## THIS WEEK'S OVC HIGHLIGHTS/STORYLINES

This week's schedule feature three games, two of which are Conference matchups...The matchup between Murray State and UT Martin features the league's No. 1 defense (MSU) against the No. 2 offense (UTM)...Eastern Illinois and Tennessee State have open dates...There were three games on the schedule last week with Tennessee Tech picking up its first Conference victory; the other two matchups were the first of two meetings between the teams this year and did not count in the OVC standings...After its win over No. 9 Jacksonville state on September 25 (its first win over a Top 10 team since 2013), UT Martin had an open date this past week...The Skyhawks are up to No. 21 in both the Stats Perform and FCS Coaches Top 25 polls; their opponent this week, Murray State, is receiving votes in both polls, while Austin Peay is receiving votes in the Coaches Poll...The last time UTM was ranked (2017), they lost at home to Murray State...Every current OVC team has been ranked at least one week in the Top 25 over the past five years (2016-20)...SEMO has forced a turnover in 19-straight games...Against two FCS opponents this season Murray State has allowed 3.0 points and 224.5 yards of total offense per game...In the 2021 calendar year (which included spring 2021 and fall 2021) four different OVC kickers have been named National Specialist of the Week...As of October 3, there are 15 former OVC players on NFL rosters (9 active, 4 practice squad, 2 injured reserve)...This year the League consists of seven football-playing schools who will play a six-game Conference schedule; additionally, some OVC schools will play other OVC opponents in designated matchups that will not count in the Conference standings (four games total, two of which are this week)...Two OVC players were named to each the Walter Payton Award Watch List (Draylen Ellis, Geno Hess) and the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List (Marcis Floyd, Kordell Jackson); the awards are presented by Stats Perform to the National Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year at the FCS level...This year's FCS Playoffs will include 24 teams and the field will be announced on Sunday, November 21...The OVC has placed multiple teams in the FCS Playoffs seven times in the past 11 years; OVC teams have 12 playoff wins since 2013, including five Quarterfinal appearances and one National Championship game appearance...In 7 of the past 11 years, an OVC team has defeated a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent...Last academic year (2020-21), 187 football student-athletes were named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll for achieving a 3.25 GPA or better.

## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### OFFENSIVE

#### **Jeremy Hickbottom, QB • 6-4, 210, Sr. • Mobile, Ala. • Tennessee State**

Hickbottom accounted for 367 yards of total offense and three touchdowns as Tennessee State topped Austin Peay 24-22, marking its first win in Clarksville since 2016. The transfer from Grambling completed 18-of-34 passes for 301 yards and two touchdowns (63 and 45 yards) and took a quarterback keeper 48 yards for a third quarter touchdown that put TSU on top for good. He finished the game with 66 rushing yards on 10 carries. It marked the first 300-yard passing game for a TSU quarterback since October 12, 2019. Hickbottom ranks fourth nationally in passing yards per completion (15.22), 18th in passing efficiency (149.4), 26th in passing yards (1,020) and 29th in passing touchdowns (7).

### DEFENSIVE

#### **Russell Dandy, DB • 6-0, 175, R-Jr. • Hinesville, Ga. • Eastern Illinois**

Dandy, a transfer from Butte College, had seven solo tackles (including a tackle for loss) and two interceptions while also forcing and recovering a fumble in EIU's game at Murray State. The redshirt junior accounted for all three Eastern Illinois takeaways on the day. One of his interceptions came in the end zone to end a MSU scoring attempt. Dandy is one of two OVC players (and one of 36 nationally) with multiple interceptions in a game this season.

### SPECIALIST

#### **Aaron Baum, K • 6-2, 250, R-Jr. • Orlando, Fla. • Murray State**

Baum scored 10 points, making 3-of-3 field goals and 1-of-1 PATs as Murray State topped Eastern Illinois 22-6. The redshirt junior connected from 46, 41 and 46 yards in the victory. On the season Baum is perfect (4-of-4) from 40-49 yards and ranks 34th nationally in field goals made per game (1.0).

### NEWCOMER

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE GRIDIRON

**2021 Schedule:** The 2021 OVC football schedule features a round robin format with the seven teams playing a six-game schedule. Additionally, some OVC schools will play other OVC opponents in designated matchups that will not count in the Conference standings (four games total).

