THIS WEEK'S OVC HIGHLIGHTS/STORYLINES

UT Martin is the only undefeated team in Conference play while Austin Peay, Southeast Missouri and Tennessee State each have one loss...UTM has won six games in a row, which is its longest winning streak since its 2006 OVC Championship season...Tennessee State won its third-straight game, shutting out EIU 28-0, to improve to 2-1 in OVC play...It marked the first three-game winning streak for the team since 2017, and first shutout against an OVC (or Division I) opponent since 2013...Austin Peay snapped a three-game losing streak by topping rival Murray State for the fifth-straight time...UT Martin is ranked No. 12/13 in the major polls this week, its highest ranking since the 2006 season...Every current OVC team has been ranked at least one week in the Top 25 over the past five years (2016-20)...SEMO's Geno Hess is second nationally with 12 rushing touchdowns; he ranked first in that category last year (12)...Overall four OVC players rank in the Top 12 nationally in rushing touchdowns; the OVC is the only Conference with more than two players in the Top 12...For the fourth-straight week, Tennessee Tech's David Gist rushed for over 100 yards, becoming the first Golden Eagle player since Derek White in the 2007 campaign to have four consecutive 100-yard games...As of October 24, there are 15 former OVC players on NFL rosters (8 active, 4 practice squad, 3 injured reserve)...The OVC and Southland Conference announced plans for a football scheduling alliance for the 2022 and 2023 seasons; the planned collaboration will see institutions from each conference fill available non-conference dates on schedules in the next two years with a focus toward competitive balance and reasonable travel...More specific details on the alliance, including game matchups in 2022 and 2023, will be announced at a later date...This year the League consists of seven football-playing schools who will play a six-game Conference schedule; additionally, some OVC schools will play other OVC opponents in designated matchups that will not count in the Conference standings (four games total, all of which have now been completed)...Two OVC players were named to each the Walter Payton Award Watch List (Draylen Ellis, Geno Hess) and the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List (Marcis Floyd, Kordell Jackson); the awards are presented by Stats Perform to the National Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year at the FCS level...This year's FCS Playoffs will include 24 teams and the field will be announced on Sunday, November 21...The OVC has placed multiple teams in the FCS Playoffs seven times in the past 11 years; OVC teams have 12 playoff wins since 2013, including five Quarterfinal appearances and one National Championship game appearance...In 7 of the past 11 years, an OVC team has defeated a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent...Last academic year (2020-21), 187 football student-athletes were named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll for achieving a 3.25 GPA or better.

OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSIVE

Ahmaad Tanner, RB • 6-0, 205, Grad. • Dalton, Ga. • Austin Peay

Tanner carried the ball 20 times for a career-high 148 yards (7.4 ypc) and three touchdowns as Austin Peay snapped a three-game losing streak to best rival Murray State 47-6. Tanner opened the scoring with a 37-yard touchdown in the first quarter and added scores of 17 and 2 yards in the third quarter. He was part of an offensive attack that finished the day with 373 rushing yards (the seventh-most in school history). It marked his fourth multi-rushing touchdown game of the 2021 season (most among any OVC player). Tanner ranks 10th nationally in rushing touchdowns (9) and 26th in rushing yards (602).

CO-DEFENSIVE

James Green, LB • 6-1, 220, R-Jr. • Orlando, Fla. • Tennessee State

Green tallied six tackles (5 solo), a tackle for loss and an interception in Tennessee State's 28-0 win at Eastern Illinois. Green's interception came in the second quarter and he returned the pick 47 yards to the EIU 2-yard line, which led to a Tigers touchdown two plays later that put TSU ahead 7-0. His brother Josh also had an interception in the game. Tennessee State held Eastern Illinois to just 187 yards of total offense, netting its first shutout against an OVC opponent since 2013. It also marked the team's third-straight win, the longest streak for the team since 2017.

CO-DEFENSIVE

Devin Squires, DL • 6-0, 240, R-Fr. • Kings Mill, Ohio • Tennessee Tech

Squires had five tackles, 1.0 tackles for loss, 0.5 sacks and a quarterback hurry and returned a fumble for a touchdown in a 56-13 win over Virginia-Lynchburg. The second-year player (whose father Thomas is in the TTU Hall of Fame) assisted on a sack of the VUL quarterback, leading to a fumble recovery by Jack Warwick. When Warwick was hit, dislodging the ball again, Squires was there to pick it back up and carry it into the end zone for a 19-yard fumble recovery touchdown, that put the Golden Eagles up 21-0 in the first quarter.

