Opening Statement

"That was an ugly game, it was a hard fought game and there were two teams just trying to find their way through the first round of the tournament. I thought our team, from an offensive standpoint, had first game jitters. SEMO made it tough on our guys and I feel as though we were lucky to get out of this game the winners. We made it out of the first one still living and we have another chance to play better basketball tomorrow."

Morehead State moves on to face UT Martin on Thursday at 7:00 p.m.

The Eagles improve to 30-40 all-time in the OVC Tournament.

Sean Woods is now 3-2 in the Tournament during his tenure at Morehead State.

Morehead State improves to 27-17 all-time against SEMO.

The Eagles made 6-of their last-7 shots down the stretch.

Billy Reader (18 points, 10 rebounds) was three points shy of his career-high.

SEMO falls to 10-13 in OVC Tournament games.

With the loss, SEMO is now 4-5 in the Municipal Auditorium.