**Top 25 Polls:** In the latest Top 25 polls, UT Martin is now No. 21 in both the Stats Perform and FCS Coaches Top 25s. This year marks the first time since 2017 that the Skyhawks have been ranked. Murray State is just outside both Top 25 polls in the other receiving votes section, while Austin Peay is picking up votes in the Coaches Poll. Every current OVC team has been ranked at least one week in the Top 25 over the past five years.

**Simpson Moves Into Fifth Place in OVC Career Victories:** With a 35-7 win at Northwestern State on September 18, UT Martin head coach **Jason Simpson** recorded his 92nd career victory, tying him for 5th place in OVC history.

**Zita Moves Into Fourth Place in Career Field Goals:** Tennessee State redshirt junior kicker **Antonio Zita** made his 50th career field goal on September 18 against Kentucky State, moving him into sole possession of fourth place in OVC history. Zita now has 51 field goals and is eight away from the OVC record (held by TSU's Jamin Godfrey). His 51 made field goals is second among active FCS players.

**OVC in NCAA Statistical Leaders:** In the latest NCAA statistical leaders (Oct. 3), UT Martin ranks fifth in time of possession (34:25), seventh in fourth down conversion defense (16.7%), 11th in net punting (41.0 yards/punt), 12th in rushing (218.0 yards/game) and sacks allowed (1.0/game), 17th in third down conversion (45.9%), 19th in red zone defense (70.6%), 20th in tackles for loss allowed (4.75/game) and 21st in total offense (430.8 yards/game) and rush defense (102.8 yards/game). Austin Peay is 11th in passing offense (303.0 yards/game), 15th in fumbles recovered (5), 20th in total offense (431.2 yards/game) and 22nd in turnovers gained (9). Murray State is 15th in red zone defense (69.2%), 17th in total defense (293.5 yards/game), 21st in scoring defense (18.8 points/game), 22nd in punt return defense (3.25 yards/return) and 25th in rush defense (105.5 yards/game). Tennessee State is 14th in passing yards/completion (14.70) and punt returns (13.44 yards/return) and 19th in interceptions thrown (2). Eastern Illinois is third in fumbles recovered (6), fifth in kickoff return defense (13.11 yards/return), 10th in pass defense (156.5 yards/game) and blocked kicks (2) and 22nd in turnovers gained (9). Individually, UT Martin's **Peyton Logan** is second in rushing yards/carry (8.76), ninth in all-purpose yards (136.0 yards/game) and 17th in rushing (92.0 yards/game). Teammate **Keon Howard** is 13th in rushing touchdowns (5), 14th in points responsible for (18.0/game), 23rd in total touchdowns (5) and 29th in passing touchdowns (7). Southeast Missouri's **Geno Hess** is fourth in rushing touchdowns (6), sixth in total rushing yards (470), eighth in total touchdowns (6) and 15th in rushing (94.0 yards/game). Austin Peay's **Draylen Ellis** is eighth in total passing yards (1,450), 10th in passing yards/game (290.0 yards/game) and 16th in total offense (290.0 yards/game), passing touchdowns (10) and completions (23.8/game). APSU's **Baniko Harley** is sixth in total receiving yards (489) and receiving touchdowns (5) and 14th in receiving yards/game (97.8). Tennessee State's **Dayron Johnson** is fourth in punt returns (18.0 yards/return), fifth in combined kick return yards (413) and 26th in all-purpose yards (119.2/game). TSU quarterback **Jeremy Hickbottom** is fourth in passing yards/completion (15.22), sixth in passing yards/attempt (8.87) and 18th in pass efficiency (149.4) while teammate **Rodell Rahmaan** is sixth in receiving touchdowns (6) and 14th in yards/reception (22.07). EIU's **Jason Johnson** is second in fumbles recovered (2) while UTM's **Tyler Larco** is 12th in punting (45.6 yards/punt).

**Ellis and Hess Named to Walter Payton Award Watch List:** A pair of OVC football players are among the 35 players nationally named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The selections were Austin Peay sophomore quarterback **Draylen Ellis** and Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess**. Named for the legendary Chicago Bears running back, the award enters its 35th season and is presented to the national offensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision. The Payton, first awarded in 1987, has been won by OVC players twice (both Eastern Illinois quarterbacks), Tony Romo in 2002 and Jimmy Garoppolo in 2013.