SPECIALIST

Kenny Doak, K • 5-10, 200, Grad. • Perkasio, Pa. • Southeast Missouri

Doak was perfect on kicking in Southeast Missouri's game at No. 13 UT Martin. The graduate student hit 3-of-3 field goals (31, 37, 38) and 3-of-3 PATs to account for 12 total points. Doak also kicked off six times for 290 yards and two touchbacks. He is the Redhawks second-leading scorer with 53 points this year. He leads the OVC and ranks 17th nationally in field goals per game (1.43).

NEWCOMER

Keon Howard, QB • 6-1, 215, Grad. • Laurel, Miss. • UT Martin

Howard, a transfer from Tulane, earned his third Newcomer of the Week honor of the season after accounting for 241 yards of total offense as UT Martin topped Southeast Missouri 38-30 to win its sixth-straight game. Howard completed 17-of-25 passes for 221 and two touchdowns (8 and 51 yards) and had 10 carries for 20 net yards and two additional scores (1 and 5 yards). With his work on the ground, he set a pair of UTM single-season records by a quarterback for multiple rushing touchdown performances (three) and rushing touchdowns (eight). Howard ranks 11th nationally in points responsible for (114) and 12th in rushing touchdowns.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE GRIDIRON

OVC and Southland Announce Scheduling Alliance: On October 11, the OVC and Southland Conference announced plans for a football scheduling alliance between the two NCAA Division I FCS leagues in the 2022 and 2023 seasons. The planned collaboration will see institutions from each conference fill available non-conference dates on schedules in the next two years with a focus toward competitive balance and reasonable travel. In addition to providing quality Division I FCS non-conference matchups, the alliance will allow increased visibility, exposure and branding for each Conference. Both the OVC and Southland have longstanding ESPN broadcast agreements. More specific details, including game matchups in 2022 and 2023, will be announced later.

2021 Schedule: The 2021 OVC football schedule features a round robin format with the seven teams playing a six-game schedule. Additionally, some OVC schools will play other OVC opponents in designated matchups that will not count in the Conference standings (four games total).

Top 25 Polls: In the latest Top 25 polls, UT Martin is now moved up one spot to No. 12 in the FCS Coaches Poll and remained No. 13 in the Stats Perform poll. This marks the highest ranking for the Skyhawks since the 2006 season (when UTM won the OVC Championship). That year they were ranked as high as No. 8 (Nov. 6). No other OVC schools are currently receiving votes. Every current OVC team has been ranked at least one week in the Top 25 over the past five years.

OVC Has Four Among Top 12 Nationally in Rushing Touchdowns: Four OVC players (**Geno Hess**, **Ahmaad Tanner**, **Keon Howard** and **Zak Wallace**) rank in the Top 12 nationally in rushing touchdowns. Hess is third with 12, Tanner is 10th with nine and Howard and Wallace are tied for 12th with eight. The OVC is the only conference with more than two players in the top 12 of those rankings (six other conferences have two players).

Simpson Moves Into Fifth Place in OVC Career Victories: With a 35-7 win at Northwestern State on September 18, UT Martin head coach **Jason Simpson** recorded his 92nd career victory, tying him for 5th place in OVC history. He now has 96 wins.

Zita Moves Into Third Place in Career Field Goals: Tennessee State redshirt junior kicker **Antonio Zita** made his 50th career field goal on September 18 against Kentucky State, moving him into sole possession of fourth place in OVC history. Zita now has 53 field goals (third in OVC history) and is six away from the OVC record (held by TSU's Jamin Godfrey). His 53 made field goals is second among active FCS players.

Ellis and Hess Named to Walter Payton Award Watch List: A pair of OVC football players are among the 35 players nationally named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The selections were Austin Peay sophomore quarterback **Draylen Ellis** and Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess**. Named for the legendary Chicago Bears running back, the award enters its 35th season and is presented to the national offensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision. The Payton, first awarded in 1987, has been won by OVC players twice (both Eastern Illinois quarterbacks), Tony Romo in 2002 and Jimmy Garoppolo in 2013.

