2015 OVC Softball Team Notes

AUSTIN PEAY (8-26 overall, 4-11 OVC): Austin Peay dropped a doubleheader to Evansville and was a swept by SIUE last week. Senior **Laurel Burroughs** stole three bases last week, giving her 19 on the season, setting a school single-season record. Junior **Courtney Brower** was hit by a pitch for the 13th time this season breaking the school single-season record of 12 she set last season. Austin Peay's extra-inning contest in game 2 versus Evansville was the 31st of the season. The Lady Govs will host Middle Tennessee on Tuesday and Southern Illinois on Thursday before traveling to Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State for doubleheaders this weekend.

BELMONT (9-27 overall, 4-12 OVC): Belmont dropped three games at Morehead State last week. Sophomore **Amy Zeronian** led the team with a 2-for-3 effot in the series finale with the Eagles. She finished the week with four hits and one RBI. Belmont will travel to Middle Tennessee on Wednesday, SIUE on Saturday and Eastern Illinois on Sunday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (14-21 overall, 9-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois dropped a pair to Ball State before going 2-1 at UT Martin. In the second game with the Skyhawks, freshman **Jessica Wireman** tossed her first career no-hitter. She also picked up the win in the series finale with UTM. For the week, she struck out 13 in 27.1 innings of work. Senior **Hannah Cole** hit .556 over the five games last week. She had 10 hits, three runs scored, two doubles, one home run, two RBI and one stolen base. The Panthers will travel to Butler on Wednesday before hosting Tennessee State and Belmont for doubleheaders this weekend.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (18-22 overall, 7-6 OVC): Eastern Kentucky dropped a doubleheader to No. 11 Tennessee before sweeping a three-game series with Tennessee State. Senior **Katie Tackett** hit safely in four of the five games last week. She hit two home runs and tied a personal-high five RBI in the first win over Tennessee State. She knocked in four of EKU's six runs in the doubleheader at Tennessee. She finished the week with six hits, the runs scored, three home runs and 10 RBI. Freshman **Paige Murphy** has reached base safely in 14 straight games, a team season high. Eastern Kentucky will host No. 13 Kentucky in its annual Autism Awareness games. The Colonels will also travel to UT Martin and Southeast Missouri for doubleheaders this weekend.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (26-13 overall, 9-5 OVC): Jacksonville State defeated Alabama State at home before going 1-2 versus Tennessee Tech on the road last week. The Gamecocks will return home to host Georgia Tech for a single game on Wednesday, Murray State for a pair on Saturday and Austin Peay for a doubleheader on Sunday.

MOREHEAD STATE (16-18 overall, 7-7 OVC): Morehead State swept a three-game series with Belmont last week. Freshman pitcher Mackenzie Grossman picked up a pair of wins, including the complete game shutout in the series finale. She allowed just one earned run and struck out nine in 14.0 innings of work. She has now won six of her last eight decisions. Senior Katie Raile recorded one hit in all three games. She had four hits, including one double while also driving in a pair of runs. The Eagles have played three straight errorless contests after committing seven miscues in its previous four games. Morehead State will host Wright State for a twinbill on Wednesday before travel to Southeast Missouri and UT Martin for doubleheaders this weekend.

MURRAY STATE (25-14 overall,12-5 OVC): Murray State dropped both ends of a doubleheader to Western Kentucky before sweeping a three-games series with Southeast Missouri. Junior Shelbey Miller hit safely in each game last week. She recorded multiple hits on three occasions and turned in 3-for-4 performances against both WKU and Southeast Missouri. She finished the week with 10 hits, four runs score, one double, one RBI and two stolen bases. Freshman pitcher Haven Campbell allowed just two earned runs over 8.1 innings of work for a 0.84 ERA last week. She earned one save and struck out three last week. The Racers will travel to Jacksonville State for a twinbill on Saturday and Tennessee Tech for a doubleheader on Sunday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (10-21 overall, 5-10 OVC): Southeast Missouri defeated Southern Illinois before being swept by Murray State in a three games series. The Redhawks will look to return to the win column as they host Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky for doubleheader this weekend.

SIUE (32-9 overall, 14-3 OVC): SIUE took three games from Austin Peay last week. The Cougars have passed the 30-win mark and have more wins than it did last season when it won the OVC Tournament. It marked the 20th time in head coach Sandy Montgomery's career that her team has won 30 or more games in a season. Junior Haley Chambers recorded double-digit strike outs for the third straight outing last week, giving her 12 double-digit strikeout performances this year. Chambers also hit .455 with the runs scored, one double, one home run and five RBI. Freshman Baylee Douglass picked up a pair of wins last week to give her a league-leading 8-1 record in OVC play. She struck out 14 and gave up just two runs in 12.0 innings of work. SIUE will host Saint Louis for a single game on Wednesday, Belmont for two on Saturday and Tennessee State for a doubleheader on Sunday.

TENNESSEE STATE (9-28 overall, 2-14 OVC): Tennessee State fell to Middle Tennessee and was swept by Eastern Kentucky in a three-game series. The Tigers hit five home runs during the EKU series, including a pair by **Lindsey Burgess.** She now has seven home runs on the season and 14 in her career, placing her second on TSU's single-season list and third on the career list. Sophomore **Joselyn Yates** led the team with a .583 batting average. She had seven hits and walked two times for a .643 on-base percentage. She also had a double and a run scored. Tennessee State will travel to Western Kentucky on Wednesday, Eastern Illinois on Saturday and SIUE on Sunday.

TENNESSEE TECH (24-20 overall, 11-6 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped both ends of a doubleheader with Georgia State before going 2-1 against Jacksonville State last week. Junior **Sabrie Neeb** recorded eight hit, six of them went for extra-bases. She had four doubles, one triple and one home run. She scored four times and drove in a run. Tennessee Tech will travel to Lipscomb on Wednesday before returning home to host doubleheaders with Austin Peay on Saturday and Murray State on Sunday.

UT MARTIN (21-18 overall, 9-7 OVC): UT Martin went 1-2 against Eastern Illinois last week. The Skyhawks won the series-opener and dropped the next two games. UT Martin will continue its home stand as it host doubleheaders with Memphis on Wednesday, Eastern Kentucky on Saturday and Morehead State on Sunday.