**Jackson and Floyd Named to Buck Buchanan Award Watch List:** A pair of OVC players are among the 35 players nationally named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List by Stats Perform. The picks were Murray State cornerback **Marcis Floyd** and Austin Peay nickelback **Kordell Jackson**. The award, now in its 27th season, is presented to the national defensive player of the year in college football's Division I subdivision and is named for the legendary defensive lineman. The OVC has had two winners of the award, Jacksonville State's Darius Jackson (2017) and Southeast Missouri's Zach Hall (2018).

**OVC Players on NFL Rosters:** As of October 3, there are 15 former Ohio Valley Conference players on NFL rosters (9 active, 4 practice squad, 2 injured reserve). Those players include former Eastern Illinois standout quarterback Jimmy Garoppolo, who has won two Super Bowl Championships with the Patriots and is now the starter for the San Francisco 49ers, who he led to the Super Bowl in 2019. Six of the seven current OVC football schools have at least one player in the NFL.

**NCAA Division I Playoff Information:** In 2010 the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoff field expanded to 20 teams, up from 16 previously, and in 2013 the field increased to 24 for the first time. The expansion in 2010 to 20 teams was the first since the field grew from 12 to 16 teams in 1997. The 24-team field is comprised of 10 automatic bids and 14 at-large berths. There are eight first round matchups (16 total teams), while eight (8) teams receive a bye into the second round. For the 13th time in 2021, the championship game will be played in Frisco, Texas at Toyota Stadium, a 20,500-seat multi-purpose stadium. The Southland Conference will serve as the host of the championship, which will be held on Saturday, January 8.

**Recent Playoff Success:** Beginning with the 2001 season the OVC went until 2013 without a FCS Playoff victory. But over the past eight seasons OVC teams have performed well in the playoffs, winning 12 total games and advancing to the FCS Quarterfinals three times in the past six seasons. In 2013 the OVC placed three teams in the field for the first-time ever (each won a game) and in 2015 the league had a team advance to the National Championship game (the first for the league since 1982). Over the past eight years five different OVC teams have won a playoff game.

**Two OVC Players Named to CFPA FCS Performer of the Year Watch List:** A pair of OVC football players have been named to the College Football Performance Awards (CFPA) FCS National Performer of the Year

Trophy Watch List. The duo included Austin Peay sophomore quarterback **Draylen Ellis** and Southeast Missouri senior running back **Geno Hess**. The two were among 44 players nationally named to the list. The 2021 CFPA FCS National Performer of the Year winner will be announced January 12, 2022.

**Two OVC Players Named to FCS Punter of the Year Watch List:** Two OVC players have been named to the 2021 FCS Punter of the Year Award Watch List by the Augusta Sports Council. The OVC picks, who were among the 20 nationally on the list, were Southeast Missouri's **Zach Haynes** and Tennessee State's **Kaleb Mosely**. The 2021 watch list was compiled based on the 2020 FCS Punter of the Year watchlist, the 2020 All-Conference teams, the 2020 All-American Teams and the 2021 pre-season All-Conference Teams. The FCS Punter of the Year Award winner will be voted on by the FCS Punter of the Year Award/Ray Guy Award Committee and will be announced after the regular season.

**Sgt. York Trophy Presented by Delta Dental:** Beginning in 2014 Delta Dental of Tennessee became the presenting sponsor of the Sgt. York Trophy. The trophy (founded in 2007 by the Nashville Sports Council and OVC) goes to the winner of the quadrangular season football series between the four OVC football-playing schools located in the state of Tennessee (Austin Peay, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin). The award is the only traveling trophy that involves four teams in college sports; there are three others that involve three teams, including the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. As a corporal in the 2nd battalion, 328th Infantry, in the Battle of the Meuse River-Argonne (Oct. 8, 1918), York and seven other soldiers captured 132 prisoners, was promoted to sergeant and received the Distinguished Service Cross, the French Croix de Guerre, the French Legion of Honor, the Croce di Guerra of Italy and the War Medal of Montenegro. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor.

