the Top 100 of the NCAA RPI: Murray State (82) and Belmont (94)...Murray State is also the highest ranked OVC team in the KenPom rankings, coming in at No. 65...Murray State enters the week with eight true road victories, the most of any Division I team.

Overall Winning Streaks: Entering this week Murray State has won 15-straight games which is the third-best active streak nationally behind only a pair of undefeated teams.

Longest Winning Streaks in OVC History: After setting the OVC record for longest winning streak during the 2011-12 season, Murray State has put together another long winning streak this season, reeling off 15-straight wins after Saturday's victory at SIUE. They are one of eight teams all-time in OVC history to have a winning streak of 15 games or longer.

Road Warriors: Entering the week Murray State has an 8-1 record in true road games. The eight overall road wins are the most of any Division I team.

700 Club: Belmont head coach Rick Byrd became just the seventh active Division I head coach to reach the 700 win plateau on January 17 when his team won at Austin Peay. With the 700 victories Byrd joins an elite group that also includes Mike Krzyzewski, Jim Boeheim, Bob Huggins, Roy Williams, Bo Ryan and Rick Pitino (Youngstown State's Jerry Slocum needs just two more wins entering this week to become the eighth active member). All-time the now 702 career wins rank Byrd 25th in NCAA Division I history.

Eastern Kentucky Posts 28-Point Road Win Over Nationally-Ranked Miami; Second-Largest Ever By OVC Team: Eastern Kentucky made history when it went on the road and beat No. 18 Miami (Fla.) 72-44 on December 19. It was the first victory over a nationally-ranked non-conference opponent for the team since topping No. 6 Dayton on Dec. 9, 1967. It is the second-largest victory over a Top 25 team by an OVC team, trailing only a 31-point win by Western Kentucky over No. 15 St. Bonaventure on January 3, 1953 (94-63 at a neutral site in Oklahoma City). NCAA Stats Leaders: In the latest NCAA statistical leaders (Jan. 26), Eastern Kentucky ranks second nationally in turnover margin (+8.5/game), fifth in steals (10.2/game), 12th in free throw percentage (75.7%) and 16th in 3-pointers made/game (9.0). Murray State ranks 15th in field goal percentage (48.9%), 17th in 3-point percentage (39.9%), 18th in scoring offense (78.6 points/game), 22nd in assists (16.0/game), 25th in scoring margin (+11.9 points/game) and 27th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.36). Belmont ranks seventh in 3-pointers made/game (9.7). Individually Tennessee Tech's **Charles Jackson** is first nationally in double-doubles (14), 12th in field goal percentage (59.4%) and 31st in rebounding (9.2/game). Belmont's **Evan Bradds** is first in field goal percentage (69.8%), teammate **Craig Bradshaw** is 30th in scoring (19.1 points/game) and 35th in 3-point percentage (41.5%) and **Reece Chamberlain** is 14th in assists (6.0/game). Murray State's **Cameron Payne** is 17th in assists (5.9/game), 26th in scoring (19.2 points/game) and 44th in steals (2.05/game). Eastern Kentucky's **Corey Walden** is fifth in steals (2.74/game) and 35th in scoring (18.7 points/game) while teammate **Eric Stutz** is ninth in field goal percentage (60.4%). Austin Peay's **Chris Horton** is ninth in double-doubles (11), 13th in rebounding (10.6/game) and 37th in blocked shots (2.3/game). Southeast Missouri's **Jarekious Bradley** is third nationally in free throw percentage (92.9%).

Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll: In the latest Colleg Insider.com Mid-Major Poll (Jan. 19 - the newest poll is not yet available), Murray State is ranked eighth, Belmont is 20th and Eastern Illinois entered the poll at 23rd while Eastern Kentucky was among the others receiving votes. Gonzaga picked up all 31 first-place votes to be ranked No. 1. Now in its 16th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast. 2015 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2015 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4-7 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tennessee. The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams with the men's teams playing a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals and the women's team playing a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. bracket.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on the OVC Digital Network. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6:30 and 8:30 p.m. and televised on ESPNU. The championship game on Saturday, March 7 is at 6 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6 (ESPN3) and the women's championship game is on March 7 at 1:00 p.m. CT (ESPN3).

This marks the 21st time in 22 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the sixth year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. The deadline to request credentials is **MONDAY, MARCH 2 at 3 p.m.** No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).