Jackson and Floyd Named to Buck Buchanan Award Watch List: A pair of OVC players are among the 35 players nationally named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The picks were Murray State cornerback **Marcis Floyd** and Austin Peay nickelback **Kordell Jackson**. The award, now in its 27th season, is presented to the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision and is named for the legendary defensive lineman. The OVC has had two winners of the award, Jacksonville State's Darius Jackson (2017) and Southeast Missouri's Zach Hall (2018).

OVC Players on NFL Rosters: As of October 24, there are 15 former Ohio Valley Conference players on NFL rosters (8 active, 4 practice squad, 3 injured reserve). Those players include former Eastern Illinois standout quarterback Jimmy Garoppolo, who has won two Super Bowl Championships with the Patriots and is now the starter for the San Francisco 49ers, who he led to the Super Bowl in 2019. Six of the seven current OVC football schools have at least one player in the NFL.

NCAA Division I Playoff Information: In 2010 the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoff field expanded to 20 teams, up from 16 previously, and in 2013 the field increased to 24 for the first time. The expansion in 2010 to 20 teams was the first since the field grew from 12 to 16 teams in 1997. The 24-team field is comprised of 10 automatic bids and 14 at-large berths. There are eight first round matchups (16 total teams), while eight (8) teams receive a bye into the second round. For the 13th time in 2021, the championship game will be played in Frisco, Texas at Toyota Stadium, a 20,500-seat multi-purpose stadium. The Southland Conference will serve as the host of the championship, which will be held on Saturday, January 8.

Recent Playoff Success: Beginning with the 2001 season the OVC went until 2013 without a FCS Playoff victory. But over the past eight seasons OVC teams have performed well in the playoffs, winning 12 total games and advancing to the FCS Quarterfinals three times in the past six seasons. In 2013 the OVC placed three teams in the field for the first-time ever (each won a game) and in 2015 the league had a team advance to the National Championship game (the first for the league since 1982). Over the past eight years five different OVC teams have won a playoff game.

Two OVC Players Named to CFPA FCS Performer of the Year Watch List: A pair of OVC football players have been named to the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) FCS National Performer of the Year Trophy Watch List. The duo included Austin Peay sophomore quarterback **Draylen Ellis** and Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess**. The two were among 44 players nationally named to the list. The 2021 CFPA FCS National Performer of the Year winner will be announced January 12, 2022.

Two OVC Players Named to FCS Punter of the Year Watch List: Two OVC players have been named to the 2021 FCS Punter of the Year Award Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council. The OVC picks, who were among the 20 nationally on the list, were Southeast Missouri's **Zach Haynes** and Tennessee State's **Kaleb Mosely**. The 2021 watch list was compiled based on the 2020 FCS Punter of the Year watchlist, the 2020 All-Conference teams, the 2020 All-American Teams and the 2021 pre-season All-Conference Teams. The FCS Punter of the Year Award winner will be voted on by the FCS Punter of the Year Award/Ray Guy Award Committee and will be announced after the regular season.

Sgt. York Trophy Presented by Delta Dental: Beginning in 2014 Delta Dental of Tennessee became the presenting sponsor of the Sgt. York Trophy. The trophy (founded in 2007 by the Nashville Sports Council and OVC) goes to the winner of the quadrangular season football series between the four OVC football-playing schools located in the state of Tennessee (Austin Peay, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin). The award is the only traveling trophy that involves four teams in college sports; there are three others that involve three teams, including the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. As a corporal in the 2nd Battalion, 328th Infantry, in the Battle of the Meuse River-Argonne (Oct. 8, 1918), York and seven other soldiers captured 132 prisoners, was promoted to sergeant and received the Distinguished Service Cross, the French Croix de Guerre, the French Legion of Honor, the Croce di Guerra of Italy and the War Medal of Montenegro. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor.

Two OVC Players Named Semifinalists for Campbell Trophy: Two OVC football student-athletes have been named semifinalists for the 2021 William V. Campbell Trophy®, college football's premier scholar-athlete award. The selections were Austin Peay linebacker **Jack McDonald** and Tennessee Tech tight end **Tavin Kilpatrick**. The duo were among just 36 selections at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) level. Overall there were 176 selections across all levels of college football. The NFF will announce 12-14 finalists on Oct. 27, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the 2021 NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class Presented by Fidelity Investments. Nominated by their schools, which are limited to one nominee each, candidates for the awards must be a senior or graduate student in their final year of playing eligibility, have a GPA of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale, have outstanding football ability as a first team player or significant contributor and have demonstrated strong leadership and citizenship. The class is selected each year by the NFF Awards Committee, which is comprised of a nationally recognized group of media, College Football Hall of Famers and athletics administrators.