**Academic Success:** During the past academic year (2020-21) there were 187 OVC football student-athletes who were named to the Commissioner's Honor Roll for having a 3.25 grade point average or higher. In addition, 17 student-athletes were awarded the OVC Academic Medal of Honor for achieving perfect 4.0 GPAs. The OVC also awards a Team Academic Award for the football program with the highest percentage of players with a 3.25 grade point average or higher; that award went to Austin Peay for 2020-21.

**Doak Named National Specialist of the Week (Sept. 27):** Southeast Missouri kicker **Kenny Doak** was named National Specialist of the Week by Stats Perform on September 27 after tallying a career-high 17 points in the Redhawks win over Tennessee State. The graduate student was 4-of-4 on field goals, connecting from 33, 40, 39 and 45 yards, and 5-of-5 on PAT's. The four made field goals was tied for the most by a FCS player in a game this season. Doak also kicked off four times for an average of 54 yards per kickoff with one touchback.

**A Look at the Coaches:** Entering 2021, six of seven head coaches returned to lead their teams from a season ago. The lone new coach is former Heisman Trophy winner and Tennessee Titans standout **Eddie George**, who was named Tennessee State's head coach in April. The former Heisman Trophy winner and member of the College Football Hall of Fame was a four-time Pro Bowl selection and a member of the Tennessee Titans/Houston Oilers Ring of Honor. The longest tenured coach in the league is UT Martin's **Jason Simpson** who is in his 16th season with the Skyhawks in 2021. Simpson has 93 overall victories in his career, fifth-most in OVC history.

**EIU's Cushing on Football Oversight Committee:** Eastern Illinois head football coach **Adam Cushing** is the lone football coach on the NCAA Division I Football Oversight Committee and is serving a four-year term until June 30, 2024. The Football Oversight Committee ensures that appropriate oversight of football for both the Football Bowl Subdivision and Football Championship Subdivision is maintained, enhances the development of the sport and make recommendations related to regular-season and postseason football. The committee prioritizes enhancement of the student-athlete educational experience (academically and athletically), and in doing so, promotes student-athletes' personal growth and leadership development. It works in conjunction with appropriate governance entities to provide solutions to issues impacting the health and safety of football student-athletes. The committee supervises procedures for licensing of postseason bowls and qualifications and/or selection procedures for the FCS Championship. The committee reviews recommendations from the NCAA Division I Football Championship Committee and process other issues related to the administration of the FCS Championship. The committee provides direction to the NCAA Football Rules Committee regarding playing rules governing FBS and FCS football. The committee is comprised of representatives from each divisional subgroup that sponsors football.

**Alexander on NCAA Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship:** Beginning this season Tennessee Tech head coach **Dewayne Alexander** is on the NCAA's Committee on Ethical Conduct and Sportsmanship. The committee's mission is to improve the condition of sportsmanship and ethical conduct in all aspects of college athletics by developing and implementing strategies that foster greater acceptance of the value of respect, fairness, civility, honesty and responsibility. Since the establishment of the committee, the group has focused on two areas: (1) provide best practices and creative tools (e.g., the RESPECT campaign) for campus and conference implementation and (2) increase the awareness and profile of the

**Carlisle and Horton Named to Division I Football Oversight Committee Student-Athlete Connection Group:** Tennessee Tech junior linebacker **Seth Carlisle** and Tennessee State junior defensive tackle **Raymond Horton** have been selected to participate in the Division I Football Oversight Committee Student-Athlete Connection Group (SACG). The connection group consists of 52 current players and its goal is to gather broad-based feedback from Division I football student-athletes on issues the Football Oversight Committee is reviewing. Among the priorities for the 2020-21 academic year are COVID-19 health and safety measures, transfer policies, name, image and likeness topics and social justice issues. Each Division I football conference has chosen two student-athlete representatives who will serve either one or two-year terms. The committee will meet quarterly to discuss issues and provide feedback to the Football Oversight Committee.

**Week Zero:** Eastern Illinois began this season with a Week Zero contest at Indiana State. It marked the fourth time an OVC team played during the week (2017, 2018, 2020, 2021). OVC teams are 1-3 all-time in games during Week Zero.

**OVC Teams Against FBS Opponents:** In seven of the past 11 seasons an OVC team has knocked off a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent (2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2017, 2020). OVC teams are 36-258-1 all-time against FBS opponents with eight total games (one remaining) on the 2021 schedule.