Belmont's Chamberlain Named Candidate for Senior CLASS Award: Belmont senior **Reece Chamberlain** is one of 30 Division I men's basketball players selected as candidates for the 2014-15 Senior CLASS Award®. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The complete list of candidates follows this release. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The candidate classes will be narrowed to 10 finalists later in the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one male candidate and one female candidate who best exemplify excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition. The Senior CLASS Award winner will be announced during the 2015 NCAA Men's Final Four®.

UTM's Smith Among Rare Company With Stat-Filled Game: UT Martin senior guard **Deville Smith** put himself in rare company with his performance at Illinois-Chicago on December 15. Smith had 26 points, 7 assists, 6 rebounds, 5 blocks and 3 steals in the overtime victory over the Flames. He is the first Division I player to have a 25-point, 5-assist, 5-rebound, 5-block and 3-steal performance against a fellow Division I team since Minnesota's Joel Przybilla against Iowa in 1999-00 (Przybilla had 28 points, 18 rebounds, 7 blocks, 5 assists and 3 steals).

Horton Records 10th Triple-Double in OVC History: Austin Peay junior **Chris Horton** recorded just the 10th triple-double in OVC history on Nov. 16 when he had 15 points, 13 rebounds and 10 blocks against Berea College. It was the most points by a Belmont player in the program's Division I era and the second-most points by a Division I player this season. Payne Named Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Week by CollegeInsider.com (Dec. 15): Murray State sophomore **Cameron Payne** was named the Lou Henson Mid-Major Player of the Week by CollegeInsider.com on Dec. 15 following his play at Evansville. Payne scored a career-high 32 points as Murray State won 81-79; the sophomore hit 10-of-19 field goals attempts, 4-of-7 3-pointers and 8-of-12 free throws while also adding eight assists, five rebounds and two steals in 35 minutes of action. Payne scored 20 of his 32 points in the first half as MSU built a 42-38 halftime advantage.

Bradshaw Named National Player of the Week by NBCSports.com (Dec. 1): Belmont's **Craig Bradshaw** was named the National Player of the Week by NBCSports.com/CollegeBasketballTalk following his play in three games that saw him average 33.0 points, 3.7 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.0 steals/game while hitting 58.2 percent (32-of-55) from the field, 58.6 percent (17-of-29) from 3-point range and 75 percent (18-of-24) from the free throw line in three Belmont victories. After scoring 29 and 28 points in games to open the week he hit 8-of-12 3-pointers on his way to a Belmont Division I scoring record of 42 points at Ohio; in that game he also raced the length of the court and hit the game-winning basket to lift his team to a 83-81 victory.

Payne Named to Cousy Award Watch List: Murray State's **Cameron Payne** has been named to the watch list of candidates for the 2015 Bob Cousy Collegiate Point Guard of the Year Award. The annual honor, named for Hall of Famer and former Boston Celtic Bob Cousy, recognizes the top point guards in men's college basketball. The Watch List included 35 players right now and will be narrowed to 20 in early February, then the final five by early March. The winner will be honored on Monday of Final Four weekend in Indianapolis.

Two OVC Players On Midseason Lou Henson Award Watch List: Two OVC men's basketball players have been named to the midseason Lou Henson Award Watch list by CollegeInsider.com. The Lou Henson Award is presented annually to the Division I "Mid-Major" Player of the Year. The OVC selections included Murray State sophomore guard **Cameron Payne** and Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Corey Walden**. The group are among 40 players nationally nominated for the award. The award is named in honor of Henson who retired after a spectacular coaching career that lasted 41 years. The 2015 recipient will be announced at the CollegeInsider.com Awards Banquet on April 3 in Indianapolis, site of the 2015 men's NCAA Basketball Championship.

OVC to Produce 14-Game National Television Package: The OVC will produce the largest national television package in its history in 2014-15 as 14 Conference games will air on either the ESPN Family of Networks or the CBS Sports Network. The Conference will once again have seven games on the ESPN Family of Networks, including four regular season games as well as the OVC Tournament semifinals and

championship game. The OVC will also have a seven-game package on CBS Sports Network, up from just four games on the network a season ago. The 14-game package ensures that every member institution is on national television at least once this year. In addition the OVC will produce five games that will air in select markets on the new American Sports Network.