Academic Success: During the past academic year (2020-21) there were 187 OVC football student-athletes who were named to the Commissioner's Honor Roll for having a 3.25 grade point average or higher. In addition, 17 student-athletes were awarded the OVC Academic Medal of Honor for achieving perfect 4.0 GPAs. The OVC also awards a Team Academic Award for the football program with the highest percentage of players with a 3.25 grade point average or higher; that award went to Austin Peay for 2020-21.

Doak Named National Specialist of the Week (Sept. 27): Southeast Missouri kicker **Kenny Doak** was named National Specialist of the Week by Stats Perform on September 27 after tallying a career-high 17 points in the Redhawks win over Tennessee State. The graduate student was 4-of-4 on field goals, connecting from 33, 40, 39 and 45 yards, and 5-of-5 on PAT's. The four made field goals was tied for the most by a FCS player in a game this season. Doak also kicked off four times for an average of 54 yards per kickoff with one touchback.

A Look at the Coaches: Entering 2021, six of seven head coaches returned to lead their teams from a season ago. The lone new coach is former Heisman Trophy winner and Tennessee Titans standout **Eddie George**, who was named Tennessee State's head coach in April. The former Heisman Trophy winner and member of the College Football Hall of Fame was a four-time Pro Bowl selection and a member of the Tennessee Titans/Houston Oilers Ring of Honor. The longest tenured coach in the league is UT Martin's **Jason Simpson** who is in his 16th season with the Skyhawks in 2021.

EIU's Cushing on Football Oversight Committee: Eastern Illinois head football coach **Adam Cushing** is the lone football coach on the NCAA Division I Football Oversight Committee and is serving a four-year term until June 30, 2024. The Football Oversight Committee ensures that appropriate oversight of football for both the Football Bowl Subdivision and Football Championship Subdivision is maintained, enhances the development of the sport and make recommendations related to regular-season and postseason football. The committee prioritizes enhancement of the student-athlete educational experience (academically and athletically), and in doing so, promotes student-athletes' personal growth and leadership development. It works in conjunction with appropriate governance entities to provide solutions to issues impacting the health and safety of football student-athletes. The committee supervises procedures for licensing of postseason bowls and qualifications and/or selection procedures for the FCS Championship. The committee reviews recommendations from the NCAA Division I Football Championship Committee and process other issues related to the administration of the FCS Championship. The committee provides direction to the NCAA Football Rules Committee regarding playing rules governing FBS and FCS football. The committee is comprised of representatives from each divisional subgroup that sponsors football.

Alexander on NCAA Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship: Beginning this season Tennessee Tech head coach **Dewayne Alexander** is on the NCAA's Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship. The committee's mission is to improve the condition of sportsmanship and ethical conduct in all aspects of college athletics by developing and implementing strategies that foster greater acceptance of the value of respect, fairness, civility, honesty and responsibility. Since the establishment of the committee, the group has focused on two areas: (1) provide best practices and creative tools (e.g., the RESPECT

campaign) for campus and conference implementation and (2) increase the awareness and profile of the NCAA Sportsmanship Awards.

Carlisle and Horton Named to Division I Football Oversight Committee Student-Athlete Connection Group: Tennessee Tech junior linebacker **Seth Carlisle** and Tennessee State junior defensive tackle **Raymond Horton** have been selected to participate in the Division I Football Oversight Committee Student-Athlete Connection Group (SACG). The connection group consists of 52 current players and its goal is to gather broad-based feedback from Division I football student-athletes on issues the Football Oversight Committee is reviewing. Among the priorities for the 2020-21 academic year are COVID-19 health and safety measures, transfer policies, name, image and likeness topics and social justice issues. Each Division I football conference has chosen two student-athlete representatives who will serve either one or two-year terms. The committee will meet quarterly to discuss issues and provide feedback to the Football Oversight Committee.

Week Zero: Eastern Illinois began this season with a Week Zero contest at Indiana State. It marked the fourth time an OVC team played during the week (2017, 2018, 2020, 2021). OVC teams are 1-3 all-time in games during Week Zero.