**Murray State Tabbed Preseason OVC Favorite:** Murray State has been picked the preseason football favorites in the OVC for the 2021 season. The Racers picked up seven of a possible 14 first-place votes in a poll of league head coaches and communications directors. It marks only the third time the Racers have been tabbed the preseason favorites and first time since 1996, when Houston Nutt was the head coach and the program was coming off an OVC Championship and NCAA Playoff appearance. The only other year the team was tabbed the favorite (dating back to the first preseason poll in 1978), was in 1980 when Mike Gottfried was head coach, and the team was once again coming off an OVC title and playoff appearance. Murray State totaled 64 points to finish just ahead of Austin Peay and Southeast Missouri, who tied for second-place with 60 points. The Governors and Redhawks were 2019 OVC Co-Champions and both appeared in the FCS Playoffs that season. UT Martin was tabbed fourth (38) and followed by Tennessee State (32), Tennessee Tech (28) and Eastern Illinois (12).

**APSU's Ellis and Jackson Headline Preseason All-OVC Team:** Austin Peay sophomore quarterback **Draylen Ellis** and Austin Peay graduate student nickelback **Kordell Jackson** were named the 2021 OVC Preseason Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in a vote of by the league's head football coaches and communications directors. Murray State led the way with 10 preseason selections, followed by Tennessee State with eight and Southeast Missouri with seven. Austin Peay and UT Martin had six selections apiece while Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech each had two. Returning players who were first-team All-OVC selections last year (25 in total) were automatic selections to the preseason team this year.

**Romo Becomes Sixth College Football Hall of Famer With OVC Connections:** In January 2021 it was announced that former Eastern Illinois quarterback **Tony Romo** had been selected to the 2021 College Football Hall of Fame Class. Romo is the third player that played in the OVC to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame joining Jim Youngblood from Tennessee Tech and George Floyd Jr., from Eastern Kentucky. Three former head coaches from the OVC have also been inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame with Roy Kidd (Eastern Kentucky), James "Boots" Donnelly (Middle Tennessee/Austin Peay) and Frank Beamer (Murray State). At EIU Romo was the winner of the 2002 Walter Payton Award as the top player in the FCS. After going undrafted in 2003, he would put together a standout NFL career with the Dallas Cowboys from 2003-16. The four-time Pro Bowl selection holds Cowboy records for career passing yards and passing touchdowns. Since retiring with the Cowboys, Romo has served as the lead color analyst for CBS' NFL telecasts, working alongside Jim Nantz.

**Four With OVC Connections in the Super Bowl:** At the end of the NFL regular season, there were 11 former OVC players on active rosters and five others on active rosters. For Super Bowl LV, there were four individuals with connections to the OVC taking part in the game. Former Jacksonville State All-American wide receiver **Josh Pearson** was a member of the Tampa Bay practice squad while former Austin Peay head coach and quarterback **Rick Christophel** was the tight ends coach for the Buccaneers. Former Murray State player and OVC official **Jabir Walker** was an alternate on this year's officiating crew and former Eastern Illinois and Dallas Cowboys quarterback **Tony Romo** broadcasted his second Super Bowl for CBS alongside Jim Nantz.

**Let's Get It Started:** The 74th season of Ohio Valley Conference football got underway on Saturday, August 28 when Eastern Illinois played at Indiana State in a Week Zero game. The OVC is made up of seven football-playing schools in 2021. Since its beginning, 15 of the 18 total schools that have played football in the league have claimed at least one championship.

**I-AA No More:** Although some people may still refer to it as I-AA football, the term that represents the level of Division I football in which the Ohio Valley Conference competes has been long retired. Beginning with the 2006 National Championship game, the term Football Championship Subdivision (or FCS) is to be used. Teams who play at the FCS level can offer a maximum of 63 scholarships (Football Bowl Subdivision teams can offer 85) and compete in a playoff at the end of the season to determine the national champion.