Recent Postseason Success: Last year the OVC had four men's basketball teams selected for postseason play (1 NCAA, 1 NIT, 1 CIT, 1 CBI) which matched an all-time high for a single season, tying the mark set in 2011. Overall OVC teams were 7-3 in postseason play in 2014; the seven total wins were the most for the OVC in one postseason (topping four wins in the 1971 season). With wins by Belmont (who advanced to the NIT Quarterfinals) and Murray State (who won the CIT Championship), OVC teams have now at least won at least one game in postseason play for six-straight years (the longest stretch in league history). Also included in that mark are wins in four of the past six NCAA Tournaments.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Byrd Ranks 7th Among Active NCAA Coaches: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, 2009, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 25th year at Austin Peay. Loos now has 390 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 472 for his career. Belmont head coach **Rick Byrd** (who is in his third year in the OVC) has 702 career victories, which ranks seventh among active Division I head coaches. Loos and Byrd are two of just six active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years (the others are Syracuse's Jim Boeheim, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, Oakland's Greg Kampe and Davidson's Bob McKillop).

OVC Tournament Once Again at Municipal Auditorium: The 2015 OVC Tournament will be once again be played at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. (March 4-7). It marks the fifth-straight year the tournament has been at the venue and the 10th time the combined men's and women's tournaments have been held at the venue (1994, 1995, 1996, 2004, 2008, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014); the men's tournament was also held there in 1967 and 1989. The OVC recently signed an extension with Municipal Auditorium to hold the tournament there through 2017. Beginning in 2011 the Championship switched to a format where the top eight men's and women's teams play in the merit-based format. The No. 1 and 2 seeds received two byes to the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds received one bye into the quarterfinals. The first round included the No. 5 seed against the No. 8 seed and the No. 6 seed against the No. 7 seed. That format remains the same for the men's team, although the women's teams have switched back to a traditional bracket (1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc.) bracket this season. As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements included upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium.

OVC Men's Hoops in Third Year of Divisional Play: For the third year the OVC will use divisional play for men's basketball (the OVC women's teams are not using divisional play this year). The addition of Belmont University on July 1, 2012 gave the OVC 12 member institutions, the largest the Conference has been since it was formed in 1948 (the OVC is currently the nation's eighth-oldest Division I conference). The East Division includes Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. The West Division includes Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin.

Former OVC Players in the NBA: There are currently four former OVC players on NBA rosters. Former Morehead State All-American **Kenneth Faried** was the No. 22 overall pick in the 2011 NBA Draft and is in his fourth season with the Denver Nuggets. Faried was a two-time OVC Player of the Year, three-time OVC Defensive Player of the Year and set the NCAA Modern Era (since 1973) Rebounding record during his career. Faried was named to the NBA All-Rookie Team in 2012 and helped lead Team USA to a Gold Medal in the World Cup of Basketball this past summer. Former Murray State All-American **Isaiah Canaan** is in his second year with the Houston Rockets after being drafted in the second round by the club. Former Belmont All-American **Ian Clark** signed a free agent deal with the Utah Jazz after doing undrafted and has a guaranteed deal with the Jazz this season. Former Tennessee State star **Robert Covington** was cut by Houston after spending last year with the team, but signed a free agent contract with the Philadelphia 76ers right after the season began. Two other former OVC players are currently playing in the NBDL: Travis Betran (Austin Peay) with the Erie BayHawks and Kevin Murphy (Tennessee Tech) with the Idaho Stampede.

The 2014-15 Season: The 2014-15 season marks the 67th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 66 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

Murray State's Payne Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2014-15 OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Murray State sophomore guard **Cameron Payne** who was named the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Payne is the first sophomore to be named Preseason Player of the Year since the award was first handed out in 1993-94. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Murray State having the most selections (3) and Belmont (2) also having multiple picks. Payne was named both a first-team All-OVC selection and OVC Freshman of the Year after averaging 16.8 points, 5.4 assists, 3.6 rebounds and 1.7 steals/game and leading Murray State to the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) Championship (where he was named MVP). In addition to Payne the other players named to the All-OVC Team last year and appearing on the preseason team this season are Southeast Missouri State senior guard **Jarekious Bradley**, Belmont junior guard **Craig Bradshaw**, Morehead State senior guard **Angelo Warner** and Murray State senior forward **Jarvis Williams**. The Preseason All-OVC Team was rounded out by Belmont senior guard **Reece Chamberlain**, Austin Peay junior center **Chris Horton**, Murray State senior guard **T.J. Sapp**, UT Martin senior forward **Myles Taylor** and Eastern Kentucky senior guard **Corey Walden**, who was the 2013-14 OVC Defensive Player of the Year.