OVC Teams Against FBS Opponents: In seven of the past 11 seasons an OVC team has knocked off a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent (2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2020). OVC teams are 36-258-1 all-time against FBS opponents with eight total games (one remaining) on the 2021 schedule.

Murray State Tabbed Preseason OVC Favorite: Murray State has been picked the preseason football favorites in the OVC for the 2021 season. The Racers picked up seven of a possible 14 first-place votes in a poll of league head coaches and communications directors. It marks only the third time the Racers have been tabbed the preseason favorites and first time since 1996, when Houston Nutt was the head coach and the program was coming off an OVC Championship and NCAA Playoff appearance. The only other year the team was tabbed the favorite (dating back to the first preseason poll in 1978), was in 1980 when Mike Gottfried was head coach, and the team was once again coming off an OVC title and playoff appearance. Murray State totaled 64 points to finish just ahead of Austin Peay and Southeast Missouri, who tied for second-place with 60 points. The Governors and Redhawks were 2019 OVC Co-Champions and both appeared in the FCS Playoffs that season. UT Martin was tabbed fourth (38) and followed by Tennessee State (32), Tennessee Tech (28) and Eastern Illinois (12).

APSU's Ellis and Jackson Headline Preseason All-OVC Team: Austin Peay sophomore quarterback **Draylen Ellis** and Austin Peay graduate student nickelback **Kordell Jackson** were named the 2021 OVC Preseason Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in a vote of by the league's head football coaches and communications directors. Murray State led the way with 10 preseason selections, followed by Tennessee State with eight and Southeast Missouri with seven. Austin Peay and UT Martin had six selections apiece while Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech each had two. Returning players who were first-team All-OVC selections last year (25 in total) were automatic selections to the preseason team this year.

Romo Becomes Sixth College Football Hall of Famer With OVC Connections: In January 2021 it was announced that former Eastern Illinois quarterback **Tony Romo** had been selected to the 2021 College Football Hall of Fame Class. Romo is the third player that played in the OVC to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame joining Jim Youngblood from Tennessee Tech and George Floyd Jr., from Eastern Kentucky. Three former head coaches from the OVC have also been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame with Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky), James "Boots" Donnelly (Middle Tennessee/Austin Peay) and Frank Beamer (Murray State). At EIU Romo was the winner of the 2002 Walter Payton Award as the top player in the FCS. After going undrafted in 2003, he would put together a standout NFL career with the Dallas Cowboys from 2003-16. The four-time Pro Bowl selection holds Cowboy records for career passing yards and passing touchdowns. Since retiring with the Cowboys, Romo has served as the lead color analyst for CBS' NFL telecasts, working alongside Jim Nantz.

Four With OVC Connections in the Super Bowl: At the end of the NFL regular season, there were 11 former OVC players on active rosters and five others on active rosters. For Super Bowl LV, there were four individuals with connections to the OVC taking part in the game. Former Jacksonville State All-American wide receiver **Josh Pearson** was a member of the Tampa Bay practice squad while former Austin Peay head coach and quarterback **Rick Christophel** was the tight ends coach for the Buccaneers. Former Murray State player and OVC official **Jabir Walker** was an alternate on this year's officiating crew and former Eastern Illinois and Dallas Cowboys quarterback **Tony Romo** broadcasted his second Super Bowl for CBS alongside Jim Nantz.

Let's Get It Started: The 74th season of Ohio Valley Conference football got underway on Saturday, August 28 when Eastern Illinois played at Indiana State in a Week Zero game. The OVC is made up of seven football-playing schools in 2021. Since its beginning, 15 of the 18 total schools that have played football in the league have claimed at least one championship.

I-AA No More: Although some people may still refer to it as I-AA football, the term that represents the level of Division I football in which the Ohio Valley Conference competes has been long retired. Beginning with the 2006 National Championship game, the term Football Championship Subdivision (or FCS) is to be used. Teams who play at the FCS level can offer a maximum of 63 scholarships (Football Bowl Subdivision teams can offer 85) and compete in a playoff at the end of the season to determine the national champion.

FCS All-In: Each Saturday during the 2021 football season, "FCS All-In" will debut a new episode at 9am CT and be available on-demand on YouTube. The program is a collaborative effort of the NCAA's 15 Division I FCS Conferences, bringing weekly segments from each league. For more information visit www.youtube.com/c/FCSAllin.