**FCS All-In:** Each Saturday during the 2021 football season, "FCS All-In" will debut a new episode at 9am CT and be available on-demand on YouTube. The program is a collaborative effort of the NCAA's 15 Division I FCS Conferences, bringing weekly segments from each league. **ESPN+:** The season every Conference football game (and select non-conference contests) will be broadcast on ESPN+. This marks the fourth year of the OVC's deal with ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer video service from The Walt Disney Company's Direct-to-Consumer & International segment. Fans can subscribe to ESPN+ for \$6.99 a month (or \$69.99 per year) or as part of a bundle with Disney+ and ad-supported Hulu (\$13.99/month). ## SGT. YORK TROPHY

The 2021 season marks the 15th of competition for the Sergeant York Trophy, an award created by the Nashville Sports Council and the Ohio Valley Conference. The trophy is contested between the four OVC football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee - Austin Peay, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin - and goes to the team with the best combined record versus those schools in a given year.

The award is sponsored by Delta Dental of Tennessee.

In the event of a tie, the award will be shared; however, the previous winner will retain the trophy if they are part of the tie. If the tie is between two other institutions, the trophy will go to the institution that has gone the most seasons without winning the trophy.

The award is the only traveling trophy that involves four teams in college sports; there are three others that involve three teams, including the Commander in Chief's Trophy which has been contested between Air Force, Army and Navy annually since 1972. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted Soldier of World War I. Upon his return to the United States in 1919, he was bestowed the Congressional Medal of Honor. Following the war York returned his home in Pall Mall, Tenn. where he dedicated his life to improving education and facilitating educational opportunities for children in the state of Tennessee.

#### OVC NOTABLES

- Every current OVC team has been ranked in the Top 25 polls for at least one week over the past five years (2016-20).
- Last year three teams were ranked in the final Stats Perform Top 25, the first time since the 2013 season three OVC teams finished the season ranked in that poll.
- The OVC has placed multiple teams in the FCS Playoffs seven times in the past 11 years.
- OVC teams have 12 playoff wins since 2013, including five Quarterfinal appearances and one National Championship game appearance.
- Since 2013, the OVC has produced one Walter Payton Award Winner, two Buck Buchanan Award Winners, an Eddie Robinson Award Winner and a Deacon Jones Trophy winner. In addition, the league has had two Doris Robinson Award Winners, as the National Scholar-Athlete of the Year.
- In 7 of the past 11 years, an OVC team has defeated a Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS) opponent.
- The OVC has produced at least one NFL Draft Pick in 10 of the past 14 years.
- In January 2020, OVC alum Jimmy Garoppolo became just the eighth former FCS quarterback to start a Super Bowl, doing so with the San Francisco 49ers. Last season (2020) 11 former OVC players were on active rosters at the end of the season.
- Former EIU quarterback Tony Romo was selected to the 2021 College Football Hall of Fame Class. He is the third former OVC player to be inducted (Jim Youngblood, George Floyd Jr.); in addition, there are also three former OVC coaches (Roy Kidd, Boots Donnelly, Frank Beamer) already enshrined.
- Over the previous 73 years, 15 of 18 teams that have competed have claimed at least one league championship.

#### NOTEWORTHY

- Saturday marks the first meeting between Tennessee Tech and North Carolina Central.
- This marks the second home game of the season for North Carolina Central.
- Tennessee Tech snapped a five-game losing streak dating back to last season in topping Southeast Missouri 28-17 for a win in its OVC opener.
- The Golden Eagles had just 27 yards of offense in the first half as they fell behind 10-0. But Tech scored 28 unanswered points in the second half to pull off the victory.
- Running back David Gist ran for a career-high 133 rushing yards, collecting two touchdowns to put away the game against the Redhawks. Gist averaged 5.3 yards per carry with a game-long of 19 yards.
- Freshman Jalon Baker had 10 tackles and a sack in the game. His biggest play was an interception early in the third quarter that led to a Tech touchdown one play later and started the comeback.
- Josh Reliford is second in the OVC and 24th nationally in tackles/game (9.0).
- North Carolina Central opened its season with a win over Alcorn State and has a victory over Winston-Salem State. The Eagles are coming off back-to-back losses to North Carolina A&T and Mississippi Valley State (17-16).
- The Mississippi Valley State game came down to the final play of the game, with the Delta Devils scoring on a 2-yard touchdown pass as time expired.
- Senior Ryan McDaniel leads the team with 29 catches for 389 yards this season.
- NCCU ranks 16th nationally in red zone defense (69.6%) and 23rd in red zone offense (92.3%)