Murray State Picked as OVC Preseason Favorite: In a vote of OVC head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors Murray State has was picked the preseason favorite for the 2014-15 season. Murray State, who has won a league-best 23 OVC regular season championships, picked up 15 of 24 first-place votes in being picked the overall regular season champion. The Racers were also tabbed the West Division favorites, picking up 22 of 24 first-place votes in that category, while two-time defending regular season champion Belmont was picked the East Division favorites. In the overall champion voting, in addition to Murray State picking up 15 first-place votes other teams with first-place votes included Belmont (7), Eastern Kentucky (1) and Morehead State (1). Since Murray State was picked as the overall champion, they were also an overwhelming favorite to take first place in its own division; the Racers have finished first in the West in each of the first two years of divisional play. MSU received 132 total points to top the West and were followed by Southeast Missouri (who picked up the other 2 first-place votes and 109 points), SIUE (77), Austin Peay (70), Eastern Illinois (64) and UT Martin (40). Belmont picked up 16 of the 24 first-place votes and 125 points in being picked the East Division favorite while Morehead State (103) and Eastern Kentucky (102) each picked up four first-place votes. The East was rounded out by Tennessee Tech (71), Jacksonville State (52) and Tennessee State (40).

OVC Digital Network: The OVC launched the OVC Digital Network (OVCDN) in August 2012. The OVCDN is the exclusive home for live web streamed athletic contests involving OVC schools. This marks the eighth year the OVC has streamed live events, but the second year the events will be offered free of charge and in an HD format and will feature improved quality thanks to an investment in new equipment conference-wide. Fans will also find it easier to log onto [OVCDigitalNetwork.com](#) and access the streams and can do so without any registration. The events will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without needing any special downloads or apps thanks new streaming technology.

Team Notes

Austin Peay began last week with a 69-65 road loss to SIUE but rebounded to hand Eastern Illinois its second OVC loss of the season by winning 56-52 in Charleston...The road win was the first for the team in 11 true road games this season...It also marked the first Saturday victory of the season for APSU...Freshman Josh Robinson made his third career start at SIUE and led the team with 17 points, including a trio of 3-pointers, while also adding five rebounds and two steals; at EIU he had key back-to-back 3-pointers that capped a 13-point second half comeback and later made 3-of-4 free throws in the final five seconds to seal the four-point win...For the week Robinson, this week's OVC Freshman of the Week, averaged 14.0 points, 4.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals/game...In winning at EIU (the OVC's leader in scoring defense), the Gobs did so for the first time this season when scoring fewer than 60 points; Austin Peay is now 1-6 this season when scoring less than 60...Chris Horton had a pair of double-doubles last week to increase his season total to 11; he has now had a double-double in three-straight games...Horton enters this week with 238 career blocks, just three away from moving into a tie for third-place in OVC history...Horton had 16 rebounds at SIUE and now ranks 13th nationally in rebounding at 10.6/game...Austin Peay begins a stretch where they will play five-straight games at the Dunn Center, a place where they are 5-2 this season...The week includes a Wednesday night game with Morehead State and a Saturday contest with Southeast Missouri.

Team Notes

Belmont won a pair of games last week (UT Martin and Tennessee State) to run its winning streak to three games and improve to 5-2 in the OVC...The Bruins are in sole possession of first place in the East Division...Sophomore Evan Bradds connected on 12-of-13 (92.3%) field goals last week and continues to lead all Division I players with a 69.8 field goal percentage; if the season ended today that mark would be second in OVC history (trailing a 70.0% by MTSU's Warren Kidd in 1990-91)...Bradds is hitting 80.7 percent (46-of-57) from the field in seven OVC games this season...Bradds averaged 15.5 points and 12.0 rebounds/game last week including 22 points and 15 rebounds against UT Martin and a career-high 14 rebounds against TSU...Against TSU on Sunday the team trailed by 15 points in the first half before storming back to top its in-city rival by eight points...Craig Bradshaw, who ranks second in the OVC in scoring at 19.1 points/game, hit 3-of-6 3-pointers on the way to 21 points against UTM and added 11 points, four rebounds, three assists and two steals in the win over TSU...Senior Reece Chamberlain, who was named a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award, had 10 points, five assists and three rebounds against Tennessee State after totaling 14 points, five assists, four rebounds and three steals versus UT Martin...The Bruins rank first in the OVC in total 3-pointers made (194) and third in scoring (73.1 points/game), field goal percentage (45.6%) and assists (14.7/game)...Belmont returns to the Curb Event Center this week to host Jacksonville State on Thursday and Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