ESPN+: The season every Conference football game (and select non-conference contests) will be broadcast on ESPN+. This marks the fourth year of the OVC's deal with ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer video service from The Walt Disney Company's Direct-to-Consumer & International segment. Fans can subscribe to ESPN+ for \$6.99 a month (or \$69.99 per year) or as part of a bundle with Disney+ and ad-supported Hulu (\$13.99/month). ESPN+ is an integrated part of the ESPN App and (on mobile and connected devices) and ESPN.com. More information can be found at www.OVCsports.com/ESPN.

SGT. YORK TROPHY

The 2021 season marks the 15th of competition for the Sergeant York Trophy, an award created by the Nashville Sports Council and the Ohio Valley Conference. The trophy is contested between the four OVC football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee - Austin Peay, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin - and goes to the team with the best combined record versus those schools in a given year.

The award is sponsored by Delta Dental of Tennessee.

In the event of a tie, the award will be shared; however, the previous winner will retain the trophy if they are part of the tie. If the tie is between two other institutions, the trophy will go to the institution that has gone the most seasons without winning the trophy.

The award is the only traveling trophy that involves four teams in college sports; there are three others that involve three teams, including the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor. Following the war York returned his home in Pall Mall, Tenn. where he dedicated his life to improving education and facilitating educational opportunities for children in the state of Tennessee.

OVC NOTABLES

- Every current OVC team has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past five years (2016-20).
- Last year three teams were ranked in the final Stats Perform Top 25, the first time since the 2013 season three OVC teams finished the season ranked in that poll.
- The OVC has placed multiple teams in the FCS Playoffs seven times in the past 11 years.
- OVC teams have 12 playoff wins since 2013, including five Quarterfinal appearances and one National Championship game appearance.
- Since 2013, the OVC has produced one Walter Payton Award Winner, two Buck Buchanan Award Winners, an Eddie Robinson Award Winner and a Deacon Jones Trophy winner. In addition, the league has had two Doris Robinson Award Winners, as the National Scholar-Athlete of the Year.
- In 7 of the past 11 years, an OVC team has defeated a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent.
- The OVC has produced at least one NFL Draft Pick in 10 of the past 14 years.
- In January 2020, OVC alum Jimmy Garoppolo became just the eighth former FCS quarterback to start a Super Bowl, doing so with the San Francisco 49ers. Last season (2020) 11 former OVC players were on active rosters at the end of the season.
- Former EIU quarterback Tony Romo was selected to the 2021 College Football Hall of Fame Class. He is the third former OVC player to be inducted (Jim Youngblood, George Floyd Jr.); in addition, there are also three former OVC coaches (Roy Kidd, Boots Donnelly, Frank Beamer) already enshrined.
- Over the previous 73 years, 15 of 18 teams that have competed have claimed at least one league championship.

NOTEWORTHY

- Southeast Missouri will host Eastern Illinois for its annual Homecoming Game in Cape Girardeau. Saturday marks the 29th all-time meeting between the schools.
- EIU holds an eight-win advantage in the all-time series, however, SEMO has won three in a row and four of the last five against the Panthers. That includes a 47-7 win in the opening game for both teams last spring.
- EIU had four turnovers and was limited to just 187 yards of total offense in a 28-0 loss to Tennessee State.
- Starting quarterback Otto Kuhns was intercepted three times, bringing his season total to eight. He was one of three quarterbacks who saw action for the Panthers.
- After battling injuries, Jaelin Benefield made his season debut, leading the Panthers with 56 rushing yards on seven carries (8.0 ypc) and also catching a pass.
- Cameron Leach led the team with nine tackles while Jordan Vincent and Jason Johnson added eight apiece. Johnson leads the OVC and ranks 15th nationally in tackles/game (9.8).
- SEMO trailed nationally-ranked UT Martin 31-10 with 8:11 to play in the third quarter before scoring 13-straight points to make it a one possession game. Another touchdown with six minutes to play once again made the margin one score, but the Redhawks were unable to move the ball on four plays on its final possession.
- Geno Hess reached 100 rushing yards for the third-straight week and fifth time this year with 137 yards on 18 carries. He scored the first touchdown of the game on a 66-yard run (the 30th rushing score of his career making him one of five players in school history to reach that mark). Hess ranks second nationally with 12 rushing touchdowns this season.
- Kicker Kenny Doak was named OVC Specialist of the Week for the second time this year after going 3-for-3 in field goal attempts (31, 37, 38) and 3-of-3 in PATs
- Freshman linebacker Bryce Norman had a game-high 14 tackles against the Skyhawks. Norman is tied for sixth in the OVC with 6.9 tackles/game while his 55 total tackles is second among all freshmen in the league this year.