#### NOTEWORTHY

- This marks the 26th all-time meeting between Austin Peay and Southeast Missouri. SEMO leads the series 16-9 although the Governors have won three of the last four in the series.
- Last season the Govs and Redhawks combined for 91 points in a double overtime shootout that APSU won 49-42. Austin Peay quarterback Draylen Ellis threw for six touchdowns in the win while Southeast Missouri running back Geno Hess had four rushing scores.
- Southeast Missouri had a 10-0 halftime advantage at Tennessee Tech on Saturday before the Golden Eagles scored 28 unanswered points on its way to a 28-17 victory.
- Geno Hess rushed for 69 yards and a touchdown in the game. Hess ranks eighth nationally in total touchdowns (6) this season and is sixth in the FCS in total rushing yards (470).
- Freshman linebacker Bryce Norman earned his first career start and made six solo tackles (including two for loss) and he forced a fumble on his first career sack. Norman ranks first in the OVC and 17th nationally in forced fumbles (0.4/game).
- SEMO has recorded at least one takeaway in 19 consecutive games. The Redhawks rank third in the OVC and 31st nationally with eight turnovers gained this year.
- Austin Peay suffered its second-straight loss, the first time that has happened under head coach Scotty Walden, in falling 24-22 to Tennessee State.
- Austin Peay failed to score in the first half (trailing 3-0) but scored 22 second half points. The Govs scored with 1:56 to play to close the margin to two, but the team's two-point conversion attempt failed.
- Kicker Maddux Trujillo hit a career-high three field goals, including a 40-yarder in the fourth quarter that drew the Govs within a point at 17-16. He now has eight makes in 2021, one away from breaking into APSU's Top 10 in a season.
- Brian Snead scored on a 66-yard run in the third quarter, marking his fourth career rushing score in two games against the Tigers (he has 252 yards on those four rushing scores).
- Austin Peay leads the OVC in passing offense (303.0 yards/game), total offense (431.2 yards/game) and scoring offense (31.0 points/game).

### **NOTEWORTHY**

- Saturday will mark the 61st all-time meeting between the rivals located just one hour apart.
- UT Martin has won 7 of the past 10 games in the series, although Murray State has won three of the past four. The Skyhawks won six-straight from 2011-16.
- The matchup features the No. 2 offense in the OVC (UTM) against the No. 1 ranked defense (MSU).
- Murray State limited Eastern Illinois to just six points and 287 yards of total offense in a 22-6 victory. In its two games against FCS competition this season, the Racers are allowing just 3.0 points and 224.5 yards/game.
- After missing his first three field goal attempts this season, Aaron Baum has returned to form and has made each of his last four attempts including all three against EIU. Baum hit a pair of 46-yarders, one from 41 yards and a PAT in the game to account for 10 of Murray State's 22 points. He was named OVC Specialist of the Week.
- Damonta Witherspoon ran for a career-high 141 yards and a touchdown vs. EIU. The redshirt freshman carried the ball 27 times for an average of 5.2 yards per carry with a long of 24.
- UT Martin is in action for the first time since knocking off No. 9 Jacksonville State two weeks ago. It was the first win for the Skyhawks in Jacksonville since 1987, and the first win over a Top 10 opponent since the 2013 (Central Arkansas) and first against a Top 15 opponent since 2017 (Chattanooga).
- After breaking into the Top 25 polls last week (for the first time since 2017), UTM moved up to No. 21 in both polls this week. The last game the Skyhawks played as a ranked team was on Oct. 7, 2017, a 13-10 loss at home against Murray State.
- UT Martin has now compiled three non-conference victories in as many weeks for the first time since joining the NCAA Division I Football Championship Subdivision ranks in 1992.
- UT Martin ranks fifth nationally in time of possession (34:25), seventh in fourth down conversion defense (16.7%), 11th in net punting (41.0 yards/punt), 12th in rushing (218.0 yards/game) and sacks allowed (1.0/game), 17th in third down conversion (45.9%), 19th in red zone defense (70.6%), 20th in tackles for loss allowed (4.75/game) and 21st in total offense (430.8 yards/game) and rush defense (102.8 yards/game).