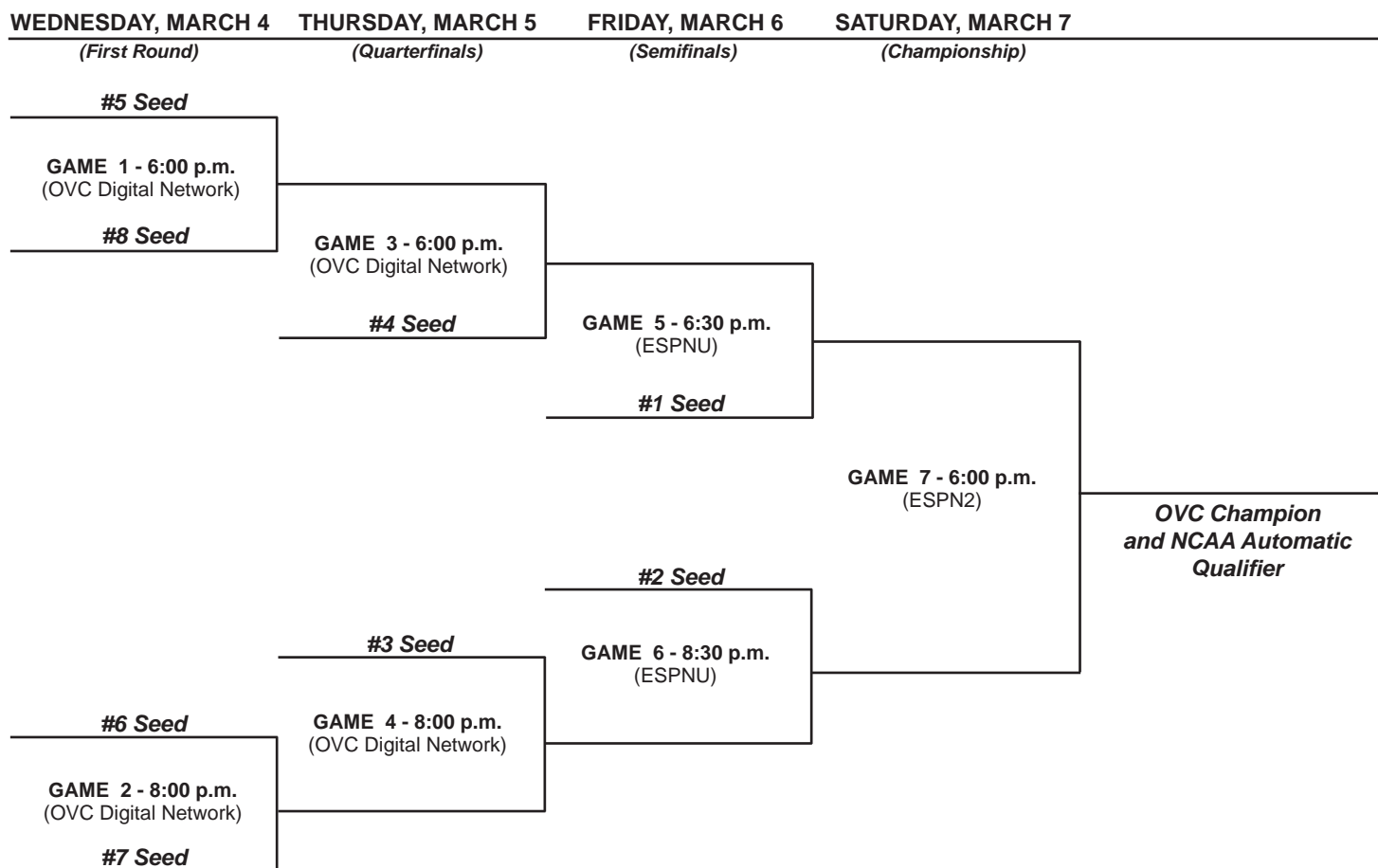