NOTEWORTHY

- In a series that dates back to 1930, Saturday marks the 70th all-time meeting between the in-state foes. The game is part of the Sgt. York Trophy series contested between the four OVC schools from Tennessee.
- The series is split over the last four meetings, but since Austin Peay rejoined the OVC for football in 2007, UT Martin holds an 11-3 advantage (including nine-straight from 2008-16).
- After losing three games in a row, following its open date Austin Peay responded in a big way, blasting rival Murray State 47-6, its fifth-straight win over the Racers.
- The Govs rushed for 371 yards, the seventh-best performance in school history. Ahmaad Tanner had 148 yards and three touchdowns (earning OVC Offensive Player of the Week honors) while Brian Snead added 134 yards and two scores. In his first career game with the Govs, quarterback Sheldon Layman added 67 yards on the ground, to go along with 126 passing yards.
- Tanner now has 28 career scores, tied for the sixth-most in program history.
- Baniko Harley became the fifth APSU player to reach 2,000 career receiving yards and with a touchdown in the second quarter became the third Gov with 20-plus career touchdown catches.
- UT Martin won its sixth-straight game in topping Southeast Missouri 38-30. It continues the team's longest winning streak since 2006 (when the team won eight in a row). The team has four non-conference wins this year, the most since 1988 when the team lost in the second round of the Division II Playoffs.
- The victory snapped a three-game losing streak against SEMO
- Senior Peyton Logan reach 2,000 career rushing yards during the game, the ninth player in UTM history to reach that mark. He had his sixth career 100-yard rushing game with 159 yards on 15 carries (10.6 ypc) including a 75-yard touchdown run. He now ranks fifth in UTM history with 2,147 rushing yards. Logan rank second nationally in averaging 7.62 yards per carry; he is also 12th in the FCS in all-purpose yards (127.86/game).
- Quarterback Keon Howard accounted for 241 yards of total offense and four touchdowns (2 passing, 2 rushing) in the win, earning his third OVC Newcomer of the Week honor of the year. He set UTM single-season records by a quarterback for multiple rushing touchdown performances (three) and rushing touchdowns (eight).

NOTEWORTHY

- It will be Homecoming for Tennessee State on Saturday at Nissan Stadium. They welcome Murray State to Nashville, the first meeting between the two teams at the venue since 2013 (recent matchups since then were played at Hale Stadium).
- The teams have played seven previously times at Nissan Stadium, with TSU holding a 5-2 advantage in those games. Overall Murray State holds an 18-13 all-time series lead, having won five in a row (and 10 of 12) in the series.
- Murray State had its largest Homecoming attendance since 2000, with 10,023 fans in the stands for the team's game with Austin Peay. It was the first 10,000-plus crowd since 2019 for the team.
- The Racers were just 3-for-12 on third down and outgained 497 to 289 on offense by the Governors.
- In his second career start, DJ Williams completed 18-of-31 passes for 140 yards and a touchdown and led the team with 75 rushing yards on 12 carries (6.2 ypc).
- Lawaun Powell led Murray State with 13 tackles. Marcis Floyd had six tackles (2.0 for loss), a sack and two pass breakups.
- Tennessee State recorded its first shutout since 2017 (60-0 over Virginia-Lynchburg) and first against a Division I opponent since 2013 (31-0 vs. SEMO) by winning 28-0 at Eastern Illinois. TSU limited the Panthers to just 187 yards of total offense.
- TSU had four takeaways in the win, its most in its last eight games, and limited EIU to 2-of-17 on third down. Brothers James and Josh Green each had an interception.
- The Tigers have now won three games in a row for the first time since the 2017 season. The three wins in a row against OVC opponents is the first since 2013 (the last time the Tigers made the FCS Playoffs).
- Geremy Hickbottom threw for one touchdown and rushed for two others in the win. The transfer from Grambling had accounted for 14 touchdowns (10 passing, 4 rushing) in seven games in 2021.
- Freshman Zaire Thornton caught four passes for 76 yards and a touchdown. He shares the team lead with 19 receptions this season.
